1. Closer collaboration between USA and Britain in war and peace - appeal by Colonel House.
2. Chinese exclusion act repealed in USA. Chinese now eligible for army induction.
3. Japs have captured village of Haptiki 2 miles North of Yinchow and are endeavouring to establish a beach-head either for evacuation or re-inforcement. Jap air force (30 bombers) attacked our columns with small damage. Allied air forces attacked supplies & dumps. During day 21 Jap planes were destroyed and a 4000 ton transport sunk.
4. Russia - Reds have advanced on Dnepetrovsk and completely encircled the defending Germans. Also in the Crimea they are dangerously close to encirclement.
5. Italy. German supply lines received a heavy pounding from the air. Sicily was heavily raided - Luftwaffe was conspicuous by its absence. Ground activity slight although we improved our positions in mountainous country.
6. Australia has appointed a High Commissioner to India.

D Coy 24 Aust Inf Bn killed five Japs in the AVIN area on 24 Oct, and found seventeen enemy dead.

Documents recovered from the enemy include maps of IAE and MARKHAM, 4 mile Strat series.

An unconfirmed report was received that ten Japs were on the road in the vicinity of YALU. A patrol sent out to check this report contacted and killed one Jap.

29 Aust Inf Bde

Patrol activity continues.

9 AUST DIV

24 Aust Inf Bde

On the night of 21/22 Oct the enemy evacuated his positions from inclusive KATIKA 640680 to the mouth of the River SIKI.

Fighting patrols mopped up and at 1100 hrs the area was reported clear.

The enemy also withdrew from close contact West of SCARLET BEACH but patrols located enemy still in positions astride KATIKA track approximately at 630682.

The Bde perimeter was moved West during the 22 Oct to a greater depth from SCARLET BEACH and at this date ran from 639696 to SIKI River at 636679 where it junctions with a Bn position.

At 1945hrs the enemy made heavy attacks East astride the KATIKA track supported by an unusual volume of LMG fire.

These attacks which took the form of mass attacks were repulsed with heavy casualties but were followed by infiltration attacks which were also repulsed.

A fighting patrol moved from KUMAMA along the track to SATELBERG road at 562663 engaged a party of twenty Japs killing at least two and wounding two without loss to themselves.

Close coastal defence against enemy small craft has now been organised.

PIB patrols and native reports confirm the belief that enemy supply failed to arrive by inland route KALASA-WAREO.

Large enemy barges have been located in the area 565676, at the headwaters of the SIKI River at 558661, 566671, 575693 and on the BONGA-NAMEO track.

On 23 Oct patrolling took place to BONGA. No movement seen.

Fighting patrols located enemy still holding positions astride the KATIKA track approximately 630682.

At 1910/23 Oct the enemy made three heavy attacks East along the KATIKA track. All were repulsed with heavy casualties.

Continual enemy movement both ways on the track PALANKO (5668) to GARLBOX (596687) engaged by our arty and casualties inflicted.

Fighting patrols attacked an enemy post at 555643 inflicting casualties.

Arty engaged enemy positions through the day, several explosions took place which were believed to be ammunition dumps.

Later information received reports a fourth attack on our position on the KATIKA track at 2000/23 which was repulsed.

Enemy movement during the night indicated attempts at infiltration.

ENEMY (ii) SEA

Our PT boats reported sinking two enemy barges during the night 23/24 Oct forty miles along the coast.

The PT boats were engaged by a shore battery.

RABAU

At midday 23 Oct, six squadrons of LIBERATORS escorted by sixty-four LIGHTNINGS bombed LAKUNAI and VUNAKAMAU airfields. Reports are not yet available from the bombers, but preliminary reports from the fighters indicate that seventy or more enemy fighters intercepted, of which nine were destroyed and five probably destroyed. Our losses were one LIGHTNING shot down and two damaged.

FINSCHLAFEN Area

At 1045 hrs 23 Oct, fourteen THUNDERBOLTS intercepted twelve to eighteen enemy fighters about twenty miles NE of FINSCHLAFEN. Three enemy fighters were destroyed and six probably destroyed without loss. Half an hour later, nine KITTYHAWKS attacked and destroyed an enemy light bomber ten miles east of FINSCHLAFEN.

Included is a document giving particulars of units with their strengths, which apparently moved by sea or marched along the coast from BOGADJIM to FINSCHLAFEN between 15 Aug and 15 Sep 43.

These included 20 Div Sigs, 26 Fd Arty Regt, 80 Regt HQ, 2 Bn, 3 Bn, plus MG Coys and Gun coys and pls, making a total all told of 3,224.

The move was to be in seven echelons: five to march by the coastal track in 26 days, one to go by barge in 7 days and the advance party, which was also to move by barge.

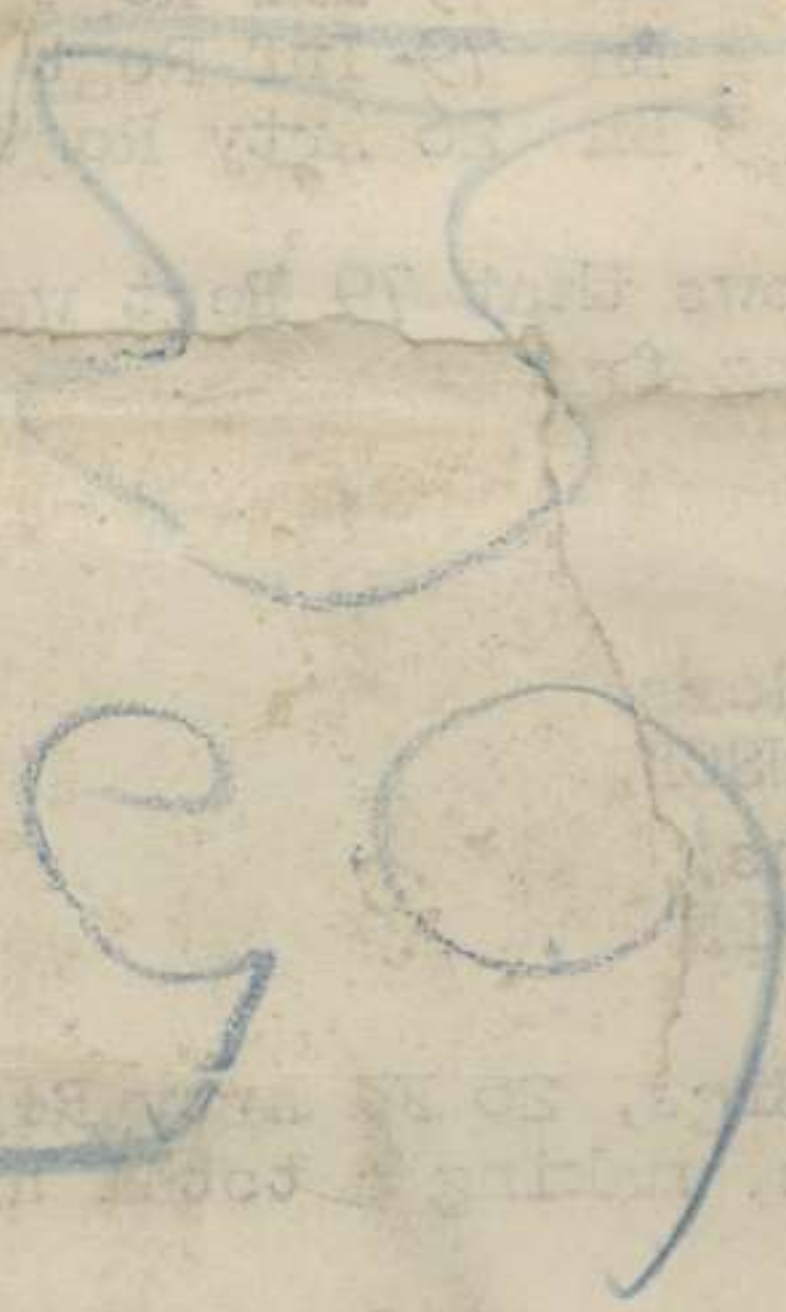

Enemy positions at 635578 were heavily mortared during the night 25/26 Oct. The enemy withdrew.

Patrols West along the SIKI R to 631 Easting reported no enemy in the area occupied by our troops.

RABAUL

About 1115 hrs, fifty-nine MITCHELLS escorted by ninety LIGHTNINGS bombed and strafed VUNAKANAU, RAPOPO and TOBERA airfields from minimum altitudes. At least forty-five grounded enemy aircraft were destroyed. An RDF station, two buildings, and a dump were demolished by direct hits and numerous buildings, searchlight and AA positions and airfield installations were damaged by strafing.

The MITCHELLS destroyed eight intercepting enemy fighters and the LIGHTNINGS thirty-four more. Two of our MITCHELLS were lost but the crew of one is safe. One LIGHTNING is missing.

At 0400 hrs, two LIBERATORS bombed a destroyer and a large merchant vessel in REIN BAY. The bombs overshot and no damage was observed. Three destroyers, five large unidentified vessels and fifteen barges were sighted.

ALEXISHAFEN

This morning, seventeen MITCHELLS bombed and strafed with 75 mm cannon fire dispersal areas and supply dumps near the airfields at ALEXISHAFEN. The attack is reported as effective. A building, several native huts and a heavy AA position were destroyed and a number of fires started.

SATELBERG Area

This afternoon, nine BOSTONS accurately bombed and strafed enemy defensive positions in support of our forward troops.

Air Operations 25 Oct

MASAWENG River Area: At 1100 hrs, nine BOSTONS bombed and strafed enemy positions at 638775, 635786, 613808 and a village at the mouth of the MASAWENG R. The attacks are reported accurate and most of the huts in the target areas were seen to be damaged. (2 Aust Corps Intell Report No 17)

F LAKUNAI airfield (RABAU) was bombed by fifty LIBERATORS. At least fifty-eight enemy aircraft were destroyed on the ground and in the air, and thirty-seven probably destroyed. One LIBERATOR was destroyed but eight of the crew are safe.

On 26 Oct eleven squadrons of MITCHELLS and seven squadrons of LIGHTNINGS took off to attack RABAU but weather prevented the attack.

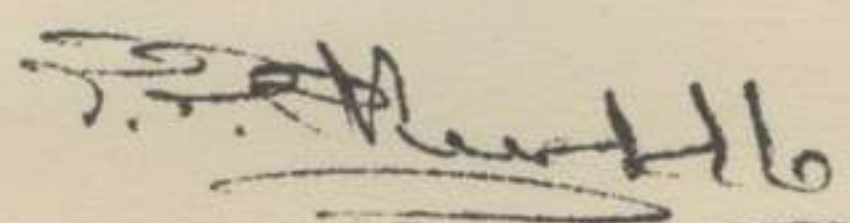

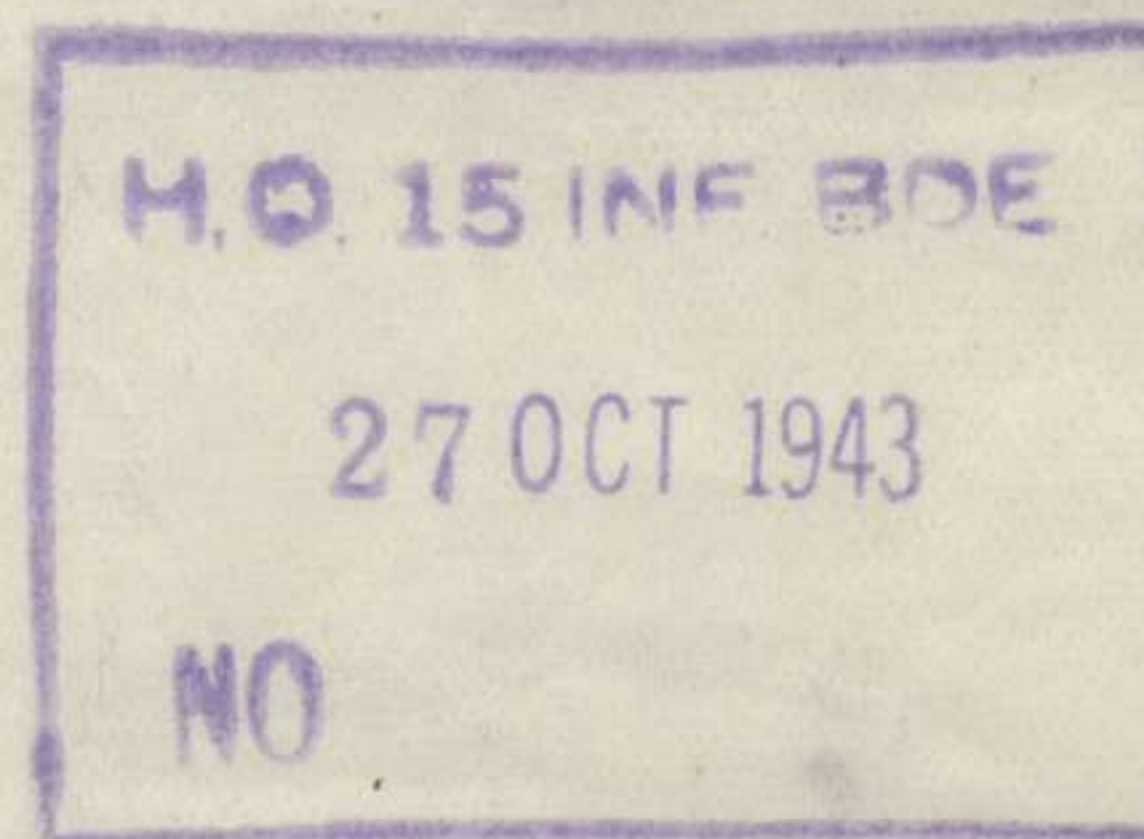

4 Aust Inf Bde

D Coy reached YAMBON ref 363542 at the junction of Government tracks to JOANGENG and SATELBERG. Indications were seen that both tracks had been used by Japs.

Patrolling continues in the area YAMBON-SAMBEANG, no enemy being seen.

Natives report that a party of three spotters was killed by Japs at KULUNGUFU.

1AE Area

ANGAU natives working with US troops captured another Jap about two miles to the West of the airfield on the afternoon of 25 Oct.

29 Aust Inf Bde

15 Aust Inf Bn patrol reports that two Jap tracks were located and followed to 480503. Four dead bodies were found, and possibly more are in the swamp. An improvised raft indicates that the remnants of the party crossed or attempted to cross the MARKHAM R.

Comment These remarks confirm statements made by PW No 27.

15 Aust Inf Bn HQ closed at 0800L/25 and reopened at the same time at 676435, D Coy remaining at MARKHAM PT.

Deserted huts and one dead Jap were found thirty minutes along the BAMBOK track. C Coy contacted 24 Aust Inf Bn at KEMEN.

15 Aust Inf Bde

A member of B Corps Sigs who was unarmed at the time, reports having sighted two Japs at 549550 (just near YALU). The Japs were in good condition and were carrying arms.

A Coy sent patrols to YALU and NARAKAPOR via North bank of the MARKHAM R to search for Japs crossing the river.

On morning of 25 Oct a two day fighting patrol left AVIN to recce the SIO track.

A new type of rifle was captured. It is stated to be identical with the 99 Type but length of only 35 inches.

7 AUST DIV

On 25 Oct, eight KITTYHAWKS led in by BOOMERANGS bombed and strafed enemy positions in the UPPER FARLE River area.

Following the air strike 2/16 Aust Inf Bn patrol raided enemy positions estimated at two coys in area 7063 and inflicted casualties.

2/14 Aust Inf Bn reached KEY POINT 4 7659.

9 AUST DIV24 Aust Inf Bde

Active patrolling and consolidation continued during 24 Oct.

2/23 Aust Inf Bn patrol to BONGA killed one Jap. Patrols along the South bank of the SONG R to 633697 and 629690 reported no movement seen.

During the night 24/25 Oct there was intermittent firing in the KATIKA area and some enemy movement.

On 25 Oct a patrol located twenty-five Japs at 653731 and enemy positions at 636690 and 635689.

A and B Coys 2/32 Aust Inf Bn made slight advances to area 639686 on 24 Oct. On the 25th they were in close contact with the enemy on the whole front.

At 1300 hrs an enemy 75 mm gun at 636681 was engaged and hit by 25-pounders. Eight enemy were killed.

At 1400 hrs the same day our arty engaged suspected enemy dumps in the PALANKO area at 5668 causing explosions and large fires which burned for two hours.

During 25 Oct arty shelled enemy positions at 595662 and on the 24 Aust Inf Bde front.

26 Aust Inf Bde

2/48 Aust Inf Bn patrols killed a Jap officer at 635677 and encountered fifteen Japs at 637679, also enemy on the KATIKA track at 617680.

Enemy were located at 635678 and dug-in positions at 635679.

On 24 Oct patrols from 22 Aust Inf Bn to KWENBANG 559591 (Ref map FINSCHAFEN 1") and a village at 547555, reported no movement seen.

The following day a small Jap party encountered at 559605 withdrew on contact.

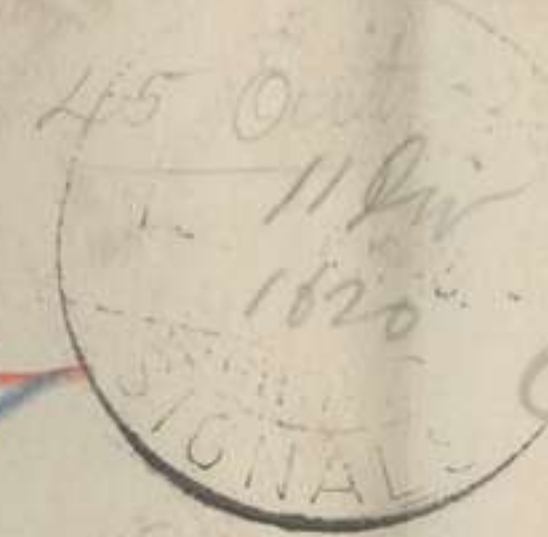

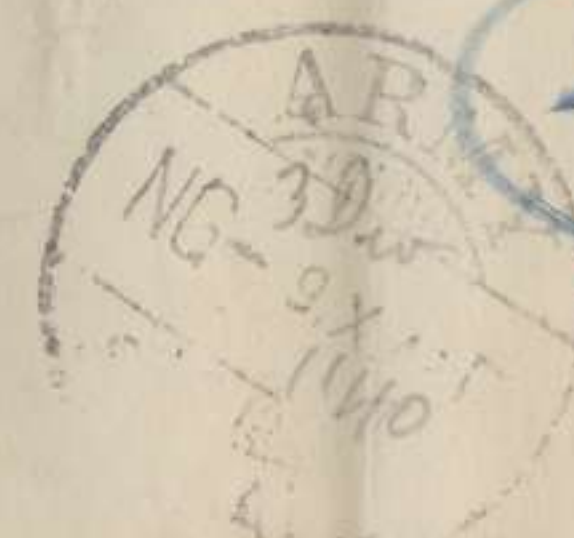

- (a) The Air Flash, which will be despatched immediately.
- (b) The Detailed Report, which is required less urgently.

THE AIR FLASH

2. (a) This message will be sent by most urgent means to Formation HQ for onward transmission in clear. By following sequence shown in sub-para (b) below it will be seen that unnecessary words are eliminated. This sequence will therefore be followed.

(b) The following information is required :-

- (i) Time of sighting.
- (ii) Number of enemy planes.
- (iii) Type (ZEKE OSCAR BETTY etc., or SSF TEF H/B etc)
- (iv) Direction of approach and height.
- (v) Details of action - bombed, strafed or reconnoitred or passed overhead.
- (vi) Place (map ref - if possible 1" to 4 miles Strat Series)
- (vii) Direction of departure and height.

Example:

Message to be sent in clear by highest permissible priority signal
1250 hrs 25 SSF 10 MB from NE at 10000 bombed GILI GILI
departed SW.

(c) Where enemy planes are sighted but do not pass overhead the information is of equal importance to Air Force. The line of flight is of particular interest and to establish this two reports may be necessary.

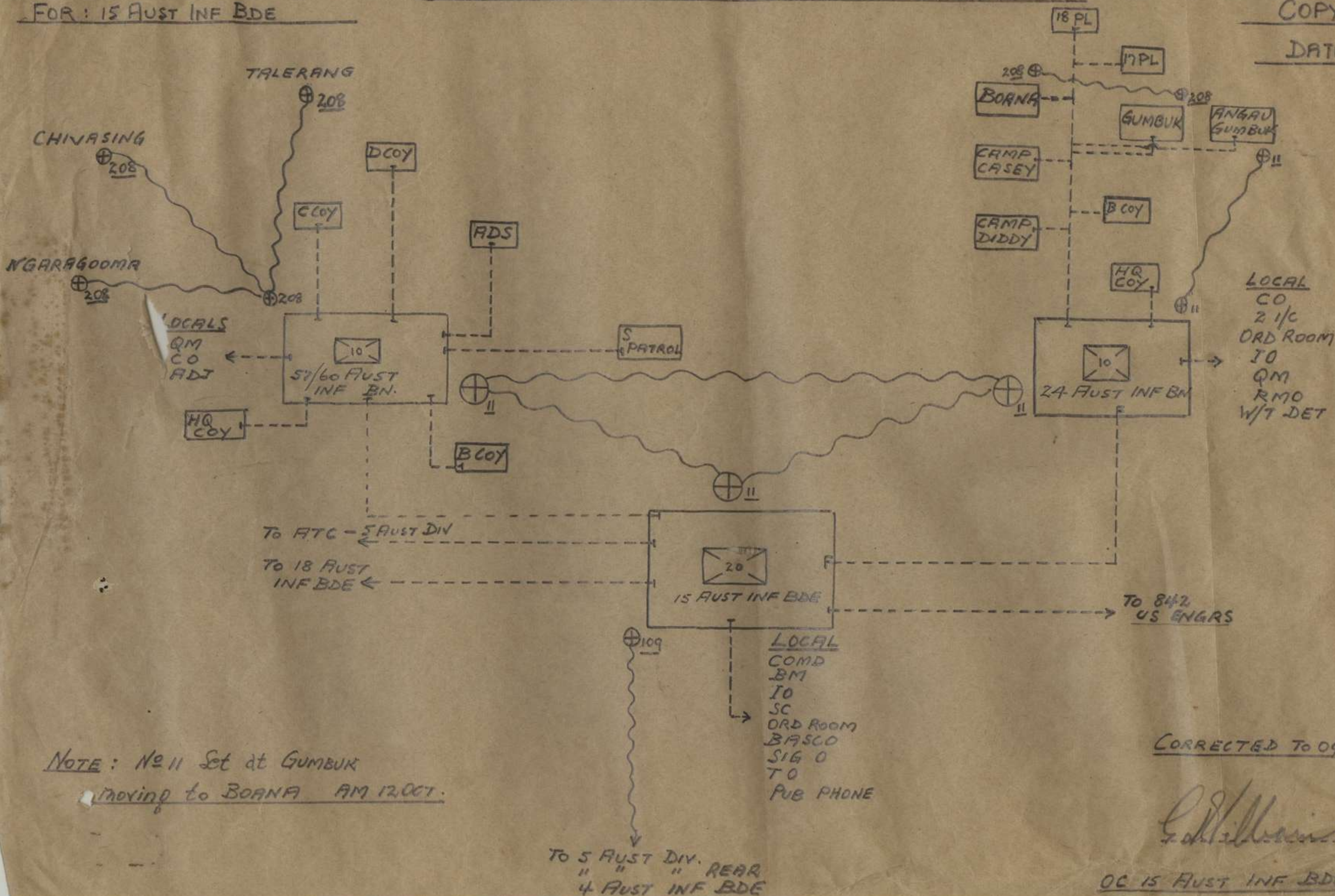
