NO 3 DISCIPLINE: PERSONAL APPEARANCE - SHAVING ETC (Extract from
Q N C F Routine Order)

1. It is fully recognised that men on fatigue duty must get dirty - that men on front line battle stations and on watch or guard or on night duty, or handling oily weapons or gear, may become dirty, and very often wisely wear old or soiled clothing.
2. There is no excuse whatsoever for a complete relaxation of the cleanliness of life and utter disregard to personal appearances - which is a sure sign of indiscipline and slackness in the unit to which such individuals belong
3. The following are a few of the most noticeable outstanding faults - hair too long and not brushed, shaving neglected, boots seldom cleaned and in many cases men appear to have disregarded washing themselves.
4. Steps are being taken to put a stop to these laxities in large cities and these measures will be enforced in this command compatible with the difference that must naturally apply to units on battle stations.
5. Because ceremonial parades and close order drill etc have been cut out or reduced to a minimum, this cannot be used as any excuse whatsoever for general slackness in bearing or appearances of the soldier.
6. A smart appearance and soldierly bearing indicates a man's pride in himself and his uniform and his unit, and these in turn mean that the esprit de corps of the unit is high, and this can only be high if the officers and N C Os give the lead.
7. Many young soldiers seem to take their pattern from the caricatures and not the real portrail of the Australian diggers which have appeared in a good many journals -- whereas the "dinkum" front line digger was, viz a man who takes the greatest pride in his personal appearance and bearing.
8. It is therefore ordered that every officer will take immediate steps to see that every N C O and soldier under his command is properly turned out and that despite fatigues and duties far more attention is paid to the reasonable decencies of soldiering and that men are encouraged to take a pride in themselves wherever they are - whether in the front line or around the camps, and most particularly on leave.




