55 UNCLAIMED STORES AND KITS

All unclaimed stores, baggage, kits and other similar material, in possession of units will be disposed under instructions of the Military Forwarding Officer through Camp and Billetting Commandants.

Units will submit list of such stores to Commandants.

56 AML RETURNS

All units will submit daily to this HQ through formations, a return of personnel AML. Returns will show personal particulars, dates and period of absence, and any disciplinary action taken. Details of reported civil offences or breaches of discipline by personnel on leave will be appended to the return whenever available.

Return of AML personnel over three days, (this HQ. A55) is no longer required.

57 DAMAGE TO SIGNAL COMMUNICATIONS

Considerable damage has been caused recently to vital signal communications by troops shooting at the insulators. This damage has been particularly severe along the Overland telegraph line, and has seriously affected communications. Commandants will ensure that all possible steps are taken to prevent recurrence.

58 LEAVE

Leave will only be granted in accordance with leave instructions promulgated through this HQ. Instructions issued to units on disembarkation for completion of one-day leave to ADELAIDE within four days of disembarkation are cancelled.

59 LEAVE PASSES

Personnel within the inner boundaries of the Falklands area must be in possession of a leave pass. Issue of passes is a unit responsibility.

60 MT WORK TICKETS

GS's will be maintained available for inspection in all AIF vehicles moving in 4 MD.

61 PETROL CONTAINERS

Units are returning 4-gal petrol containers NOT completely emptied. In order to avoid waste every care will be taken to ensure that this practice does not continue.

1 MOVE

Rd parties vide appxs 'A' and 'B' of 7 Aust Div Warning Order dated 9 Apr 42 will move from ADELAIDE area on 12 and 13 Apr 42 respectively.

2 ASSEMBLY

Convoys Nos. 1 and 2 will assemble in NAIRNE area 9172 by 1600 hrs on 11 and 12 Apr 42 respectively where they will bivouac for the night and receive detailed instructions for the move from Convoy Comds.

Convoy Comds will arrange for guides at rd junc 908718.

3 ROUTE AND DISTANCES

4 GROUPING ETC

Convoy Comds will arrange convoys in groups of approx 20 vehs.

Spacing between groups : $\frac{1}{2}$ mile

Density : 20 vtm

Speed : 20 mph (to be varied at discretion of Comds having regard to condition of rds, gradients etc.)

Halts : 10 mins every two hrs - 1 hr for lunch at mid-day.

Start times: Daily at 0600 hrs.

5 RATIONS

- (a) Rations will be available at all staging points.
- (b) Units will carry in vehs three days reserve for personnel travelling by rd.
- (c) AASC 7 Aust Div will arrange for two 5-ton lorry loads of rations to accompany each convoy as an emergency track reserve.

6 PETROL

- (a) All vehs will depart with sufficient pet for 250 miles.
- (b) Pet will be available at all staging points for replenishment.
- (c) AASC 7 Aust Div will arrange for two 3-ton lorry loads of pet in drums to accompany each convoy as an emergency reserve.

7 WATER

Water lorries will move full and replenish at staging points.

8 RECOVERY

- (a) Rec by LADs with each convoy
- (b) Evacuation of non-runners to military establishments where available - otherwise to recognised civil workshops.

9 MEDICAL

Evacuation of sick by mot arbs accompanying convoys to nearest military or civil hospital.

10 TRAFFIC CONTROL

Comds will use pro secs allotted to convoys for traffic control throughout the move, including control at the assembly point.

11 2nd LINE VEHES

Separate instructions have been issued to CASC 7 Aust Div regarding the loading of the additional 2nd Line vehs in each convoy.
