
It is intended to make the combined service at 0900 hrs each Sunday in JULIS Cinema as much like a church service at home as possible.



(d) Margins must not be wider than one inch. Where both sides of the paper are used, the margin should be on the left of the sheet on the obverse and the right side on the reverse.

(e) No more copies should be made than are actually

required.

(f) The reverse of old letters, orders, etc should be used for drafts, due regard being paid to security. Old Orders and obsolute Army Forms should also be

to test even inking. For this purpose, one sheet

should be used at least six times.

- 3. CARBONS: Carbons must be used until they have become unserviceable. In the interest of security used carbons must be kept under lock and key until they are destroyed.
- 4. ENVELOPES

(a) Size 5 in x 4 in envelopes will be used as far

as possible.

- (b) Except where envelopes contain secret correspondence for despatch to another HQ, economy labels will be used to seal envelopes. The address will be written on the label and not on the envelope. A paper knife should be used for opening envelopes.
- 5. ARMY FORMS: NIL returns will be submitted on paper and not on printed forms.
- 6. STORAGE: Stationary in Offices must be kept in a box or holder or under weight to prevent it being blown away by the wind and speilt".
