Appendix B

(h) Combined Operations

The Battalion, provided G1098 scale is issued, could play a satisfactory part in a combined operation.

No training has been carried out in Combined Operations, except:-

(1) CO attended C.T.C. Course at KABRIT.

(11) Six (6) Lectures have been given to all Officers of the Battalion.

(i) No parts of the Battalion have been trained in emplaning and deplaning.

4. REMARKS

(a) The Battalion needs 165 Reinforcements to bring it up to strength, and it will be necessary for these men to live with the Battalion for a month before they get the real spirit of the Battalion.

(b) Training is being hindered mainly owing to:-

(1) No carriers being allotted to the Battalion.

(11) Shortage of ammunition for training purposes.

(111) Lack of Training Pamphlets and Text Books.

(c) The Battalion will be more efficient when the time comes for it to go to war, if transport and all war equipment can be issued early.


3. LAUNDRY LOSSES OF CLOTHING

ECONOMY MEASURES (CONTD).

2. PAPER:

- (a) Sheets smaller than foolscap size will be used if this is economical in the case of short letters.
- (b) Single space typing should be used.
- (c) Both sides of the paper will be used for typing and duplicating.
- (d) Margins must not be wider than one inch. Where both sides of the paper are used, the margin should be on the left of the sheet on the obverse and the right side on the reverse.
- (e) No more copies should be made than are actually required.
- (f) The reverse of old letters, orders, etc should be used for drafts, due regard being paid to security. Old Orders and obsolete Army Forms should also be used as small slips.
- (g) Special sheets of duplicating paper will be used to test even inking. For this purpose, one sheet should be used at least six times.

3. CARBONS: Carbons must be used until they have become unserviceable. In the interest of security used carbons must be kept under lock and key until they are destroyed.

4. ENVELOPES

- (a) Size 5 in x 4 in envelopes will be used as far as possible.
- (b) Except where envelopes contain secret correspondence for despatch to another HQ, economy labels will be used to seal envelopes. The address will be written on the label and not on the envelope. A paper knife should be used for opening envelopes.

5. ARMY FORMS : NIL returns will be submitted on paper and not on printed forms.

6. STORAGE : Stationery in Offices must be kept in a box or holder or under weight to prevent it being blown away by the wind and spoilt".

6. E.F.M. STANDARD TEXTS

The following should be added to the list of Standard Texts:-

61. BEST WISHES FOR NEW YEAR.





One case of Australian soldiers selling rations to local inhabitants in our area has been detected. The soldiers concerned were caught red-handed in a Syrian village selling tea, jam, and other rations. As a consequence some Unit would suffer. Foodstuffs and clothes have been stolen from this Unit. It has been reported that local inhabitants have been seen wearing items of Australian uniform; even Service Dress jackets. It is suspected that these items of wearing apparel have been sold to the inhabitants by Australian soldiers. The co-operation of all members of the Unit, in the interests of the Unit's welfare, is sought in the stamping out of offences such as those mentioned. Such offences will be regarded in a very serious light.


3. The first priority of work in all Bn areas is to complete :-

Fwd pl localities of fwd coys.
 Double apron fence in front of A Tk ditch.
 Double apron fence around fwd pl localities.
 All concrete work, incl OPs and HQs.

but, as far as possible, wiring will be done concurrently with digging.

Trenches in pl localities will be fire trenches of the slit trench type provided with overhead cover. Covered living accommodation for sections will be provided. In the first instance section posts will be connected only by crawl trenches. These should be of minimum length. In the hills a combination of trenches and sangars will be used according to the nature of the ground.

4. Major C.R.V. Edgar will be responsible for all tactical decisions in the Div Central Sector and for indicating exactly to working parties the nature of work to be carried out and its detailed location.
5. Major K.H. Montgomery will supervise all working parties in Div Central Sector and at A Tk ditch.
6. RAE will provide all tools required by unit working parties detailed under para 1 (b). Unit will supply tools for all working parties provided under para 1 (a).
7. Any demands for additional tpt to lift personnel to the site of their task will be made by TO to HQ 19 Aust Inf Bde.
8. Roster of parties to be supplied by coys for week ending 1 Nov 41 is attached as appx "A".
9. Detailed order for working parties is attached as appx "B".
10. Coys will submit to this HQ by 1700 hrs daily, except Saturdays, the number of offrs, NCOs and ORs available for working parties on the following day.
