Warning Orders

4. The inclusion of formations and units in the attached appendices constitutes a Warning Order for those not already being prepared for movement but Warning Orders will continue to be issued by LHQ covering movement of units to QUEENSLAND to be prepared for tropical service by Rear Ech First Aust Army or Qld L of C Area as indicated.

5. Further warning instructions will not be issued except for additions or amendments to the Priority Lists, when relative priorities will be stated.

Submission of GRO G318/43 Particulars

6. Addressees will advise LHQ repeated Adv LHQ as quickly as possible, GRO G 318 details for all units for the warning of which they are responsible.

7. The provisions of Fwd Ech LHQ memo S/472.04/SD of 12 Jan 45 (NOT to Mov Control Gps) will be observed.

Reports of Movement

8. To ensure that rear details, if any, are accounted for addressees will advise LHQ repeated Adv LHQ by signal as soon as possible after formations, units or detachments leave AUSTRALIA, giving -

- (a) Name of Unit
- (b) Date unit or part thereof was shipped and brief details.
- (c) GRO 3318 details for balance, if any, which remains.
- (d) Date formation, unit or detachment movement completed.

Unit Leave

9. Addressees will ensure that as far as possible all unit personnel will have completed leave prior to departure.

Unit Equipment and Strength

10. Unless otherwise stated units will move at full War Establishment organized for tropical service.

Movement of Vehicles

11. Unless otherwise stated, units are required to move with vehicles. Owing to the various scales at present in operation, it will be necessary for LHQ scales to be used in cases where War Establishments have been varied.

Accommodation Stores and Tentage

12. Unless stated otherwise, units will move from AUSTRALIA with Scale A accommodation stores and tentage.

Jungle Green Clothing

13. Unless already held only units as indicated in column '1' of the appendices will be issued with jungle green clothing.

Sub division of Units for Movement

14. It is envisaged that the types of ships available may necessitate certain units being shipped in two or more parts. Addressees will ensure that units moving in detachments are organized, as far as possible, so that each detachment will be able to function, although on a reduced scale, on arrival at destination.

Ports of Embarkation

15. Tentative ports of embarkation have been stated, but it will be realised that actual provision of ships may result in amendments.

Allotment of Units to Ships

16. Whilst the earliest advice will be given, it is expected that in some cases units will be allotted to ships at short notice from LHQ. Addressees will, therefore, ensure that all units are kept in a state of preparedness to move whilst continuing to carry out, as far as possible, their normal functions.

PRESS: ON THE WEATHER IN NEW SOUTH WALES FOR THE MONTH OF JANUARY 1945

Night temperatures throughout the State were above normal from a half degree on the North Coast to 2.9 degrees on the North Tablelands and 2.6 degrees in the N.W. Plains and Slopes. Maximum readings were at times high but were not sustained for any length of time. In all Divisions the average maximum temperature was above normal except in Riverina and the South West Slopes and Metropolitan and South Coast where negative departures of 2.3 degrees and 2.9 degrees respectively were shown. The highest readings in the State were White Cliffs 117, Cobar 115, Tibooburn 114, Wilcannia 114, Renin die 113, Oronambi 113, Condobolin 113, Bourke 113 and Terrys Plains 113 degrees. At numerous stations readings of 100 degrees and over were registered during the month and the hottest spells occurred during the last fortnight. The lowest readings in the State were as is usually the case, registered on the Southern Alps where on the 4th of the month Kiandra and Kosciusko registered 29 degrees and 30 degrees respectively. Dust storms were reported from many places west of the Mountains but coastal areas were practically free of this disability until the closing day of the month when a fairly dense dust haze prevailed over the Central Coastal district. The most destructive bush fire raged in the far South East corner of the State for about 48 hours but fortunately was brought under control and finally extinguished by the rains which accompanied the passage of a Cold Front. Other outbreaks occurred on the Central Tablelands and fortunately were unaccompanied by severe damage.

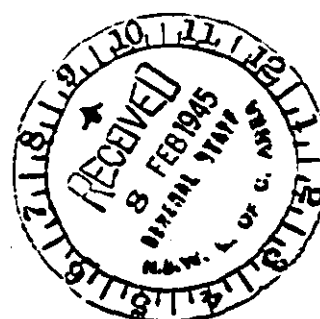
The agricultural outlook for 1945 after one of the driest years on record in the greater part of the State is not bright. Pastures are poor and the failure of cereal crops is causing grave concern for the future. Dairying received a slight uplift from the rains of this month and conditions on the South Coast and in the metropolitan area have improved. Fodder crops have failed rather badly and better production shows a decided decline. The potato harvest has been disappointing and in parts of the State crops which were not irrigated failed almost completely. Plantings have varied with the prevailing conditions and where some districts have exceeded last year's acreage others are much less.

Vegetable crops have everywhere been reduced through the droughty conditions but this month's rains should lead to substantial progress in production. The wheat yield from Northern districts has been a little more than 50 per cent of the total production for the year. Rainfall totals over the State show very fair results. The best falls occurred in Central Tableland and Eastern areas from 11th to the 17th and on the 30th and 31st. Unfortunately the Western Division had very low amounts for the most part and Fords Bridge is the only station in that vast area showing a fall above average. Broken Hill had no rain while Pooncarie, Wentworth, Barrington, Boganora and Goodooga had a few points only. The N.W. Plains and Slopes and the Central West Plains and Slopes had very good totals chiefly and so also did the S.W. Slopes and some parts of Riverina. The Tablelands Division enjoyed satisfactory totals mainly above average but here and there isolated stations showed a deficiency. The North Coast falls were much below normal and the same may be said concerning the Hastings Tenter Nanning Divisions but the average discrepancy was not nearly so great. The Metropolitan and South Coast Division had some really splendid falls and most stations had totals well above average. Sydney had a total of 1.1 inch, half an inch to over an inch below normal. At Sydney 1.1 inch was registered at Richmond, Windsor, Nowra and Pambula.

Hereunder is a rainfall table showing the average falls in each Division of the State and the percentage departure from normal.

Pressure conditions during the month were generally high, with pressure systems travelling in the direction of the central value. Tropical influences were the most important, as it was responsible in conjunction with the low pressure front, for the good rains in the Central and Southern areas of the State. Weather activity was fairly frequent and a number of cold fronts passed south from the high temperatures experienced at intervals throughout the month. Several fronts notably those which entered the State in the latter part of the month were slow moving and of more than average duration, while others chiefly passed quickly across the State. The month closed with the quick passage of a vigorous front, which scattered thunderstorms and fairly heavy rain on the Central and South coast as well as the Southern Tablelands and South coast. The highest temperature at Sydney was 80.1 degrees on the 30th, the lowest temperature was 56.0 degrees on the 18th. Mean temperature was 61.1 degrees. The total rainfall was 211 points, the highest of the month was 10.0 points, the monthly average for 30 years.

The greatest wind velocity was 15 miles per hour from the North at 10.0 on the 30th.

Barometer registered a high of 30.1 points against an average for January of 30.2 points. The lowest reading was 29.8 on the 25th, the mercury reached 29.8 on the 25th. The lowest reading was 29.8 on the 25th and a minimum of 29.8 was registered.

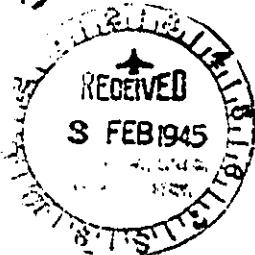

TRAINING FILMS AND EQUIPMENT - REORGANIZATION FOR DISTRIBUTION

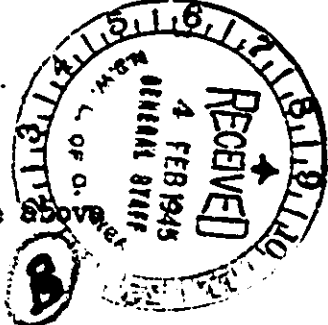
INTRODUCTION.

1. In order to make the best use of training cinematograph films and equipment a rearrangement of the present organization for controlling their distribution will be made.

DEFINITION OF VISUAL TRAINING.

2. For the purpose of this instruction visual training will cover the following equipment :

35 mm Cinematograph projectors
16 mm Cinematograph projectors
8 mm Cinematograph projectors
Epidiascopes
Strip Film projectors (35 mm)
Spare parts and accessories for the above
Cinematograph Films.



SUMMARY.

3. In effect there will be no change to First Aust Army, NT Force and Western Command, but main libraries will be established by Qld, NSW and Vic L of C Areas who will take over the responsibilities previously those of Adv LHQ (Brisbane) and Second Aust Army. Main libraries in all the above formations will form sub libraries on a geographical basis to service units in their area. SA and Tas L of C Area will be treated as sub-libraries of LHQ and be issued with films on loan for definite periods.

MAIN LIBRARIES.

4. Main libraries will be as shown hereunder and will be responsible for the supply and maintenance of all visual training equipment to units and schools in the Area of responsibility of their formation.

LHQ (DMT)
 First Aust Army
 NT Force
 Western Command
 Qld L of C Area
 NSW L of C Area
 Vic L of C Area
 SA L of C Area (Treated as sub-libraries of LHQ (DMT))
 Tas L of C Area (as regards distribution of films.)

DETAILED RESPONSIBILITY OF MAIN LIBRARIES.

5. Formations as per para 4 above will be responsible for :-

- (a) Receipt of all cinematograph equipment (incl training films) from LHQ (DMT).
- (b) Receipt of strip film projectors from LHQ (DMT).
- Note. Strip films are issued direct from LHQ to units etc.
- (c) Accounting to LHQ (DMT) for all cinematograph and strip film equipment (excl strip films which are expense stores).
- (d) Staffing and control of sub libraries.
- (e) Distribution of cinematograph and strip film equipment to sub libraries, units and schools.
- (f) Arranging screenings of training films or the loan of training films to all units and schools in the area.
- (g) Maintenance of equipment.
- (h) Training of projectionists.
- (i) The compiling and issue, to all units and schools in their areas, of a single catalogue with monthly supplements, showing films available from the main library.

SUB LIBRARIES.

6. Main libraries will form sub libraries on a geographical basis as suggested in Appendix "A" attached. These sub libraries may be closed or opened in new areas by main libraries according to changing demands. Accommodation and quartering of sub libraries will be arranged at one of the units or schools in the particular area, by

the L or C Area in conjunction with the unit or school concerned.

METHOD OF RECEIPT AND ISSUE.

7. All visual training equipment for training purposes is received by Directorate of Military Training at LHQ and issued direct to main libraries.

(a) 16 mm and 35 mm Sound Projectors.

Projectors will be issued as follows :-

- (i) To main libraries in sufficient numbers to carry out their responsibilities.
- (ii) To main libraries for special re-issue to a particular school or unit.

(b) Cinematograph Films.

Certain films will be required for continuous use, particularly at Schools, in which case provision will be made in the number distributed, and the main library will be directed by LHQ to issue the film on continuous loan to a particular unit or school. Main libraries may also issue other films on continuous loan to a unit if considered necessary, thus saving unnecessary movement of films. LHQ (DMT) will therefore issue films to main libraries under two headings viz :-

- (i) For general issue on loan through sub libraries.
- (ii) Special issue for a particular unit or school.

(c) Strip Film Projectors and Eidiascope.

These will be issued by LHQ (DMT) to main libraries in a similar manner to 16 mm projectors although in most cases their issue to a particular unit or school will be directed by memorandum detailing the distribution.

PRIORITY.

8. As units and schools etc. may request the use of training films for screenings simultaneously, it is necessary that priorities be laid down. These priorities will be as follows :-

- 1 Aust Corps - formations and units
- LHQ Schools
- Training Units
- Field Units (other than 1 Aust Corps)
- L of C Area Units.

Note : Reference is made to LHQ (165/1/4) 149366 of 30 Oct 44 to L of C Areas and Western Command only, in regards to United Service Institute. This directs the above formations to arrange screenings for the United Service Institute when requested, at the same time exercising judgment in the selection of films with regard to security.

MAINTENANCE.

9. Projectors will be serviced by technical personnel from main libraries who in addition will carry out a monthly maintenance check on all equipment or on 50 hours running time whichever is the sooner.

ALLOCATION OF EQUIPMENT.

10. (a) Equipment at present held by Second Aust Army will be allocated to NSW and Vic L of C Area or returned to LHQ (DMT) as shown in Appendix B attached.
- (b) After equipment, including equipment held at LHQ Schools, has been issued on loan from LHQ (DMT) to main libraries as per IR 6125 of 13 Jan 45 para 3, main libraries may reallocate such equipment as circumstances demand, within the provisions laid down in para 7 and 8 above.
- (c) The provisions of this instruction will not apply to 1 Aust Corps. (LHQ Sig TGL06753 of 15 Dec 44 not to all addressees refers).

ACCOUNTING.

11. The Directorate of Military Training is responsible through Vic L of C Area to the MGO for the accounting of Visual Training equipment. This equipment will be issued from LHQ (DMT) direct to main libraries on Issue and Receipt Voucher AAF F.95. Main libraries will be responsible direct to the Directorate of Military Training at LHQ for equipment issued, whether held by them or on loan to sub libraries or particular units and schools. Details for accounting by libraries and sub libraries are set out in Appendix "C" attached.

STAFF.

12. (a) The staff allotted for main libraries will be as shown in Appendix "D" attached.
- (b) To augment the above policy it is proposed to increase the War establishments of L of C Areas for Visual training personnel and to fill these by transferring the staff of existing main libraries on the following basis :-

(i) From Adv LHQ (Brisbane)

1 Officer 10 ORs - To Qld L of C Area.

(ii) From Second Aust Army

2 Officers 22 ORs - To { NSW L of C Area
 { 1 offr 15 ORs
 { Vic L of C Area
 { 1 offr 7 ORs

(iii) Approval may be anticipated to amendments to War Establishments in accordance with Appendix "C". Second Aust Army, Qld, NSW and Vic L of C Areas will submit to LHQ amendments to their War Establishments accordingly.

(iv) L of C Areas will be responsible for detailed adjustment of the transferred personnel to comply with the extra staff as shown in Appendix "C" and for the provision of such other visual training personnel as are necessary to complete their War Establishment.

(v) Second Aust Army will liaise with NSW and Vic L of C Areas with a view to transferring personnel to those formations in accordance with Second Aust Army memorandum 9285 of 19 Dec 44.

- (c) Some units have personnel on their strength who hold a Certificate of qualification as a 16 mm projectionist (AAF F 127). When such units require screenings they will employ such qualified personnel.

CONTROL OF VISUAL TRAINING.

13. Although the distribution and maintenance of training films and equipment will be in some areas an L of C Area responsibility, it is to be noted that the use of Visual Training films and equipment remains the responsibility of the Formation HQ commanding the unit (LHQ in the case of LHQ Schools). However the officer in charge of the main library will act in an advisory capacity to all commanders on the use of Visual Training and will conduct courses for the training of unit projectionists.

ACCOMMODATION.

14. At main libraries the following accommodation will be required -

Workshops
Library
Theatrette
Store
Office.

TRANSPORT.

15. As no transport will be allocated to visual training sections in formations to carry out their functions it will be necessary to requisition transport from formation pool as required.

TIME OF COMPLETION.

16. Qld, NSW and Vic L of C Areas will notify LHQ when the above reorganization has been completed.

MESSAGES ORIGINATED BY HQ NSW L OF C AREA.

1. An examination of the Signal traffic passing through Staff Message Control reveals that over 40% of the total number of outward Messages received during the day are received between 1600 and 1800 hrs. Statistics for the week ending 7 Feb 45 are quoted hereunder - (Sunday included) -

Of this total an average of 81 Messages of Deferred Category addressed to Landforces, Landops, Milbase Melbourne, Milbase Brisbane and First Aust Army units are despatched from SMC by Air Mail. The remainder are passed to Boronia Signal Centre for despatch by normal signal channels.

2. It will be readily seen from these figures that a large percentage of Messages originated during the day do not arrive at Boronia Signal Centre until after 1800 hrs. This results in heavy overloading of Signal channels till after 2400 hrs daily.

3. It is realised that this accumulation cannot be altogether avoided but with the assistance of all concerned to the following points Signal Traffic passing through Boronia after 1800 hrs could be reduced:-

(1) Greater use of Memos in lieu of Signals -

Signal channels are at present overloaded with many matters of a less urgent nature which can be adequately dealt with by memo. A fast Air Mail Service is available to all parts of the Commonwealth and Territories. Memos intended for despatch by Air Mail should be marked accordingly.

- (ii) Elimination of time lag between Time of Origin and Time Received at SMC.

Messages are received every day at SMC up to 4 hours after time of signature. This can be largely reduced by passing Messages to Registry as soon as they are signed.

- (iii) Greater use of Messages of Deferred Category.

It appears that insufficient use is made of Deferred Category Messages. Messages marked Deferred and addressed to Landforces, Landops, Milbase Melbourne, Milbase Brisbane or First Aust Army units and which arrive at SMC before 1800 hrs daily are not sent through Signal channels but are despatched by Air Mail. Messages for Melbourne and Brisbane reach addressees the following morning. Messages for First Aust Army units reach addressees in from 36 to 48 hours.

COMMONWEALTH OF AUSTRALIA

NATIONAL SECURITY (GENERAL) REGULATIONS - REGULATION 4

O R D E R

WHEREAS by Regulation 4 of the National Security (General) Regulations it is provided that if it appears to the Minister to be necessary or expedient in the interests of the defence of the Commonwealth or the efficient prosecution of the war or for maintaining supplies and services essential to the life of the community that special precautions should be taken for the security of any place he may by order declare that place to be a prohibited place for the purpose of the said Regulations;

AND WHEREAS by Instrument of Delegation in writing dated the twenty first day of September 1943 made in pursuance of Section 17 of the National Security Act 1939-1943 (which said delegation was published in the Commonwealth Gazette No 221 on the thirteenth day of October, 1943 and is still continuing and of full force and effect) the Minister of State for Defence delegated to every Officer who should at any time during the continuance of the delegation be holding the office or performing the duties of the office of Commander of a Lines of Communication Area the powers and functions conferred upon the said Minister by Regulation 4 of the National Security (General) Regulations in respect of that Lines of Communication area;

AND WHEREAS it appears to me the undersigned, Eric Clive Pegus Plant to be necessary and expedient in the interest of the defence of the Commonwealth and the efficient prosecution of the war and for maintaining supplies and services essential to the life of the community that special precautions should be taken for the security of the place hereinafter described;

NOW THEREFORE I, Eric Clive Pegus Plant, Major-General, the officer for the time being holding the office and performing the duties of the office of Commander of New South Wales Lines of Communication Area acting in pursuance of and in exercise of the powers and functions conferred upon me by the said Regulation and instrument of Delegation DO HEREBY by this my Order:-

DECLARE that between the hours of sunrise and sunset the place described in the Schedule hereto is a prohibited place within the meaning and for the purpose of the National Security (General) Regulations.

THE SCHEDULE

ARMY TRUNK LINE TELEPHONE SERVICES.

1. Excessive delay to telephone traffic on the Melbourne Sydney Trunk line is being caused by the abnormal number of "Priority" calls being demanded.
2. 75% of calls passing between Melbourne and Sydney are now classified as "Important" by the originators although in many cases the subject matter discussed does not appear to warrant the use of any priority.
3. GRO 4/45 lays down that "Important" priority is reserved, inter alia, for Directors at LHQ and for staff officers, at LHQ, and of formations and L of C Areas, not below the rank of Lt.Col. The interpretation placed on this by some officers in the above categories appears to be that by virtue of their rank or appointment they are entitled to demand "Important" calls to avoid any personal inconvenience which might be caused by normal traffic delay, irrespective of whether the urgency of the call justifies the use of a priority. This is in distinct contravention of para 2 of GRO 4/45.
4. The practice, whereby officers who have no authority to demand priority calls demand such calls in the name of an officer authorized by GRO 4/45, is increasing. There is no authority whatever for this practice, which will be discontinued forthwith. In emergency, any officer may originate a priority call in his own name in terms of GRO 4/45, para 3.
5. The use of a priority is only justified by the importance and urgency of the subject matter discussed. When discussion is completed on the subject for which the priority was authorized, the call will be terminated. The practice of handing the line over to other officers, after the completion of his conversation, by the originator of a priority call, and thus keeping the line occupied under such priority for the full period allowed even though the original call was completed in a relatively short period is an abuse of priority and will be discontinued.
6. It is desired that urgent action be taken to bring the above to notice of all concerned in order that the present congestion on the trunk service may be alleviated.
