- (c) warning applicant of the penalties provided in the case of false answers being given on A.F A.200, and
- (d) terms and conditions of enlistment as set out in AHQ 15221 being fully explained to applicant.

7. Where an applicant states he has no parents or guardian, Area Offrs will :-

- (a) Investigate applicant's statement, and
- (b) submit application and report on investigation with Area Officer's recommendation to this HQ for decision before marching in to BR&GDD.

8. In the case of personnel who state they have had no previous service, date of birth of applicant will be verified by Area Officer by sighting birth certificate and/or identity card at the time of application. If proof of date of birth is not available at time of application, Area Offr will take action in accordance with para 11(b) hereunder.

9. For all applications accepted, Areas will prepare A.F D.1 and compile new master card for each applicant immediately, the latter will be filed in the general card index. The compilation of the master card will be in accordance with SCR&E (par) 1045, para 34(i) and, in addition to this information, the following will be shown :-

- (a) Area serial number
- (b) Marital state
- (c) Previous service (to include Army number, rank, ex-unit, date of discharge, and reason for discharge)
- (d) Decision, movements, and remarks.

10. Applications accepted by Area Offrs will be registered in the "Register of receipt of applications and disposal of applicants", Pro forma APPENDIX "A" att. Details regarding maintenance of Register and rendition of relative figures as set out in Rec. Instr No 2/46 of 9 Apr 46 as amended will apply.

11. GENERAL ENLISTMENT - CHECKING

Details of all applications received from personnel will be submitted to reach respective Area HQs on the dates nominated by Area HQ in the following manner :-

(a) PERSONNEL WITH PREVIOUS SERVICE

- (i) A nominal roll of personnel who state they have had previous naval, military, and/or air force service will be submitted in duplicate vide Pro forma APPENDIX "B" att, together with an appendix, where necessary, containing any information regarding any applicant that will assist in the vetting of records.
- (ii) Area Code Majors will, on receipt of nominal rolls of personnel with previous service from Areas under their command, retain duplicates copies for record and submit original nominal roll from all Areas to DAG(R&M) by 0900 hrs on Monday of each week.
- (iii) Result of check of details of applications submitted on nominal roll will be given by DAG(R&M) to Area Code Majors on Pro forma APPENDIX "C" att. (Ref EASTERN COMD 23698 of 2 Feb 46).
- (iv) Area Code Majors will advise Areas of the result of the check, where necessary action will be taken by Area and notation made on Area Register and master index card.

(b) PERSONNEL WITH NO PREVIOUS SERVICE.

- (i) A nominal roll of personnel who state they have had no previous service will be submitted in triplicate vide Pro forma APPENDIX "B" att, together with an appendix containing any information regarding any applicant that will assist in the vetting of records, such as previous civil record, etc.
- (ii) Area Code Majors will, on receipt of nominal rolls of personnel who state they have had no previous service from Areas under their command, retain triplicate copies for record purposes and submit nominal rolls in duplicate from all Areas to DAG(R&M) by 0900 hrs on Monday of each week.
- (iii) This nominal roll will be checked with master index at Echelon 2 Records, also with Registrar General to verify dates of birth of personnel not already verified by Area Offr.

NOTE :- To minimise as much as practicable the check with Registrar General, Area Offrs will endeavour to verify date of birth at time of interview. Metropolitan Areas are authorised to contact S.sgt ROGER at Registrar General's office, telephone BO6 Extension 2529 to verify date of birth. Indication as to whether date of birth is required to be checked by DAG(R&M) will be given by 'yes' or 'no' in Column 6 of Pro forma APPENDIX "B".

- (iv) Result of check of details of applications submitted on nominal roll, Pro forma APPENDIX "B", will be detailed in Column 6 of Pro forma APPENDIX "B" and original returned to Area Code Majors for return to Area concerned, where the necessary action will be taken and notations made on Area Register and master index cards.
12. In the case of personnel with previous service Areas will, on receipt of check of nominal rolls submitted as set out above, call applicants for preliminary medical examination.
13. Personnel who state they have had no previous service, with the exception of applicants with civil record, will be medically examined as soon as practicable after receipt of application, and PME will not be held up pending result of

of check. Personnel whose names are submitted as having civil record will not be medically examined until result of check is received in area.

14. AFFILIATIONS BY OFFRS.

- (a) On application being received, Area Offr will arrange preliminary medical examination immediately, and
- (b) If applicant is found fit by AMO, AAF A.203, endorsed with medical classification, together with written application by Offr will be submitted to DAAG (R&M) for consideration. Nominal Roll in accordance with para 11(a) above will not be necessary.

NOTE :- Applicants are at present only being accepted from offrs on R of O who are medically fit "A1" or "A2" (Fit for tropical service) and who are within the age limits prescribed for AIF Offrs in GRC 355/44.

15. "SPECIALIST" ENLISTMENTS

Applicants who desire to enlist as specialists, i.e. Tradesmen, Instructors, Infantry Instructors, Landsmen, etc. will be treated in the same manner as offrs above.

16. DRAFTING TO R&GDD

- (b) Drafts will be despatched from Areas to arrive at R&GDD before 1100 hrs daily on the dates set down by Area Sde Maj.
- (c) Basic documents of recruits warned for draft will be forwarded by Areas to reach R&GDD at least two (2) days before drafts are due to arrive. Owing to different times of arrival of country trains, recruits will be marched in to R&GDD, and AAF Mob 3 made out by Areas and/or towns, and NOT by the Areas in order that R&GDD may satisfactorily check each draft on arrival; names to be in alphabetical order and "other name" in full to be shown, and double spacing will be used. Three (3) copies only of AAF Mob 3 are now required at R&GDD.

17. Recruits will be instructed to report to Recruit Reception Section, R&GDD.

18. Area Sde Majors will render to DAAG(R&M) on the first day of each month, a monthly return of AAF F.7. This return will be phoned and confirmed.

19. This instruction supersedes any instruction or part thereof previously issued in cases where they conflict and will be brought into effect forthwith in respect of all future applications for enlistment.
