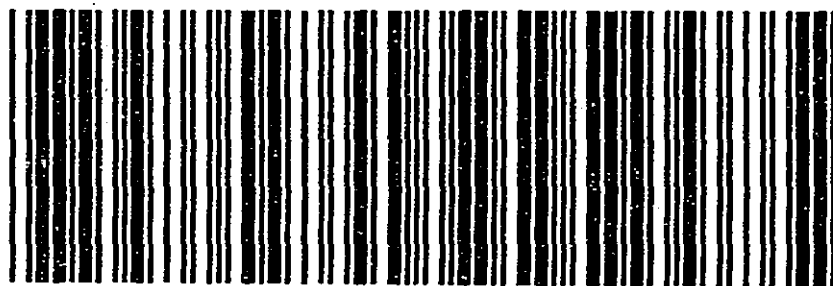

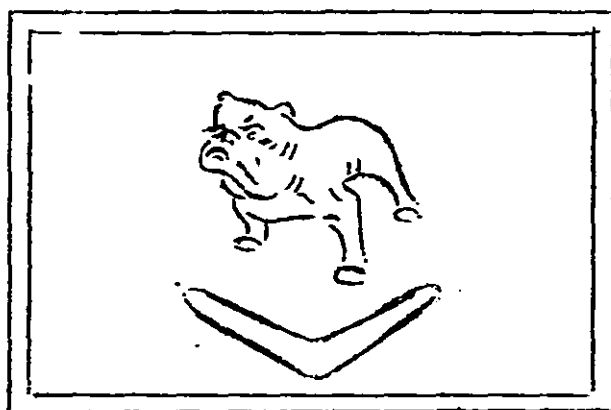

288. OUT OF BOUNDS

289. USE OF ELECTRIC IRONS

1. The use of electric irons in the camp area is restricted to the hours between 0600 hrs and 1600 hrs daily.
2. Use of irons outside these hours or any unauthorised connections of electrical appliances will result in the immediate disconnection of such points and disciplinary action will be taken against those concerned.

290. TOBACCO AND CIGARETTES

- (a) Owing to Manpower difficulties, tobacco manufacturers find themselves unable to supply full demands from the Services, including Australian Army Canteens Service and the Australian Comforts Fund, for tobacco in hermetically sealed tins.
- (b) This inability affects the total amount of tobacco available for First Aust Army areas and certain areas in AUSTRALIA where rapid deterioration of tobacco occurs if it is not so packed. Investigations with regard to alternative moisture-proof packs have shown that the same Manpower difficulties would prevent any increase in the total amount of moisture-proof packed tobacco available.
- (c) As it is considered undesirable from many points of view to cease free distribution of tobacco and cigarettes by the ASC in forward operational areas and by the ACF in their periodical distribution of parcels and in embarkation kits, the reduction must necessarily be borne by the AACF.
- (d) any necessary alterations by AACF to the basis of weekly sales to personnel of tobacco and cigarettes will be communicated through Camp Routine Orders.

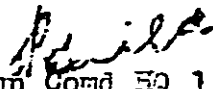
