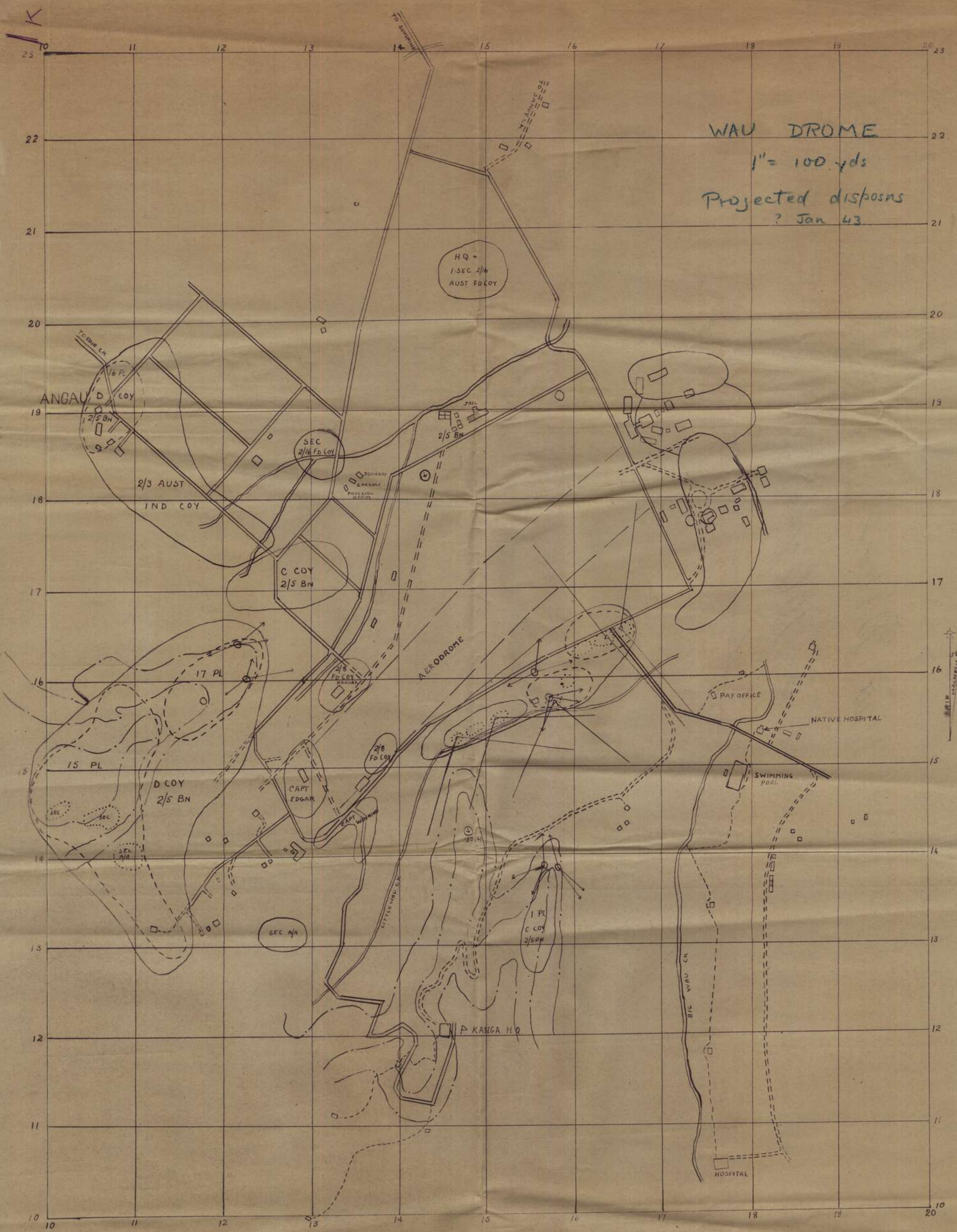

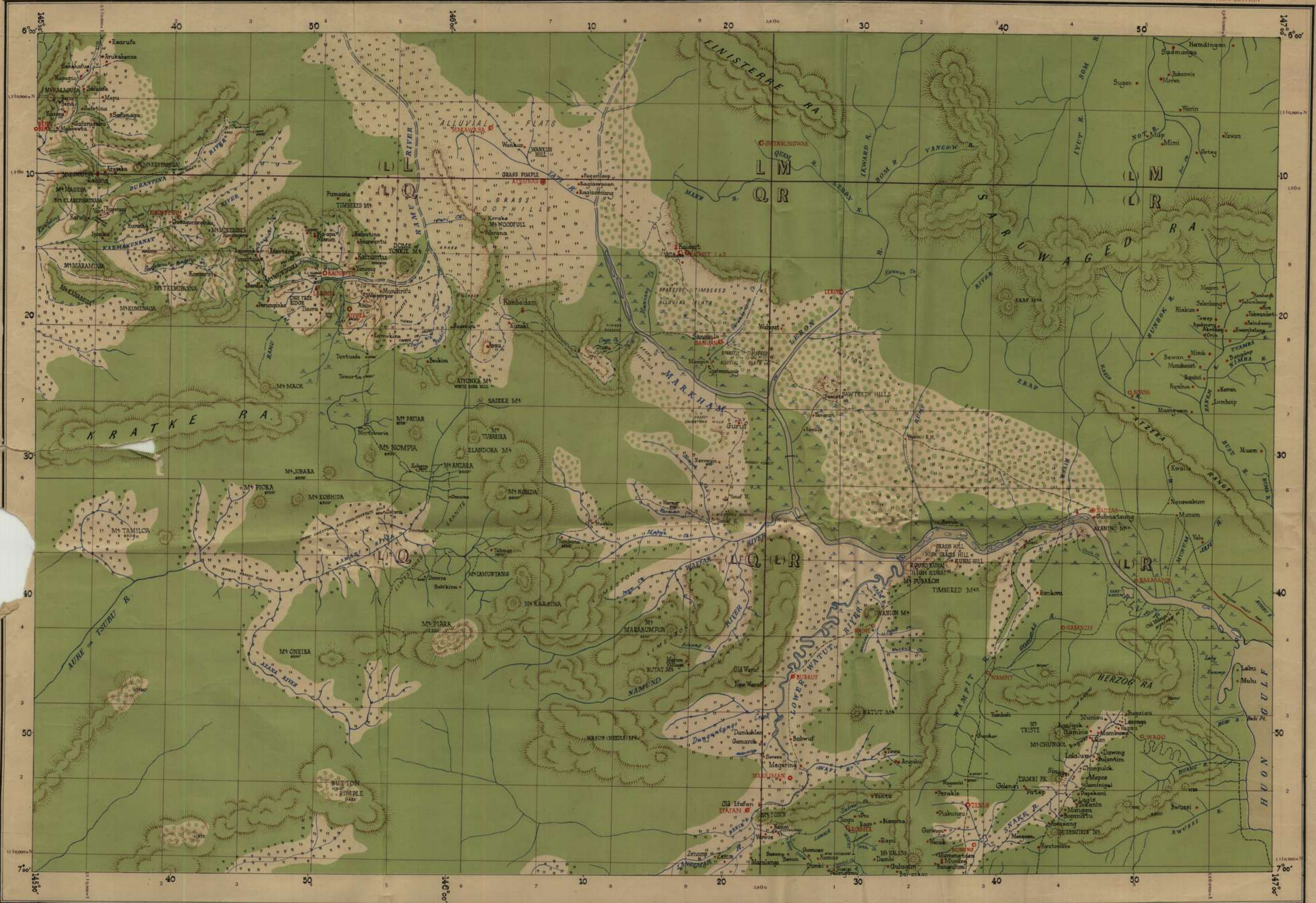
TERRITORY OF NEW GUINEA

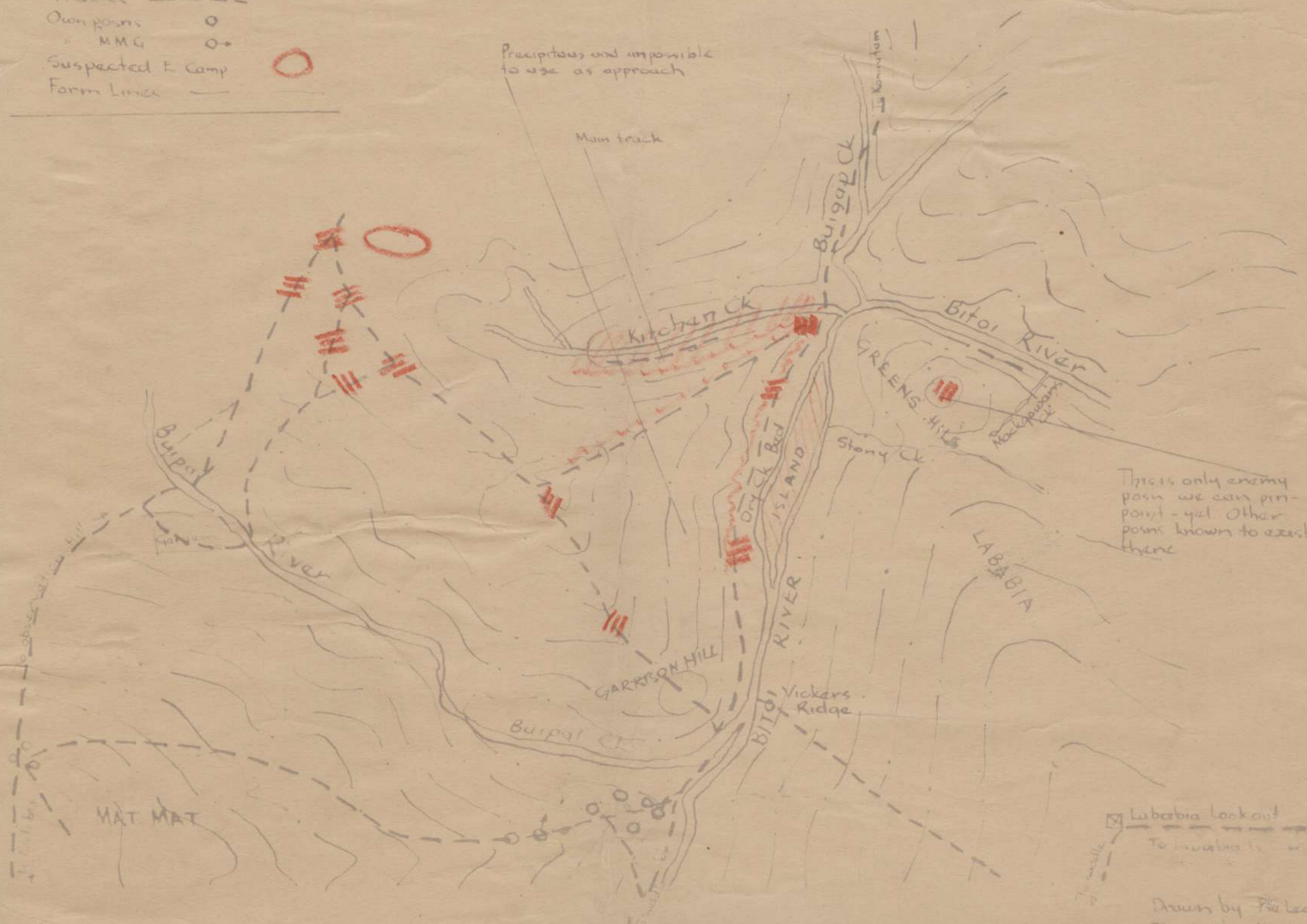

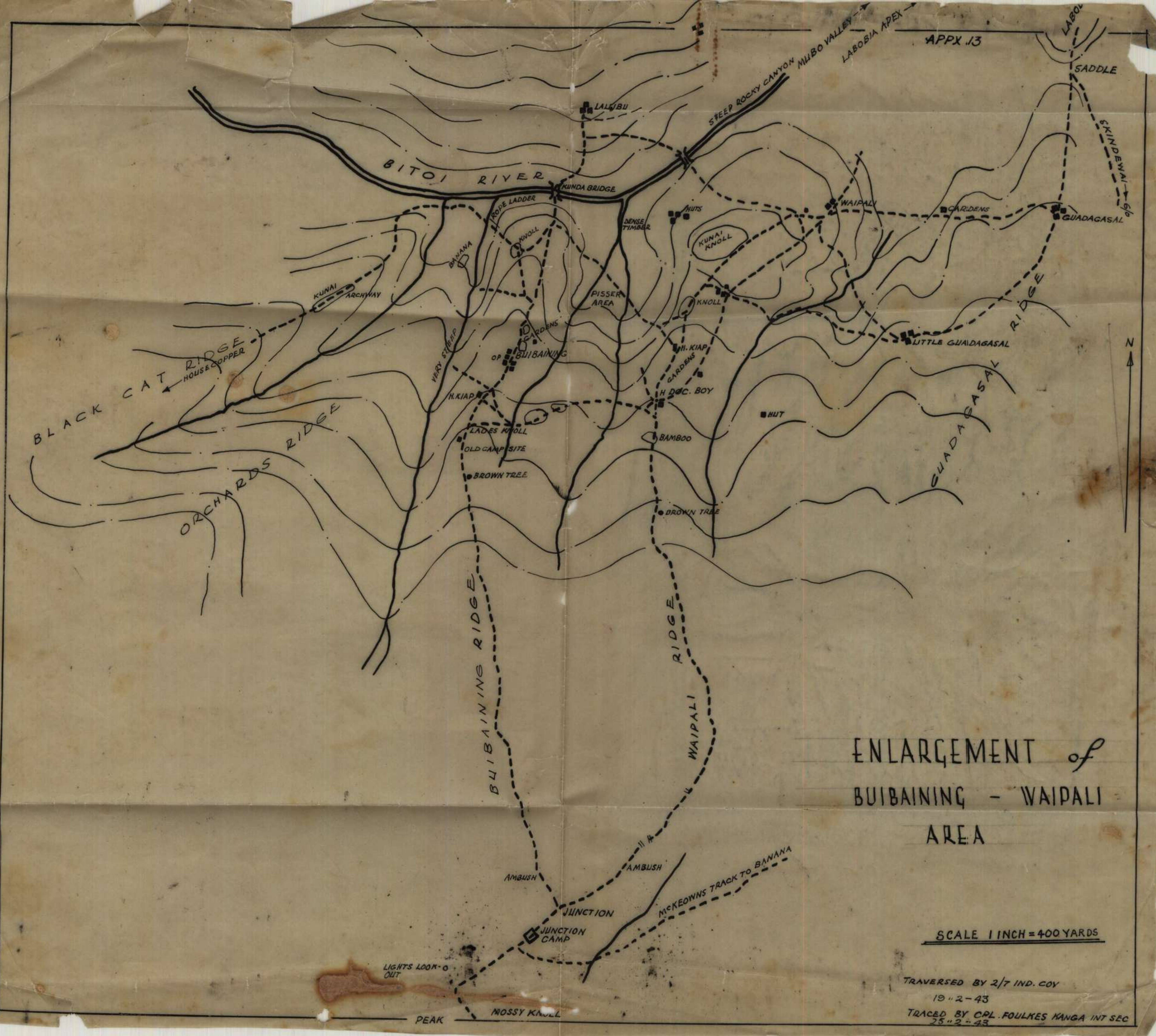

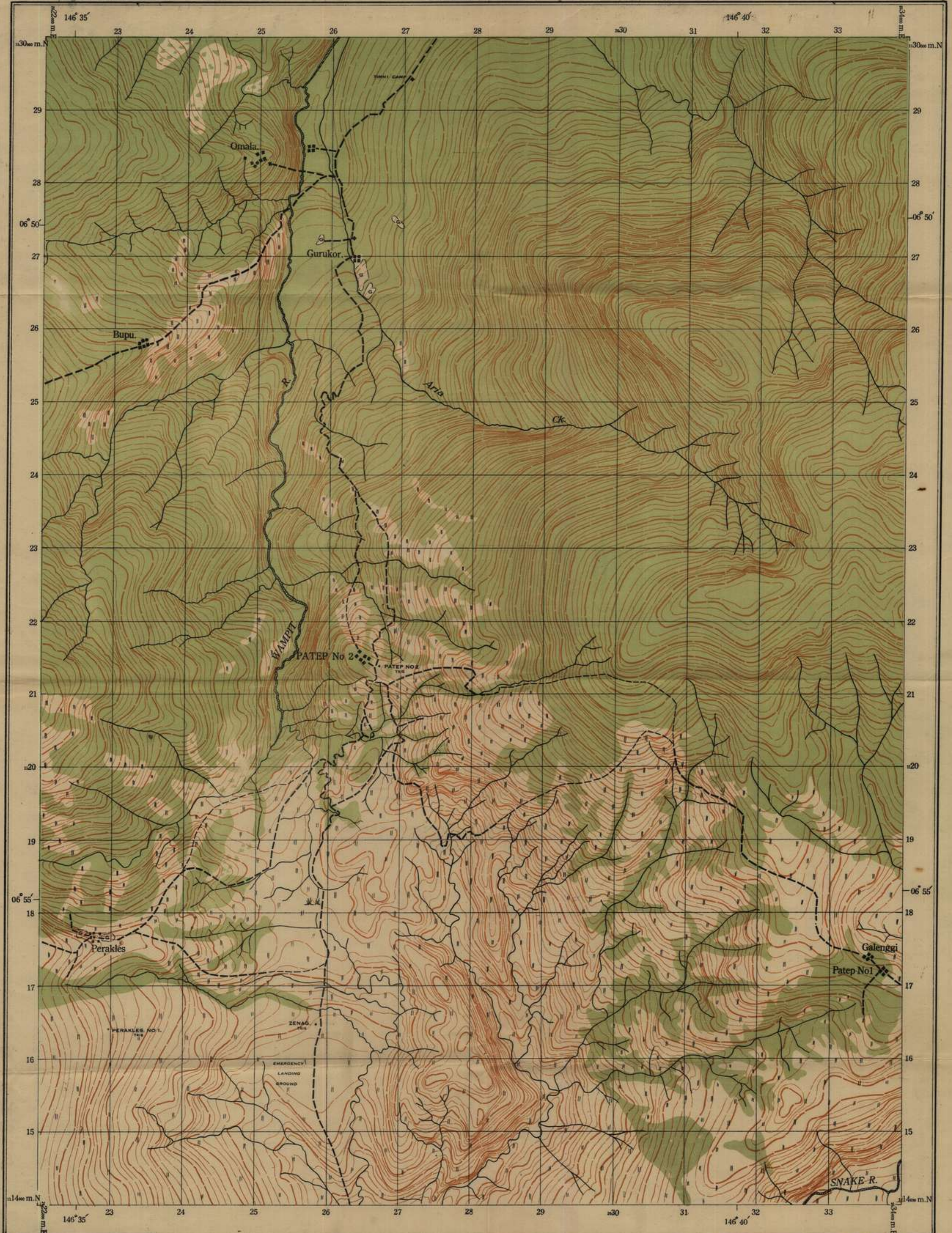
