

Movement of 2/26 Bn - GROVELY to REDBANK

1. 2/26 Bn will move from Grovely to Redbank in accordance with the following details:-

The Bn will move in three groups:-

- (a) Advance Party - to move Thursday 23 Jan 41
- (b) Main Body - " " Saturday 25 Jan 41
- (c) Rear Party - " " ~~EMKENY~~ 26 Jan 41
Saturday 25

2. ADVANCE PARTY

- (a) The advance party will consist of:-

- 2 Officers (2i/c "C" Coy; O.C. Pioneer Pl.)
- 1 Bn O/Room Sgt
- 1 Bn Storeman
- 1 Sec supplied by each Rifle Coy.
- 1 Storeman supplied by each Coy
- 6 Pioneers (incl. 1 Carpenter)
- 1 Cook to be detailed by O.C. H.Q. Coy.

Total 2 offrs. 1 Sgt. 4 Cpls 57 O.Rs.

- (b) The Advance Party will fall in on Bn Parade Ground at 0730 hrs Thurs 23 Jan 41 complete with all gear bedding etc on issue to them, and will move to Redbank by M.T. 4 30 cwt Vans will report to Bn parade ground at 0700 hrs.
- (c) Rations for the Advance Party on Thursday 23 Jan 41 will be taken to Redbank subsequent rations being drawn at Redbank.
- (d) 2/26 Bn O.M. will accompany the Advance Party and be responsible for drawing Camp Stores and Equipment. Stores will be handed over to Coy Storemen for immediate distribution on the arrival of the Main Body.
- (e) O.C. Advance Party will be responsible for the preparation and organisation of the Camp Site in readiness for the arrival of the Main Body. He will be conversant with the plan of allocation and detail Coy Guides to meet respective Coys on arrival of the Main Body and guide them to their quarters.
- (f) Coys will advise Bn H.Q. of Personnel selected for Advance Party by 2000 hrs 22 Jan 41.

3. MAIN BODY

- (a) The Main Body will move to Redbank by train in accordance with the following time table:-

All stores and equipment will be moved from Grovely to Redbank by M.T.

(b) ENTRAINING & DETRAINING

O.C.'s trains will detail an officer to inspect each train prior to departure from Grovely and on arrival at Redbank. In each case inspection will be carried out in the presence of the station master, a note of any irregularities or damage made and a report submitted to Bn H.Q.

R.T.O.'s will be in attendance at and will generally supervise entraining and detraining arrangements. Close Liason between O.C.'s trains and R.T.O.'s will be maintained.

O.C. train will be responsible for handing to R.T.O. at Grovely Station an accurate parade State of troops boarding the train, who will issue bulk warrants to the station master.

O.C. train will detail an officer to command each carriage who will in turn detail an N.C.O. to command each compartment so that strict discipline will be observed throughout the journey

On arrival at Redbank O.C. train will march troops to camp area where they will be met by guides and allocated to quarters

(c) The following Routine will be observed on Saturday 25 Jan 41:-

0500 hrs - Reveille
 0515 hrs - Sick Parade
 0530 - 0700 hrs - Empty pailliasse, bundle and label
 blankets load Coy Stores and blankets
 clean up Camp Area.
 0700 hrs - Breakfast
 0800 hrs - Bn Parade

(d) Administrative

Pailliasse will be emptied under Coy arrangements, straw will be dumped in area indicated beyond Officers Mess. Blankets and empty pailliasse will be bundled, labelled, tied and loaded in Sec and Pl lots.

All Coy stores will be loaded under supervision of an Offr.

Officers and Sergeants Mess Gear will be packed and loaded under supervision of Mess Secretaries immediately after Breakfast on 25 Jan 41.

Bn H.Q. will close down at 0800 hrs 25 Jan 41 all office gear to be loaded by 0830 hrs under supervision of R.S.M.

R.A.P. will close down at conclusion of morning sick parade and all equipment on charge and expendable stores will be packed and loaded under supervision of the R.M.O.

Officers' Baggage will be packed and labelled and dumped in area near flag pole at Bn H.Q. by 0730 hrs. Batmen will be detailed to load vehicle by Lieut. Moore who will be responsible for loading and transport.

All vehicles correctly loaded and manned by baggage guards will be paraded at 0845 hrs by T.O. and move off in convoy at 0900 hrs.




