### OBJECT

1. To cover the unloading of Liberty ship "STAMFORD VICTORY" and the reception and accn of tps, stores and vehs.

#### INFORMATION

### 2. U.S. Forces

- (a)) KURB is in the general area of responsibility of I. Corps until taken over by BCOF at a date to be notified later.
- (b) I.Corps is composed of .-
  - (1) 25 Div located in area KYOTO
  - (ii) 24 Div located at OKAYAMA

34 Inf Regt is part of 24 Div and is located at KURE.

- (c) 34 Inf Regt is disposed as follows. -
  - (i) Regt HQ .- HIRO
  - (11) One bn less two coys ETA JIMA
  - (iii) One coy UJINA
    - (iv) One cay OTAKE

### 3. British Forces

(a)) HQ BCOF - KURE (eventually STA JIMA)

(b) BCOF Base HQ - KURE

(c) BRINDIV - HIRO - CNOMICHI - FUKUYAMA

(d) 34 Inf Bde - KAITAICHI (15 miles North of KURE)

(e) MZ Bde - ETA JIMA

(f) Air Component - IWAKUNI

#### METHOD

- 4. Order of Disembarkation. See Appx 'A' attached.
- 5. Unit areas .- See Appx 'A' attached.

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## 6. Organisation for Dispersal

- (a) Mov of pers and stores by rail to KAITAICHI on 15 Feb. -
  - (1) Details of units see Appx 'A' attached
  - (ii) Personnel train. & coaches will be at entrainment point 12 miles from disembarkation point. Approx ETD 1300 hrs 16 Feb.
  - (iii) Baggage train. 12 baggage cars will be assembled at ships' side and when loaded will move direct to KAITAICHI at approx 1000 hrs 16 Feb. 34 Ede will detail OC train and baggage guards.
- (b) Mov of pers by MT.- See Appx 'A' attached.
- (c) Mov of pers on foot .- See Appx 'A' attached.
- (d) Mov of personal stores and unit stores.
  - (i) Kit bags. Personnel moving by rail or MT will retain kit bags.

Personnel marching to billets will stack kit bags on the wherf under directions from the Wharf Control officer.

Unit guards will remain with baggage.

- (ii) Extra Personal Baggage and Blankets.
  Personal baggage which has been bulk-stowed and blankets (less those of 34 Bde Gp) will be stacked on the wharf under directions of the Wharf Control Officer, for transport by MT to billets. Unit guards will remain with dumps. Personal baggage and blankets of 34 Inf Bde Gp will be loaded direct into rail trucks for transportation to KAITAICHI.
- (iii) Accn Stores, Landing rations, Unit stores will be dumped as in (ii) above.
  - (iv) Other items. All equipment not mentioned in sub-paras (i), (ii) and (iii) above will be dumped in the Transit Shed for sorting under the supervision of Capt Beauman, OC Docks Operating Coy, and will remain there under guard till transported by available MT to unit sites.
- (e) Mov of bulk stores. These will be loaded direct into MT for transportation to depots. If tpt and time do not permit of this, stores will remain temporarily under guard in the Transit Shed.
- (f) Mov of Unit MT.- All off loaded MT will be parked in the docks area under arrangements to be made by the Wharf Control Officer until guides are available.
- (g) Wharf Control Officer .- For duties see Appx 'C'.

#### 7. Sups

(a) Landing Rations .-

- (c) DID. Will open for issue of fresh rations 14 Feb.
- (d) Fresh supplies.-
  - (i) Bread will be available for issue approx 48 hours after discharge of bakery eqpt from "STAMFORD VICTORY".
  - (ii) Meat ) Will be available for (iii) Butter) issue approx 14 Feb.
- (e) Scale of issue SWPA Scale.

### 8. POL

- (a) Emergency PP.- Will be opened by 78 BIPOD Pl on wharf on commencement of unloading of vehs and will close on completion of unloading.
- (b) PP.- Will open 542432 0800 hrs 14 Feb.

#### 9. Fuel

Coal only is available and will be delivered to unit areas. Details later.

### 10. Indenting for Sups

- (a) Indents on an apea basis for issues of fresh supplier on 14, 15 and 16 Feb will be lodged by areas with the DID by 2000 hrs life Feb and 48 hrs in advance of drawing thereafter.
- (b) Indents for complete rations will be submitted 48 hrs in advance of drawing. First indents will be lodged on a date to be notified.

### 11. Tpt

- (a) As there is a scarcity of tpt only urgent requirements can be met by AASC.
- (b) Requisitions for tpt will be lodged with CASC BCOF Base KURE by 1630 hrs the day prior to the require int.

### 12. Recovery

All non runners will be towed to the EME area and handed over to an EME rep.

### 13. Labour

- (a) Japanese civilian labour is available for work on docks, whereas and in base installations.
- (b) Pending arrival of DAD Labour, CO 6 Labour Gp will co-ordinate all demands.
- (c) Requisitions for Labour must be lodged 48 hrs in advance. (i.e. Labour required on 21 Feb will be requisitioned for by 1200 hrs on 19 Feb)

## 14. Ordnance

- (a) The DADOS Stores Depot will be situated in Bldg No. 220, 200 yards from the disembarkation quay.
- (b) Canteens, Welfare and Medical Base Stores Depot personnel will be attached to the BCOF Base Ordnance Depot for quarters and rations.
- (c) The personnel of 21 AOD will be absorbed into BCOF Base Ordnance Depot and together with the personnel referred to in sub-para (b) will be quartered as follows.-

Officers - Bldg No. 222 WOS and Sits - Bldg No. 223 Other ranks - Bldg No. 221

## 15. Medical

- (a) For 34 Bde Gp, det 20 Fd Amb will open at KAITAICHI.
- (b) For BCOF pers an RAP will open in the KURE area.
  Pers and capt for this will be supplied by 20 Fd
  Amb. DADMS will select site.
- (c) Hospital cases will be sent to 361 American Station Hospital (Japanese Naval Hospital).
- (d) Water. All tap water will be chlorinated or boiled before drinking.
- (a) No fresh food will be bought locally.
- (f) VD is prevalent. All brothels are out of bounds.

### 22. Location of HQ

HQ BCOF and BCOF Base HQ are operating as an integrated HQ.

Heads of Services are located in Force HQ building.

Base Comd and Staff Offrs BCOF are located in Base HQ building.

#### 23. Telephone System

- (a) Telephane Directory of principal Staff Offrs, HQ BCOF, BCOF Base HQ, etc see Appx 'B' attached.
- (b) Service is supplied through an Automatic exchange and subscribers will dial their required numbers SLOWLY, as otherwise wrong numbers will result.
- (c) Telaphone extensions exist in most Unit and Office areas, but the instruments have been removed to prevent interference by Jap Nationals. HQs requiring service will first examine their areas and site their HQ nucleus at the spot where the extn line terminates. How extns at present are NOT practicable owing to the shortage of technical personnel and stores.
- (d) Under no circumstances will units connect "FT switchboards to the automatic system.
- (a) All requests for telephones and signal facilities will be made to Lt Col I. J. Hooker CSO's Branch, ground floor HQ BCOF extn 22422.

## 24. Signal System

- (a) Signal Office and Signal Centre are located on ground floor next to main entrance of HQ BCOF.
- (b) SDS will be instituted as soon as possible after the arrival of the Adv Party. Pending this service units will arrange delivery and collection of despatches from their own resources.

### 25. Signal Co-ordination

Pending arrival of CSO BCOF, co-ordination will be the responsibility of SO Sigs I in para 23 (a) above. Signal reps of all Fmns and Units will report there on arrival.

His duties will be .-

- (d) Safe guarding of stores etc on wherf. He will be assisted in this duty by DAPM and by Capt Beauman.
