

DRESS - TROOPS TRAVELLING ON TRAINS. Q L of C RO A.158 of 17 Apr 46.

No. 171  
It has come to notice that on numerous occasions troops travelling by train are improperly dressed. Troops travelling by mail train will be properly dressed at all times. On arrival at detraining points, troops will be dressed and ready to detrain immediately. Transit camps will ensure that this order is made known to all troops on draft. Troops travelling by troop train will be properly dressed at meal points. O&O Trains will see that this order is enforced.

RETENTION OF SERVICE CLOTHING AND ITEMS OF PERSONAL ISSUE. Q L of C RO Q.165 of 17 Apr 46.

No. 172  
Reference is made to GRO 0421/44. Although the abovementioned GRO gives approval for the retention by personnel on discharge of all items of personal issue, including greatcoats, jackets, SD, Trousers, SD, etc, it is not intended that members are to be discharged with a full scale of new items. Only such items which have become unserviceable due to fair wear and tear, and those requiring replacement owing to loss as in normal circumstances are to be replaced prior to discharge.

No.172 (Cont):

With regard to the second service dress uniform it is not intended that an initial issue or a replacement should be issued immediately prior to the signing of Form 2 of the member's Demobilization Procedure Book (AAB7) by the member's CO.

It is necessary that Army stocks be conserved to avoid the placing of Army Contracts which would absorb labour and materials required for an increasing civilian population.

A member who receives an advance payment of deferred pay under the provisions of this instruction will not be entitled to receive a further advance payment at a later date. This condition will apply irrespective of whether the advance payment received was the whole or portion only of the deferred pay credit. A member who has received an advance payment of deferred pay under this instruction and applies for a further payment may, if circumstances warrant it, be granted an advance against the security of the balance of his deferred pay under the provisions of FGM 138 (Instructions to Unit Pay Representatives No.22).

The deferred pay credit of a member as at 28th February, 1946, or 30th April, 1946, will be determined, in every case, from the member's pay ledger card. Where an application for payment is received by an authority other than the DFO, DDFO, or an ADFO of the District controlling the member's account, the DFO controlling the member's account will be requested, by signal, to advise the member's deferred pay credit as at 28th February, 1946, or 30th April, 1946, and the position of the member's active pay account.

A member may elect to receive an advance payment of deferred pay in cash or by cheque or may authorise payment to a bank account or to another person. Form WF131, suitably amended, will be used to authorise payment to a bank account or to another person. Such forms will be dealt with in the same manner as normal Forms WF131 (Remittance of Undrawn Pay).

Where an advance payment of deferred pay is made the member's active pay account will be debited in the normal manner but his drawing rate will not be restricted.
