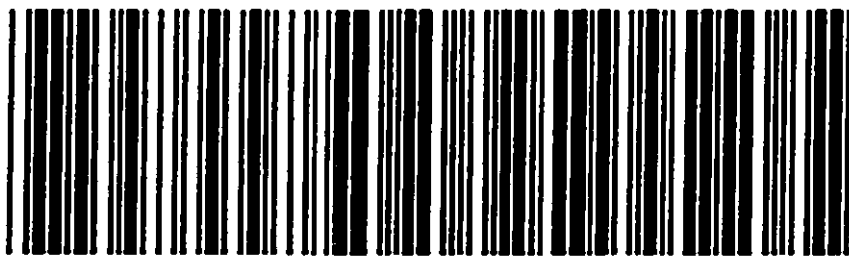

1. PREVENTION AND CONTROL OF BUSH FIRES

It is the duty of the Camp Staff Officer to organise and co-ordinate all available forces within his area for the prevention and control of bush fires, he will:-

- (a) Make contact with civil bush fire fighting authorities and Forestry Officers.
- (b) Liaise with civil police, VAOC and all army units within the Camp Staff Area.
- (c) Submit a requisition for fire fighting equipment to reach this HQ not later than 17 Feb 43. Lists may include rakes, axes, brush hooks, hoes, knapsack sprays and beaters.

Units within the Area will co-operate in preventative and combatant measures (see GRO A630-1942).

2. MAINTENANCE OF M.T.

Reference LCRO No 5, Para 57.

"GRO G70/43 is republished herewith:-

- (1) Driver's routine maintenance of all mechanical vehicles, except tanks, will be carried out by the Group System as set out in Mechanical Vehicle Training Pamphlet No 1.
- (2) The special fighting and protective equipment of wheeled armoured fighting vehicles will be maintained in the manner prescribed by the relevant Australian Army instruction book or by instructions issued by LHQ from time to time.
- (3) The daily task system of routine maintenance will not be used in Australia. All publications and leaflets issued to unit personnel or carried in vehicles which relate to the daily task system will be withdrawn from use forthwith.
- (4) Mechanical Vehicles Training Pamphlet No 1 will be carried in all wheeled vehicles, carriers (Aust) and with all motor cycles, and will be accounted for on handing over or taking over vehicles as if included in the Vehicle Outfit List.

3. ROAD ACCIDENTS

The attention of all units is directed to GRO Q56 of 15 Jan 43. In accordance therewith, all M.T. drivers and motor cycle riders will be instructed forthwith in accordance with para 4 of that GRO.

4. SIGNING OF AAF G2

Reference MBI Q15/41, MBIQ50/41, ECRO 23 of 16 May 41, Para 15.

The abovementioned ECRO is to the effect that where appearing as the authority for the issue, the words "signature of Transport NCO" should be altered to "signature of Officer Commanding".

Where the words of "signature of Transport NCO" appears as regards the checking of particulars, this should be altered, to "signature of Transport Officer".

In the last column on the front of each G2, there should appear the signature of the officer authorising each trip undertaken on the ticket on the last line used for details of each particular trip.

5. UNIT TRANSPORT

Recent instructions from Land HQ for the co-operation of all units, in the conservation of petrol, oils and rubber, is again brought to the notice of all units using Mechanical transport.

2. A check by an officer of No 4 NSW L of C Sub-Area, of the G6s of unit December issues in the Liverpool Area, discloses by a comparison of figures, that some Unit Commanders are not keeping sufficient check on transport.

3. Points brought out by the above check are:-

- (a) Lack of regular maintenance, resulting in poor petrol consumption.
- (b) Insufficient supervision of the correct method of completing G2s.
- (c) The possibility of vehicles being "milked" of petrol.
- (d) Drivers drawing petrol from Supply Depot not checking G2s against F78s.

4. For instructions reference (b) of para 3, attention is drawn to MBI Q15/41, and 50/41, and ECRO 23 of 16 May 41, para 15(a), which reads:- "To ensure maximum economy in the use of petrol, and also to conserve the wear and tear on M.T. no vehicle is to leave unit lines after 19 May 41, unless the G2 Work Ticket has been completed in detail (see Para c) and signed by an Officer or Officers authorised by the C.O. of the Unit concerned.

5. Officers driving M.T. MB I Q15/41, para 12, which reads:- It is not the duty of Officers or NCOs above the rank of Sgt to drive M.T.

Officers will not take over the driving of vehicles, except in cases of emergency, or to relieve drivers on long trips. The work ticket must be endorsed with the reason for taking over the vehicle.

It is to be borne in mind that the driver when issued with the vehicle is responsible for the maintenance and must always be with the vehicle when it is in use.

6. C.O.'S POWERS OF AWARDING SUMMARY PUNISHMENT

The following amendment has been made to Australian Military Regulations by the inclusion of the following regulation:-

249A. All existing charges against a soldier shall, except as provided by AMR 245, be investigated by a C.O. at the one time, and he may make one award only in respect of all the charges of which the soldier is found guilty".

7. NOTICES

A DCM convened by the Commander No 4 NSW L of C Sub-Area was held at Liverpool on 5 Jan 43 for the trial of N274249, Cpl. Archibald Carmichael, Camp Staff, Narrellan. The accused was charged with absenting himself without leave. The accused pleaded not guilty. The Court found the accused guilty of the charge. By sentence dated 5 Jan 43 the Court sentenced the accused to be reduced to the ranks. The accused was 15 days in open arrest awaiting trial. The finding and sentence were duly confirmed on 21 Jan 43 by the Commander No 4 NSW L of C Sub-Area. The result of the trial was promulgated to the accused at Narrellan on Jan 43.

A DCM convened by the Commander No 4 NSW L of C Sub-Area was held at Liverpool on 19 Jan 43 for the trial of NX133628, Pte. Bailey, Jack Clifton, 3rd Aust Aux Horse Transport Coy. The accused was charged with absenting himself without leave. The accused pleaded not guilty. The Court found the accused guilty of the charge. By sentence dated 19 Jan 43 the Court sentenced the accused to seven days detention. The accused was 4 days in custody awaiting trial. The finding and sentence were duly confirmed on 21 Jan 43 by the Commander No 4 NSW L of C Sub-Area. The result of the trial was promulgated to the accused at Liverpool on 22 Jan 43.

A DCM convened by the Commander No 4 NSW L of C Sub-Area was held at Liverpool on 5 Jan 43 for the trial of NX8792, S/Sgt Andrews Wilfred Thomas, 7th Adv W/Shops Coy AEME. The accused was charged with absenting himself without leave. The accused pleaded not guilty. The Court found the accused guilty of the charge. By sentence dated 5 Jan 43 the Court sentenced the accused to be fined the sum of Fifteen pounds. The accused was three days in custody awaiting trial. The finding and sentence were duly confirmed on 21 Jan 43 by the Commander No 4 NSW L of C Sub-Area. The result of the trial was promulgated to the accused at Liverpool on Jan 43.

The result of the trial was promulgated to the accused at 120 General Special Hospital on 3 February 1943.

Sentence to be reviewed on 6th July 1943.

A DCM convened by the Commander No. 4 (NSW) L of C Sub-Area was held at GOULBURN on 22 January 1943 for the trial of NX377936 Spr. Vivian James Robinson 1 SSB a PATIENT at 114 AGH.

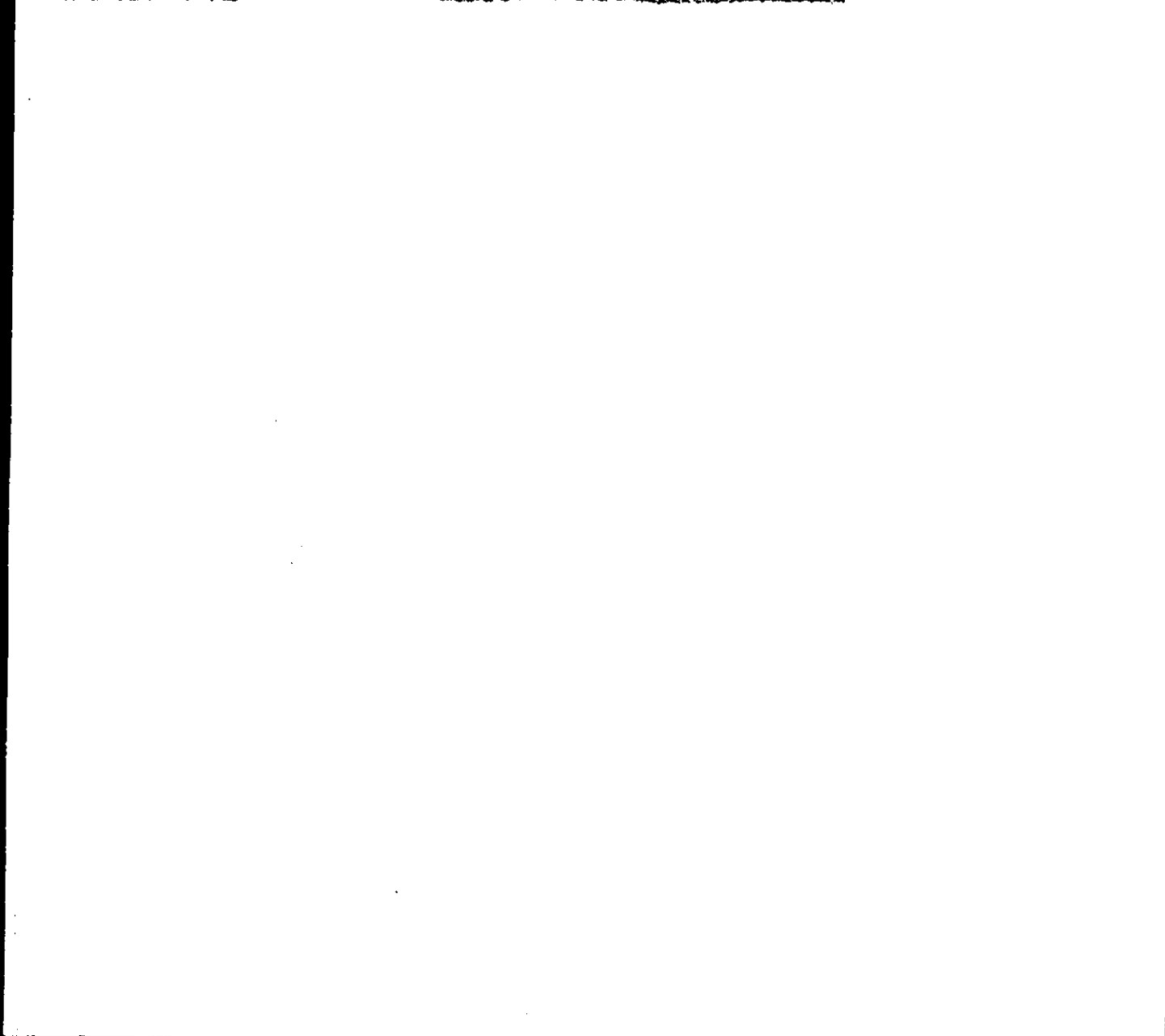
