REGISTER OF UNIT TESTING OFFICERS AND NCO'S -
ANNUAL REVIEW OF MILITARY DRIVING LICENCES AAF G11

GENERAL.

1. Inspection of military driving licences by the Staff of the Chief Inspector Unit Maintenance reveals that a considerable number of temporary, out of date and otherwise invalid licences are at present held by drivers MT. Moreover it appears that in some instances licences have been issued by persons not qualified as testing officers in accordance with MV Trg Pam No 2 (Part 2 para 10). In these cases no attempt has been made to put candidates through the prescribed tests as laid down in the abovementioned MV Trg Pam No.2.

2. Hence many soldiers have become drivers of mechanical vehicles without being made aware of the duties and responsibilities involved. They are also totally unfamiliar with the system of routine maintenance.

3. The result of this laxity is a low standard of vehicle efficiency and a tremendous extra repair commitment for the AEME organization which dislocates the normal flow of repairs through workshops.

ACTION BY FORMATIONS

4. In order to facilitate the training and testing of drivers MT and to carry out a periodical review of all military driving licences, the following action will be taken by Formations:-

- (a) Promulgate in formation routine orders by number, rank, name and in non-operational areas by units, a register of all testing officers and NCO's qualified in accordance with MV Trg Pam No.2 (Part 2 para 10).

NOTE - This register will enable units not having a qualified testing officer or NCO on strength to avail themselves of the services of the nearest testing officer.

- (b) At a time to be specified by LHQ, conduct a review by qualified testing officers and NCO's of all AAF's G 11.
- (c) Ensure that AAF's G 11 of all drivers MT considered proficient in all the requirements of the classes for which they are licensed, are endorsed by both testing officer or NCO and the member's CO.

AUTHORIZATION OF TESTING OFFICERS AND NCO's

5. No officer or NCO will be authorized to test a driver MT for a military driving licence, or conduct a review of existing licences until such time as:-

- (a) He has qualified in terms of MV Trg Pam No.2 (Part 2 para 10) and the appropriate entry appears in his AAB 83.
- (b) Notification vide para 4 (a) appears in his formation routine orders.

NOTIFICATION OF CHANGE OF UNIT TESTING OFFICERS AND NCO's

6. Changes in unit testing officers and NCO's will be promulgated in formation routine orders as they occur.

METHOD OF REVIEW OF AAF G 11.

7. Testing officers and NCO's will satisfy themselves in each individual case that the driver has qualified as per MV Trg Pam No.2 and is proficient in all type groups for which he holds a licence.

8. AAF's G 11 of all members in category described in para 7 will be endorsed as follows:

- in Col 3 mark "Reviewed" and date.
- in Col 4 signature of testing officer or NCO.
- in Col 6 signature of CO and date.

9. AAF's G 11 of all members not coming into the category described in para 7 will be either:

(a) withdrawn until the driver is trained, tested, and passes satisfactorily, the requirements as per MV Trg Pam No.2.

or

(b) endorsed as per para 8 for those type groups only for which the driver has qualified.

Entries for type groups for which the driver has failed to qualify will be ruled out in ink and initialled by the testing officer or NCO.

ANNUAL REVIEW OF LICENSES

10. All AAF's G 11 will be reviewed annually at dates to be specified by LHQ.

Reference HQ 9 Aust Div Routine Orders No. 279 of 26 Jul 45.

1. For units located on LABUAN only, the present method of drawing clothing, necessities and certain items of accommodation stores from 173 Aust FOD will cease on 12 Aug 45, when "Dues out" on all indents previously submitted by units on LABUAN only, for items hereafter referred to as Bulk items, will be cancelled by 173 Aust FOD.

2. Fortnightly bulk indenting of certain Ordnance Stores listed in Appendix "A" will commence as from 13 Aug 45 when the following procedure will be adopted.

- (a) Indents for Ordnance stores (G997), in duplicate, clearly marked "BULK INDENT" will be submitted to Divisional Tr ops Conductor, or Beach Gp BOWO, NOT later than 1600 hours on 1st and 14th of each month. - First indent to be submitted on 14th August 1945.
- (b) NON bulk items will NOT be indented for on the same indents as Bulk items.
- (c) Units will not submit indents for bulk items more than twice a month.
- (d) There will be no "to follows" on bulk indents and units will re-indent the following fortnight for bulk items short supplied against unit indents.
- (e) The figures appearing in column 9 of the bulk indent (G997) will be the quantity required based on the following:-
 - (i) Quantity short supplied against previous fortnights bulk indent, plus -
 - (ii) Estimated quantity required for ensuing fortnight, plus-
 - (iii) Quantity required to complete 5% holding of clothing items and necessities only.
- (f) All columns of indent (G997) must be correctly filled in.
- (g) The Commanding Officer will sign all indents personally - GRO O.326/44 refers. IMPORTANT - Stores indented for must be within authorised entitlements and relevant authority quoted on the indent. Indents will also bear a CO's certificate as per para 11 GRO 369/44.
- (h) Availabilities of stores indented for should be available for collection on approx 7th and 21st of each month, from DADOS DUMP, Aust Base Sub Area.

3. Units are reminded that inabilities on indents for other than Bulk items will continue to be recorded by 173 Aust FOD as "dues out" and will be automatically issued as soon as stocks are received. Units will NOT therefore re-indent for items short supplied on previous indent - Bulk indents for units on IASUAN excepted - as this will result in a duplication of requirements.

(b) To evacuate recovered Allied Prisoners of War and civilian internees.

MAINTENANCE - GENERAL POLICY

3. 9 Aust Div will be responsible for the maintenance of all forces, recovered Allied Prisoners of War, captured JAPANESE in the KUCHING, SANDAKAN and MATOEMA ISLAND areas, and for the provision of limited emergency relief supplies to the native population.

METHOD

4. Initial maintenance for the forces will be loaded at LAEURN in task force shipping as under :-

Supplies - AMF - 30 days
" - Recovered Allied PW - 50 days
" - Native Emergency Relief - in accordance with availability.
" - Estimated JAPANESE PW - 50 days where availability permits.

POL - AMF - 14 days except where otherwise stated.

Ordnance - AMF - 30 days.
" - Recovered Allied PW - sufficient for rehabilitation issues.

All other matters - 30 days.

The above levels of supply will be made available by 8 Aust Base Sub-area and will be loaded in shipping under arrangements 9 Aust Div.

5. MOVEMENT AND TRANSPORTATION

Hq 9 Aust Div is responsible for all arrangements for the marshalling and embarkation of the forces. Detailed loading of forces will be issued separately.

6. WATER SUPPLY

- (a) All units will land at destination with 4 gallons of water per man.

- (b) Water cans will be drawn from Ordnance and filled under unit arrangements.

7. SUPPLIES

Maintenance - Subsequent maintenance of the forces will be carried out from LAEUAN unless otherwise directed.

8. RATION SCALES

(a) O2 Rations

All troops will carry two O2 rations on the man. These rations will not be consumed unless it is impracticable to unload Pacific Rations in sufficient time. Unconsumed O2 rations will be returned to respective DIDs at the earliest.

(b) SWPA

As soon as practicable SWPA rations will be issued and subsequent maintenance will be based on this scaling.

(c) A3

All personnel will land with one A3 (Emergency ration), on the man.

Relief

(d) Native/Rations

See Scale attached as Appendix "A".

(e) JAPANESE PW Rations

(i) See Scale attached as Appendix "B" ;

(ii) JAP Commander will be ordered to advise quantities of rations by types in areas.

(iii) All issues of supplies referred to in sub-para (ii) above will be made by JAPS under AMF supervision in accordance with JAP PW Ration Scale, which will NOT be exceeded and will only be issued in accordance with availability.

(iv) Aust JAP PW Rations will not be issued until all JAP stocks of similar commodities are exhausted.

(v) Force HQ will advise HQ 9 Aust Div as early as possible:

quantities of JAP supplies by commodities and where located available in the area.

Numbers of JAPS to be maintained in each area in which supplies are concentrated.

(vi) JAPANESE are to be encouraged to cultivate their own vegetables without interference with native production.

(f) Tobacco, Papers and matches

Two issues will be made available pending the opening of a canteen point.

(g) Civilian Rations

Relief rations will be shipped and issued under arrangements detachments BECU.

(h) Solid Fuel

One tin of solid fuel will be carried on the man and one tin with unit stores.

(i) Expense Stores

Normal.

(j) Voyage Rations

Voyage rations will be placed on board ships under arrangements CASC 9 Aust Div.

OCs Troops will be responsible for unloading of the unconsumed portion on arrival.

9. POL

(a) Petrol

Will be carried on all vehicles as under :

Trucks $\frac{1}{2}$ -ton $\frac{1}{2}$ x 4	:	1 x 4-gallon can
Trucks $\frac{2}{3}$ ton	:	2 x 4-gallon cans
Mechanical Equipment	:	Maximum number of 4 or 44 gallon drums of POL or ADE as applicable.

(b) Refuelling of LCMs

Sufficient POL will be carried to ensure at least fourteen days supply.

(c) AVGAS

(i) All available space on craft to KUCHING will be loaded with AVGAS.

(ii) Storage and issue of drums will be the responsibility of AMF.

10. TRANSPORT

(a) Vehicles

JAPANESE vehicles will be used when available.

(b) Watercraft

LCM when possible will be allotted to each force for subsequent internal movement and resupply as may be necessary.

11. MEDICAL

(a) Responsibilities of medical units will comprise the following:

(i) Collection, medical treatment and evacuation of Allied Prisoners of War and Internees ;

(ii) Medical care of our own forces ;

(iii) Medical treatment of natives, as at OBOE SIX, until BBKAU is capable of accepting responsibility ;

(iv) Medical supervision of enemy troops when compounds have been established ;

(v) Supervision of Hygiene ;

(vi) Malaria control.

(b) JAPANESE medical units will be utilised and employed to look after JAPANESE or natives at discretion of the Force Commander concerned.

- (c) The Senior Medical officer of each Force will be the adviser to the Force Commander on these matters.

12. MEDICAL EVACUATION

- (a) Allied PW and internees requiring medical attention will be evacuated to Aust General Hospitals at LABUAN by the quickest available means, as soon as they are fit to travel.

Medical Air Evacuation Transport Unit RAAF is to provide medical orderlies on planes.

Returning shipping will be used for evacuation of personnel who are not acutely ill, in order to conserve air evacuation for the most urgent cases. LCTs will not be used for medical evacuation.

Medical units will provide medical orderlies to attend to patients during the sea voyage.

(b) Own Troops

Minor sick who are likely to recover within 3 weeks will be retained in the objective area.

(c) Natives

Except in special cases will not be evacuated.

(d) Enemy Troops

Will continue to be treated as far as possible by their own medical officers and orderlies, under supervision of SMO, with such of their own stores as are considered necessary, and will receive any assistance required to prevent them becoming a menace to the health of our own troops. They will in no circumstances be evacuated to LABUAN.

13. HYGIENE

Strict attention will be paid to Hygiene and Sanitation.

14. MALARIA CONTROL

Will be undertaken to the maximum extent possible.

Aerial spray with DDT will be available for essential areas.

When working parties of enemy PW become available, malaria control will be extended.

15. CIVIL AFFAIRS

(a) General

- (i) A detachment of BECAU will form part of each force and will be under command of the Force Commander.
- (ii) OC Detachment BECAU with a Force will in addition to commanding his detachment be the adviser to the Force Commander on all civil affairs matters.
- (iii) OC Detachment BECAU, subject to any orders issued by the Force Commander, will be responsible to the Force Commander for the control and administration of all natives within the area controlled by the Force.

(b) Relief supplies

A quantity of native relief supplies, dependent on

availability and estimated requirements by BECAU, will be moved with each Force. These supplies will be distributed by Detachment BECAU with the Force as directed by the Force Commander.

16. ORDNANCE

(a) General

An ordnance detachment will accompany each force.

(b) Maintenance

(i) Initial - 30 days maintenance for Force.

(ii) Sufficient rehabilitation stores for estimated Allied PW in areas of occupation.

(c) All stocks in excess of Force requirements will be returned to LABUAN by first resupply ships.

17. SALVAGE

(a) General

A detachment of Salvage unit will accompany each Force. Force Commander will be responsible for the organisation of the salvage system in his area.

(b) Enemy War Material (see 9 Aust Div Operation Instruction No. 8 Appendix "E") will be collected as soon as possible and held in dumps strongly guarded. All enemy small arms and small arm ammunition will be destroyed either by burning or sinking in deep water as early as practicable after surrender. 9 Aust Div will be advised of quantity by types held in dumps. Instructions will be given as to its ultimate disposal by this HQ.

(c) Arrangements will be made to strongly guard existing JAPANESE dumps of supplies or equipment.

18. CANTEEN

(a) 30 days initial supply for the Force will be landed.

(b) Canteen issue points will be established by AACS in each area.

19. RECEPTION AND ACCOMMODATION OF RECOVERED PERSONNEL

(a) Those Allied PW and civilian internees who require hospitalization will be treated and accommodated in medical installations until such time as they are evacuated from the area in which recovered, or, if fit, they are marched out to "Reception Camp" to await evacuation when either aircraft or shipping becomes available.

(b) Allied PW and civilian internees not requiring hospitalization will be concentrated at "Reception Camp". It will be appreciated that accommodation at 9 Aust Div Reception Camp, which will accompany the LUCHING Force, will be restricted, and it will probably be necessary for the Force Commander to supplement the staff of that unit from within his own resources.

(c) The Reception Camp should be treated as a convalescent holding centre. OC Reception Camp will be responsible for the detailed evacuation from the occupied area to LABUAN under instructions to be issued by the Force Commander.

(d) In the case of LUCHING Force, 9 Aust Div Reception Camp will

accompany the Force. In the case of other Forces, the Force Commander will be responsible for the provision of a Reception Camp from within his own resources.

20. EVACUATION

- (a) The highest priority will be given to those Allied PW and civilian internees requiring urgent medical treatment. The most expeditious means available will be used to return such personnel to LABUAN (see para 12).
- (b) Full use will be made of shipping returning to LABUAN for personnel not in need of urgent medical treatment, so that air travel, if available, can be utilised for urgent cases.
- (c) The method of evacuation will be at the discretion of the Force Commander, taking into account the number of recovered personnel and their medical condition.

21. INTERROGATION OF RECOVERED PERSONNEL

- (a) Detailed interrogation of recovered PW will not take place in the area in which recovered, owing to the limited facilities available and the establishment of a trained interrogating organisation on LABUAN.

- (b) Interrogation will be confined to :

- (i) Allied PW

- The Army Number, Rank, Name (including full Christian name) Unit and Next of Kin (so far as known) and address of next of kin.

- (ii) Civilian Internees

- Name (including full Christian name) marital state, nationality, place of domicile at commencement of the JAPANESE War, and address to which the released telegram is to be sent by Ech and Rec.

- (iii) Mass interrogation by interrogating teams on JAPANESE atrocities, to enable the Force Commander to apprehend suspected personnel.

22. WAR CRIMES

- (a) Where definite information of local atrocities is obtained, either by interrogation of recovered PW or otherwise, it will be immediately passed to the Force Commander, to enable early action to be taken after the surrender of arms to apprehend the individual concerned.

- (b) A list of known JAPANESE war criminals is attached as Appendix "C".

- (c) All personnel accused of War Crimes will be held in close custody in special compounds segregated from normal PW compounds.

- (d) A dossier will be prepared on all personnel so apprehended, which will be supported by statutory declarations where necessary, and will then be forwarded to HQ 9 Aust Div for War Crimes Officer, who will be responsible for the correlation and compilation of the necessary documentary evidence on which the War Crimes Commission will later prosecute.

23. RECORDS OF ALLIED PW AND CIVILIAN INTERNEES DURING THEIR IMPRISONMENT

So that the fullest information of all Allied PW and civilian internees can be obtained for Ech and Rec purposes, and to collect information of JAPANESE atrocities, every effort will be made to secure all records and other relevant papers from Concentration Camps, Barracks etc. After investigation by Intelligence and Field Security Sections, such records which deal in any way with War Crimes, or our own PW, will be forwarded to HQ 9 Aust Div for further investigation by War Crimes Officer or PWLO.

24. STRENGTH STATES

Force HQ will render the following returns :-

(a) Own Troops

AF W3007 to HQ 9 Aust Div made out as at 0600 hrs Wednesday and Saturday of each week.

(b) JAPANESE PW

A return showing the number of JAPANESE PW (by officers and Other Ranks) taken into custody to date. The return will be rendered each Wednesday and Saturday as at 0600 hrs. The first return will be rendered within forty eight hours of the Force arriving in the objective area.

(c) Allied PW and Civilian Internees

A similar return to that required by sub-para (b) above, in respect of Allied PW and Civilian Internees showing :-

(i) Allied PW - Number by nationality, indicating Officers and Other Ranks.

(ii) Civilian Internees - Numbers by nationality, indicating males, females and children.

25. HQ" RETURNS

Force HQ will render to this H. by 0700 hrs daily by signal the stockholding of the following, showing the position as at 1600 hrs the previous day :-

AMF Rations (days)
JAPANESE PW rations (days)
MT 30 (Gallons)
ADF "
AVGAS "
Main items of Ordnance Scalings.

26. NATIVE LABOUR

(a) Native Labour will be used as considered necessary by Force Commander. Native labour will be provided by area detachments BECAU.

(b) A return will be submitted weekly to HQ 9 Aust Div showing the number of native labour employed and type of work in accordance with 9 Aust Div Adm Instr 6 of 15 Jul 45 para 12(f).

27. JAPANESE PW LABOUR

Will be used as considered necessary, and to fullest extent possible, by Force Commander. For possible tasks to be demanded of JAPANESE see Appendix "D" attached.

28. JAPANESE SERVICE UNITS

All organised JAPANESE services will be utilised under strict AMF supervision to their fullest capacity until such time as all PW are compounded.

POSSIBLE TASKS DEMANDED OF JAPANESE ARMED FORCES

1. Comply with requirements of Commander Occupation Forces and to remain at their posts and continue to perform their normal duties under his authority until relieved by him,
 2. Carry out such tasks as he may assign including formulation and implementation of such plans and orders as may be required.
 3. Submit all orders, regulations, ordinances etc to him for approval prior to dissemination.
 4. Preserve, abstain from and prevent the promulgation of any orders or any activities hostile to the occupation forces, Allied PW and Civilian Internees, and nations at war with JAPAN, including destruction, removal and concealment of military and naval personnel, documents, material and equipment.
 5. Disseminate and enforce as directed, proclamations, orders ordinances and other instructions of the Commander in Chief AMF or his designated representative through appropriate echelons of their commands.
 6. Maintain discipline within the JAPANESE Armed Forces.
 7. Deliver to designated representatives of the Commander in Chief AMF prescribed arms, military materials, equipment, supplies and records in the possession of, or under the control of, JAPANESE Armed Forces. Upon delivery, removing from the hands of the troops, segregate, render harmless, preserve inoperative and secure such arms materials and equipment.
 8. Establish and define safety lanes through all mined areas both on land and sea, and subsequently render ineffective, explode or remove all mines and other obstacles to travel by land, sea and air.
 9. Restore, maintain and/or operate facilities for overland communications using JAPANESE personnel and equipment wherever possible.
 10. Maintain the logistic support of JAPANESE Armed Forces.
 11. Maintain, safeguard and operate as directed military aspects of all installations.
