Chalmers St. - Elizabeth St. - Martin Place - George St. - Campbell St. - Pitt Street to Tram and Vehicular Ramp to Central Station.

9. FORMATION ON ROUTE

Troops will march in column of threes (3's) The following distances will be observed: -

Between Units - 30 yds

Between Coys and similar Units - 10 yds

10. COMPLIMENTS

- (a) On passing Cenotaph (Martin Place) Unit Comdrs will give the order "In succession eyes right".
 - Sub-Unit Comdrs will conform to this order.
- (b) Salute will be taken at the Sydney Town Hall, George Street, at 1100 hrs by His Excellency, The Governor, Lord Wakehurst, K.C.M.G.
- (c) Two markers with sloped Rifles and Fixed bayonets will be in position at the right of the March and in front of the Saluting Base to indicate the commencement and finish of the Salute.

NOTE - Drum Majors will salute on passing Cenotaph and at Saluting Base.

11. DRESS

Service Dress, Drill Order. Hats will be work turned up by all personnel taking part in the March.

Units will march with fixed bayonets. Bayonets will be fixed before leaving Concentration Area and unfixed before commencement of return journey by train.

12. TRAIN ARRANGEMENTS

In accordance with Appendix "B" attached.

13. BANDS

- (a) Bands taking part in the march will assemble with Units for whom attached for marching.
- (b) All Bands in the March will cease playing on passing the Cenotaph in Martin Place and after passing the intersection of George and Market Streets. Playing will re-commence on arrival at Goulburn Street.
- (c) The Band of 18 Aust Inf Bn and the NSW Police Band will be stationed at the Saluting Base, Town Hall.
 - These Bands will be in position at 1000 hrs and in addition to playing the March Past will play selections of music from 1000 to 1050 hrs.
- (d) Bands of 2 Aust Army Units will proceed to and from Concentration Area under unit arrangements.

14. CASUALTIES

St. John's Ambulance will attend to all casualties Military and Civilian, throughout the route of March

15. ENTRAINING AND DETRAINING

Arrangements at Rooty Hill will be carried out under the supervision of Officers detailed by the 7 Aust Inf Div.

Arrangements at Central Station will be carried out under the supervision of Major J.C. ROSS, DAQMG (Mvts) HQ NSW L of C Area, to whom four (4) Officers detailed by 7 Aust Inf Div will report in accordance with instructions in Appendix "B".

16. MARSHALS







1. GENERAL POLICY

The policy for approximately the next four (4) weeks is that main emphasis will be laid on:-

(a) Individual weapon training

(b) Physical training

(c) camp improvement and construction

2. WEAPON TRAINING

(a) 30 yds ranges will be constructed in each Bn area immediately Sites will be submitted to, and, approved by this Ho before work is commenced.

b) A field firing range will be shortly available for use.

(c) Amn brought back from NEW GUINEA will be used for practices.

3. PHYSICAL TRAINING

The usual methods of route marches, bayonet training and organised sports, etc., will be followed.

4. HOURS OF TRAINING

6 hours per day will be devoted to training, six days per week. Rest days need NOT necessarily be Sundays.

5. SCHOOLS AND COURSES

- (a) It is anticipated a generous allotment of vacancies at all schools will be made to the brigade and it is desired that units make a survey of those personnel likely to derive most value from them.
- (b) A course for Officers will be conducted under Bde arrangements shortly.
- 6. It is desired that a higher standard of conduct be attained by troops in regard to saluting of Officers and vehicles carrying the pennants of senior Officers and general deportment of troops.






