

3. OUT OF BOUNDS

Arrangements with the proprietors of the Liberty Dance hall for the use of the hall twice weekly have proved completely unsatisfactory. The Liberty Dance Hall and all other dance halls in the OKAYAMA area are OUT OF BOUNDS.

4. JAPANESE LABOUR

Troops will NOT interfere with Japanese Labourers working under the control of Labour Supervisors or Japanese Foremen without prior reference to the Labour Office.

5. EFM TELEGRAMS UK

All ranks are advised that EFM telegrams for delivery in the United Kingdom by Christmas Day must be lodged in JAPAN NOT later than 17 Dec 47

6. POISONOUS LIQUORS

(a) The undermentioned types of hard liquor available on the Japanese market are known to contain large quantities of methyl alcohol (otherwise wood spirit):

Brandy
Whiskey
Cheal Sake

- (b) As death results in about 20% of consumers and blindness in about 60%, all personnel will be advised on extreme danger consuming these liquors.
- (c) Severe disciplinary action will be taken against members found in possession of any of these above mentioned liquors.

7. HOLIDAYS

67 Aust Inf Bn RO 179 of 12 Sep 47 is amended as follows:-

Nearest Sunday to 9 Nov - Remembrance Day

8. DRESS

Members of AMF Component of BCOF on leave or on duty in Australia, will continue to be dressed in accordance with Standing Orders for Dress issued by this HQ.

9. IMPORTATION OF GOODS TO AUSTRALIA BY SERVICE PERSONNEL SERVING IN JAPAN

- (a) Members of the Australian Services who are serving in Japan are permitted to take or forward to Australia, free of Customs Duty, goods not intended for sale, exchange or trade to the value of £10 stg in any twelve monthly period. This concession does not cover tobacco products, spirituous liquors or prohibited goods. It has been found that the Customs Department take a liberal view in assessing the value of goods.
- (b) In order to administer the concession, the Customs Department now require that all goods sent to or taken to Australia shall be declared. To this end a certificate declaring the name of the sender, date of arrival in Japan, contents and value of the parcel and the accumulated value of all goods sent or taken to Australia by the sender must be affixed to each and every parcel despatched. The form of the declaration is available in all service Post Offices.
- (c) A declaration on the same lines as stated in para (b) above is also required from all service personnel entering Australia. The form for the declaration is available at this HQ.
- (d) The declaration mentioned in para (b) above is now required by the Customs Department because they have become seriously concerned at the abuse the concession has been subjected to, particularly by servicemen who have despatched substantial quantities of goods by post and then on return to Australia have claimed exemption from Customs Duty and from provisions of the Trading with the Enemy Act for goods carried in their baggage.
- (e) The Trading with the Enemy Act is still in force. Under the provisions of this Act, Import Licenses must be issued to persons serving with or attached to BCOF. As a result of this, goods acquired in Japan cannot be imported to Australia in quantities sufficient for trading. Goods are liable to be confiscated by the Customs authorities if they are in such quantities as to indicate that they are intended for trading.

(f) Coys will ensure that each member returning to Australia for leave or discharge is in possession of two copies of completed forms in accordance with para (a) above.
