



SYRIA "I" section track recce party reach El Yammoune ref baalbek 1/50000 17812432 after crossing range from Hasroun. Party cold, tired but very cheerful. Bde Comdr called at 16 Bde H.Q. after leaving 2/6 Bn where he spent the night. After a fast trip across the Sinai desert arrived in cairo in the late afternoon. 2-Oct LT Col King Admin Comd visited 7 Aust Div to see Gen. Allen. G3 I Capt Issel called at Bde H.Q. B.M. Major Bishop returned to the fold looking very fit and well after his recent operation. Brig Savige made a round of visits in Cairo which included calls at A.I.F., H.Q., Heliopolis, Aust Trades Commis.in Egypt., M.E.F., H.Q., and H.Q., A.I.F. Details in Cairo. Lt Col King attended lecture by Col Baillon from G.H.Q., M.E. 3-0ct on " Direct Air Support " at Div H.Q. appears that the army in the field will have aircraft under command. capt Lowen left for Cairo. A conference was held at 1000 hrs. Lt Col Wrigley was joined by Capt K. Picken, Capt I. Kerr, Lt D.O. Hay I.O. and arrangements were made for one officer from 5,6, and 7 bns to become familiar with areas and later to supervise work by 19 Bde. 2/5, and 2/6 parties continued with recess of areas definitely allotted this morning. Lt Col King and Major bishop assisted 2/5 Bn party. A soccer match was played against 2/3 Bn resulting in a decisive win for 2/3. Bde H.Q. team led by Lieut Simpson H.Q. Gd Bn were no match for the young and very fit members of the 2/3 Bn team. Bde party continued recce of left Bn area and 2/5 and 2/6 Bns 23-Oct in their own areas. Lt Col King and Lt Col Wrigley met at 1700 hrs and decided on a change of plan : -- two Bns to occupy line with one Coy each under command from third bn. Third on less two coys to form Bde reserve. 


