



1. Personnel shown in Appendix A & B will embark HMS IMPLACABLE.
2. Appendix C showing details of assembly and embarkation will be issued separately.
3. Nominal Rolls will be prepared strictly in accordance with our A2112 para 4 ; copies to Movements WEWAK and 6 Div to be delivered by 1200 hrs on 10 Dec 45.
4. Units will ensure that each item of the soldier's personal equipment has a label attached showing the member's Number, Name, Rank and Unit or Unit to which his draft is attached.
5. Units will ensure that all members have Identification Cards worn on the front of their hats. They will be clearly marked with the Unit's Serial Number (as per Appx A) and the embarkation Serial number appearing beside the soldier's name on the Embarkation Roll. Blue pencil will be used for members of a Cadre - Red pencil for members of a draft moving with a Cadre.
 - (a) e.g. 5/23 (in blue) indicates Embarkation Serial No.23 of 2/7 Inf Bn Cadre.
 - (b) e.g. 14/184 (in red) indicates Embarkation Serial No.184 of a Draft moving with 2/2 Fd Regt.
6. HQ 6 Div will load 6 jeeps and trailers at a time to be notified - balance of jeeps to be loaded will be drawn from vehicle park.
