89. PREVENTION OF GAMBLING (Ref & Aust Army RO A162).

Attention is drawn to FIRST AUST ARMY ASOs Chapter 14, which reads:-

- (a) NO member will take part in gambling in the SWPA.
 - (b) NO member shall make, or have in his possession, any instruments of gaming.
2. Gambling includes book making and lotteries (including raffles) as well as games of chance.
 3. Where express written authority is given by a Bde or superior command, raffles and lotteries may be conducted for charitable purposes, subject to such safeguards as to accounting for moneys received and drawings as may be laid down in authority.

90. MALARIA.

The malaria casualty rate in 8 Bde area is still abnormally high. For the week ending 14 December, there were 25 cases - twice as many cases as sustained by any other unit in the First Aust Army Area.

In spite of DDT sprayings, there are still large numbers of malaria carrying mosquitoes in this area. Atebrin will kill MT malaria and suppress BT if taken regularly, but it will NOT prevent a man from being bitten.

It has been proved over the last few months that if a man has been excessively bitten by malaria carrying mosquitoes that malaria, accumulated in the blood stream, is apt to break out in spite of regular consumption of atebrin.

It is therefore essential that all personnel take every precaution against being bitten.

This can be achieved by:-

- (i) Adhering to dress regulations
- (ii) Use of "MAY" "
- (iii) Keeping this camp area clean and clear of empty tins etc.
- (iv) Regular spraying of swamps and water holes.

Recent inspection of Coy areas during the night have shown that dress discipline is poor. Personnel have been sighted not wearing gaiters, and with sleeves rolled up, and even lying naked on beds without the protection of mosquito nets. Such poor discipline in dress extends an open invitation to malaria. Frequent attacks of malaria undoubtedly weakens the constitution and are liable to impair future health - therefore, every man owes it as a duty to himself to carry out his malaria precautions regularly and conscientiously.

Anti malaria instructions are published with one object in view, i.e., to prevent malaria and to ensure the good health of the

troops. Obey them and you will assist in obtaining that object - disobey them and you will undoubtedly suffer from malaria and its effects, jeopardise your future health, and at the same time, incur severe disciplinary action.

91. DRESS AT NIGHT. (Ref 8 Bde Adm Instr 5).

1. Considerable laxity is noticed in dress of troops particularly at night, undoubtedly leading to increase in malaria casualties.
2. All units will -
 - (a) Detail an officer, or officers in the case of major units, whose duty will be to make periodic rounds of unit lines and check all irregularities in dress.
 - (b) On nights when pictures are held in unit areas, each unit whose personnel attend at the particular picture site will detail an officer to check mens' dress, both at the picture site and on roads leading thereto.
3. It is the duty of all officers to check any man improperly dressed either by day or by night.

92. PROVISION OF SPECTACLES. (Ref 8 Bde 65/10620 of 9 Jan 46).

Subtended is First Aust Army A27537 of 2 Jan 46 -

1. It is requested that units be circularised in terms of the abovementioned memo as follows:-
 - (i) The only optical workshop now functioning in First Aust Army Area is at 118 Gen Hospital.
 - (ii) All prescriptions for spectacles, and spectacles for repair which do not require reference to an ophthalmologist, will be forwarded direct to 118 Gen Hospital by the unit of the member concerned accompanied by a suitable memo signed by a medical officer.
2. Spectacles dispensed or repaired by 118 Gen Hospital will be forwarded direct to the unit of the member concerned.
3. In the cases of high priority and unit cadre personnel warned for movement to Australia, units should consider the advisability of deferring repair or provision of spectacles until the member concerned reaches the mainland.
4. In the case of personnel transferred to other units, subsequent to forwarding to 118 Gen Hosp of prescriptions for spectacles or repair, units will notify 118 Gen Hosp of the transfer.
5. Arrangements are being made for periodical visits of an ophthalmologist to Wewak.
6. It is considered that paras 1 and 3 above would cover the majority of personnel in this area.

93. TINEA OR RINGWORM. (Ref 8 Bde 65/10638 of 9 Jan 46).

1. A rise in the incidence of tinea and its complications is noted.
2. To avoid the latter, it is recommended that the following measures be brought to the notice of RAF Orderlies:-

- (a) No application of lotion, ointment or paint will be made to a lesion except by the express order of MO, who will detail the treatment.
- (b) The only exception is that Calomine lotion and Zinc Cream may be used freely for purposes of soothing.
- (c) Fungicides (applications for treatment of tinea) will be kept only in RAP and will NOT be issued to individuals.
- (d) A case of tinea which does not respond to one course of treatment ordered by an MO, will usually be evacuated to MDS.
- (e) Tinea patients will have it impressed on them the contagious nature of tinea, necessitating daily boiling of clothes, constant washing of hands, and no scratching or rubbing of the rash.


