

65. TREATMENT OF DISCHARGED MEMBERS SUFFERING FROM MALARIA.
(Ref GRO A117/44)

1. It is possible that Malaria may manifest itself for the first time after the member has been discharged.
2. By arrangement with the Repatriation Commission, in such cases, provided the member establishes his identity, e.g., by production of a discharge certificate, medical treatment will be made available forthwith at the expense of the Repatriation Department, pending determination of whether the malaria is attributable to the member's war service.
3. To obtain such treatment, the ex-member -
 - (a) if he resides in the metropolitan area of a capital city, should contact the local office of the Repatriation Department or apply to the Repatriation Hospital; or
 - (b) if he resides outside the metropolitan area of a capital city, should apply to the nearest local Repatriation Medical Officer.

66. PREVALENCE OF THE OFFENCE OF ESCAPING.
(Ref GRO A230/44)

1. Attention is directed to the prevalence of the offence of escaping from detention barracks and field punishment centres.
2. Charges in respect of the offences mentioned in para 1 should be laid under AA 22 and should normally be tried by Court Martial.
3. The attention of all officers appointed as presiding and members of courts-martial trying the offences mentioned in this order is directed to AIR & O 553 (3) and (4) (1st Edition) page 64, para 32, which reads as follows:-

AIR & O 553 (3).-

"When attention has been called in orders issued in the command to which the offender belongs to the prevalence of the offence of which he has been found guilty a court martial should also have regard to the fact that such warning has been issued."

MML (Aust Edition), page 64, para 82. -

"Military offences must sometimes be considered in reference to circumstances other than those connected with the individual offender. When there is a general prevalence of offences or of offences of some particular kind, an example may be necessary, and on that account a severe punishment may properly be awarded for an offence which would otherwise receive a more lenient punishment. In such cases the punishment must be regarded more from the point of view of the effect which it will produce on the force to which the offender belongs than from that of the offender himself."

4. A Sentence of imprisonment with or without Hard labour may properly be imposed for the abovementioned offence.

67. SALES TAX EXEMPTIONS - PURCHASE OF UNIFORMS.
(Ref. GRO F234/44)

1. The Sales Tax Exemptions Act provides that certain items of uniform of approved pattern may be purchased by members from civilian sources without payment of sales tax. This provision includes the following:-

Jacket, S.D., Officers.
Safari Jacket
Trousers SD., Officers.
Greatcoat.
Cap SD. Officers.

2. The exemption will not be available unless

(a) the articles in question are purchased exclusively for Military purposes; and

(b) a certificate is furnished by the purchaser to the vendor in accordance with pro-forma set out in the schedule of this order.

68. LOSS OF SPECIAL PASS.
(Ref SECOND AUST ARMY RO G179/44)

1. A special pass, No. 14366 AA Form A96 (b) to admit Capt C.E. MUNRO to all military establishments at all times has been reported lost.
2. Unit comds will detain any person attempting to use this pass and will report such attempt immediately to HQ Second Aust Army.

69. POSSESSION AND CONSUMPTION OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR.
(Ref SECOND AUST ARMY RO A187/44)

1. Except as provided in para 2 hereof, no member of the Australian Military Forces, when in uniform, shall consume any intoxicating liquor:-

- (a) In any public place;
- (b) In any doorway or vestibule opening on to any public place.
- (c) On any highway or public road
- (d) On any vacant land adjacent to a park or public reserve.
- (e) On any part of a park or public reserve; or
- (f) In any public conveyance.

2. Nothing in this order shall prevent the consumption or supply or possession of liquor on licensed premises of any Naval, Military or Air Force Institute, Mess, or Canteen in accordance with the regulations and orders applying to such Institute, Mess or Canteen.

3. COs will ensure that the above order is brought before the notice of all troops from time to time. It is the duty of COs to endeavour to inculcate in men under their command to respect their uniform, the wearing of which should operate, not as a license to break the law, but as an obligation to set an example in complying with it.

5. Attention is directed to GRO 739/43 which prohibits carrying or possession or consumption (except in a dining car) by a member of the forces of any intoxicating liquor on a train.

70. WIRELESS SETS - USE DURING PARADE HOURS.
(1 AUST INF BDE RO A151/44)

1. Instances have been brought to notice of wireless sets being turned on during parade hours.
2. This practice will cease forthwith.

71. INJURIES TO MEMBERS - USE OF BREADCUTTING MACHINES
(1 Aust Div RO A257/43)

1. (a) In order to avoid accidents to members of the forces when using breadcutting machines, loaves of bread will NOT be pushed into the cutter by hand, but will be propelled by a piece of wood which will be of sufficient size to prevent any portion of the operator's hand coming into contact with the blade of the cutter. Every member detailed to operate a breadcutting machine is to be instructed accordingly by the member so detailing him.

(b) In any future accidents arising from the use of breadcutting machines, inquiry is to be made as to whether the injured member has been advised of this direction. If he has been so advised, appropriate action is to be taken against him for disobedience of orders. Should the operator not have been so advised, appropriate disciplinary action is to be initiated against the member of the forces who detailed the operator for such duty without giving him proper instructions to conform with the direction herein contained.

(c) All reports of accidents arising from the use of breadcutting machines will contain a statement of the action taken in accordance with the last preceding sub-para, and the appropriate particulars of the member against whom such action was taken, and the result of such action.

(d) Disciplinary action against the member operating the breadcutting machine or the member detailing him for that duty as the case may be, is to be taken under AA Sec 11.

72. INCOME TAX - LIABILITY OF MEMBERS OF THE FORCES AND
COLLECTION OF TAX BY INSTALMENTS. (GROs F233/44)

1. MEMBERS REQUIRED TO LODGE TAX RETURNS.-

A member on full time military duty, the total of whose military and private income exceeds £250 during the year ending 30 Jun 44, must lodge an income tax return with the Deputy Commissioner for Taxation in the State in which the member enlisted. Such return need not be lodged by a member serving outside Australia unless his private income earned in Australia exceeds £250.

2. PREPARATION OF RETURNS.

Income tax return forms, together with printed instructions, may be obtained from pay representatives. The forms should be completed to show full details of private income, military income and particulars of dependants and other items for which rebates are allowable.

3. Unless the member lodges a return and shows his military income in fullest detail, the Taxation authorities may not be able to grant the exemptions to which he is entitled. He should therefore, include with the return a separate statement setting out the following information:-

- (a) date of embarkation for service outside Australia;
- (b) date of return to Australia;
- (c) whether the reason for return was injury of illness;
- (d) if the member has served outside Australia, his military income for the year ended 30 Jun 44, should be shown under the following headings:-
 - (1) military income up to a date 90 days after his resumption of duty in Australia; and
 - (2) military income after that date.

4. The completed return should be posted to the Deputy Commissioner of Taxation in the Capital City of the member's state of enlistment, so as to reach that address by the 31 Jul 44.

If the member is in doubt on any point, a letter setting out the full facts should accompany his return.

5. Subject to para 6 of this order, no tax deductions will be made in the case of -

- (a) any male member, without dependants, below the rank of staff sergeant;
- (b) any male member, with dependants, below the rank of warrant officer (Class 1);
- (c) any female member, without dependants, below the rank of lieutenant; or
- (d) any female member, with dependants, below the rank of captain.

Members may ascertain the rate of their tax deductions on application to their unit pay representative.

6. DEDUCTIONS TO MEET MEMBER'S LIABILITY ON PRIVATE INCOME.

Where a member has private income in addition to his military income, he may increase the rate of his deduction to provide for taxation on such private income. Such additional deduction will be entered in the member's pay book and will operate from the same date as the deduction in respect of his military income. The deduction in respect of the member's private income will not be varied during the group year.

7. REFUNDS.

Where deductions made to meet tax liability are found to exceed the amount of the assessment, the Taxation Department will automatically make a refund. Where, by reason of embarkation for service outside Australia, a member becomes entitled to a refund of deductions made during a previous

group year, it will be necessary for him to apply for such refund to the Deputy Commissioner of Taxation for the State of his enlistment. In such a case, the member should state clearly the dates of embarkation and disembarkation.

8. Any queries on taxation should be referred to Pay Sergeant.

73. IRREGULARITY OF DRESS.

1. Field Officers' reports indicate numerous irregularities in dress of personnel proceeding to and from leave.

Coys will promulgate at frequent intervals, the contents of this HQ instruction for WINTER DRESS as issued 30 Apr 44, to all ranks, and remind troops that any variations from dress as detailed therein will constitute an offence which in future will be viewed seriously.

It is reminded that Great Coats, when worn, will at all times be buttoned fully to the neck.

 The accused was charged with: AWL from 2359 on 15 [redacted] 1200 hrs on 28 Jun 44.
 The court found the accused is guilty of the charge.
 The court sentenced the accused on 7 Jul 44 to undergo detention for one hundred and twenty days.
 The accused was awaiting trial in close arrest for 9 days and in open arrest for --- days.
 The finding and sentence were duly confirmed on 12 Jul 44 by Col Vail.
 The date for review of sentence was fixed for 7 Oct 44.
 The result of the trial was promulgated to the accused at 2 AUST GUARD COMPOUND on 12 Jul 44.

87. GUNS, MACHINE, BREN - BREECH BLOCKS.

1. The incidence of erosion on the face of Bren breech blocks is high. The erosion is in the form of a ring on the face of the block around the firing pin hole.
2. The primary cause of this erosion is due to blow-backs around the cartridge cap, allowing the heated gases to strike the face of the block. The erosion may also be caused by the use of oiled ammunition. This will not be used in Bren guns in any circumstances.
3. All Bren breech blocks will be examined frequently by DME armourers and, if the ring of erosion has developed to a depth exceeding .015-in, the block will be sentenced for repair in accordance with DME Technical Instr B2-18. If the erosion is allowed to develop beyond .015-in, it is likely that the ring will break through to the ejector way and/or the extractor recess, thus causing damage to the gun and jeopardizing the possibility of repair.

INJURIES TO MEMBERS - USE OF BREADCUTTING MACHINES.

Instances of disregard of the provisions of 1 Aust Div RO Serial 38, para 118, of 11 Aug 42, have been noted.

The order is repeated herewith and must be complied with in entirety.

(a) In order to avoid accidents to members of the forces when using breadcutting machines, loaves of bread will NOT be pushed into the cutter by hand, but will be propelled by a piece of wood which will be sufficient size to prevent any portion of the operator's hand coming into contact into the blade of the cutter. Every member detailed to operate a breadcutting machine is to be instructed accordingly by the member so detailing him.

(b) In any future accidents arising from the use of breadcutting machines, inquiry is to be made as to whether the injured person has been advised of this direction. If he has been so advised, appropriate action is to be taken against him for disobedience of orders. Should the operator not have been so advised, appropriate disciplinary action is to be initiated against the member of the forces who detailed the operator for such duty without giving him proper instructions to conform with the direction herein contained.

(c) All reports of accidents arising from the use of breadcutting machines will contain a statement of the action taken in accordance with the last preceding sub-para, and the appropriate particulars of the member against whom such action was taken, and of the result of such action.

(d) Disciplinary action against the member operating the breadcutting machine or the member detailing him for that duty, as the case may be, is to be taken under

All officers directly concerned with the operation or handling of batteries will take immediate action to reduce the present excessive usage rate of these stores and to impress upon all personnel the necessity for exercising the greatest care in handling and transportation.

The use of batteries, secondary, portable, for any unauthorized purpose, such as the lighting of tents, huts and similar uses, will be discontinued forthwith, and such batteries will be returned to the nearest RSD immediately.




