A DCM convened by Col L.E. Vail, was held at HQ, NSW L of C Area on 11/9/44, for the trial of N452804, Pte COLEMAN, J.F., 13/33 Aust Inf Bn. (AIF).

The accused was charged with: Desertion (AWL from 0615 hrs. on 30/1/44 to 1630 hrs on 5/9/44).

The Court found the accused was not guilty of Desertion but was guilty of AWL.

The Court sentenced the accused on 11/9/44, to detention for 18 months.

The accused was awaiting trial in close arrest for 6 days,

The finding was confirmed on 15/9/44, by Col Vail who varied the sentence to "to undergo detention for one year", and confirmed the sentence as so varied.

The date for review of sentence was fixed for 11/12/44.

The result of the trial was promulgated to the accused at 2 Aust Gd Comp on 15/9/44.

A DCM convened by Col L.E. Vail was held on 10/8/44, for the trial of NX176129, PTE THOMSEN, L.A., 13/33 Aust Inf Bn. (AIF), at HQ, NSW L of C Area.

The accused was charge with: A.W.L. from 2359 hrs. on 22/6/44 until 0530 hrs on 1/8/44.

The Court found the accused is guilty of the charge.

The Court sentenced the accused on 10 Aug 44 to be fined the sum of £8-/-.

The accused was awaiting trial in close arrest for 9 days,

The finding was confirmed by Col Vail on 12/8/44 who varied the sentence to read "To be fined the sum of £5-/-" and confirmed the sentence as so varied.

The result of the trial was promulgated to the accused at CANUNGRU on 22/9/44.

103. INTERSTATE TRAVEL - WIVES AND FAMILIES OF DEFENCE PERSONNEL TRANSFERRED INTERSTATE.

1. Subtended for information is MOVEMENT CONTROL INSTRUCTION NO 2, Para 12 of 10 Mar 43.

"Where a member has been transferred Interstate on duty and his dependants are desirous of taking up residence in the area in which he is serving, applications for priority rail travel MUST in the first instance be made by the dependants concerned to the local Land Transport Board. (App'x "A").

If, in the opinion of the Land Transport Board's representative a particular case merits consideration the applicant will be advised to communicate with the serving member in order that he may make application on behalf of the applicant through his Unit.

The Unit will investigate the case and will forward recommendation, together with a statement of anticipated period of service in new State, to the Formation concerned, which will in turn submit a recommendation to the Local Movement Control Group.

If a strong recommendation is received in favour of the application, the local Movt Control Group will advise the local representative of the Land Transport Board that the application is supported.

It should be noted that the Land Transport Board will only issue permits in the case of dependants (not proceeding to a prescribed area) who are taking up PERMANENT residence and will keep house for a male member permanently appointed to a particular location. Single journey permits only will be issued. The bona fides of the application to transfer to take up permanent residence will come up for review if application is later made to leave the State to which transfer was made under the authority of the priority permit.

104. WEARING OF JERSEYS.

1. Attention is directed to the observance of existing orders regarding wearing of jerseys and particular attention will be directed to the following:-

(a) Sweaters other than Army issue Jerseys Pullover Khaki will NOT be worn outside shirts.

(b) Where Jerseys Pullover Khaki are worn over a shirt, the straps of the shirt will be threaded through the apertures of the Jersey and correctly buttoned.

- (b) Any member losing his AAB 83 will (unless the CO is satisfied that the loss was not due to any negligence on the part of the member) be charged under AA 24 (2) (or, in the case of officers, under AA 40), the fact of loss being sufficient to found a charge of "losing by neglect public property issued to him for his use" (or of "neglect to the prejudice", as the case may be) and to justify a conviction on such charge in the absence of a satisfactory explanation.

AUSTRALIAN ARMY PSYCHOLOGY SERVICE. (Ref GRO A356/44.)

1. (a) Vacancies exist in the Australian Army Psychology Service for testing and interviewing sergeants, who should possess the following qualifications:-
 - (i) education to leaving certificate standard or equivalent;
 - (ii) good bearing and manner;
 - (iii) some formal university or teaching college training in psychology - desirable but not essential.
- (b) In filling these vacancies, preference will be given to personnel with operational experience in the present war, especially those who are medically class B1 or B2 or who are over 30 years of age.
- (c) Any member possessing the qualifications outlined above may submit to his OC or CO an application for appointment to one of the vacancies.
- (d) The application will be in writing and will include the following particulars:-
Army number, rank (substantive and acting), name in full, unit, age, medical classification, date of enlistment, service outside Australia, educational particulars, civil occupation, formal training in psychology.

131. DISTRICT COURT MARTIAL.

A DCM convened by Col. L.E.Vail was held at HQ NSW L of C Area on 5 Sep. 44 for the trial of NX177245 Pte. DUFFY, P.E. The accused was charged with - Desertion (AWL from 2355hrs on 6/5/44 to 0945hrs on 31/8/44). The court found the accused NOT Guilty of Desertion but Guilty of AWL. The court sentenced the accused on 5/9/44 to detention for 90 days. The accused was awaiting trial for 5 days in close arrest. The finding and sentence was duly confirmed on 21/9/44 by Col. L. E. Vail. The result of the trial was promulgated to the accused at 14 Detention Barracks on 21/10/44.

135. INCOME TAX - MEMBERS WITH DEPENDANTS RESIDENT OVERSEAS

(1 Aust Div. RO F256/44)

1. The Income Tax Assessment Act provides for the rebate of tax to a taxpayer in respect of his wife and children resident in Australia.
2. A member of the AMF who married in a country other than Australia and whose wife or children are NOT resident in Australia is not entitled to such rebate. As the non-allowance might cause hardship, any member affected is requested to apply, through his payrepresentative, for a remission of tax.
3. A member applying for such remission will furnish:
 - (a) His name in full and all regimental particulars; and
 - (b) the names and addresses of his dependants,
 and will advise whether -
 - (i) his wife and children are wholly maintained by him;
 - (ii) his wife's separate income exceeds £50 per annum (Australian); and
 - (iii) it is his intention, as soon as war conditions permit and transport is available, to bring his wife and children to reside in Australia.
4. The application will be forwarded by the pay representative to the Director of Finance Administration, LHQ, who will refer the case to the Taxation Department for consideration.

140. SHAVING AND HAIR CUTTING. (GRO A118/44)

1. Subject to the provisions of para 2 of this order, a male member will keep the hair of his head tidy and short, and will shave his chin, under lip and cheeks of his face. He may wear a moustache, but will not wear side whiskers.
2. Where a unit is in an operational area, and the CO considers it necessary or desirable so to do, he may authorise any departure from the provisions of para 1, unless otherwise directed by superior authority.

141. PRECAUTION IN THE ISSUE OF PAY. (GRO F367/44).

1. The duty of making cash payments to individual soldiers rests primarily on the OC company, etc, but members detached from units may be paid by any officer who is an imprest holder or a sub-imprest holder, on his personal responsibility, if satisfied of the members identity. (FSR Vol 1 Chap XXI, Sec 195 para 2).
2. In order to prevent a member from drawing pay while AWL or in possession of an irregular leave pass or by presentation of a forged pay book or by impersonation of another member, an officer will, before paying a member or before authorising him to draw pay at a cash office, satisfy himself of the member's identity and of his entitlement to draw pay, by making such inquiries as he considers necessary and by inspecting such documentary evidence as may be available (such as Record of Service Book (AAB 83), photograph and specimen signature in paybook, identity disc, clothing ration book or movement order).

142. COMPLAINTS BY MEMBERS OF THE FORCES. (GRO A108/42)

1. The attention of all ranks will be directed to AMR & O 297 (1), which provides as follows:-
"Officers and soldiers are forbidden to use any method of obtaining redress of real or supposed grievances other than those prescribed by the AMR or authorised by these orders. Anonymous complaints and complaints through the press are forbidden.
2. The use of outside influence is forbidden by AMR & O 307 (1) which provides:-
"The use of outside influence to support complaints or applications for personal advantages, or in any matter affecting the position of an officer or soldier, is contrary to discipline. The only proper course for an officer or soldier is to apply through his CO or to apply in accordance with the AMR and these orders. Any attempt to obtain favourable consideration of requests or

142 Cont.

grievances by other means is forbidden.

3. The provisions of Division 1 Part IV of the AMR & O will be explained to all formed units on parade at least once in every three months, and to all members in training depots once every month. The consequences of failing to observe the provisions of that division will be made clear.
4. All complaints or applications of the nature described in para 2 above received at any HQ through unauthorised channels will be forwarded to the unit concerned, with a direction that the member will be paraded and informed of the Unit order on this matter and that any further failure to observe its provisions will be dealt with as an offence.

143. DRESS.

Incorrect dress e.g. troops moving about camp area without hats and without shirts is still prevalent. Dress as laid down will be strictly adhered to.

144. AREA OUT OF BOUNDS.

147. DRIVING LICENSES - REVIEW OF.

1. It is notified to all ranks that AAFs G11 held by pers of this unit are void from 1 Nov 44, excepting:-
AAFs G11 in possession of unit pers which
(a) are duly registered in the Register of Driving licenses.
(b) have had the entry Reviewed since 1 Nov. 44.
2. Personnel will be required to pass a test in D & V set by unit testing officer whenever an entry in the register is reviewed.
3. Review will take place NOT more frequently than once in 9 months and NOT less frequently than once in 12 months.
4. It will be considered a serious offence for any Affr, TO or OR to have in his possession an AAF G11 which is NOT entered in the unit Register of Driving.

148. CONSERVATION OF RUBBER - SYNTHETIC TYRES. (1 Aust Div RO 0213)

1. The critical rubber situation and the necessity for obtaining the maximum service from tyres has been stressed from time to time. The further deterioration of the situation, necessitating the introduction of tyres of synthetic construction, renders it imperative that greater care than ever be exercised in the use and maintenance of all tyres, whether synthetic or natural rubber construction.
2. Synthetic tyres are far more susceptible to failure through abuse than tyres constructed from natural rubber. All concerned will, therefore -
 - (a) Exercise the utmost care to avoid overloading, underinflation, hard braking and fierce acceleration, high speeds, bumps and other causes of severe impact;
 - (b) check wheel alignment frequently and correct irregularities promptly;
 - (c) Rotate tyres regularly;
 - (d) remove stones and flint from tyres during unit maintenance;
 - (e) submit tyres for replacement at the correct stages for reapplying; and
 - (f) submit damaged tyres for repair without delay.
3. Formations and units will ensure that prompt disciplinary action is taken where breaches of this order occur.

149. SIGNING OF G2's

1. All ranks are reminded that the right hand column of G2's must be signed on completion of trip or duty. Where vehicle is returning empty to lines the Driver will himself complete the right hand column.

150. INCOME TAX-MEMBERS WITH DEPENDANTS RESIDENT OVERSEAS.

1. The Income Tax Assessment Act provides for the rebate of tax to a taxpayer in respect of his wife and children resident in Australia.
2. A member of the AIF who married in a country other than Australia and whose wife or children are not resident in Australia is not entitled to such rebate. As the non-allowance might cause hardship, any member affected is requested to apply, through his pay representative, for a remission of tax.
3. A member applying for such remission will furnish-
 - (a) his name in full and all regimental particulars; and
 - (b) the names and addresses of his dependants, and will advise whether-
 - (i) his wife and children are wholly maintained by him;
 - (ii) his wife's separate income exceeds £50 per annum (Australian); and
 - (iii) it is his intention, as soon as war conditions permit and transport is available, to bring his wife and children to reside in Australia.
4. The application will be forwarded by the pay representative to the Director of Finance Administration, LHO, who will refer the case to the Taxation Department for consideration.

152. INJURIES CAUSED BY ACCIDENTS WITH EXPLOSIVES AND LIVE AMMUNITION.

1. Members of the public have been killed or seriously injured recently as the result of handling explosives and live ammunition which either -
 - (a) have been taken or sent home by members of the forces as souvenirs; or
 - (b) have been negligently left in places to which the public has access.
2. To prevent a recurrence of such accidents, the following instructions will be observed strictly.
3. (a) Unless acting in the course of his military duties or unless authorised by or under the National Security (Firearms and Explosives) Regulations, a member of the AIF will not have in his possession or deliver or transmit or attempt to deliver or transmit to any other person any bomb shell or other explosive or live ammunition of any kind.
(b) All Coys will take vigorous action to ensure that members comply with the terms of this paragraph.
4. (a) When any member serving outside Australia and Tasmania is to return to Australia or Tasmania, his kit and baggage will be inspected thoroughly, prior to his embarkation or embarkation to ensure that he is not in possession of any explosives or live ammunition of any kind other than such as may be necessary in the course of his military duties.
(b) His kit will again be inspected thoroughly at any place from which he is to be released on leave, prior to his being so released.
5. (a) Coys will ensure that all prescribed safety precautions for the handling and storing of explosives and live ammunition are carefully observed.
(b) Explosives and live ammunition used for training purposes will be carefully safeguarded.
(c) Under no circumstances will explosives or live ammunition of any kind be left unguarded in any place to which members of the public have access.
(d) In areas where training with explosives and live ammunition is carried out, the utmost care will be exercised to ensure that all blinds are searched for and destroyed in

accordance with prescribed regulations.

- 6. If a member is charged with an offence against this order, a summary of evidence will be taken and an application submitted to superior authority for trial by court martial.



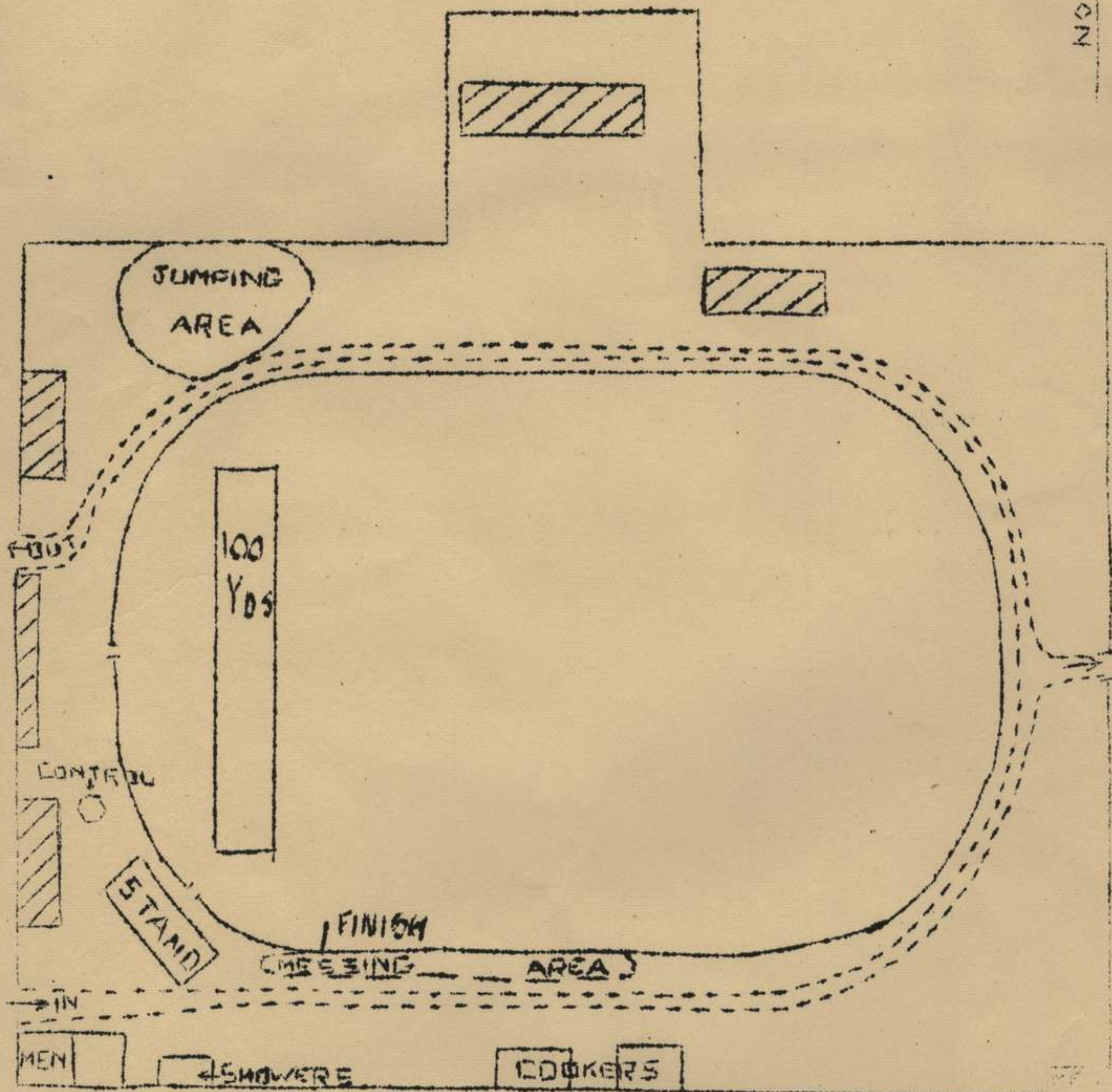



182. CAMP GUARDS.

1. Contents of 1 Aust Div memo G8961 of 4 Dec 44 is subtended for information and relevant action.
 - "1. In all cases when tracer ammunition, flares, HE or smoke is being fired, arrangements will be made for dealing with bush or grass fire resulting therefrom by:
 - (a) immediate cessation of practice (if necessary for safety)
 - (b) despatching without delay a fully equipped fire fighting party to deal with the outbreak.
 2. In order to comply with (b) above, each party under instruction will be organized wholly or in part to deal with any fire outbreak. The size of the party will be determined after due consideration of the following factors (in particular) wind, temperature, dryness of grass, undergrowth, etc.

184. CONDUCT OF TPS TRAVELLING ON MT.

1. The conduct and discipline of tps travelling in MT is still far from satisfactory. The Comd 1 Aust Inf Bn desires of all NCO's and Offrs, a higher standard of discipline whilst tps are using MT.

185. BUSH FIRE RISK - USE OF TRACER PYROTECHNICS, ETC.

1. Attention is directed to the provisions of Second Aust Army RO 344/44.
2. Instances has been reported where bush fires have been started, alledgedly through the use of tracer ammunition and flares.
3. While the present drought conditions prevail a fire of this nature may get out of control and cause considerable damage.
4. Coys will exercise the utmost care to prevent bush fires when using pyrotechnics, explosives or ammunition of any kind likely to have an incendiary effect.

202. ISSUES OF CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT TO PERSONNEL- RECORDS OF.

"2" Action is therefore being taken to amend in the near future GPO A243/1944, War Establishments and other relevant instructions to provide for the substitution of Arabic figures in such designations.

"3" Such amendments will be anticipated and action will be taken forthwith to use arabic figures in all references to trade grouping in records, instructions and other documents.
