

1. As the menace of infection by flies is a serious one it is necessary for every precaution to be taken and all possible means of fly control to be carried out in order to minimise the risk of infection.

2. The prevalence of flies in any area is in direct proportion to the energy expended by a Unit in fly control measures.

3. Action will be taken in Camp Area for-

- (a) Careful supervision and eradication of all breeding places, especially night soil disposal areas, latrines, rubbish dumps, sullage disposal areas and waste materials around Camp area.
- (b) The use of correctly sited and baited fly traps in sufficient numbers. The following ingredient is recommended as a successful bait- 1 pint thin porridge, 1 deserts spoonful of sugar plus 1 deserts spoonful of yeast. Fly traps are available through Ordnance.
- (c) The use of fly wire and fly paper. Fly paper solution may be made by melting together in a water bath 8 parts resin plus 5 parts castor oil.
- (d) The liberal use of fly spray, especially within kitchens and latrines. Fly spray is in general issue.
- (e) The use of Food covers during the transportation, storage and distribution of food to the troops.

GOWRIE SCHOLARSHIPS.

1. The trustees of the Gowrie Scholarship Trust Fund (Sir John Latham, Sir Robert Garran, Sir Claude Reading and Chief Judge H.B. Piper) announce that the fund now amounts to £139,578. The public appeal is closed, but further subscriptions will still be accepted. The trustees have now give consideration the the basis for the award of scholarships in accordance with the trust deed.
2. The trustees propose to offer annually the following scholar-
ships:-
 - 2 post-graduate research travelling scholarships.
 - 4 university or similar scholarships.
 - 10 secondary school scholarships.

It is hoped to make the first awards in 1945, to be effective as from 1st January, 1945. Eligible persons are past or present members of the armed and auxiliary forces engaged in the war and their descendants, as defined in the trust deed.

The full number of scholarships will be awarded only if there are candidates of sufficient merit.

3. Post-graduate research scholarships.

Research travelling scholarships of £A475 per annum will be tenable for two years at universities, etc. abroad.

Nominations for these scholarships may be made by the professorial boards of the Australian universities. The scholarships will be awarded by the trustees after consideration of recommendations which the University Vice Chancellors' Committee will be invited to make in respect of such nominations.

4. University and similar scholarships.

Scholarships of £A100 per annum for post-secondary education will be tenable for the normal period of the course desired to be taken at a university or other approved educational institution.

5. Secondary School Scholarships.

(a) Scholarships of £A50 per annum will be tenable for two years at secondary schools or such other schools or colleges as the trustees may approve.

5(b). No scholarships will be awarded during the compulsory period of education as defined by the laws of the various States, except to applicants who have passed an examination of a standard which:-

- (i) is substantially equal to that of the New South Wales intermediate certificate examination, or
- (ii) is such that, in normal circumstances, the applicant requires only two further years to complete a course of secondary education; or
- (iii) is of such other standard as the trustees may approve from time to time.

6. The scholarships which are tenable in Australia at universities, secondary schools or other educational institutions will be awarded by the trustees after consideration of recommendations made by such advisory committees in the various States as the trustees appoint for the purpose. Such advisory committees will take into account:-

- (i) teachers' reports;
- (ii) any examination results;
- (iii) the character and personality of the candidate;
- (iv) the course of education the candidate proposes to complete; and

will report on the financial means of the candidate and his or her parents, if desired by the trustees in any particular case.

Advisory committees will be appointed in each State of the Commonwealth and the Australian Capital Territory to consider applications and to make recommendations for awards to be made by the trustees. For this purpose, the trustees will invite the assistance of educationists and persons interested in the welfare of service personnel, ex-service personnel and their children.

7. The trustees may, in special circumstances, extend the scholarships tenable in Australia for a further period not exceeding one year.

8. The trustees may terminate any scholarship at any time if they are of opinion that the progress or conduct of the holder is unsatisfactory.

9. The number of scholarships to be awarded each year and the basis of awards may be reviewed from time to time. The number of scholarships to be awarded will depend upon the income earned by the trust fund.

TRAINING COURSE FOR EMPLOYMENT AS AERADIO OPERATOR.

1. Applications are invited by the Department of Civil Aviation for entry upon a course of training arranged by that department with the view of subsequent employment as aeradio operators. Vacancies exist for forty candidates.
2. The following qualifications are necessary:-
 - (a) returned from overseas service;
 - (b) not more than 27 years of age (unless having a morse operating ability of 25 words per minute);
 - (c) a morse operating ability of 10-15 words per minute; and
 - (d) a knowledge of mathematics to Intermediate or Junior Public standard.
3. Selection will be subject to medical examination.
4. The conditions under which the department will train selected applicants, who must be willing to accept employment under the conditions stated, are:-
 - (i) While undergoing training:-
 - (a) Location of course: Sydney.
 - (b) Duration of course: Six months at the training school and four months' practical training at an aeradio station.
 - (c) Nature of course: Generally speaking, the course will cover the syllabus as laid down for a second class commercial operator's certificate of proficiency.
 - (d) Examinations: Regular examinations will be held. Trainees will be required to pass a final examination on completion of training. The department reserves the right to terminate the employment of any trainee who is considered to be unfit for further training.
 - (e) Books and publications will be provided.
 - (f) Fares to Sydney for applicants selected from other localities will be paid by the department.
 - (g) Salaries will be dependent on the length of war service. Less than one year's service - £293 p.a., with an annual increase of £12 for each year of service.
 - (h) Travelling allowances: Accomodation not provided. Married men whose homes are outside the Sydney metropolitan area will be paid a travelling allowance of £2-10-0 per week.
 - (ii) On completion of training.
 - (a) Locality of appointment: Any aeradio station in the Commonwealth (including remote localities).

(11) (b) Salary range: £334 to £418 p.a., plus district allowance £10 to £100 p.a. single men and £20 to £120 p.a. married men, payable to operators posted to remote localities.

5. Successful appointees will be required to enter into an undertaking to serve in the department for at least two years after completing the course.

6. Each applicant should state his full name, date of birth, whether married or single, the number and age of children (if any), service and/or civilian address, date of enlistment, details of overseas service, experience in radio, navigation, meteorology, and/or aerodrome control, educational qualifications and previous employment. 

55. THIRD VICTORY LOAN.

1. The Third Victory Loan of £100,000,000 cash will open for subscription on 13th Mar 1945 and close not later than 27th Apr 1945.

2. Arrangements have been made for paymasters to accept applications for Commonwealth Government Inscribed Stock or Treasury Bonds from members of the AIF who desire to invest their savings in the loan.

Particulars of Loan:

3. Loan applications may be made for an amount of £10 or a multiple of £10.

4. Treasury Bonds are payable to bearer and are issued at par for £10, £50, £100, £500, and £1,000.

5. Inscribed Stock may be purchased at par for amounts of £100 or multiples of £10 above £100.

6. Interest is payable at 2-1/2-% per annum if invested for five years and 3-1/4-% per annum if invested for sixteen years, and will be credited half-yearly to a member's savings Bank account or current account, if desired.

7. Interest will be subject to Commonwealth taxation but not to any income tax under the law of a State. During the period of uniform taxation, a rebate of 2/- in the pound on interest will be allowed to cover freedom from State Taxation. Any bank nominated by a member will, if requested, hold the bonds in safe custody.

8. Application forms will be available from paymasters and unit pay representatives and are required to be completed in duplicate. An applicant's signature will be witnessed by an officer.

9. Sufficient credit must be available in the member's pay book to cover the amount he or she desires to invest in the loan. The amount subscribed will be debited in the pay book.

10. Cash may be accepted in payment of a loan subscription, in which case the amount tendered will be entered in the pay book to establish the necessary credit and a pay sergeant's or cash office receipt issued and pasted in the pay book.

11. Deposits on amount of loan subscriptions will not be accepted. Where members desire to subscribe by instalments, the procedure set out in GRO F.303/1944 will be observed. Supplies of "Bank Advice of Service Allotment" forms (vide appendix of GRO F.303/1944) will be available from paymasters.

12. The Commonwealth Bank will forward to a member an interim receipt for the amount subscribed.

13. General: Both Treasury Bonds and Inscribed Stock are readily realisable and may be sold at any time. Any bank will arrange this for a member, if desired.

56. METHODS OF ADDRESSING FEMALE MEMBERS OF THE AMF. SECOND AUST ARMY ROUTINE ORDER, NO 444.


1. Female members of the AMF, during the course of military duty will be addressed in accordance with the following:-
- (a) OFFICERS OF THE AMF: Officers of and above the rank of Major are addressed orally as "Patron" and those who are below field rank are addressed orally as "Sister".
 - (b) OTHER FEMALE MEMBERS OF THE AMF.
- The method of orally addressing female members of the AMF other than Officers of the AMF will conform in every respect to the existing custom in regard to male members of the AMF, subject to the following:-
- (i) Where the word "Sir" is used in addressing male members of the AMF, the word "Madam" is used in addressing female members.
 - (ii) Female lieutenants of the AMF may be addressed by their surname with the prefix "Mrs" or "Miss", whichever is applicable.
 - (iii) Female warrant officers of the AMF will not be addressed as "Warrant Officer", "Mrs" or "Miss" but will be addressed as "Madam" or by the title of their appointments, such as "Sjt-Major", etc, with such abbreviations, if any, as are in accordance with the customs of the Service.

57. MEAL ARRANGEMENTS FOR PERSONNEL TRAVELLING BY CIVILIAN TRAINS. SECOND AUST ARMY ROUTINE ORDER 443.

1. Advice has been received that the conduct of Service personnel travelling by civilian trains is such that considerable embarrassment and inconvenience is being caused to Managers of Rly Refreshment Rooms.
2. It has been represented that drafts of Service personnel detrain at stations often before trains have stopped and rush the Refreshment Rooms and sit at various tables, and partake of a meal in excess of that for which an AMF T19 is held by DCO and refuse to pay the difference on being requested to do so by Manager Railway Refreshment Room.
3. Action is to be taken immediately by all concerned to ensure that DCOs of parties travelling by civilian train and to whom an AMF T19 has been issued to cover cost of meals consumed en route are instructed as follows:-
- (a) On arrival at a mealing station draft is detrained and marched to Rly Refreshment Room.
 - (b) DCO contacts Manager of RRR who will arrange for all personnel to be seated in a particular portion of the room.
 - (c) DCO will be held responsible for presenting AMF T19, and collecting and paying the Manager any cost incurred by member of the draft in excess of the sum covered by the AMF T19.
4. Disciplinary action will be taken against any DCO who fails to carry out these instructions.

58. DAMAGE TO LICA LIGHTS AND FITTINGS.

1. Light sockets and fuses are missing from the LICA Huts. On various occasions Light Globes have been taken from the sockets and left on the tables and, in most cases, these globes, which are difficult to replace, are broken.
2. Disciplinary action will be taken if troops interfere with fuses, switches, and globes.

Q41 SUPPLIES OF TOBACCO AND CIGARETTES WITHIN AUSTRALIA:

Following is the text of LHQ memo 29771 of 2 Mar 45:

" Due to an acute shortage in tobacco supplies in Australia a further reduction in the tobacco quota for service personnel in non-operational areas has been requested, as it is considered necessary to enforce a reduction in the tobacco available for sale to service personnel located in certain areas.

Supplies for Prisoners of War and Internees will also be made on a reduced scale.

This reduction will come into operation on 1 Apr 45, and the areas in which the reduced quota will exist will be South of the Tropic of Capricorn, that is a line immediately South of Rockhampton.

The new quota will be based on 2 ozs of tobacco or seventy cigarettes per member, less 10% for non-smokers in the case of males and 25% in the case of females.

The proportion of tobacco and cigarettes supplied by Canteens will be similar to that now operating. "
