

NOTIFICATION
OF CHANGES
IN RESPECT

Extract from GRO A330/44 is republished.

1. A member of the AMF may nominate any person as his next of kin for army purposes, although that person is not his legal next of kin.
2. It is the function of the 2nd Echelon organization to notify fatal and certain other casualties sustained by a member to the person recorded in army records as the member's next of kin, or to any other person nominated by such next of kin to receive casualty advices.
3. Failure by a member to report promptly particulars of a change of next of kin or a change of address of next of kin, in order that the appropriate 2nd Echelon component may be advised, causes considerable administrative work to the Army and may delay or prevent notification of a casualty being given to the proper person, thereby causing distress to the member's relatives.
4. Each member will be warned that a change of his allottee or an entry in his AAS 83 of a change in the particulars of his next of kin will not be sufficient to notify the 2nd Echelon organization of a change in respect of his next of kin.
5. (a) Each member will be advised that, on his marriage, any will or codicil previously made by him, save in exceptional circumstances, becomes of no effect and, and under Australian Military Regulations, he is bound, upon marriage, to make a new will. (b) On marriage, a member will make another will immediately, either on an AAF A130 or by a separate document, and will submit the AAF A130 in an envelope (AAF A 131), duly completed, to his unit HQ for transmission to the appropriate 2nd Echelon component. (c) A member may obtain the assistance of an officer of the AALC in the preparation of a will.

Extracts from GRO A356/44 are republished as directed.

- (a) Vacancies exist in the Australian Army Psychology Service for testing and interviewing Sergeants, who should possess the following qualifications:-
 - (i) education to leaving certificate standard or equivalent;
 - (ii) good bearing; and manner;
 - (iii) some formal university or teaching college training in psychology - desirable but not essential.
- (b) In filling these vacancies, preference will be given to personnel with operational experience in the present war, especially those who are medically class B1 or B2 or who are over 30 years of age.
- (c) Any member possessing the qualifications outlined above may submit to his OC or CO an application for appointment to one of the vacancies.
- (d) The application will be in writing and will include the following particulars:-
Army number, rank (substantive and acting), name in full, unit, age, medical classification, date of enlistment, service outside Australia, educational particulars, civil occupation, formal training in psychology.

VEHICLES

1st Aust Army Order A211 is republished.

1. Drivers of military vehicles will not leave same unattended except when properly relieved. The parking of a vehicle in a military parking area does not relieve the driver of this responsibility.
2. When vehicles are proceeding in convoy, OC convoy may permit drivers to leave their vehicles during halts, provided the OC makes adequate provisions for the piquetting of the vehicles.

1st Aust Army Order Q191 is republished.

1. The storage of unit ammunition underground or semi-underground in ATHERTON TABLELAND area has been found unsatisfactory owing to the difficulty of providing effective drainage.
2. Accordingly, units will arrange for ammunition to be stored in buildings above ground level ensuring that adequate dunnage, ventilation, and surface drainage are provided.

GRO 9236/44 is republished.

1. At the first available opportunity, all Bren magazine springs (incl spares) will be inspected by unit personnel to ensure that they are properly greased or oiled. If springs are dry, their life is greatly shortened.
2. The following preservatives will be used for the purpose of oiling or greasing the springs:-

"Corrosion preventative, type A (oil type)"

"Corrosion preventative, type B (soft jelly type)".

After the initial examination, springs will be examined once monthly, provided that, subsequently to the second monthly examination, the examination period may be extended at the discretion of unit commanders if springs are found to be still greased efficiently

Extract from GRO 0343/44 is republished

Approval is given for the wearing of armlets (brassards), with badges of rank affixed thereto, by NCOs when shirts are worn as an outer garment.

Extract from GRO F334/44 is republished.

1. The second victory loan of £120,000,000 cash will open for subscription on 26th September 1944 and close not later than 31st October 1944.
2. Arrangements have been made for paymasters to accept applications for Commonwealth Government Inscribed Stock or Treasury Bonds from members of the forces serving in Australia or New Guinea who desire to invest their savings in the loan.

Extract from 11 Aust Div Adm Inst No 15 is republished.

(a) The Trg areas allotted to this unit embrace a number of private properties. Units will instruct all ranks regarding the following subjects:-

- (i) Bush fire prevention.
- (ii) Cleaning up of camp and bivouac sites, including filling-in of latrines, weapon pits etc.
- (iii) Damage to growing crops.
- (iv) Indiscriminate use of firearms.
- (v) Closing of gates and openings in fences. It should seldom be necessary to cut a fence. Where it is done, the fences must be temporarily closed forthwith and properly repaired by the unit as soon as possible afterwards.

(b) While it may not always be axix possible to camp away from waterholes on cattle properties it is to be remembered that some of the beef cattle seldom see more than one stockman on horseback every few months and the activity of several troops on foot around a waterhole scares them away for such length of time that they lose condition. If practicable, waterholes in trg areas 3, 4, 5 and 6 will be avoided.

First Aust Army Adm Standing Orders Chap 5 Sec 1 Para 2 is republished.

(a) All members who are evacuated beyond R A P will be evacuated with personal arms, equipment, personal effects and documents. Other items of controlled stores will not be evacuated.

(b) In addition the following will also accompany casualties

- (i) Tent, mosquito (where issued)
- (ii) Sheet, ground
- (iii) All personal belongings of the member suitably secured in kit bag or any other suitable container, labelled with regimental particulars.

1. From 1 to 24 October the unit was divided into 2 categories, viz: Advanced HQ consisting of Queensland and NSW personnel, who had returned from leave, concentrated in MAPEE area, and the main body of the unit consisted of Victorian, South Australian and Tasmanian personnel who were concentrated at WATSONIA.

2. ADVANCED HQ.

From 1 to 24 October this party were in the MAPEE area, where they prepared the camp site for the remainder of the unit. The camp area was ^{partially} cleared, lines laid out and tents erected. Meals were provided for each trainload until the last draft arrived in MAPEE area on 24 Oct 44.

3. MAIN BODY

(a) Personnel were concentrated at WATSONIA on 6 Oct when they returned from leave. Until 12 Oct preparations and training for the march of 15 Aust Inf Bde (AIF) through MELBOURNE on 13 Oct 44 were carried out.

(b) On Sunday 8 Oct 44, 400 men of the unit attended the Annual Pilgrimage to the Shrine of Remembrance of 24 Aust Inf Bn (AIF). The address was given by Lt Col SMITH DSO and the whole ceremony was most impressive.

(c) On 12 Oct 44 a general meeting of all personnel was held at WATSONIA and it was decided to form an Association which would be known as 3/24 Aust Inf Bn Association. This Association would be linked with 24 Aust Inf Bn and 2/24 Aust Inf Bn Association, the three Associations together would be known as 24 Aust Inf Regtl Association. Office bearers were elected and arrangements completed for the inauguration of the Association.

(d) On 13 Oct 44 the unit marched through the streets of MELBOURNE with 4 and 15 Aust Inf Bdes and were given an excellent reception. The salute was taken by Lt Gen SAVIGE CB CBE DSO ED. The standard of marching was very high and glowing reports were received from good authorities.

(e) After the march the unit prepared to move North and concentrate in the MAPEE area. They moved en route in 4 train loads, the first leaving WATSONIA on 14 Oct and the last on the 17 Oct 44. The complete unit was concentrated at MAPEE on 24 Oct 44.

4. From 24 to 29 Oct 44 all the unit personnel were engaged in camp maintenance settling in and making preparations for future training.

5. On 30 Oct 44 training was commenced. The week's syllabus consisted of smartening up and hardening under direct control of section commanders. In addition revision of all weapon training was to be carried out.

6. Lt Col SMITH DSO on returning from leave was medically boarded B class and did not move North with the unit. Major KA CARROLL was Adm Comd until 31 Oct when Lt Col AJ ANDERSON was appointed to command the unit.

7. The general health and morale of the troops was very good and they entered into the preparation of the camp and training with great enthusiasm. A slight reaction after the long period of leave was noticeable at first but they soon settled down.

The unit left WATSONIA on completion of its A.R.L for movement to the TABLELANDS.

A "Q" representative and 3 assistants remained at WATSONIA until such time as all accommodation, stores and equipment were handed over to the Camp QM.

MOVEMENT TO TABLELANDS

The unit was broken into 4 drafts and left WATSONIA on the following dates 14, 15, 16, and 17 Oct. On route these drafts staged at LTD BRISBANE for approx 6 hours then on arrival at REDLYNCH all drafts staged for approx 24 hours.

Unit drafts arrived at MAPEE on the following dates 21, 22, 23 and 24 Oct. 152 General Transport Company provided transport for movement of personnel from TOLGA to unit area.

ACCOMMODATION

During the month, whilst the unit was on ARL a Bn rear party had commenced on the unit area.

All tentage had been erected and a 60 x 18 hut erected for use as RQMS store.

Any shortages of accommodation and stores were obtained from CAMP STAFF MAPEE with the exception of a MEAT HOUSE which has yet to be made by the engineers.

RATIONS

All items on the ration scale are being received. Fresh commodities of this scale are being appreciated by all.

EXPENSE STORES

In reasonable supply all items being available fortnightly on demand.

CONTROLLED STORES

All controlled stores were sent to 2/90 LAD to be examined and any necessary repairs carried out. The following items of controlled stores have not as yet been returned from 2/90 LAD :-

Purchases were made twice weekly from the bulk Canteen at KAIRI. Beer for OR's was draft beer and drawn twice weekly on the basis of 2 bottles of beer per man per week.

Most items have been in fair supply with the exception of chocolate and Nugget.

TO'S REPORT FOR MONTH OCTOBER 1944

On the 21 Oct 44, at MAPPE area the unit was equipped with full WE of vehicles - viz:

8 $\frac{1}{2}$ ton Jeeps complete with trailers -
the jeeps and trailers are all new and in good running order.

A high standard of maintenance has to be maintained at all times to these vehicles - every effort was made by the drivers to keep their vehicles in first class order.

An inspection by Capt BRECHLEY (266 L A D) of all vehicles on the 31 Oct, disclosed only minor faults in two Jeeps, which have since been attended to by L A D.

All vehicles were used in the preparing of the new camp site and for general camp duties. 152 Aust Gen Tpt Coy sent 2x3 ton trucks each day to the unit to help out in the general preparation of the camp site. 1x15 cwt

4 X 4 vehicle was attached from the 15 Aust Inf Bde for this purpose also.

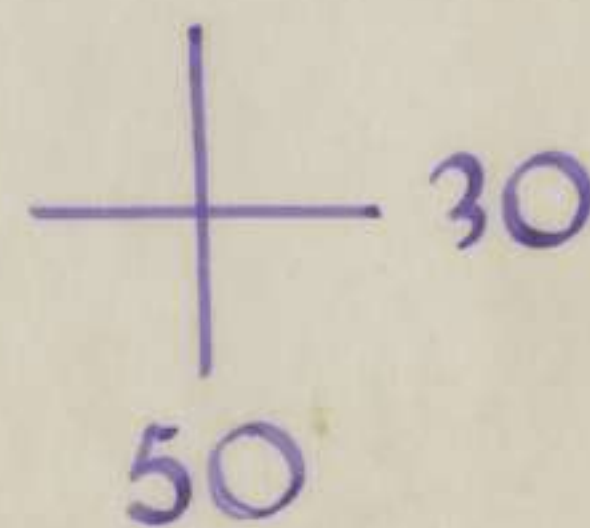
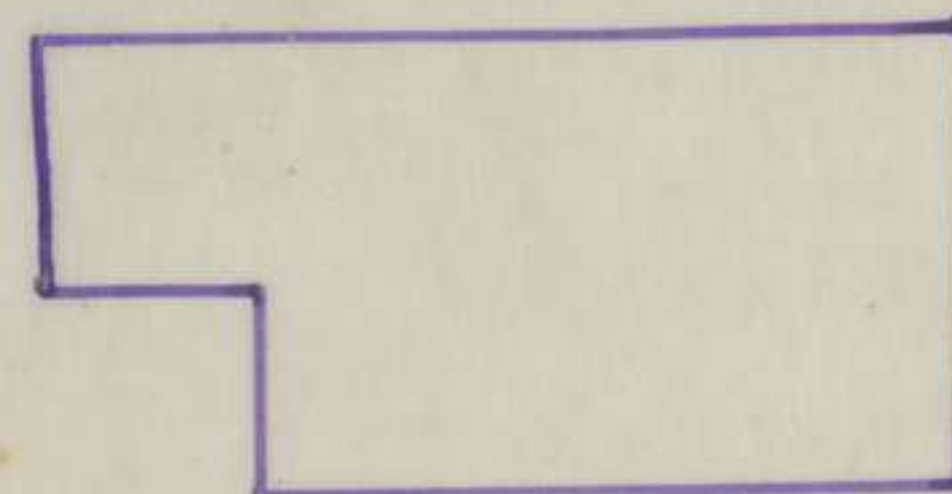
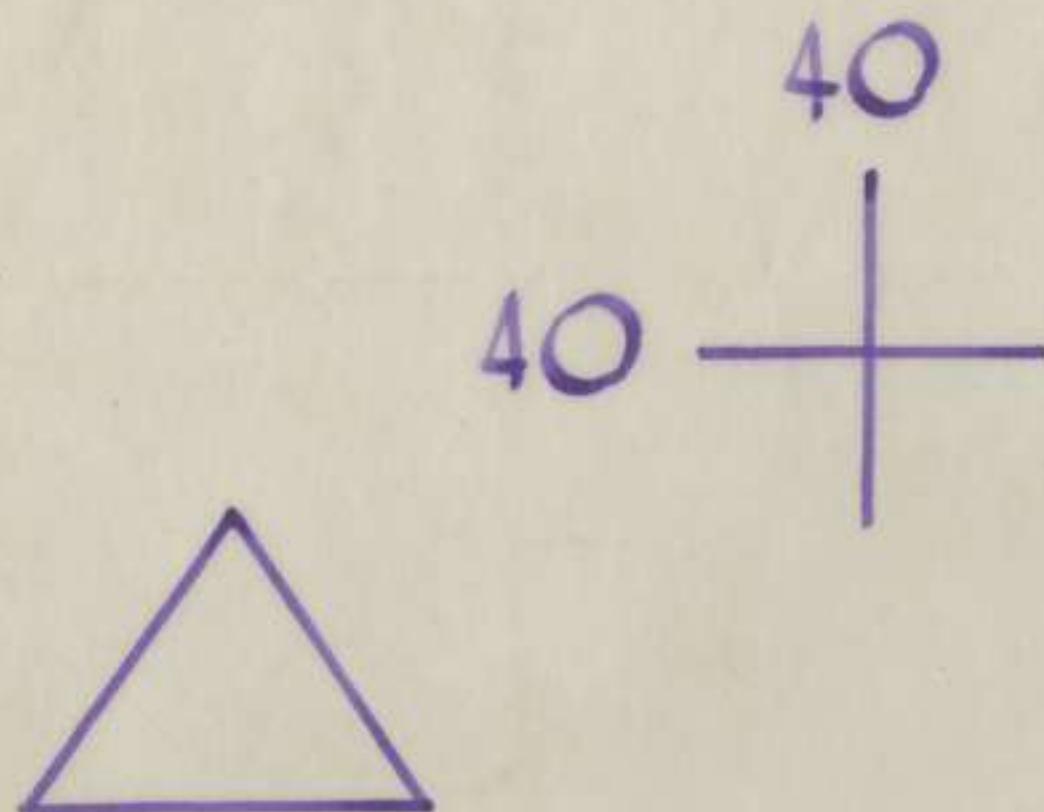
