2/3 AUST INF BN ADM INS NO 21. Movement

- (a) 2/3 Aust Inf Bn will move from present AMBILIOUS TRG area to previous camp site WONDECLA on 31 Aug 43.
- (b) Movement will be effected by ROAD and RAIL as per appendices "A" and "B" attached.
- (c) OC Road party Capt F B Haven, i/a convoy Lieut T N Binney. Capt Haven will supervise loading and unloading of unit stores and equipment.

2. Accommodation

- (a) All accommodation stores, tentage bedboards (except bedboards taken over in this area) will be taken to WONDECLA.

3. Administration

- (a) Coy comds will ensure that all tentage, bedboards and Coy accommodation stores are stacked in a central dump in Coy lines by 1200 hrs 30 Aug.
- (b) Picks and shovels will be returned to Bn Q store by 1000 hrs 30 Aug.
- (c) Offrs & Sita Messes will close down as from 1400 hrs 30 Aug and all mess furniture and kitchen gear will be crated and stacked outside respective kitchens.
- (d) Unit Canten will cease to function as from 1000 hrs 30 Aug. Stock will be boxed and ready for loading by 1600 hrs.
- (e) Band Instruments will be packed under supervision of Sjt Edgworth by 1200 hrs 30 Aug.
- (f) Blankets One blanket will be carried on the man, remaining blankets will be rolled in bundles and left Bn Q Store by 1600 hrs 30 Aug. of 10
- (g) Officers Baggage all Officers will ensure that their personal baggage, less VALISE, is stacked outside Bn Q store by 1600 hrs 30 Aug. Valises will be stacked at Bn Q store by 0500 hrs 31 Aug.

4. Dress

All personnel will move out in full marching order. Felt hat, jungle greens, gaiters American type, pack on back, haversack on side.

5. Rations

One dry meal will be carried on the man, QM will supply hot breakfast and hot evening meal. Coy QMSs will collect dry rations from Bn Q store 30 Aug.

6. Medical

- (a) 2/1 Fd Amb will provide one motor ambulance to travel at rear of road convoy.
- (b) Coy lines will be left in clean condition. Hygiene instructions will be rigidly adhered to.
- (c) RMO will travel with road convoy with selected staff and will establish RAP immediately on reaching destination.
- (d) RMO will arrange for medical orderlies to travel with each rail party.

7. Postal

OO 6 Aust Div Postal Unit will arrange for diversion of all mail. Unit postal Sjts will travel with rd party and arrange for immediate distribution on such diversion.

8. Routine

31 Aug 43 Reveille 0400
 Breakfast 0430

9. Loading Parties

Cops will detail 1 NCO and 10 ORs to report to QM at 1800 hrs 30 Aug.

10. Rear Party

- (a) Lieut G W Gibbins and 10 ORs of his Pl will remain as rear party to clean camp site. RMO will attach 2 hygiene men to this party.
- (b) One 30 cwt truck will be left in charge Lieut Gibbins to transport his party to WONDECLA after Camp Staff Officer has certified lines clean.
- (c) QM will provide sufficient cooking gear for party.

2/3 AUST INF BNAMPHIBIOUS OPERATIONSASSEMBLY AREAS

The following is an explanation of attached diagram showing method employed to form battalion up ready to embark on craft at near shore.

There are 4 separate checking points marked out as (i) assembly areas (ii) F.U.P. (iii) Waiting line (iv) Ready line.

ASSEMBLY AREA

1. The whole Bn gp moves into the assembly area, which, it is suggested, may be from half to 4 miles from the beach, and there the final sorting-up of boat loads of personnel takes place. The IO and I Sec go forward to the edge of the beach, laying a tape as axis of advance. Back from the edge of the beach, which will usually be the timber's edge, the F U P is layed out. From the E O the posn of the boats is ascertained and the centre line is laid out in line with the centre boat back to F U P.

F U P

2. The force is divided into waves, each wave being no more than nine boats. Running at right angles to the centre line the first tape is layed out just inside the timber's edge. Markers or pegs are layed out on this tape, corresponding in posn 2nd number to the boat in the wave which they are representing. This when wave 5 is on the beach, and boats are 30 yards apart the first tape line has pegs every 30 yds, each in front of a boat. On centre line a marker is placed on which his number, denoting number of the wave and at each end of the tape another marker is placed, also showing wave number. This facilitates personnel in realising the left and right limits of their area. Successive waves are laid out at right angles to centre line and parallel to first wave line. These also have pegs along them to correspond to actual boats on the beach, so that personnel moving forward do so in ~~relation~~ relation to their particular boat on the beach. In these successive waves however, the pegs are not numbered. So when the F U P is completely laid out it appears as represented in attached diagram, with the highest numbered wave in front and wave 1 at rear. With this task completed the I Section are left as guides on each centre marker and I O moves back along the tape representing axis of advance and reports to the IO that F U P is in a state of readiness. The Bn Gp then moves forward in wave order to F U P where each wave is guided to its respective markers and each boat load moves to their respective peg. When Bn is in posn, the T O (Suggested) acting as an L O reports to E O. that the Bn is ready to embark.

WAITING LINE

3. This is a line laid out on the beach as close to timber line as possible and corresponding with wave tapes in the F U P. When the E O is ready to embark troops order is given "wave 5 to the waiting line" and wave 5 moves off from F U P to the waiting line. The E O orders wave to move to the ready line. As forward wave moves to next posn, the remaining waves all move up one place.

READY LINE

4. On reaching this line Pl Sjt of 2 i/c Boat party reports to the embarkation checker, who is waiting on the ready line and then, on the seaman calling boat 11 or 21 etc., boat loads double forward and embark. Officer or NCO in charge of boat hands in triplicate copies of :-

- (a) Pers embarking (name rank and number)
- (b) List of weapons carried

these are handed to representative of the E O. A fourth copy is retained by the Unit embarking.

DRILL ON BOATS

5. As soon as the personnel are on board, all equipment is taken off and life jackets are donned. Troops are then seated on equipment. Some boats only, have actual seats along the sides. Troops then embarked must stay in relative posn on boat so that Sec leaders have their own Secs under comd. Whilst on boat the comd of the boat (as distinct from boat party comd) is in sole control. When approaching the far shore, he will give the order to remove life jackets and troops prepare for landing.

GENERAL POINTS ABOUT ASSEMBLY AREAS AND LOADING

6. It will be noted that the waves are loaded in reverse order to their actual landing. This is because the waves 3, 4 and 5 have to have stores loaded, they will take much longer to load than waves 1 and 2. Thus by loading first landing waves last it gives the actual assaulting troops much less time on the water and this the maximum amount of rest possible. This may be overcome to a large extent by pre-loading of stores which will be reported on separately. When the craft have loaded each wave moves out to an "assembly area" where the whole mission collects and forms up for move to far shore. The whole mission turns about so that when approaching the far shore wave 1 is in front. This turning about calls for care in loading as troops to land on the right flank must be loaded on the left flank at the near beach.

BOAT DRILL

GENERAL

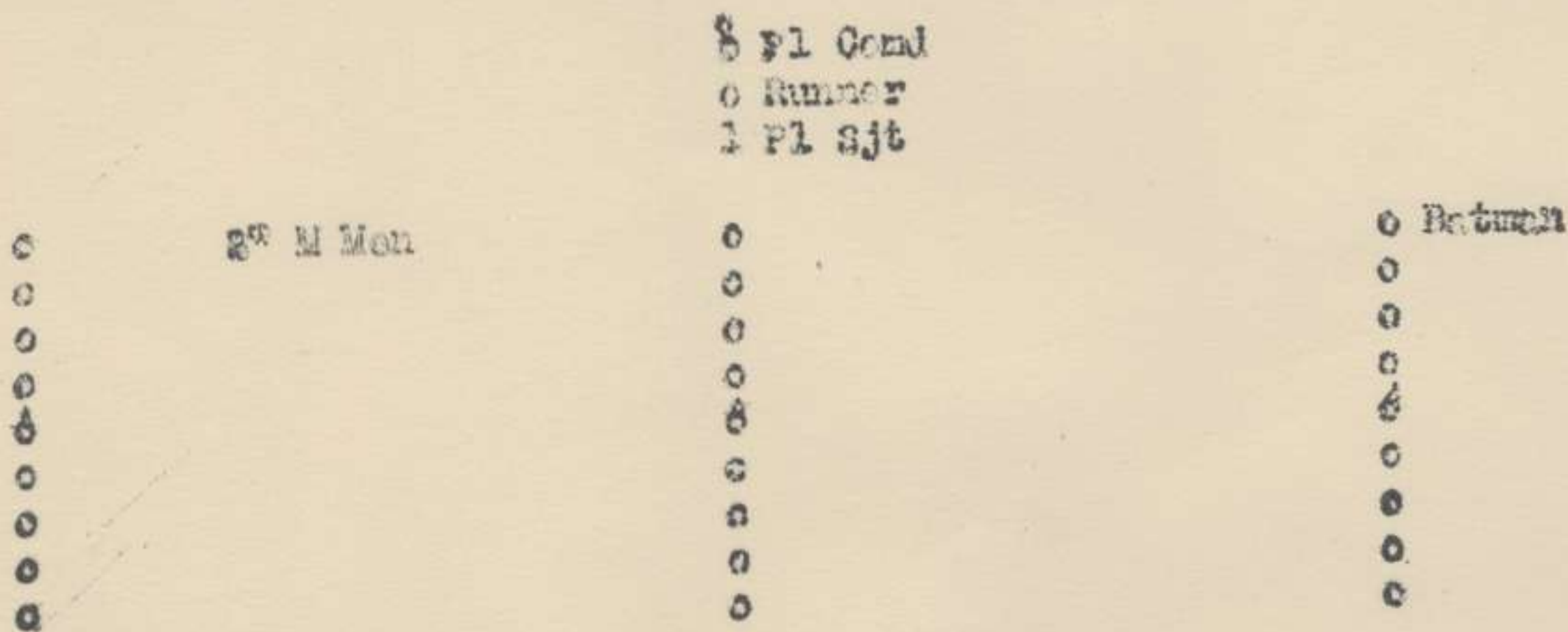
7. Certain factors limit size of assaulting force. These are:-
 (a) Size of waves. Owing to necessity of control it is impracticable to have more than nine boats in a wave. This may spread wave over 600yds
 (b) Size of boats. Internal measurements of LCV (P) are:-

- Length 18'
- Breadth 6'5" at bottom
- 7'9" maximum at top
- Can take combination loads of 30 men,
- or 1 Truck 1/4 tn and 1 Tk & Gun
- or 1 Truck 1/4 tn and 1 QF 25 pr It. etc.
- Maximum load 7,500 lbs.

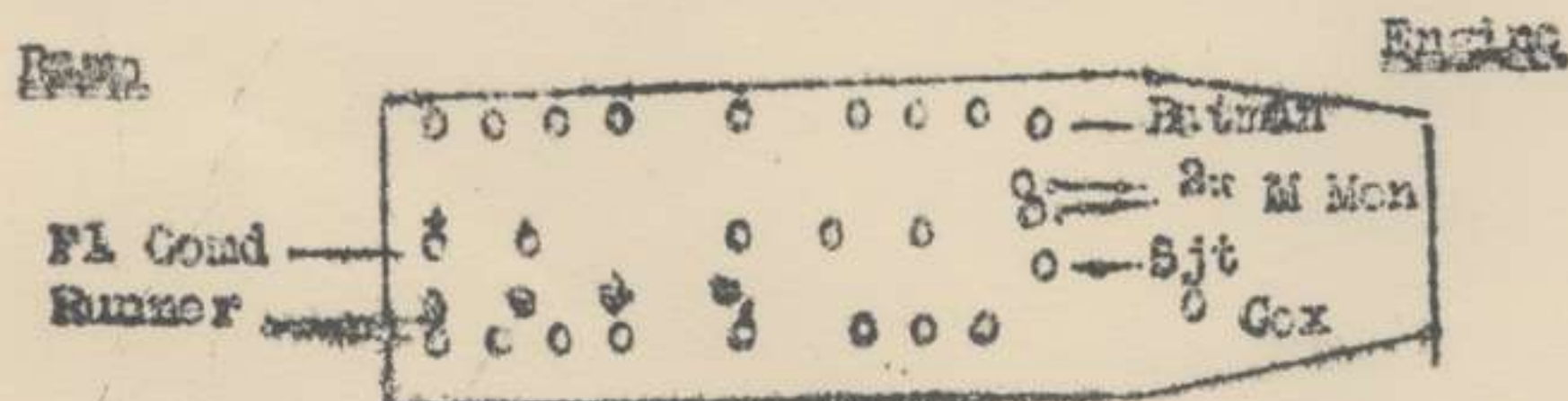
8. This first wave will usually consist of two boys with letter boy following on or being used as a floating reserve to exploit most successful landings

9. Owing to the necessity for certain "gate crashers" to be included in the early waves, such as engineers F D O parties AA Beach Maintenance Parties, pls may have to be slimmed. Surplus pers from pls to be allotted at discretions of C O.
 (a) allotted to other boats
 (b) used later as carrying parties for extra stores etc.
 (c) immediate reinforcements.

10. LOADING DRILL
 Necessity for boat embarkation and disembarkation drill vital. Suggested drill for Pl of 30. Move from assembly area as follows:-



Pl Comd moves in front of his troops to Ready Line and checks the personnel through and takes up a position at bow end of boat, handling the aforementioned lists of personnel and stores to C O. One formation adopted inside LCV(P) is as follows, whilst Pl Sjt leads Pl onto boat, at the double:-



Forward sections are on flanks of LCV and as ramp lowers dash out on to the beach and deploy immediately. With formation as above the Sec leader is thus in centre of his Section without undue movement. Reserve Section wait until last man of flanking secs are passed and then disembark in open formation. This method brings Pl HQ in rear or to a flank of the reserve section and it may be considered more suitable to have them forward of reserve section. This can be easily readjusted by alteration of posns on boat. As waves approach far shore, tps are warned by cox'n, remove life jacket and don eqpt. At same time they crouch below armour plating and brace themselves for shock of impact as boat lands at full speed. Immediately ramp touches beach tps must dash out. Care will be taken when disembarking to keep them to the sides of the landing craft. Life jackets on being removed must be placed into spaces provided on sides to facilitate movement of craft. It is possible that in actual ops we will be equipped with new type of life jacket which does not necessitate removal of eqpt and can be inflated as required. We consider that the complete drill above should be adopted on all occasions whether tactical or not.

BEACH HEAD DRILL

11. As illustrated by diagram.

MOPPING UP DRILL

12. Suggested that Coys and Pls move to final posns on bearing giving two logs, thus clearing area in series of parallel lines. Owing to possibility of landing on wrong beach or of plans going awry, Coys may not have the task originally assigned. Good Beach Head drill, initiative and speed of action then essential. Problem of supply if landing made on wrong beach, exploit that beach or move supplies to the right beach.

INTERCOMMUNICATION

13. (a) Wireless used with range of up to 5 miles. Care not to prejudice secrecy and silence usually enforced until contact.
(b) Coy Comds should travel with or near wave leaders (naval) suggested one Coy comd with wave leader, one in adjoining boat.
(c) Bn comd probably with wave 3 leader, NOT with mission leader as he may not land. CO can relay message to mission leader and mission leader to Bn.

LIGHTS

14. (a) Semaphore and Morse flicker can be used.
(b) Missions and beaches all denoted by basic colours:
RED // GREEN and these colours maintained : i.e. RED mission RED beach.
YELLOW

NUMBERS

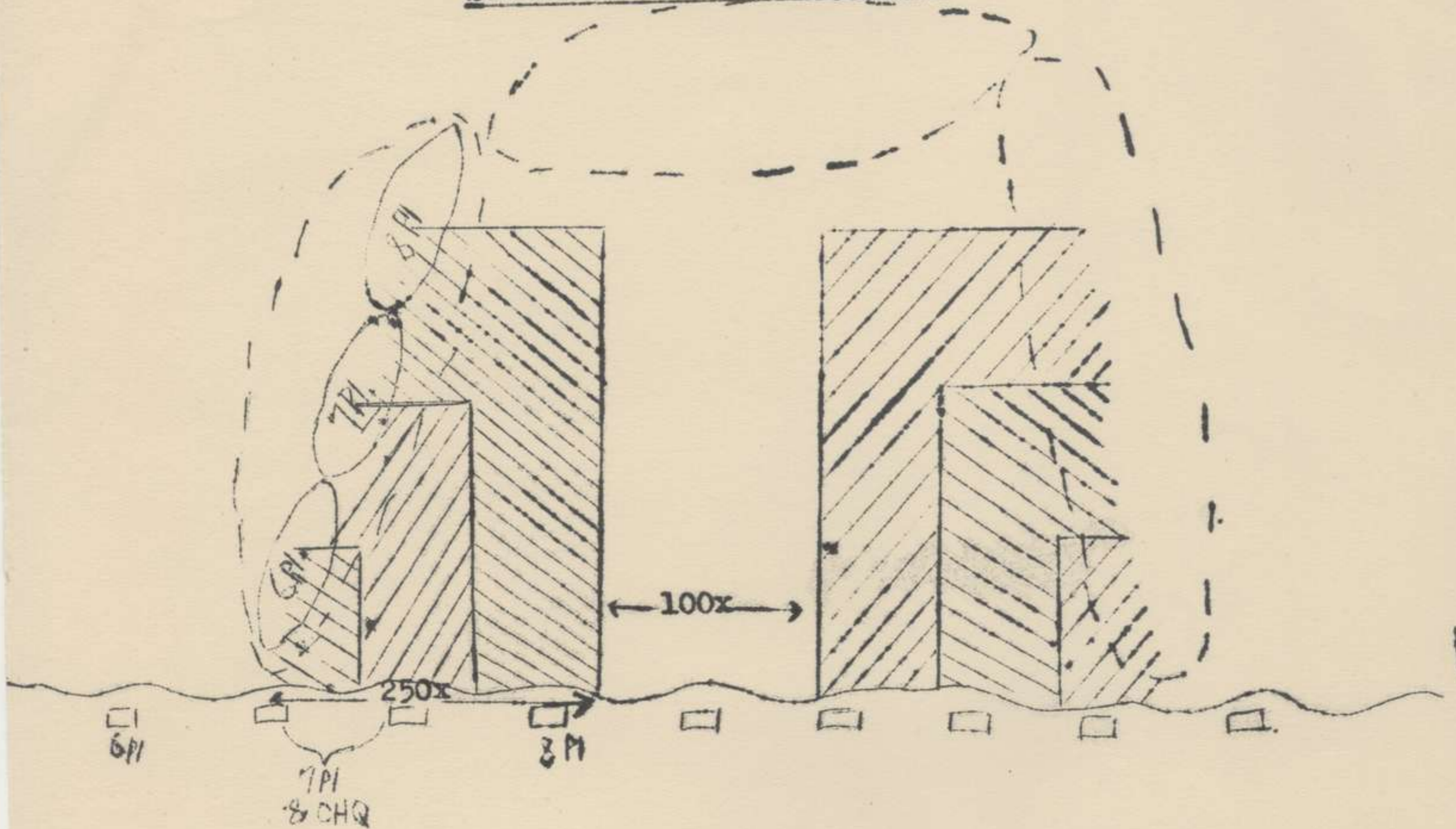
15. Boats are numbered by waves and positions within wave : i.e. No 1 Boat of Wave 1 is not boat 1 but boat 11. Boat 2 of next wave is boat 21.

CENTRE LINE

16. Boat 5 is always the control boat, moving on centre line and carrying wave leader.

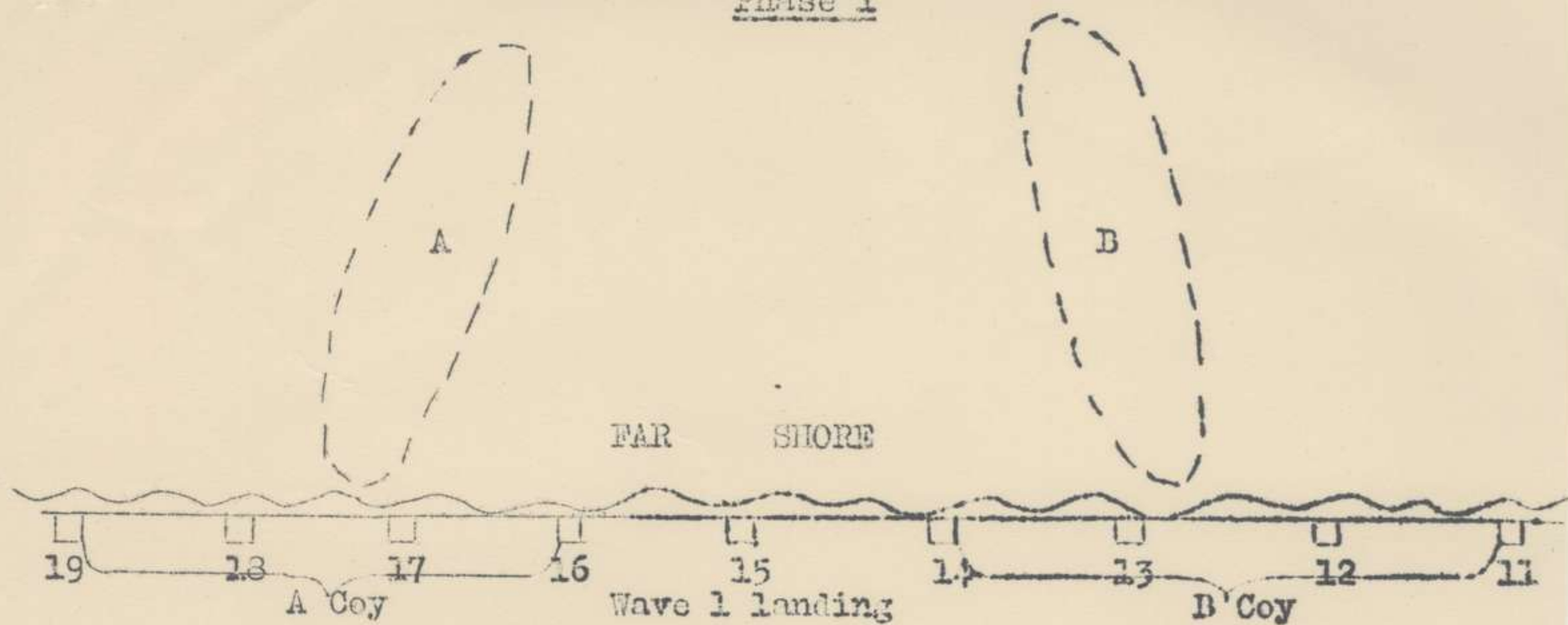
SUGGESTED MOPPING-UP DRILL



Wave I landing on beach. Platoons move to predetermined positions and commence to sweep area. Central unshaded area is swept by third Coy whilst moving through.

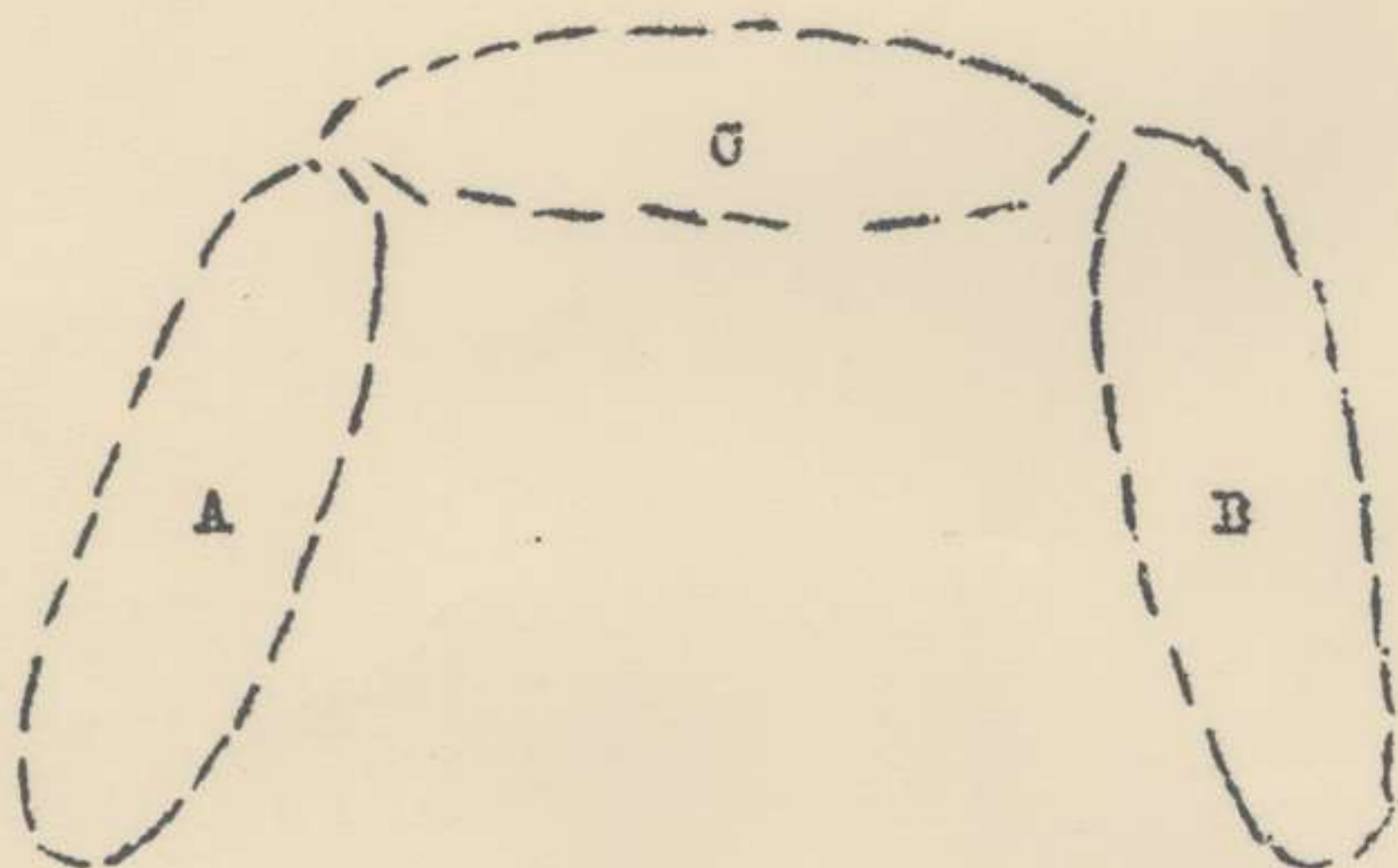
SUGGESTED BEACH-HEAD DRILL

Phase 1



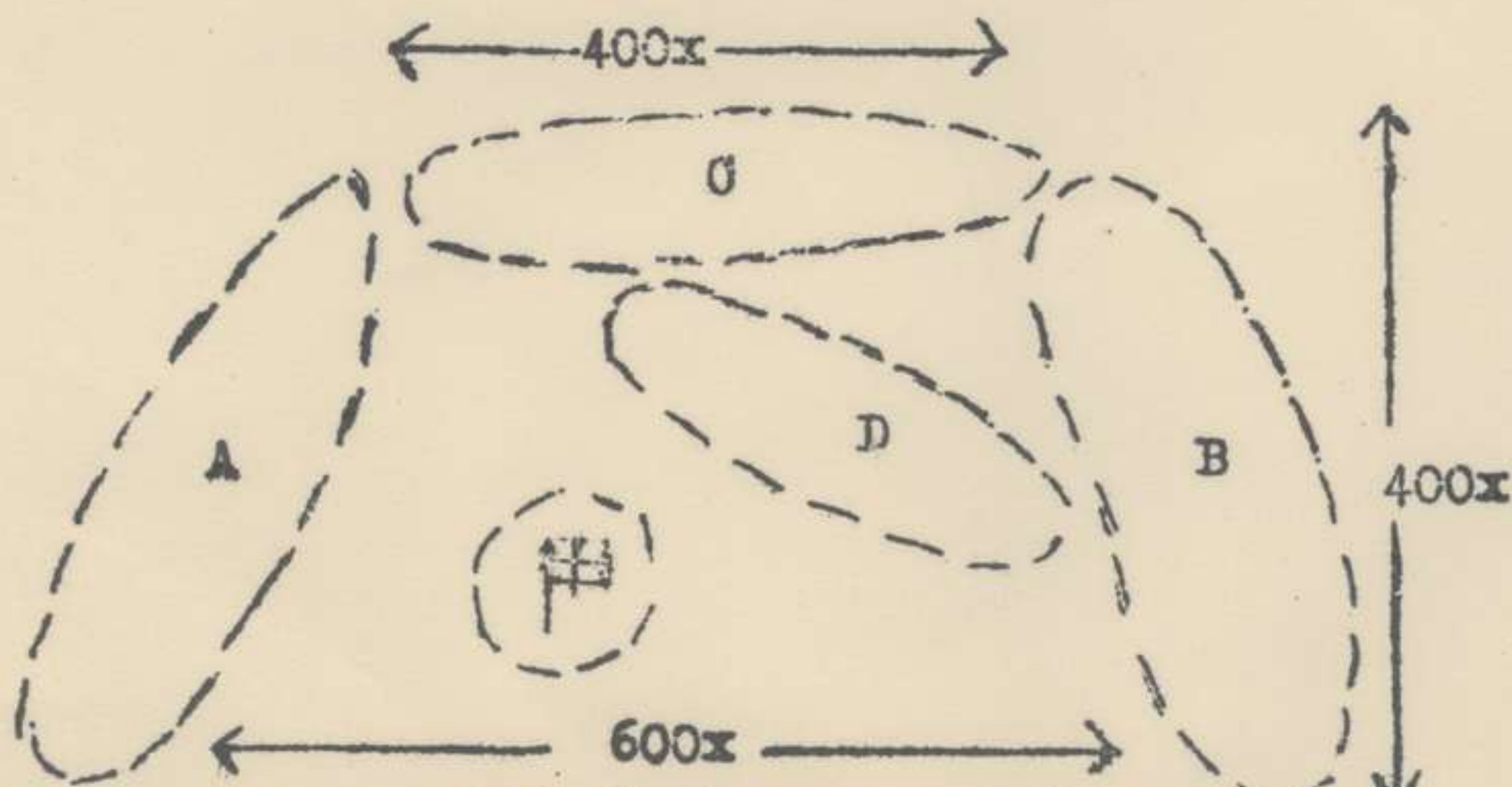
Leading Coys take up positions on flanks.

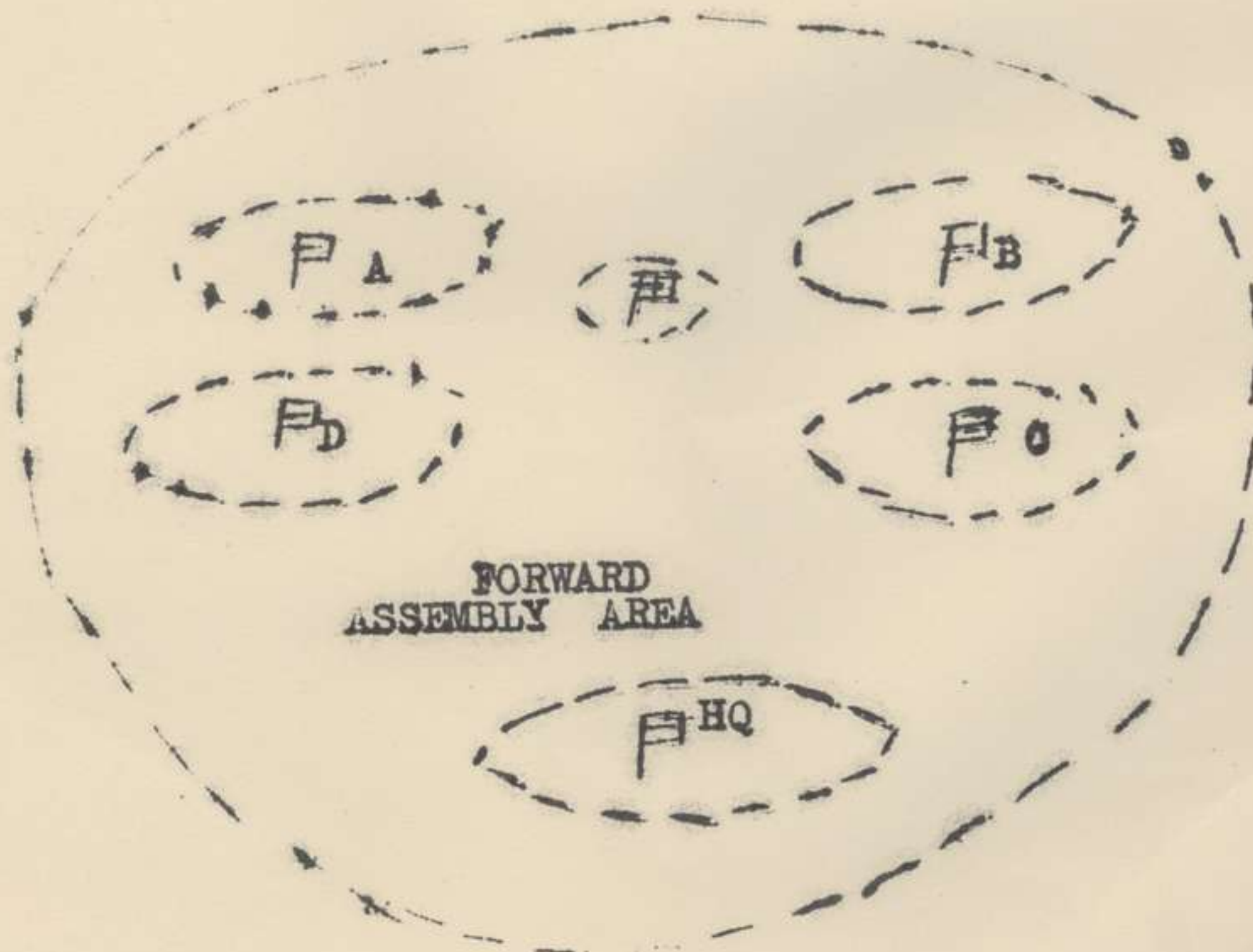

2. MECHANICAL VEHICLES - LOADING

(a) PERSONNEL.

(i) Unless otherwise ordered in writing by an officer, the number of personnel carried in load carrying vehicles will not exceed:-

(ii) Where personnel are partly equipped, or where material is loaded in addition to personnel, the number of personnel must be adjusted accordingly.

(iii) An officer will not give an order to exceed the above figures except by endorsement on the Driver's AAF G2. Such an order will not be given unless the exigencies of the Service demand it. It is unlikely that such exigencies will arise except in operations, and the officer giving such order will be held responsible that this action is justified by the circumstances.

(iv) Personnel must be seated wholly within the confines of the body, and will not ride on the canopy, cabin roof, sides, or tailboard of the vehicle.

(v) Should this order be contravened, the driver will not move his vehicle until the contravention has been rectified and will report the matter on return to his Unit.

(b) MATERIALS

(i) Attention is directed to "Standing Orders For Drivers of Mechanical Vehicles 1942" para 17 (c).

(ii) Drivers will not be ordered to exceed the authorised load for a vehicle except by an officer, in writing on the AAF G2, when the exigencies of the service demand it.

(iii) Units are responsible that drivers are fully conversant with the amount, which constitutes the authorised load for the vehicle concerned, of the materials which they are likely to transport. The average weight of loose materials such as sand, gravel and earth is 112 lbs per cubic foot.

The following orders will be read at a muster parade held in coys and a certificate rendered to this HQ by 1800 hrs 3 Jul 43 to the effect that these orders have been read to all personnel present with coy.

2. DAMAGE TO TIMBER.

Many instances of needless ringbarking and felling of timber causing unnecessary damage have been observed in the area.

This practice will cease forthwith and the provision of GRO Q134/43, as set out hereunder, will apply.

*1. Members will not, except for operational purposes, cut or authorise or direct the cutting of timber growing on private or public property (including forestry reserves) without first obtaining the consent of a person having power to agree to such cutting.

DCM: NX 4271 Pte ANDRESEN H

A DCM convened by the Colonel L E Vail was held at HQ NSW Lof C Area on 19 June 1943. for the trial of NX4271 Pte ANDRESEN H LTD. The accused was charged with : Desertion AWL from 1715 hrs on 10. 3.43 until 1430 hrs on 9. 6.43. The accused pleaded not guilty, and the court found the accused Not Guilty of desertion but guilty of AWL for the period stated in the charge sheet. The Court sentenced the accused to undergo detention for 45 days. The accused was in custody a waiting trial for 10 days. The finding and sentence were duly confirmed on 26 Jun 43. by Colonel L E Vail. The result of the ~~trial~~ trial was promulgated to the accused at ~~HOLDSWORTHY~~ on 30th June, 1943.

3 AIRGRAPH SERVICE

This service is an arrangement under which letters written by senders in Australia upon special forms are photographed in miniature in this country and the negatives thus obtained forwarded by air to the overseas country of address, where enlarged prints are taken, enveloped and delivered by post to the addressees. The service now functioning from Australia is available only for communication:-

(a) To civilians in - Aden, Anglo-Egyptian Sudan, Bahrein, British Somaliland, Canada, Ceylon, Cyprus, Egypt, Fire, India, Iraq, Kenya, Uganda, Mauritius, Northern Rhodesia, Nyasaland, Palestine, Seychelles, South Africa, Southern Rhodesia, Tanganyika, Transjordan, United Kingdom, ~~XX~~ Zanzibar.

(b) To members of the forces of the Empire serving in - The countries included in the list above, and Syria, Persian Iraq Force, Ethiopia (Abyssinia) Iran (Persia) Madagascar, Somalia (Italian Somaliland) Occupied Territory of Eritrea.

and the charges payable are as follows :-

(i) For airgraph letters to members of the forces of the British Empire - 5 d.

(ii) For airgraph letters to civilians - 10d.

Forms upon which airgraph letters may be written by senders are available from Army postal orderlies serving with units, from whom further details of the service can be secured by personnel.

Normal unit censorship arrangements will apply to airgraph letters lodged by personnel. The franking Officer's signature will appear in the lower left-hand corner of the form (above the direction "This space should not be used"). Censorable matter will be obliterated and not excised. The Unit censor stamp will be affixed in the space between the address panel and the single printed line directly thereunder; it will be placed as far to the left as practicable.

Detailed instructions covering preparation of the letters by senders are set out on the backs of the forms, which will, however, in every case following censorship be passed through unit channels by postal orderlies for onwards transmission.

- 2 -

If one form be insufficient for the whole of a letter, two or more separate forms may be used, but in such case each form will be treated as a separate letter and a separate fee must be paid for each. Writing must be plain and preferably in black ink, to secure satisfactory photographic reproduction. Use of pencil is not recommended but, if used, it will be a soft black lead pencil; indelible pencil will not be used.

Names and addresses of addressees of airgraph letters will be written by hand in prominent block lettering (as large as practicable) and will be kept wholly within the panel provided on the form. The full address of the sender and the date of writing at the top of the "Letter" portion of the form and at the foot of the letter the sender's full name will be written in block lettering followed by his signature.

The airgraph letter as delivered to the addressee overseas will be less than one quarter the size of the original lodged by the sender. The need for block lettering as above described and clear writing generally will therefore be readily understood.

Terrain : No artificial restrictions are made. The area will be accepted in all respects as it at the time of exercise except for the two additions concerning MOUNT GARNET which is given in Appendix "A".

(b) The area of operations will be considered a highly malarious area.

SITUATION - GENERAL.

In the middle of Jun 45 the Japanese landed in force in the GULF AREA using the estuaries of the MITCHELL RIVER 4707 and TOPSY CREEK 4605. The Japanese seized the MITCHELL RIVER and RUTLAND PLAINS aerodromes 4804, 4903 and established an advanced base in this area.

Late in Jun the Japanese advanced eastwards on the rd MITCHELL RIVER MISSION 4804 - DUNBAR 5697 - Highbury 6492. The local VDC kept touch, reporting the progress of the advance. At the crossing at DUNBAR CREEK 5598 a small concentration of the VDC surprised and defeated a small advanced Japanese force bivouaced for the night 25/26 Jun at that place. Emboldened by this success and embittered by reports of the ruthless burning of their homesteads the VDC decided to make a stand at LYND RIVER 6692 and deny the crossing of this river to the Japanese at this point.

The Japanese, moving to the south, crossed the river secretly during the night and, surprising the VDC force at daylight on 29 Jun, attacking from the rear and southern flank, they inflicted severe casualties and a decisive defeat. Cohesion in the VDC forces in this area was lost and ground reports thereafter of Japanese movements were spasmodic and unreliable.

Japanese air bombing was directed against the railway CAIRNS MAREEBA and on 3 Jul the ry br at 597738 (1" CAIRNS) was partly destroyed and rail traffic ceased.

The Japanese advance continued and WROTHAM PARK 1689 aerodrome was secured on 1 Jul.

Air reconnaissance reported Japanese forces moving east on two routes:

- (a) WROTHAM PARK 1689 - MT MULLIGAN 0501 - THORNBOROUGH 0600 - MAREEBA 0900
- (b) BLACKDOWN 1585 - MUNGANA 0206 - PETFORD 0604 - IRVINEBANK 0703 - HERBERTON 0904.

By 10 Jul the Japanese forces were in contact with Australian troops on the line of the GREAT DIVIDING RANGE 0806, 0904 and after fierce fighting during 7, 8, and 9 Jul, the position had stabilised as follows:

Australian troops holding the passes through the GREAT DIVIDE to the west of MAREEBA 0900 and ATHERTON 0905 had maintained all their positions and the Japanese forces were digging in in this area. In the HERBERTON 0904 area the Japanese had a partial success; HERBERTON was captured but exploitation to the north, S.E. and south was unsuccessful and the position was stabilised with

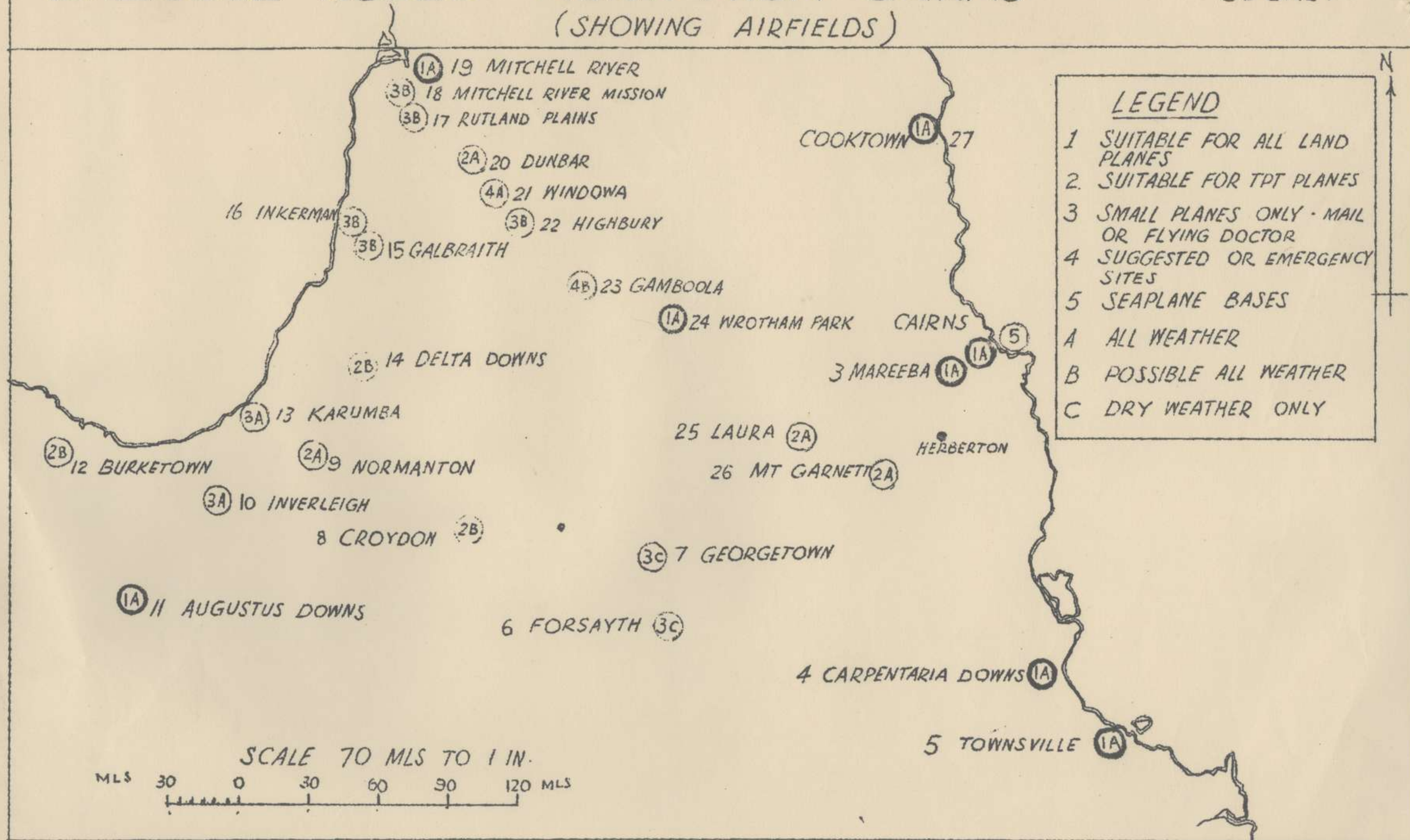
Australian troops holding the crossing over the HERBERTON RANGE 0904 to the north and the road and railway exits at WONDECLA 0904 to the S.E. and south. As yet there has been no threat to the Australian forces in the RAVENSHOE 0902 area

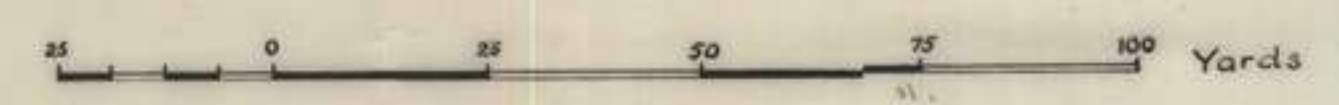

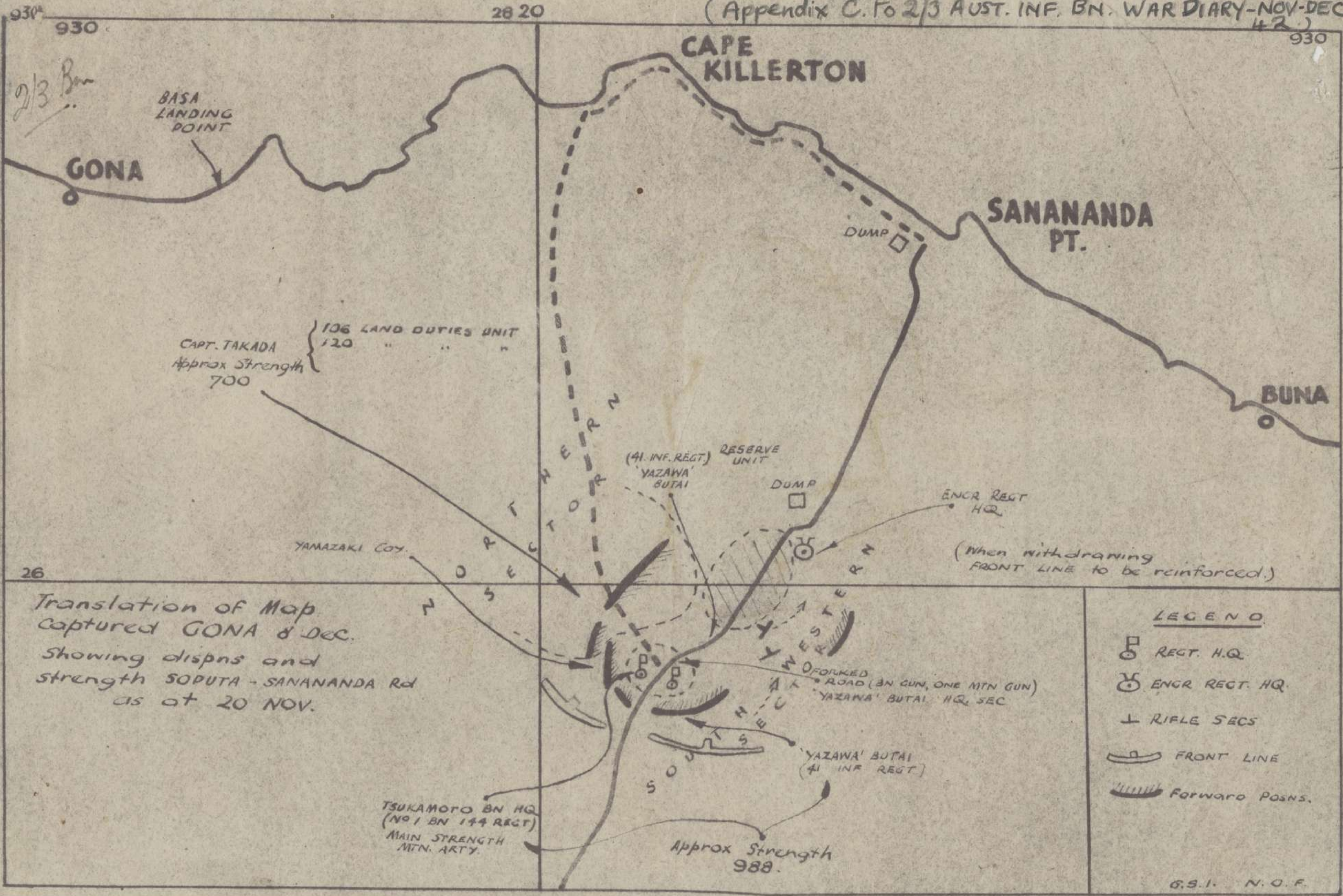

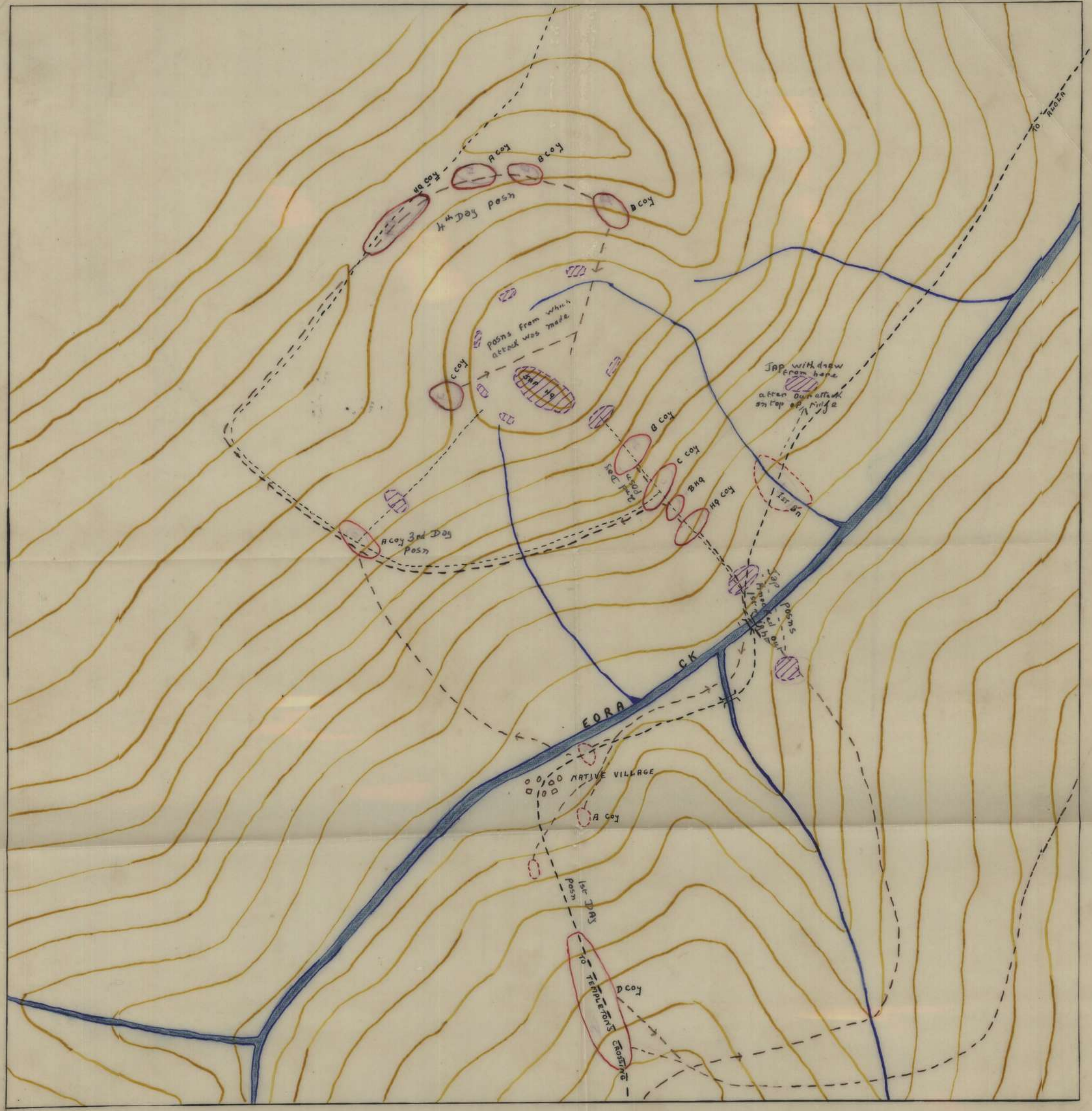

AMALGAMATION

1. Mainly owing to the lack of reinforcements, it has become necessary to amalgamate units and it has been directed that 30 AUST INF BDE will be absorbed into other units of this Division as follows:-
 - (a) HQ 30 Aust Inf Bde into HQ 16 Aust Inf Bde
 - (b) 49 Aust Inf Bn into 2/1 Aust Inf Bn
 - (c) 39 Aust Inf Bn into 2/2 Aust Inf Bn
 - (d) 3/22 Aust Inf Bn (less personnel originally on strength 2/22 Aust Inf Bn) into 2/3 Aust Inf Bn
 - (e) Personnel originally on strength 2/22 Aust Inf Bn but now with 3/22 Aust Inf Bn into 2/4 Aust Inf Bn
 - (f) Sig Sec 30 Aust Inf Bde into Sigs 6 Aust Div.

IDENTITY

2. With a view to retaining original unit identity COs of absorbing units will, as far as is practical, reorganise their units so that personnel taken on strength under this amalgamation form complete sub-units of at least platoons within their new unit.

ACTION

3. All necessary action to effect this amalgamation will commence on 3 Jul 43 and will be completed without delay. Each unit within which another unit is being absorbed will submit a report on the amalgamation to this HQ on the completion thereof.

PERSONNEL

4. All ranks present with units being absorbed (except other ranks originally on strength 2/22 Aust Inf Bn and necessary rear parties as mentioned below) will move to the unit within which they are being absorbed during the afternoon of 3 Jul 43. Detailed arrangements to effect this move will be made by Comd 16 Aust Inf Bde in conjunction with Comd 30 Aust Inf Bde and CO Sigs 6 Aust Div.
5. Personnel of 3/22 Aust Inf Bn originally on strength 2/22 Aust Inf Bn will remain at their present location under comd OC Advance Party 19 Aust Inf Bde who will be responsible for completing the amalgamation in respect to these personnel within 2/4 Aust Inf Bn.

6. Rear Parties from each unit of 30 Aust Inf Bde (the composition and strength of which will be determined by Comd 30 Aust Inf Bde) will remain at their present location to effect the handing over of equipment stores etc to 19 Aust Inf Bde as outlined below. On completion of the "hand over" these personnel will join the unit with which their parent unit amalgamated.
7. All other ranks of units of 30 Aust Inf Bde temporarily attached to other units of 30 Aust Inf Bde (including HQ) will move with their parent unit.
8. All other ranks on the "posted strength" of units of 30 Aust Inf Bde will be "taken on strength" (w.e.f. 3 Jul 43) of the respective units within which they are being absorbed.
9. Personnel other than those set forth in para 7 attached to units of 30 Aust Inf Bde (whether within the W/E of the unit or not) will not be "taken on strength" as attached to the unit within which their original unit is being absorbed.
10. A nominal roll (in duplicate) of the personnel mentioned in para 9 showing their posting in the unit to which they were attached will be forwarded to this HQ by 1800 hrs 4 Jul 43.
11. Personnel of the various "Services" on strength of HQ 30 Aust Inf Bde will be treated as attached personnel and similar action will be taken regarding them as is set out in paras 9 and 10.
12. Notwithstanding the provisions of paras 9, 10 and 11 above the personnel referred to therein will move with the units to which they are attached and remain with the new unit pending instructions from this HQ as to their disposal.
13. WOs, NCOs and trade group specialists of units of 30 Aust Inf Bde will (as far as possible) be absorbed with their present rank or trade grouping into their new unit.
14. Surplus WOs and NCOs will be carried supernumerary to establishment for a period of one month when a review of this situation will be made. In the meantime unit commanders will study the qualifications and capabilities of these personnel and be ready to submit individual reports thereon and suggestions as to their disposal.
15. A nominal roll in duplicate will be submitted to this HQ as soon as possible of all trade group specialists surplus to establishment. The roll will include the trade groupings of the personnel shown thereon, a brief statement of their qualifications and suggestions (if any) as to their disposal.
16. It is pointed out that nothing contained in the above paras precludes unit commanders replacing some of their present WOs, NCOs or tradesmen with personnel from the unit being absorbed - in fact it is highly desirable that this takes place - in which case the personnel replaced will become surplus to establishment and be dealt with in accordance with paras 14 and 15.
17. Each absorbing unit will keep amended to date a nominal roll of all personnel who were taken on strength under this amalgamation but who did not march into the unit. These personnel will be the responsibility of the absorbing unit to the same extent as any other member who is on the posted strength but not present with unit. Rear Parties mentioned in para 6 will not be included in this roll as these personnel will be deemed to be present with the unit.

18. A copy of the roll mentioned in the last para will be forwarded immediately to 6 Aust Div Reception Camp and this HQ will be informed of the total number of personnel by ranks and trade groupings included therein.
19. "X" List personnel of 30 Aust Inf Bde and the personnel mentioned in para 17 will not be marched in to the unit which absorbed their parent unit. They will be held at 6 Aust Div Reception Camp pending instructions from this HQ as to their disposal.
20. 6 Aust Div Reception Camp will forward daily to this HQ a return of all personnel mentioned in para 17 and "X" List personnel of 30 Aust Inf Bde who marched in during the previous 24 hours. A pro forma of this return will be obtained from this HQ.
21. Certain selected officers and other ranks from units of 30 Aust Inf Bde will be posted to HQ 6 Aust Div. These personnel will be called forward as required by this HQ.

OFFICERS

22. Except as mentioned, officers of 30 Aust Inf Bde will move with their present unit but will not be transferred without authority from this HQ. Initially they may be re-allotted within the Brigade at the discretion of Comd 16 Aust Inf Bde. A list showing the allotment of officers of 30 Aust Inf Bde within 16 Aust Inf Bde will be forwarded to this HQ. At a subsequent date these officers will be disposed of as outlined below.
23. Lt Col A.G. Cameron has been recommended to command 2/2 Aust Inf Bn and pending approval will administer command of that battalion.
24. Lt Col O.A. Kessels and Lt Col R. Honner will report to HQ 2 Aust Corps on 3 Jul 43.
25. Approval has been given for each battalion of 16 Aust Inf Bde and 19 Aust Inf Bde to carry ten officers supernumerary to establishment. Bde Comds therefore will as soon as possible submit recommendations for the transfer and posting of officers of 30 Aust Inf Bde to units under their comd to bring strengths to the number approved.
26. COs of units of 30 Aust Inf Bde will submit to this HQ immediately a confidential report (in duplicate) on each officer of 30 Aust Inf Bde under their command. In addition to setting out the qualifications and capabilities of each officer the report will include age, civil occupation, a brief record of service, schools and courses attended and the COs recommendations as to their disposal. It is to be noted that every report on an officer must be read and initialled by him.

RECORDS

27. All records and returns necessary to effect this amalgamation will be completed to the satisfaction of DRO WARWICK and DFO BRISBANE.

ACCOUNTS

28. All outstanding accounts owing by units of 30 Aust Inf Bde will be settled and paid immediately. Unit Comds will render to this HQ on or before 6 Jul 43 a certificate under their own hand that all debts due by the unit or any part thereof have been paid and that no claims against the unit are outstanding or in dispute.

UNIT PROPERTY

29. Unit Welfare A/Cs, Funds, and property purchased out of unit funds for the welfare of its troops will be transferred to the absorbing unit. Except that in the case of 3/22 Aust Inf Bn an amount calculated at the rate of £1.0.0 per member transferred to 2/4 Aust Inf Bn will be paid by the former battalion to the latter battalion and the remainder of the funds and property of 3/22 Aust Inf Bn will be transferred to 2/3 Aust Inf Bn.
30. Amenities provided by philanthropic bodies will not be transferred by units of 30 Aust Inf Bde to the absorbing units but will remain in their present location and be taken over by 19 Aust Inf Bde.

PERSONAL ARMS ETC

31. Personnel of 30 Aust Inf Bde moving to new locations will move with personal arms (excluding SMG), personal equipment, bed boards and band instruments.

UNIT EQUIPMENT ETC

32. All vehicles, unit equipment, camp accommodation stores, engineer stores, training stores and training ammunition held by 30 Aust Inf Bde will be handed over to, and taken on charge by, 19 Aust Inf Bde.

MESS PROPERTY

33. Officers and Sergeants mess property held by units 30 Aust Inf Bde will be transferred to messes of respective absorbing units.

MOVEMENT

34. Personnel will march to new locations. Transport required to move baggage will be supplied by AASC as demanded by 30 Aust Inf Bde.

CAMP SITE

35. Immediately unit areas are vacated by 30 Aust Inf Bde, Advance Party 19 Aust Inf Bde will march in and occupy camps as follows:-

Camp F - HQ 30 Aust Inf Bde	by	HQ 19 Aust Inf Bde

Camp L - 3/22 Aust Inf Bn	by	2/11 Aust Inf Bn

FIXTURES AND FITTINGS

36. Electric Light plants installed in 30 Aust Inf Bde area will be taken over by 19 Aust Inf Bde pending further instructions.
37. All camp fittings, fixtures and completed constructional works in 30 Aust Inf Bde will remain in situ.

SWILL CONTRACTS

38. Swill contracts at present operated by 30 Aust Inf Bde will be taken over by 19 Aust Inf Bde.

CANTEEN STOCKS

39. Canteen stocks of 30 Aust Inf Bde will be:-

- (a) purchased by respective absorbing units, or
- (b) returned to ADCS.


