145. PERSONNEL TRAVELLING ON 2230K TRAIN EX NEWCASTLE ON SATURDAY NIGHTS:

Personnel returning ex NEWCASTLE on Saturday nights must NOT travel on train ex NEWCASTLE 2230K. Special troop train departs NEWCASTLE 2251K and ALL personnel MUST travel on this train.

Failure to comply with this instruction will result in cessation of Saturday Special, and disciplinary action will be taken against any offenders.

146. INCOME TAX - MEMBERS WITH DEPENDANTS RESIDENT OVERSEAS: (GRO F.377/44.)

1. The Income Tax Assessment Act provides for the rebate of tax to a taxpayer in respect of his wife and children resident in Australia.

2. A member of the AMF who married in a country other than Australia and whose wife or children are not resident in Australia is not entitled to such rebate. As the non-allowance might cause hardship, any member affected is requested to apply, through his pay representative for a remission of tax.

3. A member applying for such remission will furnish -

- (a) his name in full and all regimental particulars; and
- (b) the names and addresses of his dependants,

and will advise whether -

- (i) his wife and children are wholly maintained by him;
- (ii) his wife's separate income exceeds \$50 per annum (Australian); and
- (iii) it is his intention, as soon as war conditions permit and transport is available, to bring his wife and children to reside in Australia.

4. The application will be forwarded by the pay representative to the Director of Finance Administration, LHQ, who will refer the case to the Taxation Department for consideration.

147. ISSUES OF CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT TO PERSONNEL - RECORDS OF: (GRO 0.369/44.)

APPENDIX "B"

1. Personal equipment cards (AAFs F204) are being introduced as records of personal equipment on issue to all members of the AMF on full time duty and will be issued whether personal equipment is on issue to them or not.

2. Members will carry AAF F204 at all times, subject to the same conditions as if it were part of AAB 83. AAF F204 will be carried in the cover provided for AAB 83.

3. Members will be required to sign in the column provided on unit's "Statement of Clothing and Necessaries" or "Statement of Personal Equipment", respectively, for all issues of clothing or personal equipment made to them, except where issues are made in exchange for articles withdrawn, i.e. on a one for one basis. Before the member signs for the articles, he will ensure that the blank squares on the appropriate line of the statement are ruled through.

4. Whenever an article which has been entered in a member's AAB 83 or AAF F204 is withdrawn from him, and no article is being issued in replacement, it is the duty of the unit QM to issue and the duty of the member to obtain a receipt on AAF F25A for the article handed over. Members are required to keep these receipts and to produce them when called upon to do so.

5. Members will take reasonable care to prevent loss, destruction or undue wear of personal and unit equipment and clothing on issue to them. Failure to take such care will be regarded as an offence. Disciplinary action will be taken, in accordance with GRO A.727/1943, in all cases where loss, destruction or unfair wear of an article appears to be due to culpable neglect on the part of the member.




