65. USE OF FIRE PROTECTION APPARATUS.

Southern Command 426 of 2/1/42 directs that it has been brought to notice that Units in occupation of Camps are using Fire Protection Apparatus for other than legitimate purposes.

It is advised that Fire Hose is now unobtainable and that the practice of using Fire Hose for watering garden plots etc., is to cease immediately. Fire Hose which has been used for above purpose is to be cleaned and dried, and placed in position for Fire Protection. Similarly the practice of using Fire Hydrants for flushing of drains, watering of areas etc., is prohibited.

It is requested that all Units be advised in terms of the above paras, and in future disciplinary action should be taken against offenders, as such improper practice can only be considered as mis-use and sabotaging of fire equipment.

66. TRANSFERS TO OTHER UNITS - APPLICATION FOR.

Numerous cases have occurred recently where members of this Unit have applied direct to other Units for transfer. All personnel are to be notified that any applications for transfer to other Units must be submitted to these H.Q. through their respective Company Commanders. Should any person contravene this regulation the application will be refused and disciplinary action taken against applicant. Ignorance of this regulation will under no circumstances be accepted as excuse for failure to apply through these H.Q..

67. DUTY VEHICLE.

The Duty Vehicle will only be used with the consent of the Commanding Officer, Adjutant, Quarter Master, Orderly Officer or Reg Sgt Mjr.

68. LINES.

No member of this Unit is to enter the area, showers, latrines etc., allotted to other Units. Any person detected so doing will be arrested and dealt with under Army Act.

69. DRESS. - UNIFORM TO BE WORN.

Uniform will be worn by all ranks of the Australian Military Forces who are employed on Full Time Duty or attending camps of training, at all times except when participating in Sport. All previous instructions regarding the occasions on which uniforms will be worn during the present War are cancelled.

70. DEFENCE WORKS SECURITY.

Attention of all troops is drawn to the URGENT necessity to restrain the passing on of information relating to Defence Works now being carried out in the forward areas. All conversations must be guarded, troops must be warned to make no mention of defence works in personal correspondence and inquisitive visitors must be strongly discouraged.

71. REPORTS OF O.C's TRAIN

Attention is directed to the necessity of O.C's Train fully completing Forms Q 1/40 at the completion of the journey and lodging one (1) copy with Pde. through the normal channel. When damage is noted, the O.C. Train must report what action was taken to detect the responsible person. It will be appreciated that a claim for damage will later be submitted by the railways, and the report of O.C. Train should contain sufficient information to permit of the responsibility for the claim to be immediately fixed. Adjutants etc. should scan forms Q 1/40 before forwarding to ensure that information required is contained in the report.

However, should any personnel be desirous of subsequently transferring his name will be entered on the register maintained by these H.Q. and should the present regulations be later relaxed transfer to the R.A.A.F. or A.I.F. will be permitted. However, personnel who volunteer for R.A.A.F. or A.I.F. will receive a certificate to this effect through this H.Q.

78. INCINERATOR USE OF

No one is to deposit any rubbish or refuse etc., either in incinerator or in the area of same without the prior consent of the O.C. H.Q. Coy.

79. BOOT REPAIRS

The attention of Unit Commanders is drawn to the apparent laxity in some Units, in the holding of regular and thorough inspections of footwear. Quantities of boots are being handed in to Camp Boot-makers for repair, which have become so greatly worn as to be beyond repair, or only repairable for a short period of wear, at the expense of excessive material and labour. It is incumbent upon Unit Officers to see that boots are not allowed to reach a stage where insoles are worn and heels trodden down to the uppers.

5. TELEGRAMS AT CONCESSION RATES - MODIFICATION OF CONDITION OF ACCEPTANCE?

- (a) Reference S.C.R.O. 235/41, telegrams will be accepted for despatch at any telegraph counter from members of the forces without the imprint of the Department of the Army Concessional Postal Rate stamp provided that:
 - (1) the member is in uniform and personally attends to lodge the telegram.
 - (11) each telegram is endorsed (not necessarily for transmission) with the name, number rank and unit of the sender.
- (b) A member of the Forces not in uniform may lodge telegrams for despatch at the concessional rate provided that an official stamp has been impressed on each telegram by the defence authorities.

6. RELEASE OF MEN SELECTED FOR NAVY.

- (a) Members of Militia units or men who ^{are} registered for military service may be discharged on production of a written notice signed by the Naval Recruiting Officer, that the soldier has been selected for attestation in the Naval Forces.
- (b) Naval recruits are attested three weeks before the actual date of mobilization to enable them to return military kit etc, and have discharges finalised before being mobilized for service within the Navy.
- (c) In the event of men failing to report for Naval attestation the Commanding Officer or Area Officer will be immediately notified by the Naval Recruiting Officer.
- (d) Attention is directed to S.C.R.O. 214/41.





Any man taken sick during leave must contact the local Army Medical Officer and obtain a Sick Report (A. 46).

A Medical Certificate from a Civilian Practitioner will not be acceptable as evidence of sickness while on leave.

22. SANITATION.

The attention of all ranks is to be drawn within the next two days to the danger of epidemics unless sanitary precautions are strictly observed. This is particularly necessary in view of dispersal and the number of new recruits.

All military experience has shown that apparently slight neglect leads very swiftly to infection by flies etc. of food, water etc. and consequent epidemics.

For instance on GALLIPOLI in 1915 there were 145,000 casualties from sickness and only 47,000 from wounds. In EGYPT and PALESTINE in the 1914-18 war there were 503,000 casualties from sickness and only 40,000 from wounds - a ratio of 12 to 1.

Any man who uses as a latrine any part of the camp area other than the appointed places is a menace to the health of all his comrades as the sanitary protection which was provided in civil life must now be provided by the men themselves.

Any offence in this regard will be punished with strict disciplinary action, such as a heavy fine. This instruction will be promulgated to all personnel at least once a week.

23. LEAVE
BEHAVIOUR
ON.

Acts of vandalism, such as stone throwing, are being committed by troops whilst returning from local leave. The Camp Commandant has advised that, if this practice continues, he will consider applying to higher authority to have Albury and Wodonga put OUT OF BOUNDS to troops. The C.O. feels that the good sense of members of this Unit, will prevent such a drastic action being taken.
