AIM

1. The aim of a Commanders Diary is to provide data on which to base future improvements in Army training, equipment, organization and administration, and to furnish historians with a record of the activities of units and formations in operational and non-operational periods in peace and in war.

GENERAL

- 2. Entries are to be made daily on AF C 2118 (Adapted) each entry being initialled by the officer detailed to keep it.
- 3. Commanders Diaries will conform with the rules for drafting orders given in "Staff Duties (Australia)" Chapter 2, Section 12.

RESPONSIBILITY

During Non-operational Periods

4. A Commanders Diary is to be compiled by commanders of all formations.

During Operational Periods (1)

- 5. A Commanders Diary is to be compiled in duplicate by:
 - a. Commanders of all formations.
 - b. Each branch of the staff at formation headquarters commanded by a brigadier or above.
 - c. Heads of services not below the rank of lieutenant colonel.
 - d. Personal staffs and officers holding special appointments.
 - e. Unit commanders.
 - f. Commanders of a detachment of a unit when so ordered.

COMPILATION

- 6. Both original and duplicate copies are to consist of:
 - a. Cover (AF C 2119) (Adapted).
 - b. Index as printed on cover.
 - c. Narrative (AF C 2118) (Adapted).
 - d. Annexes as shown in the Index.
- 7. All details of the unit or formation (if a detachment is concerned, the name of the parent unit), period covered and enclosure numbers of the annexes are to be shown on the cover. If there has been a change of command since the last report, the date of assumption by the new commanding officer is to be included.
- 8. The annexes are to be assembled in the groups shown on the cover. If there are no enclosures for an annex NIL will be entered on the cover. If additional annexes are convenient for a particular headquarters, the relevant papers should be grouped as annexes starting at B.

DISPOSAL

12 FD REGT OPERATIONS INSTRUCTION 2/71 CHANGE IN ALLOCATION OF CALLSIGNS AND TARGET NUMBERS

Introduction

1. On the changeover between 107 Fd Bty and 104 Fd Bty, the allocation of callsign and target number blocks is to revert to those used prior to the arrival of A Fd Bty in SVN.

Change of Callsign

2. After 107 Fd Bty ceases operations on 5 May 71, the following callsign blocks are to be adopted:

A Fd Bty - 1

104 Fd Bty - 20

US Bty - 40 (no change)

HQ Bty (FOs only) - 31, 32, 33.

- The change is to be effected at 050300H May 71.
- 4. The HQ Bty FOs are to be allocated callsigns as follows:

a. Capt Lynch - 31

b. Lt Sheedy - 32

c. Spare - 33 (to be used by 2Lt Main until 16 May 71)

Change of Target Numbers

- After 107 Fd Bty ceases operations, prefixes and target number blocks listed in Section 3 of 12 Fd Regt Standing Operating Procedures for operations in Vietnam will be adopted. The block allocated to 161 Fd Bty RNZA becomes spare. The change of numbers for current targets is to be made as follows:
 - a. Targets recorded within a battery. The prefix and first digit are to be changed e.g. ZQ2124 becomes ZP1124.
 - b. Targets recorded within the battery but later upgraded. The first digit is to be changed e.g. ZT1649 becomesZT2619.
 - c. Targets originated by Arty Tac. No change.

12 FD REGT OPERATIONAL INSTRUCTION 3/71 NATO MET MESSAGE - CHANGE IN FORMAT

Reference: A. Directions for the use of Artillery Instruments No 5 (1969).

Introduction

The NATO agreement standardizing the format for reporting meteorological data used for manual gunnery computation is STANAG 4061. The format is set out at Annex A to chapter 1 of Reference A. It is not the one at present in use in Vietnam. The new format is to be adopted by US Artillery in MR111 at 010001H May 71.

Changes

- The only significant change in the format from the one at present inuse takes place in the date - time group section of the identification line. STANAG 4061 format records date-time group as YYGoGoGoG where:
 - is the day of the month.
 - GoGoGo is Greenwich mean time of the start of the period of validity b. to the nearest tenth of an hour.
 - is the number of hours for which the message is valid. US C. Artillery does not predict this period 12 I'd Regt will therefore always receive G as Zero (0).
- Copies of the proforma on which to record the message are enclosed together with an explanatory sheet which has the same content as Annex A to Chapter 1 of Reference A.
