I am very pleased to be able to say that the vessel is now on its way to SINGAPORE, and it is hoped we will arrive at that port on the morning of Wednesday 9th.

Serious as it was it is providential that it was not a terrible lot worse, it was so near to being a dire tragedy.

UNIT COMMANDERS REPORT VOYAGE SYDNEY -SINGAPORE 25 Sept - 10 Oct 57

FAMILIES

The facilities provided were good. However the space, deck and lounge, allotted to families severely restricted troops training. I doubt whether trooping and the movement of families on the one ship would ever be entirely satisfactory.

ACCOMODATION

This was quite fair, although troop cabins had no natural ventilation. Most troops slept on deck and this fact probably led to a number of colds and in flue nza.

MEALS

These were generally of a high standard, well prepared and efficiently served.

SHIP'S STAFF

The necessity of a permanent ship's staff was proven time and time again.

TRAINING FACILITIES

These were extremely limited. Even physical training which is normally practicable on board ship was of little value because of lack of deck space. Training consisted entirely of lectures, P T and discussion groups.

PROVISIONINGON

occasioned by the delay in the voyage. It appears though that an adequate reserve was not provided.

ADMINISTRATION

7. (a) The unit orderly room was not satisfactory.
(b) Ship's Standing Orders should include CB Orders.

(c) If possible troop and family sick parade times should be amended to avoid overlap.

INFORMATION PRIOR TO EMBARKATION

8. It was not possible to make out a training programme prior to embarkation. Prior knowledge of the layout and facilities available for training would have been useful. Training stores such as blackboards, chalks, lectures etc, should be provided by the ship's staff.

DRESS

9. All ranks were warned to bring the minimum amount of khaki clothing as it is not worn in MALAYA. Because uniform was worn at all times on board it became most difficult to comply. Either dress regulations on board should be relaxed or the requirement for KD's be stated prior to embarkation.

IRONS

10. There was a grave shortage of irons. This may have been alleviated had earlier warning been given to troops and families prior to embarkation.

CO - OPERATION

11. The co-operation and kindness of all ship's officers was wonderful. This to a large extent made the voyage pleasureable in spite of many difficulties.
