8. CLEANING OF SMALL ARMS

Troop and Section Commanders WILL be responsible for ensuring that weapons on charge to men in their Tp/ Sec are cleaned and inspected at least once weekly. If the weapon has been fired they will ensure that it has been cleaned and inspected on day of firing and on the two succeeding days after firing.

9. PISTOLS, CLUB WEAPONS

The Bty Capt will arrange a duty roster of Pistol Club members who will be responsible for the cleanliness of Pistol Club Weapons

He will direct spot checks of these weapons by the Bty Orderly Officer.

Smith and Wesson issue pistols will be cleaned by the Armoury Orderly.

18. DUTIES OF THE PERMANENT ARMOURY ORDERLY

- a. His hours of duty will be the normal hours of duty as laid down as per Bty syllabus or when called on outside duty hours to issue and receive weapons.
- b. The permanent Arms Kote Orderly will have an up to date roll of small arms showing registered numbers and private arms in the armoury. He will be responsible for issuing arms against signature to individuals only, the same arm to the same individual (whenever possible). Bulk issue of arms will not be made and he will sign in arms when individuals have completed their duty. He will provide a book which will show date of issue, No of weapon, when issued and who received the arms and date the arms were received back in the armoury, and the signature of the armourer.
- c. The Armskote Orderly who receives arms will be responsible for ensuring that the arm is unloaded. He will never load or charge magazines in the armoury or permit this to be done.
- d. The Armskote Orderly will keep a constant check of arms and will inform his BC or BK when the return of arms appear to be overdue. He will report any loss of arms immediately it is noticed. Weapons will not be kept out overnight except by pers on guard or exercises.
- e. The arms will be chained together in NOT less than batches of ten. Pistols will be kept in locked boxes chained to an immovable object.
- f. LMGs and RLs will be secured to an immovable object.
- g. The keys to the armoury, and keys to locks securing arms within the armoury will be either in possession of the permanent armskote orderly, duty armskote orderly or locked in the key cabinet in Bty Orderly Room.
- h. The permanent armskote orderly will during normal working hours be present in the armoury or if absent, secure the armoury and hand the keys into the key cabinet in the Orderly Room.
- j. He will ensure the following checks of weapons are carried out:-
 - a. Numerically - daily by Bty Orderly Officer.
 - b. Registered numbers - weekly, or whenever loss of an arm is reported, by an officer or NCO detailed by the BK.
- k. He will maintain the armoury in a clean and tidy condition at all times.
- l. He will NOT accept weapons into the armoury until he is satisfied they are clean and correctly oiled.

- m.. He will ensure that the cleaning of weapons is carried out at intervals as laid down in Bty ROs. i.e. all weapons cleaned at least once weekly and if after firing cleaned on day of firing and on two succeeding days.
- n . He will NOT allow ammunition to be stored in the armoury.
- o . He will ensure that NO person smokes in the armoury.
- p . He will ensure that the cleaning of weapons is NOT carried out on the concrete in front of the Q store or armoury.
- q . He will be in possession of all books required in the armoury. These are :-
 - (1) Daily check book.
 - (2) Daily issue book { (1) OMC/LMG
(2) SLR
 - (3) F12s
 - (4) Summary of F12s.
 - (5) Ledger.
 - (6) Air portability book.
 - (7) Orderly handover/takeover book. These books will be checked on handover/takeover.
- r . He will ensure that the Daily Check Book is signed by the Bty Orderly Officer and will present this book to the BK daily by 1500 hrs each working day for inspection.
- s . He will ensure the oncoming Duty Armskote Orderly is instructed in his duty and read his orders to him and ensure he fully understands these orders.
- t . He will ensure that a 100% check of all books, weapons and bayonets is carried out on handover/takeover by the oncoming and dismounting orderly. He will carry out spot checks at least two other times in the armoury .
- u . He will detail the cleaning of spare weapons by the Duty Armskote Orderly as necessary.

DUTIES OF THE DUTY ARMOURY ORDERLY

103 Fd Bty RAA

19..a. During working hours the Permanent armoury orderly will be present in the armoury. During off duty hours, the armoury will be in the care of the Duty Armoury Orderly mounted daily as detailed by the BSM.

b. The duties of this orderly are:-

- (1). He will mount duty at:-
 - (i) Mon to sat inclusive 0800hrs (He will perform duties of Bty runner during normal working hours when NOT required in the armoury).
 - (ii) Sunday and Public holidays Stand Down days 0800 hrs.
- (2). He will dismount at 0800 hrs daily.
- (3). On mounting he will draw the keys from the permanent Arms Kote orderly and return them to him on dismounting. The keys to be in his possession are:
 - (i) Keys to the outside door.
 - (ii) Keys to ALL locks securing weapons.
 - (iii) Keys to all cupboards.
- (4). He will be sober on taking over his duty and will NOT drink alcoholic licquor during his tour of duty.
- (5). He will remain in the Arms Kote or in its immediate vicinity during his tour of duty. When it is necessary to leave for meals, he will get the permission of the Bty Orderly NCO,, and will lock the outside door and place the key in the key cupboard in the Orderly Room. Either he or the Bty Orderly NCO will be in the immediate vicinity of the Arms Kote at all times.
- (6). He will receive and lock up arms from the dismounting guard and members returning from exercises etc.
- (7). He will sleep in the Arms Kote on his own stretcher which will be removed on dismounting.
- (8). He will be in possession of all books required in the Arms Kote. These are:-
 - (i) Daily Check Book.
 - (ii) Daily Issue Book
 - a. OMC/LMG
 - b. SLR
 - (iii) F12's
 - (iv) Summary of F12's
 - (v) Ledger
 - (vi) Air Portability Book
 - (vii) Orderly's Handover/Take over Book

These books will be checked on Handover/Take over.

- (9). He will ensure that the Daily Check Book is signed by the Bty Orderly Officer.
- (10). He will leave the armoury in a clean and tidy condition on dismounting duty.

.....A

- (11) He will ensure that the cleaning of weapons is not carried out on the concrete in front of the Q store or Armoury.
- (12) On mounting duty he will report to the Permanent Armoury Orderly or in his absence to the Duty NCO to have his orders read to him.
- (13) He will ensure that no person smokes when in the armoury.
- (14) He will NOT issue weapons to other units without approval of the BQMS or BK.
- (15) He will receive and issue weapons to the Personnel on guard duty but will NOT issue or receive weapons unless the Permanent armoury orderly is not available in the Bty lines to do so.
- (16) He will NOT allow ammunition to be stored in the armoury.
- (17) He will NOT accept weapons into the armoury until he is satisfied the weapons are clean and correctly oiled.
- (18) He will clean and oil weapons as detailed by the Permanent armoury orderly,,Bty Orderly Officer or Duty NCO.
- (19) The armoury orderly who receives weapons into the armoury will be responsible for ensuring that the weapon is unloaded He will NEVER load or charge magazines in the armoury or permit this to be done.
- (20) The duty armoury orderly will NOT unlock the Battery Armoury Doors (from the inside) until he is satisfied with the identity of the person requesting admittance. This can be done by requesting the person on the outside to push his Identity Card under the door. Even then if the armoury orderly does NOT recognise the person from his photograph he should be asked to contact the duty NCO or Officer and return in their company to the armoury.

ORDERS FOR BATTERY DUTY NCO

20. a. His tour of duty will be 1230 hrs on the day nominated in Battery Routine Orders Part 1 till 1230 hrs the following day except on Sundays, Public Holidays and Stand Down Days when his tour of duty will be from 0800hrs to 0800 hrs.
- b. DRESS : During normal working hours he will be dressed in the dress of the day as required by the Bty Syllabus. Outside working hours he will be smartly turned out in Hat KFF, Shirt or jacket OG, trousers OG, 37 pat web belt, shoes and socks he will wear a lanyard and RAA titles.
- c. His duties are as follows :-
- (1) He will supervise the cleaning of the BHQ Block by the Asian labourer, ensuring that at no time is the labourer left in any office or store unattended.
 - (2) He will ensure that all offices, stores and tpt compound are locked when the Bty stands down and the keys are secured in the key cupboard for which he is responsible. If any member requires to enter any of the above after hours he will sign the keys, both in and out, of the key register.
 - (3) He will carry out a security check at least once by day and by night.
 - (4) He will raise the Battery Flag at Reveille and lower it at Retreat.
 - (5) He will awake all living in members at Reveille.
 - (6) He will report to the Kitchen at least ten minutes prior to each meal and remain there throughout the mess parade. He will check the dress of all Battery personnel attending the mess parade and send offenders back to the Battery lines if they don't comply with Regt Dress regs.
 - (7) He will wind the BC's clock and ensure that it is showing the correct time.
 - (8) He will not leave the Battery Office unattended, if he has to leave the office for any reason he will ensure the Armoury Orderly is in attendance.
 - (9) He is responsible for calling out the Battery when operations or exercises are ordered, in accordance with the instructions located in the cupboard of the BSM's office.
 - (10) He will ensure that in off duty hours no person is allowed in the Orderly Room other than those on Official business.
 - (11) He will ensure that all lights in gun and vehicle compound are operative replacing bulbs if necessary Spare bulbs are kept in the cupboard in Orderly Room Extension ladder in sig store.
 - (12) He will ensure before dismounting duty, that the waste paper baskets in each office are emptied, and the contents burnt by him personally.
 - (13) At 0720 hrs he will conduct the Bty Sick Parade..He will compile A46 (Sick Report) Personal Particulars and fall in sick parade by 0730 hrs ensuring members are correctly dressed i.e. wearing Slouch Hat Jackets and shorts OG, boots hoesetops putties and web belt and are in possession of small kit.

- (13) (Cont) He will allow those who can not march to proceed independantly and will march the remainder to the MI Room taking the A46 Book with him and ensuring that all arrive before 0745 hrs. He WILL show the A46 book to the BC before 1600 hrs daily.
- (14) He will ensure that NO unauthorised vehicles are parked in Bty lines or in front of BHQ during his tour of duty.
- (15) In the absence of the Permanent Armskote Orderly he will read to the Duty Armskote Orderly his duties and ensure that he is fully conversant with his dutues.
- (16) He will ensure that the Bty Orderly Room is left in a clean and tidy condition before dismounting each morning.
- (17) The duty NCO each sunday will ensure that the trophies in the trophy cabinet are polished.
