SITUATION REPORT

NARRATIVE

1. On Tue Oct 5, visited OC Adm Coy 1 RAR in relation to use of RAEME potential. Later spoke with OC 1 ALSC re Cfn NEVILLE's marital problem.
2. On Tue Oct 12, the DAQM Maj M QUEALY visited the workshop area. We spoke generally on parts support, service from AUSTRALIA, difficulties encountered in backloading and increase of workshop scope.
3. On Wed Oct 13, the area was visited by Lt Col MURPHY and Sgt WRIGHT who conducted an audit of production control and return parts procedure.
4. On Fri Oct 15, WO2 CHEESEMAN arrived to take over the Art Veh posting vacated by WO2 PEDERSON.
5. On Sun Oct 17, over 70% of the detachment saw the Lucky Starr show at 1 RAR area.
6. On Wed Oct 20, visited by Capt R MANLEY RAEME.
7. On Thurs Oct 21, Sgt NICHOLLS marched in to replace Sgt B THOMPSON.
8. On Sat Oct 23, Sp Bn held a parade to award decorations, The morning ceremony was followed by an inter-company sports meeting in the afternoon.
9. On Mon 25 Oct, saw OC again re Cfn NEVILLE.
10. On Wed 27 Oct, visited 1 RAR to organize priority repair of their vehicles for a forthcoming exercise.
11. On Fri 29 Oct, visited by Cpl GOATER and discussed engineer plant.
12. This concludes the narrative as at 31 October, some sixteen inches of rain have fallen, the majority in the first two weeks.

G. MATTERS

13. No Action occurred in the living or working areas during the month.

A. MATTERS

14. Most A matters remain steady and acceptable.
15. The position relating to Cfn NEVILLE caused the detachment a lot of concern during the month. Both morale and production were adversely affected to a considerable degree. (The member left 1 ALSC for return to AUSTRALIA 3 Nov 65).
16. Two members sat for Class 1 Education exams during the month and are awaiting results at present.

TECHNICAL

PUBLICATIONS.

17. A number of publications were received during the month. They included the majority discussed with Capt P TRAVERS during his recent visit.

B2 STORES

18. Provision of Cat B2 stores remains the major problem on turnover of equipment.

VEHICLE SECTION

19. Clutch and brake replacements and adjustments made up the bulk of work during the month as this trend continues from September.

20. Due to an expected delay in the permanent camp preparation, major workshop improvements were commenced and completed during the month. Time expended on self help under RAE supervision amounted to 244 man hours and included the digging, preparation, and laying of twelve tons of cement for a service bay and two adjoining repair bays.

21. Section personnel were commended for their work during the month. As well as this quite large task, they worked well under pressure towards the latter part of the month in preparing 1 RAR vehicles for an operation.

GE SECTION

22. The work load early in the month was comparatively light but increased greatly in the latter half when called upon to produce seven complete shrapnel shields for M113's in less than two days for an unexpected carrier operation. The task was completed with assistance from US sources in the provision of welding plant, our mobile set breaking down after only three hours operation.

23. Section improvement involved the erection of a black trades shelter of wood and galvanized iron with a concrete floor. The effects of weather on production has been decreased together with the fire danger.

24. Section personnel are working well especially in their adaptation to ancillary trades.

WRLS & ELEC SECTION

25. The workload for the month consisted mainly of repairs to AN PRC 10 sets and minor repairs to GRC 8. The section was involved in the installation of eight GRC 8's into the new carriers during the latter days, and worked extremely well to complete the task in the allotted time. Most faults remain of a minor nature, all PRC 10's required realignment especially in the transmitter section.

26. The electrical section was employed on generators and battery chargers. The overall position on generators remains as for last month although the arrival of transistors and diodes allowed the repair of three BUCKNELLS.

27. Section improvements were carried out consisting of an additional 11 x 11 lightweight tent, flooring and erection of solid timber workbenches.

29. The following is a copy of a report submitted to HQ AAFV on the alleged L1A1 defect :-

RIFLE 7.62 MM 11A1 - REPORT ON SUSPECTED DEFECT

- a. 1RAR Q12658 of 15 Sep 65
 - b. D Eqpt MG063485 of 22 Sep 65
 - c. 1RAR AQ1528 of 4 Oct 65

1. An investigation into the suspected defect was commenced in late September and is still proceeding as further cases occur.

2. The following factors were considered as possible causes of adjustment to lower gas settings:-

- a. Lack of sufficient maintenance with resultant corrosion and rust deposits.
- b. Incorrect equivalent lubricants.
- c. Incorrectly applied lubricants.
- d. Mechanical fault.
- e. Changeover to US ammunition.
- f. Tendency to set a lower notch to be certain of fire under adverse conditions.
- g. Inconsistent gas pressure directly due to ammunition.
- h. Inconsistent gas pressure due to the effect of atmospheric conditions.
- j. A combination of any above.

3. A number of these factors have since been eliminated and are considered below :-

3.
 - a. Ref 2a. although this proved to be the cause in some cases, there are still enough rifles that do NOT respond to thorough cleaning to suggest something deeper.
 - b. Ref 2b. because ADE has confirmed the equivelants used are correct.
 - c. Ref 2c. because the trial armourers applied lubricants correctly.
 - d. Ref 2e. because with some rifles during the trial "Lake City" and "Remington" ammunition produced a better result than L2A2.AUST.
 - e. Ref 2f. because although this proved to be true in some cases, consistent firing on the recommended pressure could not be obtained.

4. In regard to 2d. the trial was conducted on a strip/clean/lubricate as necessary/replace as necessary/test fire basis on each component group of the rifle. The following test have been completed :-

- a. Clean gas regulator passage.
- b. Strip, thoroughly clean and lubricate return spring tube and spring and reassemble.
- c. Strip, thoroughly clean and oil, eliminate causes of friction in the breech and block mechanism.
- d. Strip, thoroughly clean, eliminate all sources of friction in the piston and gas cylinder.
- e. Replace gas cylinder and piston assembly. In many cases micrometer readings showed that old piston assemblies were equal in all respects to new pistons held in stock however all were changed to keep the trial consistent.

Result from this series of tests were inconclusive as they improved some rifles, had a limited effect on others and no effect at all on the remainder. The RAEME armourers have accounted for all the mechanical faults within their scope of knowledge as tradesmen, but cannot either improve, or guarantee that any improvement made will remain consistent. They have changed gas cylinders and pistons from rifles firing on Setting No 5 onto those firing on No 1. In some cases this is successful, in others there is no change. They have tabulated results from a rifle on one day only to find a completely different set of figures evolving on the next day even though they ensure the circumstances are similar. Using a marking system tabulating "Ejected", "Extracted but failed to eject", and "Failed to extract", a series of shots can vary through the complete range.

5. In regard to 2 g. and h., the tradesmen here are not competent enough to comment, however side results of the trial indicated differences in type and age of ammunition used and in view of the mechanical inconsistencies found, it is felt this line is worth pursuing in conjunction with advanced mechanical tests.

6. At present, the condition with the majority of rifles appears to have stabilized about Setting No 3 and this may well be an acceptable setting for conditions here, however, there is still this small percentage of weapons that will only fire on 0 or 1 at present that fired on Setting No 4 five months ago.

7. It is felt that these are cause for some concern and that a visit from a Design Engineer is warranted.

For the month of October the workshop completed 309 manhours of general engineering, 477 manhours of vehicle repair and 615 manhours of tals/electrical repair.

INCREASE OF OFFICER STRENGTH - EME DET

Reference : Conversation Brig BENDALL/Maj QUEALY/Maj McDONALD
Capt HEESON of 20 Nov 65.

1. It is considered that a requirement exists to increase the establishment of the EME Det of 1 ALSC by one Lieutenant RAEME. The following summary is given in support of the request.
2. The task of the Captain RAEME on 1 ALSC establishment involves two facets :-

a. EME 1 ALSC covering :-

- i. Liaison with HQ AAFV in all matters pertaining to Corps responsibilities and advice to the Staff on repair and maintenance policies and procedures, modifications, state of pool vehicles, and special projects. It is considered that one day per week is necessary for this task and is just sufficient to cover routine matters. At present, only one day per fortnight can be allowed.
- ii. Liaison and Q planning with the 173 Bde maintenance Officer on the operational readiness of Australian equipment in the Brigade. This task involves a comprehensive weekly briefing of the Maintenance "O" Group and at present takes up half a day per week, however, often this extends over this time if Support Bn S4 Staff is involved.
- iii. Liaison with RAEME attachments and parent units on all phases of Corps and technical aspects of maintenance. There are 60 RAEME personnel spread over six units in the BIEN HOA area and a small detachment in SAIGON to cater for HQ AAFV and 709 SIG TP. To spend three hours a week at each of these detachments and parent unit consumes over two days per week and this amount of time is considered to be the minimum necessary to obtain full facts on problems and achieve any positive results from these visits.

b. OC EME Det

This duty covers the command, control and technical administration of the workshop. At present the remaining three and a half days are available for this role.

3. It will be appreciated that the tempo of the foregoing activities increases prior to and during periods of operation. Difficulty in liaison increases due to the deployment locations of units and echelons, and command and control is effected when the workshop sends out forward repair teams, therefore the task becomes more time consuming.

4. The total hours worked at present average 85 hours per week on a ration of 15% : 35% : 50% : to staff liaison, unit liaison and workshop command respectively. Although this ratio can be regarded as a general yardstick, in fact, one or other of the tasks assumes a priority during any one week therefore it is not difficult to get in arrears on a particular task. It is usually the workshop role that suffers in this regard.

5. It is considered that the time available for the latter is insufficient to provide the continuity of command and control necessary. The maximum delegation has been given to the Warrent Officers in their respective sections and they are fully committed to their individual tasks. The addition of a Lieutenant into the detachment would guarantee a condition of continuity thereby ensuring the effectiveness of the repair system thus allowing the Captain EME to carry out his other duties without any detrimental effect on the workshop.


