SWIMMING AND BATHING RESTRICTIONS

1. The germs of LEPTOSPIROSIS pass through the unbroken skin, but more easily through the broken skin, as well as through the lining of the mouth and throat and the outer lining of the eye. These germs abound not only in untreated water but in the soil, particularly the banks of rivers; so contact of the skin with certain areas of soil or sand can result in LEPTOSPIROSIS. The germs of this disease are passed out in the urine of rats, mice, dogs, voles, other rodents,

..... 2/

Pigs, cattle, foxes, skunks and water birds. At present fifty-nine different types of LEPTOSPIROSIS are known.

2. Recreational bathing and swimming in untreated fresh water is FORBIDDEN AT ALL TIMES.

3. The incidence of LEPTOSPIROSIS is in direct proportion to the period of immersion. Exposure of the naked body to LEPTOSPIROSIS through the medium of recreational bathing/training is an unnecessary hazard and one which cannot be condoned.

EM 109. DISTURBANCE ALLOWANCE

1. AHQ CANBERRA advise that new rates of the above allowance are approved as follows:-

a. Married Members

(1) Removal to unfurnished premises:-

- (a) First and second removals - \$100 (£50).
- (b) Third and fourth removals - \$130 (£65).
- (c) Fifth and subsequent removals - \$160 (£80).

(2) Removal to or from unfurnished premises:-

- (a) To furnished premises on posting to another locality - \$30 (£15).
- (b) From furnished to unfurnished premises in the same locality - The relevant allowance less \$30 (£15).

b. Unmarried Members

On move to unfurnished premises - \$30 (£15).

2. It is expected that the new rates will be effective from 1 Mar 66, but no action is to be taken until amendments to Financial Instructions for the PMF 1962 are issued.

3. The allowance paid under provisions of paragraph 1 a. (2) (a) above are not contingent upon possession of furniture and effects. The only condition for eligibility is a posting to another locality.


4. The condition of eligibility for the allowance on moves to unfurnished premises in the case of married and unmarried members, is for removal to comprise furniture and effects valued at an amount of not less than \$1000 (£500).

EM 118. DUTIES JESSELTON

1. Any person on duty in JESSELTON and staying at a hotel is to pay all charges, prior to departure, with the exception of accommodation.

VENEREAL DISEASE

A WORD FROM THE ASSISTANT DIRECTOR MEDICAL SERVICES

4. To consort with such women is like wallowing in a particularly filthy dung heap crawling with maggots. In fact it is really worse than that.
5. Some say to be promiscuous is only natural; besides, it's worth it because Venereal Disease is easily cured - easier than a cold in the head. If you believe that, doubtless you have told your mother and your girl friend that.
6. SYPHILLIS (POX) and GONORRHOEA (CLAP or GC) were the two most well known types of Venereal Disease, with "CLAP" easily taking the lead.

EM 129. SAFETY PRECAUTIONS - CARRIAGE OF DANGEROUS ARTICLES BY PASSENGERS IN RAF TRANSPORT, CIVIL and CIVIL CHARTER AIRCRAFT

1. The following restrictions apply to the carriage of the u/m items by passengers travelling in RAF transport, civil and civil charter aircraft. The restrictions apply equally to the carriage of these articles in baggage.

<u>Article</u>	<u>Restriction</u>
a. Portable radios and other transistorised equipment	Batteries must be removed.
b. Hearing aids	(1) If worn must be declared to the aircraft crew before take-off. (2) If not in use the batteries must be removed.
c. Compressed gas containers (Butane, Propane, etc)	Carriage prohibited.
d. Aerosol containers including hair lacquer sprays.	Carriage prohibited.
e. Cigarette lighters.	Only cotton filled or butane lighters are permitted. Those having an unpacked visible reservoir (usually plastic) are prohibited.
f. Matches.	Only safety types in small quantities are allowed and then only provided they are those with a thick shank normally on sale in the United Kingdom. All other types are prohibited.
g. Privately owned firearms.	Carriage prohibited except for sporting weapons which are subject to the following rules:- (1) The authority of the sponsoring Defence Department Movement Staff must be obtained. (2) The weapon must not be packed in hold baggage. (3) Before embarkment the weapon must be declared, and delivered separately from other baggage, to the movements or airline authority at the airfield. (4) A declaration must be made to the Customs authorities when the weapon is exported and imported. (5) The owner is responsible for obtaining the necessary import/export licences.
h. Service firearms.	Carriage prohibited unless specially authorised.
j. Explosives.	All explosives, except safety ammunition, including fireworks of all descriptions and toy pistol caps are prohibited.

k. Inflammables.

All inflammable liquids and solid fuel are prohibited.

l. Mercury

Carriage prohibited.

m. Cameras

Cameras MAY be carried in the aircraft cabin but their use in RAF aircraft and on RAF airfields is prohibited. If used in civil aircraft during flight or on civil airfields they may be confiscated.

n. Potassium Chlorate
(Chlorate of Potash)
tablets

Carriage prohibited.

o. Other articles

When any doubt exists as to the safety of any other article for carriage by air it must either:-

(1) Not be taken or

(2) Be declared to the movements or airline authority.

2. The appropriate movements regulations, instructions and air travel guides will be amended in due course.

- a. One reinforcement, Elec Mech, Spr WALDEN, requested 31 Dec 65, marched in 21 Mar 66.
- b. One member, Spr CANNON, is being considered by your HQ for RTA, compassionate circumstances.

2. Medical

- a. High MEDEVAC rate for appendicitis at last report seems to have been arrested. Nil cases for month.
- b. Two CASEVAC for month, one fractured skull and one suspected spinal injury.
- c. Visits were made during the period by DADAH and ADMS, both of COMLANDBOR LABUAN. Reports have not yet been received.

3. Officer Appointments


11. Outstanding Boards of Survey

REPORT FOR MONTH OF MAR 66 - GS MATTERS

Reference: HQ AAF FARELF 31/1/5 (G) (5) dated 31 Jan 66 (Copy to HQ DOBOPS)

1. Output for the month of March was as follows:-
 - a. Detailed Survey 2.4 miles - From 57.7 to 60.1.
 - b. Clearing 1.7 miles - From 55.2 to 56.9.
 - c. Formation 1.1 miles - From 54.8 to 55.9.
 - d. Surfacing 1.5 miles - From 52.7 to 53.5 and 54.4 to 55.1.
 - e. In addition a 90' Double-Single Bailey Bridge was constructed at LANGKUKU and two 40' timber bridges between PANDEWAN and LANGKUKU.
2. With the opening of a new firm grey mudstone quarry at Mile 55.1 and a soft sandstone quarry at Mile 55.8, hauls have been drastically reduced and because of satisfactory grades, surfacing should now overtake formation regardless of the weather. The surfacing material is inferior at present to that available from the quarry at Mile 46. It is possible it may improve with depth below natural surface. A SABAH Govt geologist visited the project 22-24 Mar and confirmed the quarry sites being developed as the best available.
3. Rainfall for the period was 8 inches.
4. Progress has slowed somewhat due to heavy earthworks from Mile 54.4 to 56.2 and an extremely heavy drainage commitment from LANGKUKU (Mile 56.2) to TATALUAN (Mile 57.7). The latter stretch of 1.5 miles requires 12 culverts.
5. The section TATALUAN (Mile 57.7) to TAMPISISON (Mile 60.1) is the worst encountered to date. 24 Const Sqn Recce Report indicates this section as being the most difficult between Mile 36 and Mile 80. To avoid the bridle track with its extremely heavy drainage commitment, a ridge alignment in side hill cut has been selected. Heavy earthworks can be anticipated.



7. Progress for the period was not up to expectations for reasons given above. It is probable that handover will now be at approx Mile 59.

8. It is considered that some replacement vehicles will be required by the next Squadron. A separate submission is being forwarded.

9. Estimated project completion date of JUN 67 remains unchanged.
