243. ARMY HEALTH BENEFITS SCHEME

1. Paragraph 157 of AMO Administrative Instruction - Australian Army Component EDITION of 26 Aug 55, provided that personnel who are members of the Army Health Benefits Scheme may suspend their contributions whilst their families are stationed in MALAYA, as free medical treatment is provided for their dependents through the Army.
2. In the case where a member elects to suspend his membership of the AHBS whilst his family is in MALAYA, he should arrange this through his Company Orderly Room and the Unit Pay Representative. Prior to the return of a member's family to AUSTRALIA, application should be made for renewal of membership.
3. However, members who continue to contribute to the AHBS are eligible for medical and hospital benefits in respect of medical treatment given by legally qualified medical practitioners and registered hospitals in SINGAPORE and MALAYA.

4. Claims from contributors in SINGAPORE and MALAYA should be forwarded in the normal way direct to the Secretary of the AMBS sub-committee in the command where the members pay records are maintained. Fully detailed supporting documents will be submitted with the claims.

DISCIPLINE - PRIVATE FIREARMS

1. All ranks are warned that they are subject to the provisions of the Federation of MALAYA Arms Enactment concerning the possession, sale, import and export of arms which have not been issued from military sources for use in the course of their duty.

2. The attention of all ranks is drawn to the following provisions of the Arms Enactment:

- (a) No person shall have in his custody or possession any arms except under a licence issued by the Chief Police Officer of the State.
- (b) Arms may NOT be imported or exported without a licence.
- (c) No person shall take delivery of any arms on purchase or transfer without first obtaining a licence authorising the purchase or transfer thereof.
- (d) No person shall deliver to any other person any arms on sale or transfer except upon production to him of a licence authorising the purchase or transfer thereof.

3. All privately owned arms and ammo will be kept in unit custody when not in use. These arms will be treated in the same manner as WD arms for the purpose of safe custody and checking. Any loss will be reported to the police vide para 28 of MCO 9/4/56; attention is also drawn to MCO 524/55.

4. Under NO circumstances will private weapons be carried off duty except for sporting purposes.



223. DRESS

1. The following orders of dress will be adopted by all ranks 2 RAR with effect from the publication of this order.
2. These main orders of dress will be worn by members under the conditions set out in succeeding paragraphs:
 - (a) Operational Service Dress
 - (b) Camp/Barracks Dress
 - (c) Leave Dress
 - (d) Sporting and Recreational Dress

3. It is essential that a uniformly high standard of dress and turn out be maintained, and to this end commanders at all levels will ensure that these orders are strictly observed. All officers and NCOs will ensure that irregularities in dress and turn out are constantly and consistently checked. Disciplinary action, where appropriate, will be taken against offenders.

4. Operational Service Dress

- (a) This dress will be worn by all ranks engaged in operations beyond static and base camps, and on training exercises as directed by company commanders:

Hat Jungle

Bush Jacket OG (with side patch pockets and belt removed;)
(jacket worn as a shirt inside trousers.)

Trousers OG

Jungle Boots

Belts Waist 4 1/2 pattern

Web equipment 4 1/2 pattern (as ordered)

Badges Rank as appropriate.

- (b) No embellishment such as formation signs, AMF signs or regimental titles will be worn with this dress.
- (c) Ammunition will be carried in equipment pouches provided and will NOT be carried in or on clothing.
- (d) Sleeves will be worn up until 1900 hours daily, thereafter they will be rolled down and buttoned at the wrist.

5. Camp/Barracks Dress

- (a) This dress will be worn by personnel when engaged on normal duties in barracks and in static and base camps,

1. It is advised that Cabinet has recently approved the following conditions of service to apply in respect of service with BCFESR in MALAYA or SINGAPORE or equivalent service in that area with units not primarily part of the Reserve:

(a) Eligibility for Repatriation Act benefits for death or incapacity resulting from any occurrence that happened during such service or arising from a pre-existing disability aggravated during such service. The general Repatriation benefits that may be provided are:

(i) War pensions;

(ii) Medical treatment for members and certain dependants;

(iii) Vocational training and rehabilitation loans under the Disabled Members and Widows Training Scheme for disabled members and widows;

(iv) Education and training under the Soldiers' Children Education Scheme;

(v) Grant towards funeral expenses;

(vi) Assistance by way of loan in certain cases in relation to a disability due to war service.

(b) Eligibility for benefits under the War Services Homes Act only where a member qualifies for repatriation benefits.

(c) A deduction from assessable income for income tax purposes of £120 per annum for service of six months or more during the income year (or such lesser amount as is decided by the Taxation Commissioner for shorter service in the area.)

2. Eligibility for the above benefits will take effect from the date that appropriate legislation receives Royal Assent. Prior to this date members in MALAYA or SINGAPORE are covered by the Repatriation Act at all times, are eligible for benefits under the War Service Homes Act and Re-establishment and Employment Act and are fully exempt from taxation.

3. It is stressed that from the date new legislation is passed to give effect to the Cabinet decisions in paragraph 1 above, personnel will only be entitled to benefits under the Repatriation Act and War Services Homes Act where death, incapacity or aggravation of a pre-existing disability results from service in SINGAPORE or MALAYA. They are not entitled to benefits under these Acts in respect of service alone in these areas.

228. DOMESTIC SERVANTS IN HOTELS, BOARDING HOUSES, ETC.

1. Several requests have been received for approval to employ domestic servants for families, under certain circumstances, in hotels, boarding houses, etc.

2. The provision of servants in "normal" married accommodation was approved to provide some help in housekeeping duties for these families in conformity with special conditions pertaining in MALAYA.

3. In the case of families living in hotels or hostels, etc. all housekeeping services are provided by the management and are covered by the accommodation charges made.

4. The care of children is the responsibility of the individual even in the event of illness and whether the member is housed in quarters, hostel or an hotel.

5. No occasion should arise which would necessitate Commonwealth intervention or the provision of an amah at public expense to care for a member's children. In the event of any emergency it is suggested that suitable arrangements could be made within the Australian Service community.

6. In the circumstances, Aust Army Force FARELF has stated approval cannot be given for the employment of domestic servants for families in hotels, boarding houses, etc.

225. DISCIPLINE - SECURITY OF ARMS AND AMMUNITION

An individual who is responsible for the loss through negligence, of arms and/or ammunition, will normally be tried by Court Martial.

226. MEMBERS LIVING AT AUSTRALIAN HOSTEL, PENANG - RECREATION LEAVE

1. When a member living at the Australian Hostel, PENANG, proceeds with his family on authorised recreational leave the hostel accommodation charges will be reduced for the period of leave.
2. Members so affected will present their paybooks and leave passes to the Unit Pay Representative for adjustment.
3. Companies will ensure that leave passes are made out to commence and terminate at 2400 hours vide para 15(b) of Standing Orders for Leave contained in MBI 24/54.

227. OPERATIONAL BENEFITS - MALAYA

1. It is advised that Cabinet has recently approved the following conditions of service to apply in respect of service with BCFESR in MALAYA or SINGAPORE or equivalent service in that area with units not primarily part of the Reserve:

(a) Eligibility for Repatriation Act benefits for death or incapacity resulting from any occurrence that happened during such service or arising from a pre-existing disability aggravated during such service. The general Repatriation benefits that may be provided are:

(1) War pensions;

(11) Medical treatment for members and certain dependants;

(iii) Vocational training and rehabilitation loans under the Disabled Members and Widows Training Scheme for disabled members and widows;

(iv) Education and training under the Soldiers' Children Education Scheme;

(v) Grant towards funeral expenses;

(vi) Assistance by way of loan in certain cases in relation to a disability due to war service.

(b) Eligibility for benefits under the War Services Homes Act only where a member qualifies for repatriation benefits.

(c) A deduction from assessable income for income tax purposes of £120 per annum for service of six months or more during the income year (or such lesser amount as is decided by the Taxation Commissioner for shorter service in the area.)

2. Eligibility for the above benefits will take effect from the date that appropriate legislation receives Royal Assent. Prior to this date members in MALAYA or SINGAPORE are covered by the Repatriation Act at all times, are eligible for benefits under the War Service Homes Act and Re-establishment and Employment Act and are fully exempt from taxation.

3. It is stressed that from the date new legislation is passed to give effect to the Cabinet decisions in paragraph 1 above, personnel will only be entitled to benefits under the Repatriation Act and War Services Homes Act where death, incapacity or aggravation of a pre-existing disability results from service in SINGAPORE or MALAYA. They are not entitled to benefits under these Acts in respect of service alone in these areas.

228. DOMESTIC SERVANTS IN HOTELS, BOARDING HOUSES, ETC.

1. Several requests have been received for approval to employ domestic servants for families, under certain circumstances, in hotels, boarding houses, etc.

2. The provision of servants in "normal" married accommodation was approved to provide some help in housekeeping duties for these families in conformity with special conditions pertaining in MALAYA.

3. In the case of families living in hotels or hostels, etc. all housekeeping services are provided by the management and are covered by the accommodation charges made.

4. The care of children is the responsibility of the individual even in the event of illness and whether the member is housed in quarters, hostel or an hotel.

5. No occasion should arise which would necessitate Commonwealth intervention or the provision of an amah at public expense to care for a member's children. In the event of any emergency it is suggested that suitable arrangements could be made within the Australian Service community.

6. In the circumstances, Aust Army Force FARERF has stated approval cannot be given for the employment of domestic servants for families in hotels, boarding houses, etc.

229. LEAVE DRESS - SARAWAK RANGERS

1. Approval has been given to Other Rank members of the SARAWAK RANGERS to wear civilian dress outside Unit lines, when not on duty after completion of one years service.
2. The necessary authorisation has been pasted to the inside cover of their Part 1 Paybook (MR66) at HQ SARAWAK RANGERS, as each member returned from leave.
3. Approved civilian dress for Other Ranks, SARAWAK RANGERS, is as follows:

White Shirt with long sleeves - shirt to be tucked inside the trousers.
Dark grey long trousers.
Black boots or shoes.
Plain Tie (Regimental tie to be worn when possible).

230. DISCIPLINE - MF

All RAR drivers who have occasion to visit the Depot, Brigade of GURKHAS, SUNGAI PATANI, will ensure that:


- (a) they obey all traffic signboards regarding directions and speed limits, and
- (b) they obey all hand signals given by Regimental and Military Policemen.

231. DISCIPLINE - ARMS AND AMMUNITION

All ranks are warned that the offences of:

- (a) improper loading of firearms without authority,
- (b) negligent discharge of firearms,

are declared prevalent under the terms of AMR & O 321(3).

234. DISCIPLINE - TROOPS TRAVELLING BY TRAIN

1. It has been reported that troops entraining at Garrison Towns are boarding trains, having consumed a considerable amount of intoxicating liquor.
2. The various separate dangers of this, to both the general travelling public, and security generally when soldiers are travelling armed, are obvious.
3. Military Police patrols are now being placed at the main Railway Stations at times of arrival and departure of trains and have been instructed to check this point. If, in the opinion of the NCO IC patrol, soldiers are not fit to travel, having regard to their security role in guarding the train, as well as being responsible for arms and ammunition, they will be returned to their unit and a report submitted.

235. DISCIPLINE - MOTOR TRANSPORT - KUALA KANGSAR CAMP

All 2 RAR transport vehicles when in KUALA KANGSAR Camp, excluding one ambulance parked at the Regimental Aid Post, will be parked in the Battalion Transport Lines except when actually engaged in loading or unloading troops or stores.

236. DISCIPLINE - MOTOR TRANSPORT - SPEED LIMITS 2 RAR VEHICLES

1. The maximum speed table for vehicles of 2 RAR is as detailed below:

237. DISCIPLINE - MOTOR TRANSPORT - SPEEDING

1. Complaints have been received from the Federal Police that Military vehicles are being driven at excessive speeds on the NORTH/SOUTH road, thereby endangering life.

2. As a counter measure, both Federal and Military Police are setting speed traps, meanwhile all drivers are warned that excessive speeding offence reports will be dealt with severely. It must be clearly understood that on occasions, even five miles per hour can be excessive, and that drivers must travel at a speed which is consistent with safety under any given conditions.

238. DISCIPLINE - MOTOR TRANSPORT - ROUTE CARDS

1. To minimise the danger of accidents through speeding on long trips, drivers will be given definite instructions on the timings to be adhered to throughout a journey. This will be done by means of route cards.

2. Route cards will, in future, be issued by the Battalion Transport Officer, and sub-units concerned, unless operationally impracticable, to all drivers proceeding a distance of over thirty miles from start point, except when an officer is in charge of the move.

3. Route cards will include the following information:

- (a) Start point and time of departure.
- (b) Route, giving mileages and times due at intermediate points.
- (c) Destination and time due.
- (d) Any special instructions, e.g. time and place of halts.

239. MEMBERS MARRYING IN MALAYA - PAYMENT OF MALAYA ALLOWANCE

1. In view of the fact that the married accompanied rate of MALAYA allowance is payable, from the date of marriage, to members who marry in MALAYA/SINGAPORE the following information is required by the Department of the Treasury:

- (a) Period of Tour.
- (b) Period the member and his wife will be united in the area.
- (c) Particulars of the type of accommodation occupied by the member and his wife.
- (d) Whether the wife will accompany the member to AUSTRALIA on completion of his tour of duty having regard inter alia to the Immigration Laws.

2. The required information will be forwarded to this HQ, by companies, in respect of each member who marries in MALAYA/SINGAPORE in the future.

3. In the case of members who have already married in MALAYA/SINGAPORE companies will forward the information to reach this HQ not later than 4 Sep 56.

240. INITIAL CLOTHING ALLOWANCE - MEMBERS SERVING IN MALAYA/SINGAPORE

1. AHQ have given the following decisions in respect of the payment of initial clothing allowance to members who marry in MALAYA/SINGAPORE.

- (a) Where a member married a woman from AUSTRALIA, or any other country, who moves privately to MALAYA/SINGAPORE, particulars of the case will be referred to AHQ, for submission to the Department of the Treasury (Defence Division) for determination as to whether an initial clothing allowance for wife will be made under Financial Administration Instruction 442 para 85.
- (b) Where a member marries a Malayan or other resident of MALAYA/SINGAPORE - initial clothing allowance for wife vide Financial Administration Instruction 442 para 85 will not be paid.

2. Companies will forward to Battalion Headquarters an "Application for Initial Clothing Allowance for Wife" in respect of each member who has married a woman from AUSTRALIA or any other country who moved privately to MALAYA/SINGAPORE.



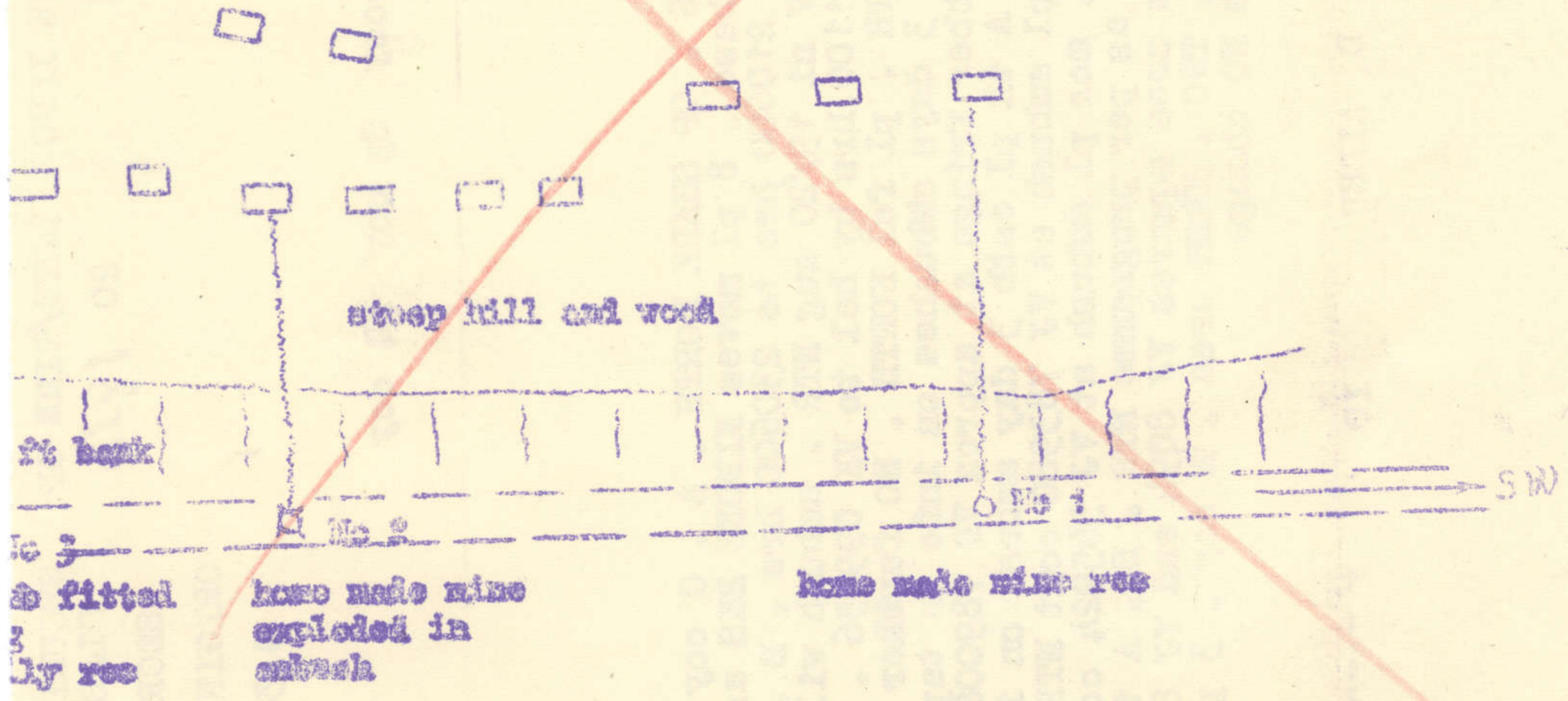

The company will send a technical officer abroad soon to investigate the technique and cost of nuclear power.

The project is planned because of the high cost of coal at Mt. Isa, and not because of the proximity of uranium deposits at Mary Kathleen. An official of the company was quoted as saying that pure uranium would be needed for the reactor and that this would have to come from England or America. (Vol. 14, No. 27). He pointed out that local production was of uranium oxide.

On the same day, the Minister for Supply, Mr. H. Beale, was reported in Brisbane as saying that the company could be assured of all advice and technical assistance possible in a nuclear powerhouse project.

SUBMARINE COMPLETES GRAVITY SURVEY

H.M. Submarine TELEMACHUS returned to Sydney on July 31 after completing a gravity survey of the South-West Pacific area lasting two months.

In announcing this the Minister for National Development, Senator W.H. Spooner said that the survey was an example of successful co-operation between scientists of Australia and of the United States, and the Royal Navy and Royal Australian Navy.

The scientists were Mr. Hugh Traphagen of the Lamont Geological Observatory, New York and Mr. Stewart Gunson of the Commonwealth Bureau of Mineral Resources, Geology and Geophysics.

Senator Spooner said that the submarine traversed a course Sydney-Wellington-Auckland-Tonga-Suva-Sydney. The object of the survey was to gain knowledge of the composition and structure of the earth's crust in this particular area, which is of great interest to geologists and geophysicists because it includes the boundary between different types of volcanic rocks.

In a press interview the scientists were reported as saying that to take the gravity readings the submarine dived to depths of up to 220 feet to escape the rocking influence of the surface waves. Altogether 125 readings were taken during the 7,200 mile cruise.

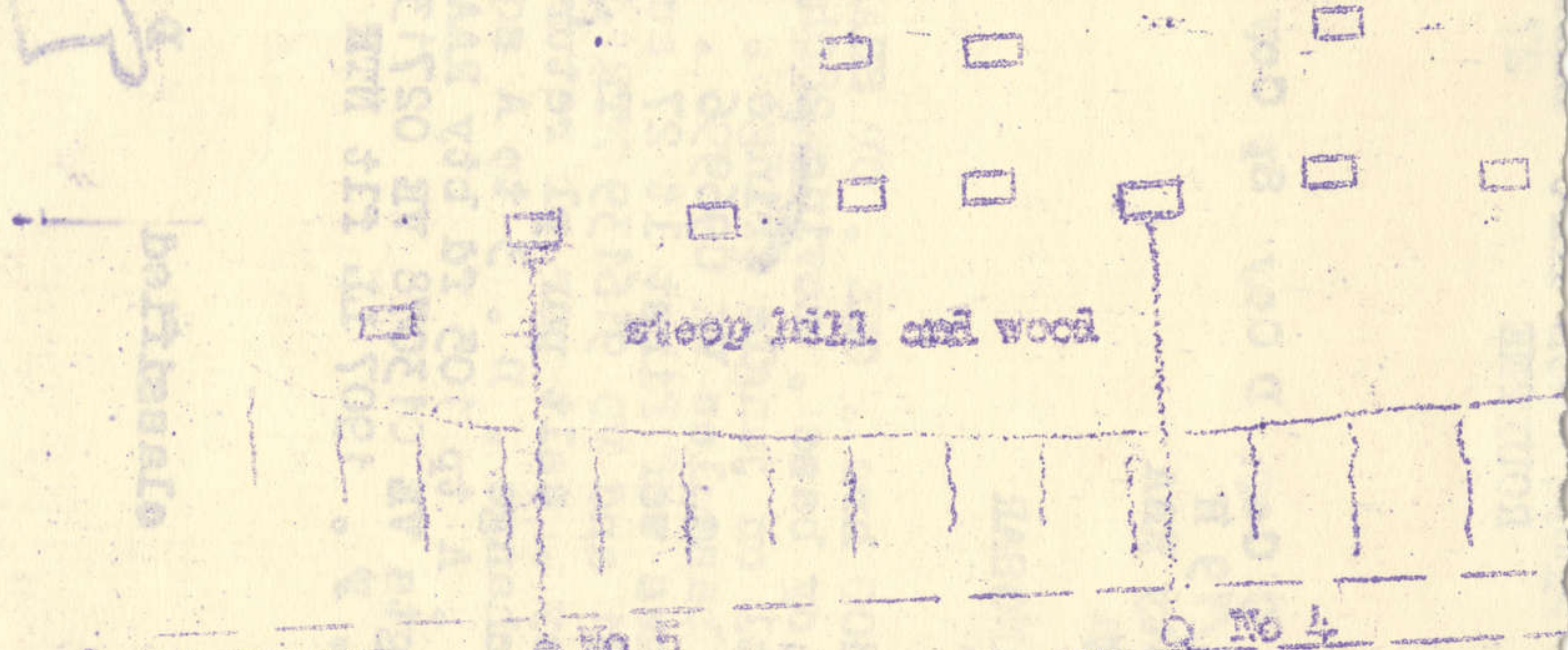
