

1. Attached is an application in respect of the abovenamed member.
2. It is requested that special consideration be given to the allocation of a FMQ to the above member due to the following special conditions existing and which course of action would be in the interests of both the Service and the member:-
 - a. The member's wife is due for confinement during February 1967 and has NO near relatives or relations in WAGGA WAGGA.
 - b. This HQ is required to conduct a formation major field exercise during February 1967. This NCO is the only clerk posted to G Branch, and, as this HQ is working short of clerical staff already to have this member away for any length of time both for the imminent birth and again for another period on removal would be untenable. It is considered that the allocation of a FMQ during December 1966 or January 1967 would keep the need for non-effective service on ARL and/or EMERGENCY leave to a minimum disruption to the member).
 - c. Special notice should be taken of the condition of the members 3 year old son in context with the size of the family and the imminence of another birth and the fact that separation from his family under these circumstances may NOT be in keeping with personal morale or efficiency.
3. This application is accordingly forwarded for processing and early advice of the date of allocation of a MQ would be appreciated.

1. Under the terms of reference A, 2 RAR was instructed to provide a company headquarters and two platoons to Jungle Trg Centre to assist in presentations of tactical demonstrations.
2. When 2 RAR came under command Hq 6 TF this responsibility passed to 8 RAR, who were at this stage, newly raised and under command S4 Area. (Reference C refers).
3. The reason for the changover mentioned above appears to have been made on the basis that a "priority" unit must be relieved of such extraneous responsibilities and be permitted to train as a complete unit for its major role. Since reference C was published, 8 RAR too, has been allotted to under command this headquarters and is scheduled for service overseas in 1967.
4. It is considered, in view of 8 RAR commitments and the limited amount of effective training time left in which the unit can be trained to full pitch, that 8 RAR must now also be categorized as a "priority unit", and accordingly should be relieved of this commitment as soon as possible.
5. The need for a demonstration company at Jungle Trg Centre is fully recognised, and the following alternatives are suggested:-
 - a. Have 8 RAR relieved of the task by a unit not earmarked for overseas service in the near future - ie 1 RAR. (This task could revert to a unit returning to the BRISBANE Metropolitan area from overseas service after regrouping).
 - b. Form an "independent" company, NOT part of a battalion, along the lines of the proposal outlined in reference B. This subunit could then become an integral part of Jungle Trg Centre Staff/establishment.
 - c. Staff the demonstration company with "time" expired NS Officers, NCOs and private soldiers. This would of course, involve the provision of an ARA "cadre" of OC, RIC, CSM, CQMS, Clerk and Storeman.

6. It is appreciated that there are certain problems associated with sub paragraphs 5b and c, mainly due to officer and NCO manpower problems. The course of action mentioned in paragraph 5a seems to be more feasible in the short term view.

7. From both the HQ 6 IF and 8 RAR points of view, it is most important that the unit be able to prepare itself for overseas service with the minimum external commitments, and accordingly this request is forwarded for your action.



SAFETY IN THE ARMY

Reference: AHQ 746:R1:7 dated 20 Jun 66.

1. It has been decided not to proceed with the proposed MBI, but instead to produce a comprehensive and authoritative guide to safety in the Army - a "Manual of Army Safety" - which will satisfy a long felt need.
2. The Manual is to be issued provisionally as Notices in AROs, and progressively as chapters are completed. They are to be removed from AROs as received and filed in a separate plain binder. The first chapters are being edited now and should be available to units in Jan 67.
3. Within AHQ, coordination is effected by the Co-ordinator of Army Safety (CA Safety). This appointment was introduced temporarily in Sep 65 and is now to continue on a permanent basis. CA Safety will be a Grade I staff officer appointed to the Directorate of Military Training and responsible primarily to DCGS through IMT for the following duties:-
 - a. Advice to all branches and directorates at AHQ on safety.
 - b. Advice to AG Branch on safety aspects of investigations and courts of inquiry.
 - c. Subsequent to an accident, the coordination of AHQ staff action on safety aspects.
 - d. Where necessary, safety consultant duties in commands.
 - e. Assistance in the investigation of accidents involving army aircraft.
 - f. Continuous review of the effectiveness of current safety instructions.
 - g. Safety aspects in the development of new weapons and equipment.
 - h. Liaison with RAN and RAAF Safety Directors.

AMENDMENT TO ESTABLISHMENT : HQ 6 TF : II/2/1 (TW)

Reference : A. MBI 1-4.
 B. MBI 82-1.

Introduction

1. HQ 6 TF has been functioning as an autonomous headquarters since 24 Jun 66, and during this period it has been possible to fully test the current establishment under both barracks and field operations. It is apparent that many deficiencies in the current establishment exist if the Headquarters is to function effectively in its role in both peace and war.

Aim

2. To produce an amendment to the present establishment (II/2/1(TW)).

Approach

3. It is proposed to examine the need for an increase in establishment under the following terms:-

- a. The existing establishment in barracks and field employment.
- b. The "Shadow Postings" problem.
- c. The proposed new establishment (Annex A).
- d. Justification of the proposed increases (Annex B).
- e. A Summary of Increases/Decreases (Annex C).
- f. ORBAT 6 TF including restricted strengths (Annex D).

General

4. The following proposals are for an amendment to an existing establishment.

5. NO establishment is to be superceded or cancelled.

The Existing Establishment

6. The existing establishment is inadequate both for the tasks entrusted to the HQ when based at ENOGGERA (ie, without shadow posted personnel) or when in the field.

7. Operations in Barracks.

a. ORBAT. Annex D.

b. It will be noted that from 1 Dec 66, HQ 6 TF is responsible for all command, training and administration functions of approximately 2,700 troops.

c. The restricted HQ establishment makes inadequate provision for staff to handle AG matters, clerical work or domestic administration in a fixed camp. The HQ is also insufficiently staffed to conduct field exercises or TEWTs for the units of the formation and at the same time carry on the daily routine staff work of the HQ.

d. Additional problems arise when it is considered that in the first half of 1967 the HQ will be responsible for mounting and inspecting those units under command who are earmarked for service in VIETNAM or MALAYASIA.

8. Functioning in the Field. These observations are based on difficulties experienced during Exercise BARRA WINGA:-

- a. The full establishment in the field does NOT have sufficient staff to man the operations room on a 24 hour basis without drawing on specialist officers who have their own full time duties. The HQ is NOT adequately equipped to cope efficiently with the air aspects of operations, particularly air resupply and movement generally. The AG Staff is insufficient to handle the workload which is increased considerably by casualty evacuation and reporting. The shortage of clerical staff continues to exist.
- b. Domestically a TF HQ is NOT equipped to handle the load thrown on it by the numerous attachments which are always to be found at a Task Force HQ. HQ 6 TF at BARRA WINGA was rationing up to 270 personnel. This included that part of the TF Sig Sqn located with the HQ, ASSU tentacle, CO Fd Regt and Party, Arty, Survey and Intelligence, detachment Div Int Unit, Army Aviation, Armoured, Engineer and PIR Liaison officers, PR officers and Press representatives and the RAAF TFASO and his party. In addition there are always visitors.
- c. Domestically the HQ and the TF Sig Sqn live together and it is necessary to pool resources. This leads to problems of control and accounting. It is for serious consideration that the system be changed and either the HQ Coy of the Task Force be made responsible for the domestic administration of the TF Sig Sqn, or as in the British Army, the TF Sig Sqn be made responsible for the domestic administration of the TF HQ.

Shadow Postings

9. Whilst there is a shortage of personnel it is realised that the "Shadow Posting" system will continue. Exercise BARRA WINGA pointed up a number of logistic problems which it is believed would have been avoided if the Service officer of HQ 6 TF had been available to the HQ, and to the units on a full time basis before the exercise.
10. Ordnance problems were mainly ones of scalings, or lack of initial issues. Because the TF Ordnance Officer is shadow posted, NO one appears to be in a position to study the scaling problems from the Task Force point of view.
11. Rationing problems (and especially those associated with peace-time accounting requirements in relation to fresh rations as opposed to combat rations) were NOT understood by the TF Staff Officers or the units. The presence of the TF S and T Officer during previous training periods and the BARRA WINGA planning period would have avoided our difficulties.
12. Similarly the full time presence of the Hygiene Officer and the EME Officer would have ensured a better preparation of units for BARRA WINGA.
13. Logistic training and preparation of units always takes second place to operational training and preparation. Without Service Officers on the Task Force HQ this is always going to be a very poor and inexpert second. There is a need for these Service Officers to be available permanently. The current planning for next year's exercise in SHOALWATER BAY is already being hampered because the Shadow Posted Service Officers have returned to their units.

The "Minimum" Establishment

14. The practice of reducing all establishments to the barest minimum so that a maximum number of units can be raised from within the manpower ceiling is producing establishments which are NOT workable. HQ 6 TF does NOT have sufficient officers on establishment to provide a 24 hour manning of the Operations Room without seriously interfering with other sections of the HQ. If one man is sick, if one man is absent on leave or for any other reason, the establishment drawn up to provide the barest minimum is immediately unworkable.
15. It would appear that the old practice of producing a "War Establishment" and a "Peace Establishment" (or a Ceiling Establishment) would bear reconsideration. Young officers studying organization are currently

being misled as far as the requirements of a Task Force HQ are concerned when they study the present establishment. It could be that this criticism applies to other establishments.

JUSTIFICATION OF PROPOSED INCREASES TO ESTABLISHMENT II/2/1(TWO)

PART I. - PERSONNEL

General Staff Branch

1. GSO 2 (Learner).

a. In the Field. It has been found that the GSO 2 is largely involved in planning and liaison with units, and frequently the Headquarters is left with NO grade 2 staff. Should the Commander and the GSO 2 NOT be available this can (particularly when the HQ is split) lead to the battle being "run" by a GSO 3. In addition there are many coordination tasks which, unless performed by the already overworked GSO 2, are left to the GSO 3 whose primary roles are the manning of the TF Comd Net Voice and assistance to the GSO 2 on operational planning and orders. Specific tasks envisaged for the GSO 2 (Learner) in the field are:-

- (1) Detailed understudy of all functions of the GSO 2.
- (2) Assistance in operational planning and orders.
- (3) Supervision of the Operations Room.
- (4) Coordination of TFMA defensive layout and patrol and DF systems.
- (5) Assistance in the provision of "24 hour manning" in the Operations Room.

b. In Barracks. The GSO 2 is fully employed on coordination of training units under command and detailed supervision of all aspects of operational readiness, inspections and training assessments. He is also employed as CO of all headquarters personnel and as such is ultimately responsible for all aspects of G, A and Q administration originating from HQ Coy. These functions leave little time for planning for formation exercises (particularly as these are becoming increasingly complex and sophisticated). It is envisaged that the GSO 2 (Learner) would be employed largely on exercise writing, officer training and other projects as directed by the Commander.

2. Liaison Officer (Lieutenant). Currently the Liaison Officer (Lieutenant) is shadow posted to this headquarters - to be present only when restrictions are lifted for a major exercise such as Exercise BARRA WINGA. In barracks there is a definite requirement for at least one Liaison Officer (Lieutenant) to be present for normal duty. As well as being employed on normal liaison duties with the Captain Liaison Officer, the junior Liaison Officer should be given specific tasks such as maintenance of Staff Tables, coordination of schools and courses (a particularly time consuming, if NOT difficult, task), and compilation of the Commander's Diary. In the Field a definite requirement exists for two Liaison Officers (Lieutenants). It is important that the Commander be able to send simultaneously, liaison officers to each of his major units. If this facility had been available during Exercise BARRA WINGA, it is considered that the passage of orders and information would have been much more satisfactory. Written orders and encoding/decoding of orders sent by signals means are too slow in many instances particularly if the situation is fluid. In addition, both Liaison Officers (Lieutenants) when NOT engaged on liaison duties can be used to full advantage in the Operations Room. One of these two Liaison Officers should be used as a Commander's aide - the lack of an effective aide on Exercise BARRA WINGA threw an extra burden onto the staff, and at times caused inconvenience to the Commander.

3. Intelligence Officer (Lieutenant). A definite requirement exists in the field for the intelligence section to function 24 hours per day. An officer, other than the GSO 3 (Int), is required to act as a Battle Intelligence Officer, capable of collating, preparing and disseminating routine intelligence information, preparing routine reports and general supervision of the intelligence section. Additionally he should be capable of understudying the purely Staff aspects of the GSO 3 (Int) tasks, viz, intelligence liaison, briefing and appropriate operational staff work.

4. Task Force Regimental Sergeant Major. There is a definite requirement for a Task Force RSM. On occasions (particularly in the field) there was found to be a need for liaison by the HQ Coy CSM or the "Area Comd SM" with unit RSM's or equivalent, on matters such as work parties, internal traffic control, provision of escorts, &c. Again, for reasons of inequality of rank, a Task Force RSM (WOL) is required. His duties should include:-

a. In the Field.

- (1) Liaison with unit RSMs or equivalent.
- (2) Control of movement in the TF HQ area as directed by the Staff.
- (3) Supervision of routine administration, viz, dress, individual movement, traffic control in the area through RAA Pro Sect if attached.
- (4) Discipline.
- (5) Coordination of unit work parties as directed by the Staff.
- (6) Conduct of a "continuous" NCO training cadre (when possible) to assist minor units in maintenance of promotion requirements.

b. In Barracks.

- (1) As above plus a limited amount of ceremonial duties in conjunction with the A Staff.
- (2) In addition there is a requirement for a Task Force HQ to provide a training cadre for first promotion, promotion to sergeant and WO courses. Major units can generally cope with "first promotion" type courses, but it has been found that all units require assistance in some form or other in conducting promotion or coaching courses for the senior NCO/WO examinations. It is envisaged that the Task Force RSM would be the permanent SI of a Task Force Promotional Cadre, augmented as required by a small cell of WO instructors from units under command. This, in addition to providing invaluable assistance to units in the formation, would ensure an equally high standard of NCO training throughout.

5. Clerks (General Duties)(Corporal). Under its present restricted establishment, HQ 6 TF is entitled to only two "GS" clerks - the WO2 Chief Clerk and a Sergeant Clerk GD. The Chief Clerk is obviously fully committed to the TF Registry and detailed supervision of all clerks. In addition he is of necessity employed on routine typing. The remaining Sergeant clerk is theoretically responsible for all aspects of G clerking - (routine states and returns, maintenance of existing states and returns, routine schools and courses, maintenance of training schedules, amendments to existing publications PLUS the G Branch typing for 6 officers!!! In the field, without civilian typiste assistance, the position becomes extremely critical, particularly as a G clerk should always be in attendance in the Operations Room. Two additional corporal clerks GD are required. NO requirement exists for a Private Clerk GD.

NOTE: It will be apparent from a study of Annex A that the clerks mentioned in lines 22, 32 and 55 have been designated as Corps Code 00 (All Coprs) rather than "50" RAASC. This is strongly recommended for the following reasons:-

- a. Although RAASC traditionally provide clerks above unit HQ level, it does NOT necessarily follow that a RAASC clerk is fully competent in his respective posting. For example, a RAASC NCO who has been posted as a transport platoon

administrative NCO could hardly be expected to make a G clerk without extensive training. On the other hand, clerks from the headquarters of RAAC, RAA or RA Inf units would settle down much more quickly on the average. The reason is "background".

b. At present "Arms" units (non RAASC) clerks have a rank ceiling of Staff Sergeant. Much valuable clerical experience need NOT necessarily be wasted by these NCOs ceasing to be clerks in order to gain promotion to warrant rank.

6. Operator Intelligence (Corporal). The current establishment shows an entitlement of one operator intelligence (corporal) and one operator intelligence (private). For reasons of specialisation, and inadequacy when the HQ is split, it is submitted that this is insufficient junior staff to support the GSO 3 (Int) and Intelligence Operator (Sergeant). The intelligence operators (corporal and private) are currently (in the field) responsible for:-

- a. Minor intelligence collection and collation.
- b. Collation of intelligence reports from units NOT involving assessment.
- c. Map marking of the following maps:-
 - (1) Comd
 - (2) GSO 2
 - (3) DAA and QMG
 - (4) AQ Battle Map
 - (5) Patrol Map

plus other maps as directed (viz unit CO's, OCs or LO's maps).

- d. Recording intelligence information, maintenance of the intelligence log and classified files.
- e. Maintenance and issue of maps, overlays and air photographs.
- f. Limited air photograph interpretation.
- g. Preparation of models, traces and overlays (up to 50 copies of the latter).

It is considered that the minimum junior staff required to perform all these functions efficiently, plus maintaining the intelligence dutyman on a 24 hours basis is as follows:-

Branch of the DAA and QMG

7. SCA (Learner). The amount of A traffic passing through the HQ both in barracks and in the field is beyond the capacity of one staff officer to handle. However, as much of the work is of a routine nature, the workload of the SCA can be greatly eased by the provision of a Staff Captain (Learner). This officer should be a junior officer who will gain invaluable staff experience whilst processing the routine A traffic of the headquarters. As the Staff Captain (Learner) gains experience he can be trained as an understudy to the Staff Captain A in all A (PA and PS) matters. To give some indication of the workload in the field, Appendix 1 to this Annex shows details of purely NODUF (ie NON Exercise) traffic processed by AQ Branch during the period 15 Oct to 2 Nov 66 whilst the formation was involved in Exercise BARRA WINGA. From these figures it will be seen that the SCA produced almost 50% of the total NODUF output during the period.

8. Staff Captain (Q Movements). In the field in particular the TF is predominantly maintained by air for movement of personnel, stores, casualty evacuation, &c. In view of the increasing bias towards this form of transportation, consideration should be given to the provision of a SCQ (Mov) to deal with all aspects of aerial resupply and the constant movement of casualties, reinforcements, emergency leave cases, &c. In addition he would coordinate all road movement necessary in similar cases.

9. Clerk Movements (Sergeant). This appointment is necessary to support the SCQ (Mov) in his tasks particularly when the comprehensive documentation involved is considered.

10. Clerks (General Duties). The current establishment of clerks allotted to the AQ Branch (Sergeant, Corporal and Private) has been found inadequate. Allowing that the corporal should work under SCQ for maintenance of Q records, states and returns and Q typing, it will be seen that the Sergeant and Private clerks are left to cope with the enormous task of all the clerical side of PA and PS administration which accounts for approximately 50% of the total headquarters output. Typing alone, would occupy 85% of the A clerks time in barracks and in the field. On top of this are other clerical functions such as amendments to publications (always considerable), maintenance of states and returns, records, registration of signal messages originated within the branch, mail receipt, duplication and other minor clerical tasks as directed by the Staff Officers. It has further been discovered that in every case, the private clerk has been far too inexperienced for the task and has to be "carried" for some time (up to 3-4 months). The allocation required is set out below:-

- a. Sergeant Clerk. Works directly with the DAA and QMG and generally supervises the clerical effort of the branch.
- b. Corporal Clerk. SCQ.
- c. Corporal Clerk. SCA.
- d. Corporal Clerk. SCA (Learner)

In the field the two "A" corporal clerks would have to form a typing "pool" as well as carrying out their normal duties. In addition, the practice of 24 hour manning of the AQ operations room in the field becomes a more practicable proposition. On Exercise BARRA WINGA clerks worked up to 16-18 hours per day.

Services

11. Chaplains. The present entitlement of chaplains is two. In the Army there are three major religious groupings (RC, CE and PD). Admittedly in the field all three denominations are represented, but in barracks there is one religious group NOT catered for. It is essential that a formation of this nature, in barracks have three chaplains, one of each denomination to care for the spiritual and moral welfare of the 2,700 troops under command. In the field however, it has been found that three chaplains are inadequate. It is considered that the minimum requirement is four chaplains employed as follows:-

- a. The senior chaplain of the four acts as the chaplain coordinator and advises both Staff and chaplains of relevant activities, problems, &c. In addition he would act as chaplain to the Field Ambulance where, on active service, an obvious requirement exists. He would also be responsible for the spiritual welfare of the 20 minor units (Exercise BARRA WINGA figures) in the TEMA.
- b. The remaining three chaplains allotted to each major unit (ie infantry or artillery units).

12. Services Staff (Hygiene Officer, ST, Ord, EME Officers and Their Sergeant Clerks). As indicated in paragraphs 9-13 of the main submission, there is a requirement for these officers and clerks (who are normally shadow posted) to be present on the headquarters full time. The justification for these personnel is apparently realised when the headquarters deploys in the field for field exercises viz BARRA WINGA, therefore this Serial is devoted to outlining the barracks requirements for this group which forms a highly specialised part of the headquarters. The "specialisation" of these officers is in fact the basis of this submission. The normal staff pressures plus the general lack of experience of the staff (G and AQ Staff) on technical matters viz hygiene, supplies and transport, ordnance and EME, allow extremely little time for staff attention to, for example, the state of a units field or barracks hygiene, the true state of vehicles and plant, &c. Consequently, in the long run, the task force units themselves suffer through the inability of the Staff to adequately supervise the more technical aspects of administration and maintenance. It is envisaged therefore, that these currently "shadow posted" officers and clerks could be equally as fully employed in barracks as in the field. Since prevention is better than cure it is important that unit shortcomings on problems that exist be sorted out BEFORE the units depart for exercises or operational service and NOT when they have moved to the exercise

area/operational theatre. In addition to the tasks of regular unit liaison, inspection and reporting in their particular fields, these officers will also meet the requirement for a "commander" of their particular service sub-units. For example in 6 TF at present there are five RAEME sub-units (LADs or workshops or sub-unit detachments of these) and two major units and one minor unit having RAEME personnel attached (and approximate total of 141 EME personnel). There is a requirement for such specialist officers on Headquarters 6 Task Force to fulfil the normal command functions of advice, liaison, technical supervision, supervision of training and general coordination within the formation. In addition, at present there are NO staff officers capable of giving detailed specialist advice on these Services to the Task Force Commander. This problem would also be overcome if the restriction on this Staff were to be lifted.

Headquarter Company

13. Company Commander (Major). OC HQ Coy should be upgraded to the rank of major. The appointment involves, especially in the field, considerable cooperation with the Staff and units within the TFMA. On Exercise BARRA WINGA it was found that OC HQ Coy was frequently over-ranked by persons with whom he was dealing, and this tended to make his task more difficult. Due to the diversity of trades, duties and functions of HQ Coy, this is considered to be too complex an appointment for a captain. In addition, OC HQ Coy should be capable of acting as a "minor unit" commander in regard to powers of discipline and Q administration neither of which are usually delegated below field rank.

14. Clerk General Duties (Sergeant). A clerk GD (Corporal) is insufficient. HQ Coy, as well as its own administration, is responsible for the pay and rations of the units which form an integral part of the headquarters - viz the TF Sig Sqn and the TF HQ LAD. During Exercise BARRA WINGA approximately 270-280 personnel were administered in these functions by HQ Coy. (This figure includes the abovementioned plus artillery and RAAF attached, public relations and press personnel and observers/visitors). Also when considered as a minor unit having its own pay and ration accounts, plus the responsibility for auditable records, ie, leave records, travel warrants, accountable forms and a limited public monies account, it is apparent that the appointment involves rather more responsibility than that generally entrusted to a corporal. Hence the Clerk GD (Sergeant) should become the HQ Coy clerk and the Clerk GD (Corporal) should remain on establishment as the pay NCO. It is considered vital that an NCO, trained in pay duties be part of HQ Coy. Neither the TF Sig Sqn nor the HQ TF LAD have an establishment for any pay NCO. Obviously HQ Coy is best suited to coordinate the pay administration of all these three minor units.

15. Quartermaster (Lieutenant). Although on paper, the strength of a TF HQ is little less than a rifle company, there is little similarity in the types of stores held. The stores range from "normal" type company stores to a considerable range of technical and semi-technical stores. Additionally, in the field, HQ Coy is responsible for the provision of Scale A accommodation for the TF HQ Area - as previously stated, this involves messing and accommodation facilities for up to 80 officers and WO/Sgts, plus the inevitable visitors/observers. In addition, a requirement exists for HQ Coy to have a "maintenance issue" capability. At present NO satisfactory arrangement exists in barracks for maintenance issues of clothing and other necessaries. The QM (Lt) would also act as understudy to OC HQ Coy and as Coy 2IC.

16. Batman. The increase of batmen from 6 to 9 is strongly recommended on the "1 batman per three officers" basis. Any ratio less than this in the field or in barracks is impracticable.

17. Cooks. The current authorisation for cooks is one sergeant and two privates. This establishment has proved inadequate in both barracks and in the field, being insufficient to run 2 shifts per day. The minimum requirement is assessed as one sergeant, one corporal and four privates. This should enable officers/sergeants and OR messing facilities to be greatly improved, particularly in the field.

18. Hygiene Dutyman. Present entitlement - one corporal. In barracks and in the field this NCO has been unable to effect any supervisory work, because primarily due to lack of staff, he had to be employed on hygiene duties himself. The standard of hygiene in the HQ Coy area and TF LAD Area, although

fair, would be much improved if this NCO were free to carry out his primary task of supervision. Accordingly one private, hygiene dutyman is required.

19. Orderly. Four orderlies are required instead of the authorised three. The orderly earmarked for postal duties is also capable of acting as an HQ Coy orderly/runner; however in the field the other two orderlies are employed as operations room runners/orderlies on a 24 hours basis. This system, primarily because soldiers cannot work at full efficiency for twelve hours per day (every day) was NOT successful. With a fourth orderly this system could work well. In barracks, orderlies are used as "file chasers", messengers and in limited clerical duties, and again four are required.

20. Medical Assistant. At present, HQ Coy has NO medical assistant. This involves, in barracks, continual imposition on the RAP of a major unit such as 2 RAR (who may NOT always be in barracks), and in the field accepting a "shadow posted" NCO who invariably does NOT know the HQ Coy personnel and routine, and consequently takes some time to adjust. On Exercise BARRA WINGA the medical assistant "corporal" was a private soldier. The medical assistant corporal should be posted full time to the HQ Coy. In barracks he can be employed in a unit RAP, where, if that unit is absent on exercise, he can still operate as part of that unit's rear party, and thus still continue to give medical aid when required. In the field his tasks will be much easier because:-

- a. He will know the HQ Coy routine and personalities.
- b. He will already be "part of the team".
- c. He will be fully conversant with running a company aid post due to his training under supervision at a major unit RAP.

21. Steward. Present entitlement is one corporal and one private. This allows one steward for each an officers' and sergeants' mess!!! Granted that some assistance may be gained from "integrated" units - viz, TF Sig Sqn, it is considered that an additional private steward is a minimum requirement.

22. Storeman (Infantry). One major weakness in the present authorised establishment is the lack of a rations storeman/clerk. At present, both in barracks and in the field HQ 6 TF, TF Sig Sqn and HQ TF LAD personnel are physically fed under HQ Coy arrangements. None of these other units have a ration storeman, and consequently the task is being performed by untrained personnel, who, being posted in other trades and duties are subject to a high rate of turnover. It is well nigh impossible to keep the necessary tight control of rations on this basis. This requirement should be met as soon as possible.

23. Defence Platoon. Normally the platoon is "shadow posted" and joins the headquarters shortly before an exercise. This generally is acceptable, however there is a need for a work force of approximately section strength (10 men) to be available for the multitude of general duty tasks which occur continually in barracks. One weakness of the present establishment is that, even in the field, there are NO troops available at all times for such tasks. The minimum requirement on a full time basis is one corporal, two MG numbers, and 7 riflemen.

24. Transport Drivers. The present entitlement of six drivers (one corporal and five privates) is apparently based on a "one man one vehicle" basis, since there are six $\frac{3}{4}$ -ton or $\frac{1}{4}$ -ton vehicles. It has been found that this vehicle scaling is inadequate, particularly in the field when the headquarters is split into TF MAIN and REAR. It is intended to seek an increase of three vehicles (2 x $\frac{3}{4}$ -ton and 1 x $\frac{1}{4}$ -ton). Obviously, if approved, a further three private drivers are required.

5. Justification. It has been found particularly in the field that the present vehicle sealings are inadequate. This has been found to be especially the case whenever the headquarters is split into MAIN and REAR.
 - a. There is a requirement for HQ Coy to have two vehicles and trailers - the general allocation being one each to HQ Coy and one to the QM/CQMS.
 - b. The GS requirement is also increased by on $\frac{3}{4}$ -ton vehicle and trailer for the use of the Captain LO and Task Force RSM. On Exercise BARRA WINGA the LOs were often trying to borrow vehicles for emergency liaison tasks.
 - c. In AQ Branch it is considered that there should be a vehicle allotted to the DAA and QMG for his tasks of staff liaison. This vehicle should be fitted for radio. Again, during Exercise BARRA WINGA, it was found that the Commander should be able to talk to his principal AQ Staff officer if he should be absent.
 - d. The AQ Staff should also have their own vehicle for liaison - particularly for the Services' Officers who have NO other means of vehicle transportation.
 - e. Superimposed on this is the requirement for vehicles for padres, press reporters, PR personnel (occasionally) and observers and visitors.
