

2 RAR - TRAINING DIRECTIVE 1/63 1 JAN 63 - 30 JUN 63

INTRODUCTION

- All members of the battalion will be aware of the constant changing situations and tensions in South East Asia. The possibility that 2 RAR will have to move to a theatre of operations at short notice remains. As part of the British Commonwealth Strategic Reserve 2 RAR has to be ready, in a matter of hours, to leave their present location and to fight in any area of South East Asia.
- All officers and NCOs have a responsibility to ensure that troops under their command are physically fit, trained to the maximum efficiency within the time available, and in all respects to be ready for active service against a potential enemy.
- Training is a race against time. When a sudden emergency develops and troops living in a peace time atmosphere are suddenly thrown into action, commanders at all levels regret they did not make use of time they once had. Each hour of the working day within this unit has therefore to be designed to ensure that it is fully used to improve our battle worthiness. All ranks will therefore approach training with the attitude of mind that everything achieved will reduce the numbers of lives lost, should an emergency develop.

AIM

4. The aim of this instruction is to designate specific training activities during the period 1 Jan - 30 Jun 1963 and to present a framework on which Company Commanders can organize the training of their companies.

OUTLINE

- 5. An outline of events is given at Annex A. The period will be roughly divided as follows:
 - a. Jan Feb Platoon training
 - b. Mar Jun Company training.
- Superimposed over this platoon and company training there will be a number of battalion exercises designed to keep the unit at the maximum operational efficiency. An outline of major exercises is given below:-
 - 9 10 Jan DOVETAIL (MALAYA)
 - 25 Feb 2 Mar BELLBUSTER (MALAYA)
 - 12 29 Mar GAVOTTE (BORNEO)
 - 24 May 7 Jul SEATO EX (THAILAND)

PLATOON TRAINING PERIOD

- 7. During Jan Feb the emphasis will be on getting reinforcements welded into platoon teams. Platoons will place emphasis on night operations, patrolling, and on mastering platoon techniques of the four phases of war.
- Platoons will spend at least 10 nights in the field. Training will be designed to exercise platoons in movement in various types of terrain at night and in the holding of a defensive position by night.
- Ompanies will set a three day test exercise for each platoon involving advance, attack and defence by night.
- During the period 10 Jan 23 Feb 2 RAR has priority on the Asahan Jungle Lanes. Each platoon will spend at least three days field firing on these ranges. The following will be available to companies:-

Ambush Range (SLR, MG, SMG)
Shooting Galleries (SLR, MG, SMG)
Sheaker Lanes (SLR, MG, SMG)
3.5 RL and 94 Gun Range
Pl/Sec Def Range (SLR, MG, SMG)
Sec Attack Range (SLR, MG, SMG)

- 11. Each company will undertake a route march of 20 miles in 24 hours during this period.
- During this period companies will ensure that they have trained two loading and lashing teams. They will deal directly with SUEO on this matter.

COMPANY TRAINING PERIOD

- The period Mar Jun will be used by companies to improve their techniques in the four phases of war. During this period each company will take part in a test exercise to be set by battalion; any phase of war may be selected.
- Companies will train against a Chinese type enemy.

 However, some emphasis will be given to anti-guerilla operations. In particular troops will be trained to find a Viet Cong type enemy.

 During this period training in the search of a defended village will be organized on a battalion basis.

SPECIALIST TRAINING

- Continuation training for trained paratroopers will be organized under battalion arrangements.
- 16. The mortar and anti tank platoons will carry out field firing during this training period. The pioneer platoon will carry out refresher training with live explosives and ammunition. In addition these platoons will train in a rifle platoon role.

OFFICER TRAINING

17. Officer training will continue to be held at 1630 hrs each Monday. The programme will be co-ordinated by OC A Coy after consultation with CO

APON TRAINING

All training loses its effect unless troops can kill enemy after they find him. Although there was an improvement in marksmanship within the unit during 1962, greater attention must be given to this during 1963. Companies will ensure that full use is made of all available ranges. All members of the battalion will fire their annual range practice by 17 May. Companies will have records of individual performances available at all times. A team under direction of CO will test selected soldiers at random to gauge whether the standard of shooting is improving at the required rate.

TRAINING FACILITIES, RANGES ETC

The I.O. will issue a separate instruction setting out availability of ranges and all training facilities during period. This instruction will also cover the procedure at weekly training conferences and the method to be employed to ensure that maximum use is made of all training facilities.

TRAINING FACILITIES 1 Jan 63 - 30 Jun 63

GENERAL

The aim of this instruction is to lay down the division of responsibility for trg facilities between Int Sec and WO2 Regt Duties and outline what trg facilities are available for coy and bn trg.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- All internal unit trg facilities will be controlled and maintained by WO2 Regt Duties. These facilities include:
 - a. 25 yd Range
 - b. Unit Lecture Hall
 - c. Aslt Course
 - d. Indoor Range.
- In addition WO2 Regt Duties will be responsible for the indenting, collection and supply of films required by sub-units.
- The Int Sec will be responsible for:
 - a. Promulgation and submission of all scheduled courses avail to unit members and submitting bids to respective schools.

DETAILS OF FACILITIES

5. Terendak Comp Jungle Range No 1

2 RAR has first priority on the use of this range and is responsible for its maintenance. Distance from the unit lines is approx 3 miles and Range Orders are held by Int Sec. Sub-units using the range must repair all tgts at the conclusion of firing. Controlled by Bde HQ.

6. Jungle EAST and Jungle WEST

When any of the four Jungle Ranges are in use a large area of Jungle WEST is incl in the danger area. Controlled by Bde HQ and therefore Jungle WEST will NOT be used.

7. Mersing Rd Range KLUANG

A 400 yd 12 tgts classification range. Travelling time approx 3½ hrs. Range orders not avail as yet. Controlled by Bde HQ and avail to 28 Bde Gp immediately although most of Feb and Mar have already been allotted to units outside the Bde.

8. MENYALA Range PORT DICKSON

Both Classification and Grenade Ranges avail. Normally only allocated to 28 Bde Gp for a max of 6 days each month. Controlled by Fed Army.

9. BRINCHANG CAMP CAMERON HIGHLANDS

Hutted accom for approx coy str avail. Not suitable for tactical trg. Travelling time approx 9 hrs by rd. Controlled by 17 Gur Div.

10. KUANTAN Biv Area

A non-gazetted area requiring special land clearance. Suitable for approx coy str. Travelling time approx 10 hrs.

11. KONKOI Trg Area

An area approx 15 miles square ME of SEREMBAN. In the area are both open and jungle areas, three lakes, two rivers, an airstrip and several tracks. NO swimming is permitted because of the danger of leptospirosis. Further details are avail from Int Sec. The trg area is controlled by 17 Gur Div.

APPLICATIONS FOR FACILITIES

- 12. Applications for the use of internal unit facilities will be lodged with WO2 Regt Duties giving as much notice as possible.
- 13. Applications for the use of bde and div controlled facilities will be given to the IO at the monthly trg conference unless notified otherwise.

MONTELY TRG CONFERENCE

14. These conferences will be held in the Int Office during the first week of each month. Timings will be notified separately. At these conferences the bids for the following month will be discussed, and then forwarded to the controlling authority.
