	17	Comd 28 COMWEL Indep Inf Bde Gp, Brig P.N.M. MOORE, DSO, MC, made a farewell visit to 105 Fd Bty RAA and addressed members of the Bty returning to AUSTRALIA. The Bde Comd thanked the Bty for a job well done and described it as the best administrated unit in the Bde Gp.
