COMMANDERS DIARIES INSTRUCTIONS

AIM

1. The aim of a Commanders Diary is to provide data on which to base future improvements in Army training, equipment, organization and administration, and to furnish historians with a record of the activities of units and formations in operational and non-operational periods in peace and in war.

GENERAL

- 2. Entries are to be made daily on AF C 2118 (Adapted) each entry being initialled by the officer detailed to keep it.
- 3. Commanders Diaries will conform with the rules for drafting orders given in "Staff Duties (Australia)", Chapter 2, Section 12.

RESPONSIBILITY

During Non-operational Periods

4. A Commanders Diary is to be compiled by commanders of all formations.

During Operational Periods (1)

- 5. A Commanders Diary is to be compiled in duplicate by:
 - a. Commanders of all formations.
 - b. Each branch of the staff at formation headquarters commanded by a brigadier or above.
 - c. Heads of services not below the rank of lieutenant colonel.
 - d. Personal staffs and officers holding special appointments.
 - e. Unit commanders.
 - f. Commanders of a detachment of a unit when so ordered.

COMPILATION

- 6. Both original and duplicate copies are to consist of:
 - a. Cover (AF C 2119) (Adapted).
 - b. Index as printed on cover.
 - c. Narrative (AF C 2118) (Adapted).
 - d. Annexes as shown in the Index.
- 7. All details of the unit or formation (if a detachment is concerned, the name of the parent unit), period covered and enclosure numbers of the annexes are to be shown on the cover. If there has been a change of command since the last report, the date of assumption by the new commanding officer is to be included.
- 8. The annexes are to be assembled in the groups shown on the cover. If there are no enclosures for an annex NII will be entered on the cover. If additional annexes are convenient for a particular headquarters. starting at B.

DISPOSAL

Construction Projects

- 2. General. The high level of activity in December has been sustained. Five projects were completed during the month, and impressive dedication ceremonies held for the Ngai Giao and Vinh Thanh Schools, the Hoa Long High School, and the Long Son Maternity Dispensary. All major projects are proceeding satisfactorily and most 1 ATF Unit Civic Action teams are now on their second round of projects. Four new projects were started during the month.
- 3. Projects in Support of Village Self Development.
 - a. All projects in support of the 1969 VSD are now complete except for:
 - (1) Construction of the large new Xuyen Moc Market which should be completed in Febuary.
 - (2) Repairs to the Long Dien Market which should be complete by early March.
 - (3) The Long Son water supply, which is still delayed pending the arrival of stores on the Jeparit. The object of this project is to give Long Son a guaranteed water supply during the dry season.

The village is understandably getting very anxious to proceed with the work, and it is sincerely hoped that the stores will be on the next Jeparit expected in mid Febuary.

b. Villages are already planning the expenditure of their 1970 VSD monies. It is proposed to support the Plan this year in the same way as in 1969, and the necessary liaison and planning is now being carried out.

Road and Bridge Works.

- a. Roadworks by 1 Fd Sqn and 17 Const Sqn continue on Route 23. Placing of pavement is complete except for the sections immediately east of Baria and in Dat Do township area. Sealing continues throughout and is now 75% complete. 17 Const Sqn are in the process of replacing two old bridges between Long Dien and An Nhut with new two way class 60 bridges.
- b. 1 Fd Sqn continues with the rebuilding of Route 2, working at present on the section between Suoi Nghe and Binh Ba.
 Good progress is being made.
- c. 17 Const Sqn have commenced the rebuilding of Route 44 from Thu Luu YS403598 to Long Hai.
- d. The village road project in Phuoc Hoa Long continues to have an outstanding impact. Work in Phuoc Hoa Long village is now 80% complete, and the team will move to Phuoc Tho village during Febuary.
- e. 1 Fd Sqn continues the construction of a new Class 60 bridge at YS501563 on Route 44. Work has been much slower than expected due to difficult soil conditions.
- f. 17 Const Sqn have recommenced the filling of low lying areas around the new Baria Market, and the construction of a short length of new road near the market.
- Bau Tram School. (Project 231) 17 Const Sqn have completed the filling of the site, and work on the building can start as soon as formal approval is received. This will be the largest CA project yet undertaken. The filling of the site involved the carting, placing and compacting of over 10,000 cub yds of fill.
- 6. 1970/71 Program. Negotiations are in hand with Province authorities to prepare the 1970/71 program.

MEDCAPS and ICAPS

7. The program continued successfully during January. The Vietnamese 7 Marine Bn who were in training at Van Kiep National Training Centre joined in the MEDCAP program until they left at

the end of the month. The RMO of 8 RAR has now accepted a second MEDCAP, taking over An Ngai from the 7 Marine Bn. 8 Fd Amb have also accepted one more MEDCAP.

8. The 1 Aust CA Unit Hygiene Sgt has commenced duties as the the Assistant Public Health Advisor in Phuoc Tuy.

Youth and Sports

9. The GVN Youth and Sports program continues to receive much support. 1 ATF sporting fixtures with Vietnamese teams continue, and are producing very good results. Two successful pre-Tet sports carnivals were held on the weekend 31 Jan/1 Feb, one at Long Dien and one in Baria. The new Boy Scout Troops in Hoa Long and Dat Do now appear to be firmly established and continue to receive 1 ATF support. Soccer fields have been built at Hoa Long and Dat Do, renovated at Binh Ba, and planned at Xuyen Moc. There is a pronounced resurgence of interest in sport in the Province.

Medical

- 1. During January the MEDCAP Programme has been expanded, particularly along Routes 44 and 326. 8 RAR now conducts MEDCAPS in An Ngai as well as Tam Phuoc. 1 Aust CA Unit commenced MEDCAP activities in Hoi My on 9 Jan 70 and Phuoc Hiep on 30 Jan 70. 8 Fd Amb commenced MEDCAP activities in Hoa Long on 31 Jan 70.
 - 2. MEDCAPS conducted during the month by 1 ATF were:

a.	1 Aust CA Unit	57 (4010 patients seen)
b.	1 Fd Regt	7 (389 patients seen)
0.	5 RAR	6 (195 patients seen)
d.	6 RAR	5 (187 patients seen)
e.	8 RAR	6 (161 patients seen)

- January. 1 Aust CA Unit has conducted 11 ICAPs during the month (707 patients seen). On each occasion the ICAP team has remained overnight in the ICAP location.
- 4. The RMO of 7th Marine Battalion (RVN) concluded MEDCAP activities in Phuoc Tuy at the end of the month. The unit is leaving Phuoc Tuy Province shortly.
- There were no major conflicts, natural disasters or serious epidemics in Phuoc Tuy Province during January.
- The hygiene corporal of the Medical Detachment 1 Aust CA Unit has participated in the Vietnamese Ministry of Health programme of spraying DDT in villages of Phuoc Tuy Province. He has also made investigations into, and is preparing a report on, garbage disposal in Baria.
- 7. A programme of issuing a toothbrush, tube of toothbrush and instruction leaflet to children who might benefit from this has been instituted and will continue.

Dental

8. The DENTCAP programme has continued with increasing attendances. During January 17 DENTCAPs were conducted, 531 patients seen and 814 treatments given.

MONTHLY EDUCATION REPORT JANUARY 1970

Primary Education

- 1. Project 230. (Minor Repairs to Primary Schools) is proceeding at a steady pace.
 - b. No repaired classroom furniture was delivered to schools during Jan 70 because the Province Primary Education Service was unable to provide transport.
- 2. Two-classroom schools, (completed projects 264,265, 268) at Ngai Giao, Vinh Thanh, Ong Trinh respectively, were handed over with appropriate ceremony on 10 Jan 70 (Ngai Giao and Vinh Thanh) and 27 Jan 70 (Ong Trinh).
- Playground equipment (Project 229) was installed at Ngai Giao and . Vinh Thanh schools.

Secondary Education

- 4. The Box Library Service has not been inaugurated because librarians from the schools involved have yet to be nominated and trained. Chau Van Tiep High School, Baria is to co-ordinate this training.
- Four instructors from 1 Aust CA Unit continue to spend 40 man hours per week teaching English to approximately 800 High School students at 22 classes in five grades in five High Schools in Phuoc Tuy Province.

Adult Education

6. Six Instructors from 1 ATF spent approximately 56 man hours during Jan 70 teaching English to approximately 48 adults. Most of the students were employees of Government Services, including some teachers from Phuco Hai Primary School.
