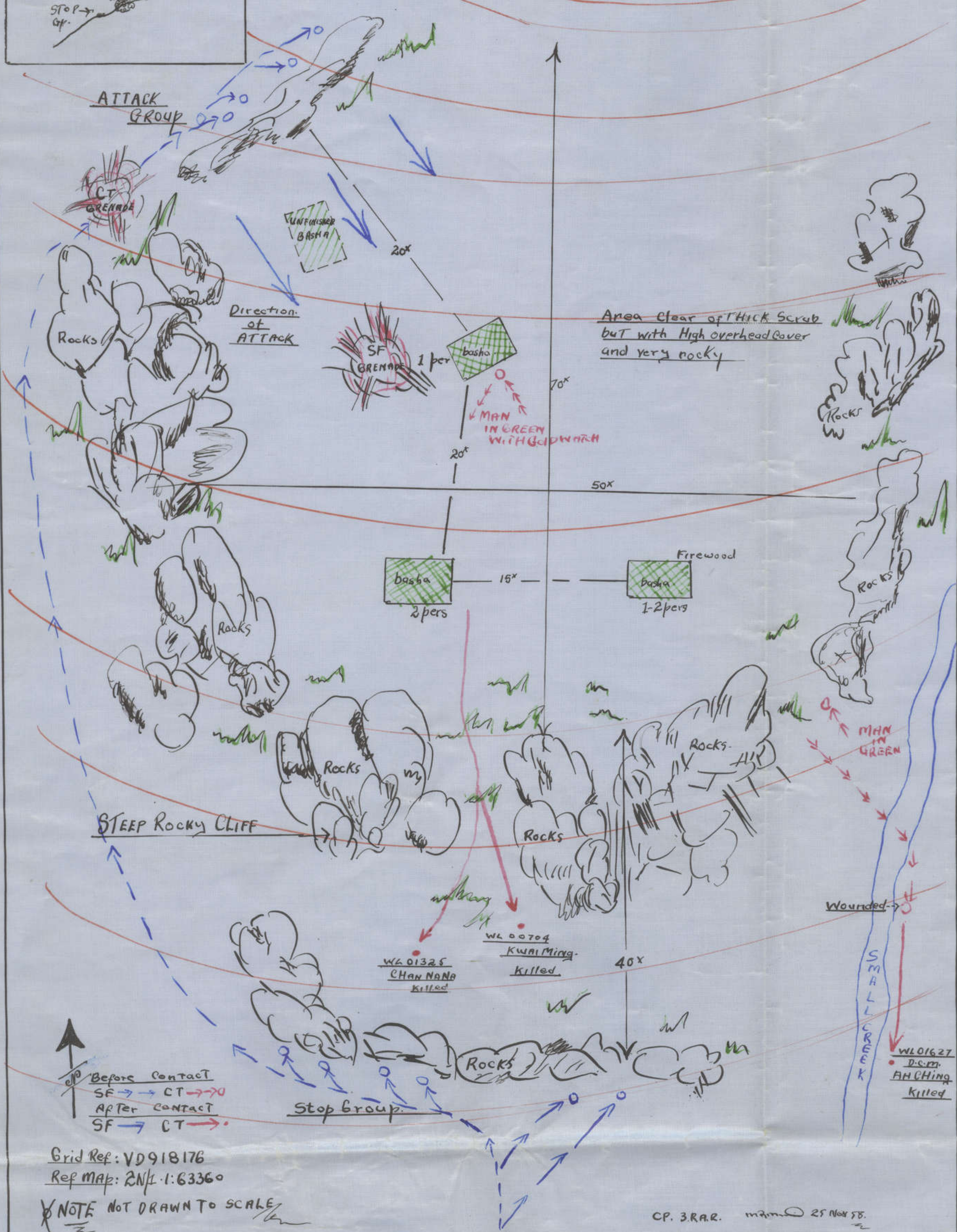

RESUPPLY OF PATROLS IN THE FIELD

GENERAL:

1. This instr is designed to cover the procedures to be adopted for the resup of ptls in the fd by Lt ac, hele, aust or Sakai porters and must be read in conjunction with the relevant sections of Chapters XVII and XXII of the ATOM pamphlet, 3 RAR SOs for MALAYA 6/57 and the 3 RAR JOGGER.

WARNING:

2. Whenever possible ptls in the fd will be given 48 hrs warning of a re-sup. This period is designed to allow the ptl comd to ascertain his exact requirements and pass them to his control in time for them to be complied with.

PORTERS:

3. When indenting for Sakai porters coys must bear in mind the lack of guarantee that the nos ordered will in fact report for work. An over insurance of 5 to 10 per cent must be made.
4. Indents for porters must be made to the Bn CP as early as possible to enable co-ordination of the limited sup.

BASIC RE-SUP PACK

5. To reduce wrls tfc and simplify ordering and provision action a Basic Pack will be used. The contents of this are listed at Appx 'A' and must be known by all ptl comds. Requests for resup will then only require additions or deletions to be passed to control.

INDIVIDUAL PACKS:

6. To ensure economy in clo and simplify resup requests all ptls that are likely to be resup will, before leaving base, deposit with the coy CQMS individual packs (suitably labelled) which will incl one set of clo and any NAAFI or other personal items that the members may require.
7. Should an individual be unable to provide the set of clo at the time he leaves base the coy CQMS will extract a set from the soldier's dhoby, record the fact, and place it in the individual pack.

JUNGLE BOOTS:

8. For all ptls that are not static ambushes each resup will incl 100% replacement of jungle boots. Coy CQMS will maintain lists showing sizes of all troops on ptl. In this regard it must be borne in mind that the new "BELL" type boots are a size smaller than the "NATURAL" boot. i.e. NATURAL size 8 = BELL size 9.

LOAD LIST:

9. In order to detect pilfering and to assist pl sgts in their break up of stores load lists will accompany each resup party.

10. A detailed brief is essential and the points to be covered are listed in Appx 'B' att.

GENERAL:

1. The procedure for bn and coy pay will be in accordance with unit accounting procedure for the AKA 1956 (UAP) as amended, and Aust Army Force FARELF pay instr No 7 dated 30 May 57. The following paragraphs amplify these references, the more important being sidelined.
2. The bn paying offr will collect the bn advance from the bank on the Wed of pay week. He will distr to coy paying offr the coy advance obtaining signatures on the WF 34A.

PREPARATION FOR PAY:

3. Advances must be demanded only after a careful consideration of the mov of tps, claims and ARL. To ensure an accurate forecast of the coy advance the coy pay clerks must obtain a member's pay requirement i.e. Pl Sgts submit to the coy pay clerk the individual pay needs. These will be consolidated together with an appropriate amount for payment of claims held by coys, expected claims due before pay day and the SARAWAK Ranger requirement. The total coy advance will be submitted to the bn pay office by 0900 hrs on the Mon before pay day.
4. The attention of sub-unit Comds, paying offr and clerks is directed to UAP para 563 which states 'The following points will be observed in the preparation of acquittance rolls:- etc.,' The sub-unit paying offr must check the points listed in the above reference prior to the pay parade. In particular the paying offr must ensure that No alterations are made to the Foreign and Australian columns of the acquittance rolls. Should this error occur the acquittance must be cancelled and a new acquittance prepared. The acquittance rolls will NOT be TOTALLED until the completion of the Coy pay. Any alterations on the acquittance rolls must be initialed by the paying offr.

PAY PARADES

5. The attention of all paying offr is directed to UAP paras 551-556 which quote the following points:-
 - (a) Responsibility for public monies
 - (b) Security of public monies
 - (c) The proper accounting of advances
 - (d) The liability of losses incurred by paying offr.
 - (e) Safe custody of acquittance rolls, pay books and claims.
6. Paying offr will always be armed when in custody of public monies and will be accompanied by armed escort when travelling.

..../2.

7. The correct procedure to be adopted when effecting payments is laid down in UAP paras 564 to 570. The provisions of para 568 are particularly stressed and must receive careful attention by paying offrs especially

(a)

(i) A progressive check of the acquittance rolls against paybook amounts must be made, this is done by the pay clerk calling out the member's name, amount both DOLLARS and AJST and pay book line e.g.,

Pte JONES LINE 73, \$100, £14.12.9

(ii) The paying offr will before making a payment check the member's progressive total debits against the pregressive total credits and ensure himself that the member is not being overpaid.

(iii) The member will produce his ID Card and Identity discs to the paying offr before payment.

(b) All alterations on acquittance rolls must be initialled by the paying offr. Where the member has already signed the roll and the roll has to be cancelled, his initials must be placed on it together with those of the paying offr.

(c) All unused acquittances must be cancelled and initialled.

(d) The paying offr must sign each acquittance roll and the date of acquitting.

(e) It is stressed that each member signs the acquittance roll LEGIBLY with his usual signature appearing in the pay book and that he signs in the CORRECT PLACE.

(f) Claims will NOT be paid until they are approved for payment. NCO's will NOT witness payment of claims. Claims must be accorded the same security as public monies because they represent monies paid and are a cash document.

8. Sub unit paying officers will adhere to the instructions as laid down in Unit Accounting Procedure wherever possible. It is realised that at times, due to operational necessity, a sub-unit paying officer may have to hand over his duties to another officer before completing a pay. Such a practice should be avoided wherever possible but if unavoidable the original paying officer will prepare a complete reconciliation showing the amount of acquittances by roll numbers, claims paid and cash on hand. These when totalled should equal the amount of the **advance.**"

The relieving paying officer will check this reconciliation in detail and assure himself before making another payment that the handover is correct and sign the reconciliation as such. This reconciliation will be retained until the Coy pay is completed and correctly acquitted to the Unit Pay Rep.

ACQUITTANCE OF ADVANCES

9. After the last man has been paid and all claims paid, the paying offr aided by his pay clerk, will strike a balance, checking the correctness of all acquittances, all claims and paybook entries and checking the conversions of the final totals. If there is an appreciable difference check each individual conversion until the error has been located and adjusted. When satisfied acquit the coy advance to the bn paying offr. A receipt will be issued by the bn paying offr for the amount refunded. (Attention is drawn to UAP para 572). The acquittances will be pinned up in totals by COMMANDS and faced with a 'STATEMENT OF COY PAY' completed and signed by the coy paying offr.

PARTICULAR INSTRUCTIONS FOR PAYMENT OF SARAWAK RANGERS

GENERAL

1. Pay accounts of ORs SARAWAK RANGERS are maintained by the Federation Army Paymaster at KUALA LUMPUR. Rates of Pay and Allowances as applicable to these soldiers serving in MALAYA as shown below; these rates are all PER MONTH. Sub-units will disburse bi-monthly within the entitlement shown in Coln (g) of the Table.
2. Family allotments by ORs SARAWAK RANGERS to their dependants in SARAWAK are compulsory. All contribute, whether married or single, in conformity with the communal way of life in their own country. Rates of such allotments are shown in coln (f) of the Table. Remittance is made monthly in bulk to SARAWAK by the Federation Army Paymaster. Payment to Allottees is made by the civil authorities at local treasuries in SARAWAK.
3. Promotions and Star-gradings will be advised as they are promulgated from HQ SARAWAK RANGERS in Battalion Part III Orders - SARAWAK RANGERS. This advice will constitute the authority for the rangers Paybook Pt II to be entered up with such upgrading, and payment w.e.f. the date advised will be made by sub-units at the new rate commencing on the next normal pay period. Promotions and star-gradings will not be effected in the member's paybook by Coy pay reps. Pay books Part II will be returned to the UPR for all adjustments to rates of pay.

ACQUITTANCE ROLLS

4. Federation Army Acquittance Rolls (MAF/PAY/1) enfaced "SARAWAK RANGERS" will be issued by the UPR for the purpose. The soldier will sign the roll in the normal manner where possible; if he is unable to do so his RIGHT thumb print will be placed in the signature space using an ink pad. SARAWAK RANGERS are to be encouraged to sign, in the normal manner for their pay. Acquittance Rolls will be prepared in quadruplicate by inserting two plain (flimsy) sheets, with a carbon, behind the duplicate.

DISBURSEMENTS

5. Amounts will be scaled down to the nearest \$5.00 when preparing bids for advances. The Rangers should be encouraged to underdraw their pay so as to build up credit in their pay accounts against the time they go on leave to SARAWAK. Under NO circumstances will they be paid on any pay parade more than they have previously requested. Cash advance will be demanded in the normal way as part of the Coy main advance.
6. Paying Officers will sign the Ranger's Paybook Part II when disbursement has been made. Pay stoppages will be entered in this book as occurring in RED INK, cross-referenced to the particular WF22 and signed by the officer/NCO making the entry.

ACQUITTANCE

7. Sub-unit Paying Officers will Acquit SARAWAK RANGERS' Pay in the normal manner to the Bn Paying Officer and UPR. There is provision for this on the "Statement of Coy Pay" pro-forma issued.
8. The Battalion Paying Officer will total all Ranger Acquittances on receipt from coys and check these rolls for correctness. Three copies will be exchanged for cash with 2 MALAY REGT at TAIPING.

FINALISATION OF BN PAY

10. The bn paying offr aided by the pay sgt will compile a statement of bn pay viz WF 196A showing total acquittance, sundry paid claims and the cash refund. These are then fwd to AUST CASH OFFICE SINGAPORE by registered SDS.
11. Any surplus or deficiency will be disclosed on the 'COY STATEMENT OF PAY' at the time of acquittal and will be accompanied by a statement in triplicate explaining the error. Any losses will be made good by the paying offr concerned. When such disclosure has been made, a paying offr may be recouped in the event of such a deficiency subsequently being found to be non-existent. When a surplus is disclosed the money will be paid to the bn paying offr.

CLAIMS (To be read in conjunction with 3 RAR Adm Instr 8/58).

12. Coy clerks and pay clerks must be fully conversant with the provisions of AUST ARMY FORCE FARELF PAY INSTR No 7 of 30 MAY 57 & Q ADM INSTR No 7 as amended, together with the sample claims on how to compile all claims CORRECTLY.
13. All claims should be submitted immediately after the event warranting the claim, except subsistence claims ref para 14. Particular care must be taken in the handling of claims because immediately it is processed by the UPR the claim becomes an accountable document. An approved claim ready for payment is a cash document.
14. No claim will be paid until examined by a member of the Aust Cash office SINGAPORE except SUBSISTENCE claims which will be examined by the UPR 3 RAR or the bn paying offr and passed for payment.
15. When a member is paid by claim it must be ensured that all payments are properly receipted by the claimant and his signature witnessed by the paying offr. The witness to a claim WILL always be an officer.
16. Aust Army Force FARELF have directed that all claims submitted for approval by 3 RAR will be certified only by the CO or 2IC. In order to ensure the correctness of claims for their signature, the stamp issued to coys for the certification of claims will always be placed on the back of all claims and the certificate signed by the coy comd or coy 2IC only.

SECURITY OF PUBLIC MONIES

17. The Battalion Paying Officer and sub-unit Paying Officers as appointed will observe the strictest security measures when entrusted with Cash Advances. Paying officers will always be armed when collecting advances; disbursing payments and returning the unused cash portion of their advances. An armed excort will be provided throughout this period.
18. When collecting advances and returning cash balances from points outside operational camp sites, two vehicles will normally be used, the paying officer travelling in one with one escort and an escort being provided in the second vehicle.
19. Paying Officers are directly responsible for Public Monies entrusted to their care and will ensure that, when payments are NOT being made, cash and cash documents are locked in a safe or strong box and that an armed sentry is continually posted in the same building or hutment.

CONCLUSION

20. The time and space problem in acquitting the Battalion advance, posed by widely dispersed sub-units, can be largely overcome by:-

- (a) accurate forecasting of pay advance requirements,
- (b) regular submission of correctly compiled, signed and certified claims,
- (c) care in the preparation of paybooks and acquittance rolls by the coy clerks,
- (d) preplanning of company and sub-unit pay parades, and
- (e) diligence and attention to detail by Paying Officers in making payments and in acquitting their advances.

PART XII : CIVILIAN LABOUR

GENERAL

1. All military units in MALAYA are entitled to employ civilian labour personnel. This labour is controlled by a unit peculiar to MALAYA known as the Pioneer Civil Labour Unit. Within 3 RAR all contacts with this unit will be made to the Civilian Labour Staff at Battalion Headquarters.

SCALE OF EMPLOYMENT

2. The entitlement of civilian labour varies in accordance with the type and size of accommodation the unit/sub unit is occupying, together with the numbers of personnel in occupation. The exact scale for any company at any one time will be advised by the Civilian Labour Staff at battalion headquarters.

EMPLOYMENT

3. The battalion Civilian Labour Staff will employ, discharge and move all labour in liaison with the sub units concerned. Whilst employed in a sub unit area all civilian labour will come under the control of that sub unit headquarters, however, labour will not be employed on tasks outside the scope of their employment. Each Friday sub units will forward a parade state of their civilian labour staff to the battalion Civil Labour Office.

SECURITY

4. Prior to employment civilian labourers will have been security screened and will have been issued with a military permit (AF A29).

MEDICAL

5. Before employment within 3 RAR the RMO will examine all civilian labourers who are likely to come into contact with food. In addition, these personnel will be given a monthly FFI. The battalion Civil Labour Officer will supervise that the above examinations are made and that appropriate records are kept by the WO Caterer.
6. In case of accidents on duty civilian labour will be treated at Government expense, however, for sickness not brought on by their employment they must make their own arrangements for treatment.

PAY

7. The Civil Labour Office is responsible for all payments to civilian employees. Such payments will be made twice a month.

LEAVE AND STAND DOWN

8. Monthly paid staff (all employees, except labourers) work a six day week of 48 hours at a rate of 8 hours a day.
9. Hourly paid staff (labourers) work a five and half day week of 44 hours at a rate of 8 hours a day.
10. Annual leave will be granted to all civilian staff. This grant is 10 days a year and will be organised by the battalion Civil Labour Office.

JCLOs

11. Company commanders should use their JCLOs as interpreters and controllers of all civilian labour within their areas.

CONTRACTORS STAFF

12. The various contractors employees are not the responsibility of the civil labour office and their administration is covered in Part XI of this instruction.


231. DISCIPLINE TRAFFIC ACCIDENTS
