

PERSONAL EFFECTS STOLEN OR ACCIDENTALLY DESTROYED OR DAMAGED:
COMPENSATION FOR OR INSURANCE OF

MBI 71/59 is reproduced hereunder:-

1. The Commonwealth does not act as the insurer of the personal belongings of its servants or tenants and the possibility of loss or damage due to fire, burglary or accident is a normal risk applicable to members in common with the community generally. This also applies to loss of or damage to regimental or mess property. Personnel, messes and units are, therefore, responsible for providing any protection such as insurance which they may desire.
2. A member of the Permanent Forces or a Department of the Army employee may arrange through the Australian Army Canteens Service to ensure private property belonging to him or to his dependants living in camp or quarters anywhere in Australia or the Territory of Papua and New Guinea, and irrespective of the type of buildings in which they are housed. Members desiring to avail themselves of this service should apply to the nearest canteen for an appropriate proposal form and particulars.
3. Details of the insurance coverage which may be effected through the Australian Army Canteens Service are published as a Notice to these MBIs. The information will be displayed prominently on unit etc Notice Boards.
4. In exceptional circumstances where a member suffers loss or damage to private property and where he has not and could not reasonably have been expected to protect by insurance coverage his own or his dependants' belongings against loss or damage, a claim for ex-gratia compensation may be submitted for consideration.
5. Any such claim submitted will be accompanied by the following:-
 - (a) A full account of the events leading up to the loss or damage, together with a copy of any report by an investigating officer or proceedings of a Court of Inquiry;
 - (b) An outline of the member's normal duties and any special assignment at the time of the occurrence; and
 - (c) A Statutory Declaration from the member, supported where possible by signed statements from other members.
6. In the Statutory Declaration the member will:-
 - (a) Explain briefly the circumstances of the loss or damage;
 - (b) State if he was aware of this MBI or had been informed of its contents;
 - (c) In respect of each article lost:-
 - (i) outline the steps taken to recover the articles;
 - (ii) show the value when new;
 - (iii) show the value less depreciation;
 - (iv) state why the article was not insured; and
 - (v) attach receipts and vouchers (if held) as exhibits to the declaration.
 - (d) In respect of each article damaged, show the cost of repair, and attach supporting evidence.
7. The substance of this instruction will be brought to the notice of all members.

INSURANCE: PERSONAL EFFECTS OF MEMBERS OF MEMBERS OF THE ARMY:
REGIMENTAL AND MESS PROPERTY AND FIDELITY GUARANTEE

1. The Commonwealth accepts no liability for the loss or damage to regimental or mess property, or property belonging to service personnel or their dependants including those in married quarters. Therefore, personnel, messes and units are responsible for providing any protection such as insurance that they may desire. The Australian Army Canteen Service (AACS) can, upon request, arrange the necessary insurance. The types of insurance available to full time members of the Permanent Forces and Department of the Army employees anywhere in Australia (including Papua and New Guinea), providing their residence is within a Military installation, are briefly explained in the following paragraphs.

Unit, Mess and Personal Effects located in
Military Installations: Fire and Burglary Policy

2. The policy available covers loss through fire and/or burglary of such items as trading stock, plant, equipment and tropies owned by a Unit Canteen or Mess and in the case of personal effects, clothing, valuable etc.

3. Conditions attaching to the policy are as follows:-

- (a) Unless specifically endorsed on the policy and then at a much higher premium, fire caused by storm or tempest is not covered;
- (b) Risks of war, riot and civil commotion are not covered;
- (c) There must be evidence of breaking and entry into a building to support a burglary claim.

4. It is essential that property be insured for its correct value in order that the insured party or person in the event of a loss receives fair compensation. The premium rates and procedure are as follows:-

(a) Premium Rates

- (i) Unit and Mess property - Premium rate is 10/- per £100 of value based on declared value of stock, plant and equipment irrespective of type of building in which the property is housed. If fusion of electric motors is required, an additional rate of 18/- per £100 is payable with a minimum charge of 10/-;
 - (ii) Personal property - Premium rate of 7/6 per £100 of value of personal effects excluding cash. If necessary a cover for cash holdings can be specifically arranged.
- (b) Premium payments - Premiums are payable in advance, annually;
 - (c) Proposal form - These are available from every AACS installation. The completed proposal forms should be lodged direct with GQ AACS detachment together with a cheque for the premium involved;
 - (d) Claims - Claims setting out full particulars of loss should be submitted promptly in writing to the HQ AACS Detachment.

...../3.

Personal Clothing and Effects located in Military Installations: All Risks Policy

5. An "All Risks" Policy covers the holder's property against all risks in Australia and Papua and New Guinea.
6. Conditions attaching to the policy are as follows -
- (a) The assured will bear the first £5 of each and every loss;
 - (b) All claims must fall within the scope of the policy;
 - (c) The policy excludes:-
 - (i) wear, tear and gradual deterioration of any article insured;
 - (ii) mechanical derangement of cameras and binoculars.
 - (d) Risks of war, riot and civil commotion are not covered;
 - (e) Limit any one Assured £250 and £50 any one article.
7. It is essential that property be insured for its correct value in order that the insured party or person in the event of a loss receives fair compensation. The premium rates and procedures are as follows:-

Premium Rates

Commissioned Officers	60/- per £100 of value
Other Ranks	50/- per £100 of value

Premium payments, Proposal Form and Claims as in 4(b), (c) and (d) above.

Fidelity Guarantee (Misappropriation of Unit, Canteen or Mess Funds)

8. COs will realize the wisdom of holding a Fidelity Guarantee policy in respect of those persons responsible for control and handling of Unit Canteen or Mess cash funds and stocks. This policy requires that in the event of a claim arising, the person or persons guilty of the offence must first be proven guilty in a civil or military court. Application should be made to the court for restitution.

9. The terms of the policy are as follows:-

- (a) Premium Rates - Premium Rates are available upon application to the HQ AACS Detachment;
- (b) Proposal form A letter should be addressed to the HQ AACS declaring the names of the persons over whom the cover is required and the amount of cover for each person, enclosing a cheque for the premium involved. Where a person named in the original proposal ceases to be employed in the position for which the cover was taken out, the name of the person substituted will be advised in writing to HQ AACS;
- (c) Claim - Claims setting out full particulars of the loss should be submitted promptly to HQ AACS.

Storage and Transit Insurance - Household Furniture and Effects

10. Insurance covers can also be arranged on householders' furniture and effects, the property of Army personnel families whilst in stores and/or transit anywhere in Australia.

.....

11. Insured property (known as the interest) in store may be covered against the risks of fire and burglary if required. Premium rates will vary according to the location and construction of each store. For fire cover the premium would be approximately 5/- for each £100 of cover for interest in a brick store, and 10/- for each £100 of cover for interest in a wood or iron store. A burglary cover would cost approximately 10/- for each £100 of cover.

12. Insured property in transit can be covered against loss of, or damage to the goods by fire, collision, derailment and/or overturning of the carrying vehicle including the risks of theft, pilferage and non-delivery. The rates for this cover vary according to the length of travel involved.

Television - Fire, burglary and damaged parts

13. Comprehensive cover is available to a unit, mess, serving member or civilian employee of the Department of the Army against a risk of fire, burglary or damaged parts of a television receiver. Premium rates are available upon application to HQ AACS Detachment.

General

14. Serving members or employees of the Department of the Army residing outside of a military installation can effect their insurance through the Canteens Service. However, they need first apply to the HQ AACS.

Cancellation

15. The notice concerning 'Insurance; Personal Effects of Members of the Army' published with MBIs dated 23 Aug 57 is hereby cancelled.

25. INCOME TAX ON GRATUITIES PAYABLE TO MEMBERS OF THE AMF

MBI 4/59 is reproduced hereunder:-

1. Under existing approvals, members within the following categories are eligible for gratuities on completion of their engagements or appointments notwithstanding that they may continue to serve:-
 - (a) Officers serving on short service commissions;
 - (b) Members of the RASR;
 - (c) Members of the Women's Service (excluding officers of the RAANC who are contributors to the DFRB Fund);
 - (d) Members of the Special Overseas Force for Korea who were enlisted from civilian life.
2. In addition to the foregoing, gratuities are payable to officers who have been promoted from the ranks who:-
 - (a) As other ranks elected under Section 80 of the DFRB Act not to become contributors to the DFRB Fund; and who
 - (b) Have elected to receive any Pay Code gratuity to which they may have become entitled.
3. In view of the incidence of taxation on gratuities which are paid other than on final discharge, approval has been given for members who receive such payments and who continue to serve, in accordance with paras 1 and 2 of this instruction, to be permitted to choose:-
 - (a) To be paid when the entitlement accrues - the amount to be taxable in full; or
 - (b) To be paid on final retirement - only 5% of the amount to be taxable. In this event, no interest will be paid on the amount which is held for the member until discharge.
4. Where a member who continues to serve is entitled to a gratuity in accordance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of this instruction, such gratuity will not be paid until his discharge, unless the member specifically requests payment. Where a member desires payment immediately, he should apply for it to the Command Paymaster controlling his account, indicating in his application that he is aware that the whole of the gratuity will be assessable for taxation purposes.

26. SAFETY PRECAUTIONS - SPRAYING WITH ARSENICAL WEEDKILLERS OR POISON SPRAYS

MBI 12/59 is reproduced hereunder:-

1. The following instructions will be promulgated immediately prior to each occasion of use to all personnel handling arsenical weedkillers or poison sprays:-
 - (a) Protective clothing will be worn when spraying;
 - (b) Weedkillers will not be used from a knapsack spray;
 - (c) Weedkillers will not be used in sprays used for killing flies, etc.
 - (d) Rubber Gloves and a rubber or waterproof apron will be worn when mixing the weedkiller and when spraying;

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS - SPRAYING WITH ARSENICAL WEEDKILLERS OR POISON SPRAYS

(Cont)

- (e) If the skin is splashed or otherwise contaminated with weedkiller or the liquid spray, work will be discontinued immediately and the skin thoroughly washed;
 - (f) Those who have handled weedkiller containers will wash their hands thoroughly immediately afterwards;
 - (g) Those who have used the spray will wash their hands thoroughly and shower for at least five minutes afterwards;
 - (h) Sprays used for spraying weedkiller will be thoroughly cleaned after use.
2. Personnel handling weedkiller who show any signs of illhealth, in particular, loss of appetite, weakness, nausea or indigestion, soreness of the eyes or any affection of the skin, will report to the medical officer immediately for examination.
3. Unless adequately protected, personnel will be debarred from moving through sprayed areas for at least 24 hours after spraying. This is of particular importance in family areas where, in warm weather, all children are bare-legged and, in many cases, bare-footed.

15. DISCIPLINE - MT

1. A large number of traffic accidents are due in part to bad driving habits which, while not amounting in themselves to dangerous driving, reduce the drivers control over his vehicle to such an extent that he is unable to meet unexpected minor hazards.

2. Such habits arise frequently from over confidence on the part of the driver, and can be avoided, by continued attention being paid to driver training after a driver has qualified, to ensure that the driving procedures taught in Mechanical Vehicle Training Vol I Part II (WO Code 8673) are maintained.

3. Common faults are:-

- (i) Bad cornering
- (ii) Travelling too close to the vehicle in front
- (iii) Risky overtaking
- (iv) Continually changing to other traffic streams to gain a temporary advantage
- (v) Failure to observe the clauses of the Highway Code relating to white lines
- (vi) Flicking of head lamps in recognition of comrades driving other vehicles
- (vii) Failure to dip head lamps when passing or following other vehicles at night
- (viii) Bad signalling, combined with excessively sudden slowing down.

4. These faults will be brought to the notice of all drivers, and of officers and NCO's who have occasion to act as vehicle commanders.

2. The secretary's office is located on the main road leading to the ISTANA and is well signposted.

10. ENDORSEMENTS OF PASSPORTS AND CHILDREN BORN IN MALAYA/SINGAPORE--
ACTION BY PARENTS

1. The endorsement of the name of a child on one of its parents' passports, usually the mother's enables a child (under the age of 16 years) to travel to AUSTRALIA without requiring its own passport.
2. An endorsement does NOT have the effect of registering a child as an AUSTRALIAN citizen. The procedure to be adopted for the registration of a child as an AUSTRALIAN citizen is detailed in RO 754/57.
3. The fee for an endorsement on a passport is \$1.00.

3 PAR R.O. 754/57 is republished hereunder:

CHILDREN BORN IN MALAYA/SINGAPORE -ACTION BY PARENTS

1. This order sets out the procedure to be followed by parents to whom a child is born in MALAYA or SINGAPORE, to ensure correct registration and payment of all allowances.

NOTIFICATION OF BIRTH

2. When a child is born, to the wife of an Australian serviceman, in a British Military Hospital the Hospital registers the birth of the child. One copy of the Certificate of Registration of Birth is then forwarded to the civil Registrar of Births and Deaths and one copy is handed to the child's parents.
3. The Certificate of Registration of Birth is NOT a Birth Certificate. To obtain a Birth Certificate the child's parents must present the Certificate of Registration of Birth to the civil Registrar of Births and Deaths at either:-

(a) City Council Office
St Andrews' Road
SINGAPORE

(b) Federal House Building
Opposite Loke Yew Building
KUALA LUMPUR.

The Registrar of Births and Deaths will issue a Birth Certificate on payment of a fee of \$2.

In the case of a child born, to the wife of an Australian serviceman, in a civilian hospital in MALAYA/SINGAPORE, the parent must himself register the birth of the child with the civil Registrar of Births and Deaths.

5. Immediately a child is born to an Australian serviceman in MALAYA/SINGAPORE, the member must immediately notify his company etc clerk and obtain from him a "Form 'C' Variation of Malaya Allowance Advice". The Form 'C' will be completed by the member and returned to his company etc pay representative who will make the necessary adjustments to the member's pay and allowances.

REGISTRATION AS AN AUSTRALIAN

6. A child, of an Australian serviceman, born in MALAYA/SINGAPORE is automatically at birth a British Subject, but is not automatically an Australian Citizen. Also before the child can be registered as an Australian Citizen, the male parent must himself be an Australian Citizen.
7. An Australian serviceman who was born in Australia is automatically an Australian Citizen. A member who was born elsewhere must either be already registered as an Australian citizen or must become one before he can apply for registration of his child.
8. Application for registration as an Australian citizen (either of the male parent or of the child) should be made by the soldier to the Australian Commission

(a) Grosby House
Robinson Road
SINGAPORE

(b) 40 Ampang Road
KUALA LUMPUR.

9. MALAYA ALLOWANCE

The additional food allowance of 4/20 (AUST) per day payable for each child will be entered in the soldier's paybook immediately Form 'C' "Variation of MALAYA Allowance Advice" has been completed by the soldier.

MATERNITY ALLOWANCE AND CHILD ENDOWMENT

10. Australian servicemen are entitled to claim Maternity Allowance and Child Endowment for children born to them in MALAYA/SINGAPORE. Such claims must be submitted on Form SCL "Claims for Maternity Allowance and/or Child Endowment". The Form SCL should be obtained, by the soldier, direct from the Australian Commission at either of the addresses shown in Para 8.
11. Information as to the amounts payable and the method in which the form should be filled out are printed on the back of Form SCL.
12. The claim form SCL should be completed, by the member, in accordance with the printed instructions and returned to the Australian Commission.

- 13. It is not possible to obtain payment of Maternity Allowance or Child Endowment through a Post Office in MALAYA/SINGAPORE. A Member claiming Maternity Allowance or Child Endowment should nominate a bank account, in AUSTRALIA, to which payment can be made.
- 14. Should the member desire to transfer the money, paid into the bank account, to MALAYA/SINGAPORE this can easily be arranged by his bank in AUSTRALIA.
