

99. DEFENCE FORCES RETIREMENT BENEFITS ACT 1948-58 PURCHASE OF SERVICE IN CMF CAMPS OF CONTINUOUS TRAINING

- 1. AHQ have advised that certain service in LMF camps of continuous training is covered by section 26 of the DFRB Act, which deals with the purchase of past service for pension purposes.
- In the past, numbers of applications to purchase service in CMF camps of continuous training held during the early part of World War II have been received by the DFRB Board, but owing to some legal uncertainty, these have not been accepted unless the CMF service formed a continuous period with other purchasable service in the AFF or in the CMF after the member's call up for FTD.
- In response to further applications from serving members, the matter was referred to the Attorney-General's Department which has ruled that service with the CMF in a camp of continuous training whether continuous with later service in the war-time Forces or not, if full-time service for the purpose of section 26.
- 4. The DFRB Board has therefore agreed that a member who is already contributing for past service under section 26 and now desires to purchase further service in the category referred to in para 3, will be permitted to do so.
- 5. Elections to purchase such service, must be made on a DFRB Form 36, certified by the CPM of the member's Comd of enlistment, and sent to the DFRB Board through normal channels. Should any difficulty arise in verification of the member's service it should be referred to AHQ.

100. ADDRESSING OF HOUSEHOLD EFFECTS AND UNACCOMPANIED BAGGAGE TO AUSTRALIA

- In future all shipments of the above goods to AUSTRALIA will be addressed with the members Number, Rank and Name c/o Headquarters Command in which the member is reposted.
- 2. The current practice of consigning the effects direct to a removal agent or to the owner of the effects has proved to be unsatisfactory in many cases.



99. DEFENCE FORCES RETIREMENT BENEFITS ACT 1948-58 PURCHASE OF SERVICE IN CMF CAMPS OF CONTINUOUS TRAINING

- 1. AHQ have advised that certain service in CMF camps of continuous training is covered by section 26 of the DFRB Act, which deals with the purchase of past service for pension purposes.
- In the past, numbers of applications to purchase service in CMF camps of continuous training held during the early part of World War II have been received by the DFRB Board, but owing to some legal uncertainty, these have not been accepted unless the CMF service formed a continuous period with other purchasable service in the AIF or in the CMF after the member's call up for FTD.
- In response to further applications from serving members, the matter was referred to the Attorney-General's Department which has ruled that service with the CMF in a camp of continuous training whether continuous with later service in the war-time Forces or not, if full-time service for the purpose of section 26.
- 4. The DFRB Board has therefore agreed that a member who is already contributing for past service under section 26 and now desires to purchase further service in the category referred to in para 3, will be permitted to do so.
- 5. Elections to purchase such service, must be made on a DFRB Form 36, certified by the CPM of the member's Comd of enlistment, and sent to the DFRB Board through normal channels. Should any difficulty arise in verification of the member's service it should be referred to AHQ.

100. ADDRESSING OF HOUSEHOLD EFFECTS AND UNACCOMPANIED BAGGAGE TO AUSTRALIA

- In future all shipments of the above goods to AUSTRALIA will be addressed with the members Number, Rank and Name c/o Headquarters Command in which the member is reposted.
- The current practice of consigning the effects direct to a removal agent or to the owner of the effects has proved to be unsatisfactory in many cases.
