

122. MBI 4/59 INCOME TAX ON GRATUITIES PAYABLE TO MEMBERS OF THE AMF is reproduced

1. Under existing approvals, members within the following categories are eligible for gratuities on completion of their engagements or appointments notwithstanding that they may continue to serve:-
 - (a) officers serving on short service commissions;
 - (b) Members of the RASR;
 - (c) Members of the Women's Services (excluding officers of the RAANC who are contributors to the DFRB Fund);
 - (d) Members of the Special Overseas Force for Korea who were enlisted from civilian life.
2. In addition to the foregoing, gratuities are payable to officers who have been promoted from the ranks who:-
 - (a) As other ranks elected under Section 80 of the DFRB Act not to become contributors to the DFRB Fund; and who
 - (b) Have elected to receive any Pay Code gratuity to which they may have become entitled.
3. In view of the incidence of taxation on gratuities which are paid other than on final discharge, approval has been given for members who receive such payments and who continue to serve, in accordance with paras 1 and 2 of this instruction, to be permitted to choose:-
 - (a) To be paid when the entitlement accrues - the amount to be taxable in full; or
 - (b) To be paid on final retirement - only 5% of the amount to be taxable. In this event, no interest will be paid on the amount which is held for the member until discharge.
4. Where a member who continues to serve is entitled to a gratuity in accordance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of this instruction, such gratuity will not be paid until his discharge, unless the member specifically requests payment. Where a member desires payment immediately, he should apply for it to the Command Paymaster controlling his account, indicating in his application that he is aware that the whole of the gratuity will be assessable for taxation purposes.

123. MBI 8/59 UNLAWFUL POSSESSION OR DISPOSAL OF FIREARMS AND EXPLOSIVES is reproduced

1. In this instruction "explosives" means explosive substance of any kind and includes any ammunition containing a propellant, or explosive filling or live cap.
2. A member in possession of firearms or explosives, unless such are on issue to him as part of his authorised Army equipment, is amenable as regards such possession to the laws of the State or ordinances of the Territory in which he is serving.
3. Attention is drawn to DA 79. Ex-enemy equipment, other than personal effects of captured enemy personnel, is Commonwealth property, and unless a member has been duly authorised to retain it as a souvenir, its retention is an offence against the Defence Act.

4. Except when acting in the course of his duty, a member will not deliver or transmit to, or attempt to deliver or transmit to, any other person, or acquire in any way from or attempt to acquire in any way from, any other person, any firearms or explosives, the property of the Commonwealth.

124. MBI 12/59 SAFETY PRECAUTIONS - SPRAYING WITH ARSENICAL WEEDKILLERS OR POISON
SPRAYS is reproduced.

1. The following instructions will be promulgated immediately prior to each occasion of use to all personnel handling arsenical weedkillers or poison sprays:-
 - (a) Protective clothing will be worn when spraying;
 - (b) Weedkillers will not be used from a knapsack spray;
 - (c) Weedkillers will not be used in sprays used for killing flies, etc.
 - (d) Rubber Gloves and a rubber or waterproof apron will be worn when mixing the weedkiller and when spraying;
 - (e) If the skin is splashed or otherwise contaminated with weedkiller or the liquid spray, work will be discontinued immediately and the skin thoroughly washed;
 - (f) Those who have handled weedkiller containers will wash their hands thoroughly immediately afterwards;
 - (g) Those who have used the spray will wash their hands thoroughly and shower for at least five minutes afterwards;
 - (g) Sprays used for spraying weedkiller will be thoroughly cleaned after use.
2. Personnel handling weedkiller who show any signs of illhealth, in particular, loss of appetite, weakness, nausea or indigestion, soreness of the eyes or any affection of the skin, will report to the medical officer immediately for examination.
3. Unless adequately protected, personnel will be debarred from moving through sprayed areas for at least 24 hours after spraying. This is of particular importance in family areas where, in warm weather, all children are bare-legged and in many cases, bare-footed.

125. MBI 71/59 PERSONAL EFFECTS STOLEN OR ACCIDENTALLY DESTROYED OR DAMAGED:
COMPENSATION FOR OR INSURANCE OF is reproduced.

1. The Commonwealth does not act as the insurer of the personal belongings of its servants or tenants and the possibility of loss or damage due to fire, burglary or accident is a normal risk applicable to members in common with the community generally. This also applies to loss of or damage to regimental or mess property. Personnel, messes and units are, therefore, responsible for providing any protection such as insurance which they may desire.
2. A member of the Permanent Forces or a Department of the Army employee may arrange through the Australian Army Canteens Service to insure private property belonging to him or to his dependants living in camp or quarters anywhere in Australia or the Territory of Papua and New Guinea, and irrespective of the type of buildings in which they are housed. Members desiring to avail themselves of this service should apply to the nearest canteen for an appropriate proposal form and particulars.

3. Details of the insurance coverage which may be effected through the Australian Army Canteens Service are published as a Notice to these MBIs. The information will be displayed prominently on unit etc Notice Boards.
4. In exceptional circumstances where a member suffers loss or damage to private property and where he has not and could not reasonably have been expected to protect by insurance coverage his own or his dependants' belongings against loss or damage, a claim for ex-gratis compensation may be submitted for consideration.
5. Any such claim submitted will be accompanied by the following:-
 - (a) A full account of the events leading up to the loss or damage, together with a copy of any report by an investigating officer or proceedings of a Court of Inquiry;
 - (b) An outline of the member's normal duties and any special assignment at the time of the occurrence; and
 - (c) A Statutory Declaration from the member, supported where possible by signed statements from other members.
6. In the Statutory Declaration the member will:-
 - (a) Explain briefly the circumstances of the loss or damage;
 - (b) State if he was aware of this MBI or had been informed of its contents;
 - (c) In respect of each article lost:-
 - (i) outline the steps taken to recover the articles;
 - (ii) show the value when new;
 - (iii) show the value less depreciation;
 - (iv) state why the article was not insured; and
 - (v) attach receipts and vouchers (if held) as exhibits to the declaration.
 - (d) In respect of each article damaged, show the cost of repair, and attach supporting evidence.

MBI 80/59

126. ARMY HEALTH BENEFITS SOCIETY is reproduced.

Introduction

1. The Army Health Benefits Society (AHBS) began to function on 3 Sep 53 in accordance with its Constitution.

Aim

2. The aims of this MBI are:-
 - (a) To draw attention to the Constitution of the AHBS and to the information included in the AHBS Handbook and the AHBS Information Leaflet;
 - (b) To issue instructions regarding the administration of the Society.

Constitution

3. A copy of the Constitution is attached at Annex 'A'. It includes the rates of contributions and benefits payable for the different AHBS Schedules.

4. Rules under the Constitution will be issued separately.

They will contain instructions issued on administrative and policy matters additional to this MBI.

AHBS Handbook

5. The AHBS Information Handbook at present on issue is to be cancelled, and will be replaced by a loose-leaf type of booklet to be issued to all units, sub-units and AHBS Representatives and to every officer as a personal text-book. It will contain basically the same information as the present Handbook, with provision for easy amendment and for the addition of Rules of the Committee made from time to time.

AHBS Information Leaflet

6. An AHBS Information Leaflet will be prepared,, designed to show the basic details of AHBS Schedules and rates of contribution thereto, information re applying for membership, transfer between Schedules, lodging of claims, etc. and clearly stating where full detailed information on the Society may be obtained. This leaflet will be for issue to all members and intending or prospective members.

Administration of AHBS

7. A Committee of Management at AHQ comprising five members of the Society (including the DGMS or his representative) will administer AHBS in accordance with-
- (a) the Society's Constitution;
 - (b) the directions of the Military Board and/or the Minister;
 - (c) any directions from the Department of Health arising from its responsibilities in administering the National Health Act.
8. The Committee will submit a quarterly report to the Military Board on the activities of the Society. The report submitted at the end of the last quarter of each calendar year will cover the year's activities.
9. The Committee will submit an Annual Report to members after the Completion of each calendar year. This report will be published as a Notice to MBIs and will contain information on the activities of the Society throughout the year, and will include a copy of the Society's Audited Balance Sheet as at the end of the year.
10. Command Sub-Committees
- (a) Each Command (excluding NT Command) will appoint a Command Sub-Committee of not more than five which will include representatives of the Commander of the Command, preferably the senior military staff officer (as Chairman), DDMS and the Command Secretary. Not less than two members of the Sub-Committee will be members of the Society;
 - (b) Command Sub-Committees will administer the Society in their Commands as delegated by the Committee of Management in accordance with the Constitution; C Comd will administer NT Comd.
11. AHBS Unit Representatives
- Each CO will appoint an AHBS Unit Representative to assist members of the unit as required on matters relating to AHBS.

LEAVE FACILITIES - HONG KONG CHEERO CLUB

Background

In 1949, when there was tension in this part of the world, the garrison rapidly increased particularly in the NEW TERRITORIES where there were no social amenities. His Excellency the Governor Sir ALEXANDER GRANTHAM appointed a Committee to look after the welfare and entertainment of the men stationed in the Colony. Of the clubs which were opened by this Committee, only the CHEERO Club now remains.

The club is entirely financed by voluntary subscriptions from local civilians. It is subsidized so that prices of refreshment etc can be kept within the reach of a serviceman's pay, and also to meet the cost of dances, concerts and bathing parties as well as to provide prizes for games and competitions.

Location

The club is at present accommodated on the reclamation Car Park opposite the Guard Room of MURRAY Barracks. A new location in a modern building adjacent to the present site is planned, but this will of course depend on how much support the club gets from servicemen in the months to come.

Amenities

Hot and cold meals and drinks are on sale. Beer can be obtained from 12 noon till 14.00 hrs and again from 18.30 till 22.00 hrs.

Games facilities include Billiards, Table Tennis, Darts and other indoor pastimes.

The Reading Room is provided with a large variety of papers, magazines and periodicals.

The Lending Library is open daily including Sundays.

Outings are arranged for leave parties to Island beaches and the following are Regular Weekly Events:-

Tuesdays - Whist Drive - 8 pm - Cash Prizes

Thursdays - Darts

&

Fridays

Saturdays - Tombola.

Leave Accommodation

There is accommodation available at the club for fifty four other ranks for weekly leave - and an additional fifteen for over-night leave. Hot and cold showers are available. Accommodation may be booked by telephone 37344 or by booking in at the Reception Desk of the Club. Bedding is provided, and lockers are available for clothing but men should provide their own padlocks.

Payment

The cost of staying at the Club for one week is only \$50, this covers accommodation and three good meals each day. The \$50 is collected from each man on arrival, and in exchange he is issued with meal tickets to cover the three meals a day for the week.

Each man on the leave party should be paid ration allowance for seven days before leaving **his unit**. This is not always done by units and has in the past prevented men from using the Club for leave.

The cost of overnight leave is \$4 per night which covers bed and breakfast.

Booking and Reporting

Units are not given an allocation since this has not proved necessary. If units do find that they are not getting sufficient vacancies an allocation can be arranged. Bookings are made by units direct with the Club.

On arrival all personnel report to the Club Sgt who does not book them in unless a valid leave pass is produced.

Dress

Civilian clothes of suitable standard may be worn at all times.

If uniform is worn it must be of a high standard.

Military Assistance

A Sgt is provided by Fms for a tenure of approx 4 months.

The HONG KONG Signal Regt have their Orderly Sgt available should any disciplinary action be necessary.

The HONG KONG Pro Coy mobile patrol visits the Club.

The Club Manager

The Manager Mr RA BROWN whose work is entirely voluntary is pleased to see COs or unit representatives at the Club at any time if they should wish to discuss any problems they may have in getting their men to the Club.

DUTY - HOUSEHOLD EFFECTS

The following is the text of a letter received from the Comptroller General of Customs and Excise, AUSTRALIA.

I would advise that for Customs purposes furniture is not regarded as personal effects and is not automatically free of duty when imported by its owner.

However, household effects which have been in actual use by a passenger for at least one year are admissible free of duty to a value of £A400 per adult passenger. Two members of a family, being children, may be regarded as one adult. It is quite probable, therefore, that the articles mentioned in your letter would be so admissible as you and your wife have an £A800 allowance between you.

I would add that the furniture may, at the discretion of the Quarantine authorities, need to be fumigated and if this is the case you may expect a small charge for them for this service.

(a) E nemy Forces

- (1) On 10 Jul 59 the ab o fd offr from GRIK visited the ladang of Pengulu ALI which is loc at the junc of the Sg BELUM and Sg RENGIT at VE 124670 . The fd offr was given certain info b y two abos named GOH and AWEH .
- (2) Six CT's have been visiting ALI's ladang three or four times per mth to collect tapioca . They stay overni and take three or four abos back to their camp to ca rry the tapioca . ALI and his 2ic are the main contacts and are pro CT . The last time the CT's visited the ladang was on 27/28 Jun . On this occasion they gave ALI an MCP manifesto
- (3) The CT camp (hereafter ref to as camp A) is in the Bt JUALI area at VE 076571 and is one days march from ALI's ladang . The camp was first occupied in Feb 59 ; was known to be occupied on 3 Jul , and is almost certainly still in use .
- (4) There are six plastic type bashas and two sentry posts . There are eleven CT's - six who visit ALI - four who man the sentry posts - one female and a four yr old child .
- (5) The CT's are known to have two pistols , 1 rifle , 1 carbine , 1 sten and grenades . There is talk of an LMG . They wear jungle green , no hats have been seen ; are known to have hockey boots but move barefoot . Their names tie up with the 12 Dist ASAL . Their leader who calls himself ABONG is believed to be WL 00279 of TET MEUW .
- (6) Fifty feet behind camp A is the ladang of hostile abo , Fengulu SEROYAK . There are thirty to forty abos in this ladang .
- (7) SOUTH of camp A , approx three days march , is a second CT camp (hereafter ref to as camp B) . This camp is believed to be loc in the Sg CHEBONG area VE 0441 . The specific loc is not known but is believed to be within a 3000 yd radius of this map sq . It is probably the camp of BCM HENG HO and consists of about eight CT's .
- (8) In the event of camp A being attacked it is almost certain that the CT's would withdraw into SEROYAK's ladang , mingle and disperse with the abos and attempt to pass as abos . It is almost certain that the CT's would then head SOUTH to camp B .
- (9) Because of the influence of hostile abos such as SEROYAK and KERINCHING plus the activities of 12 Dist ASAL the abos are largely pro CT . 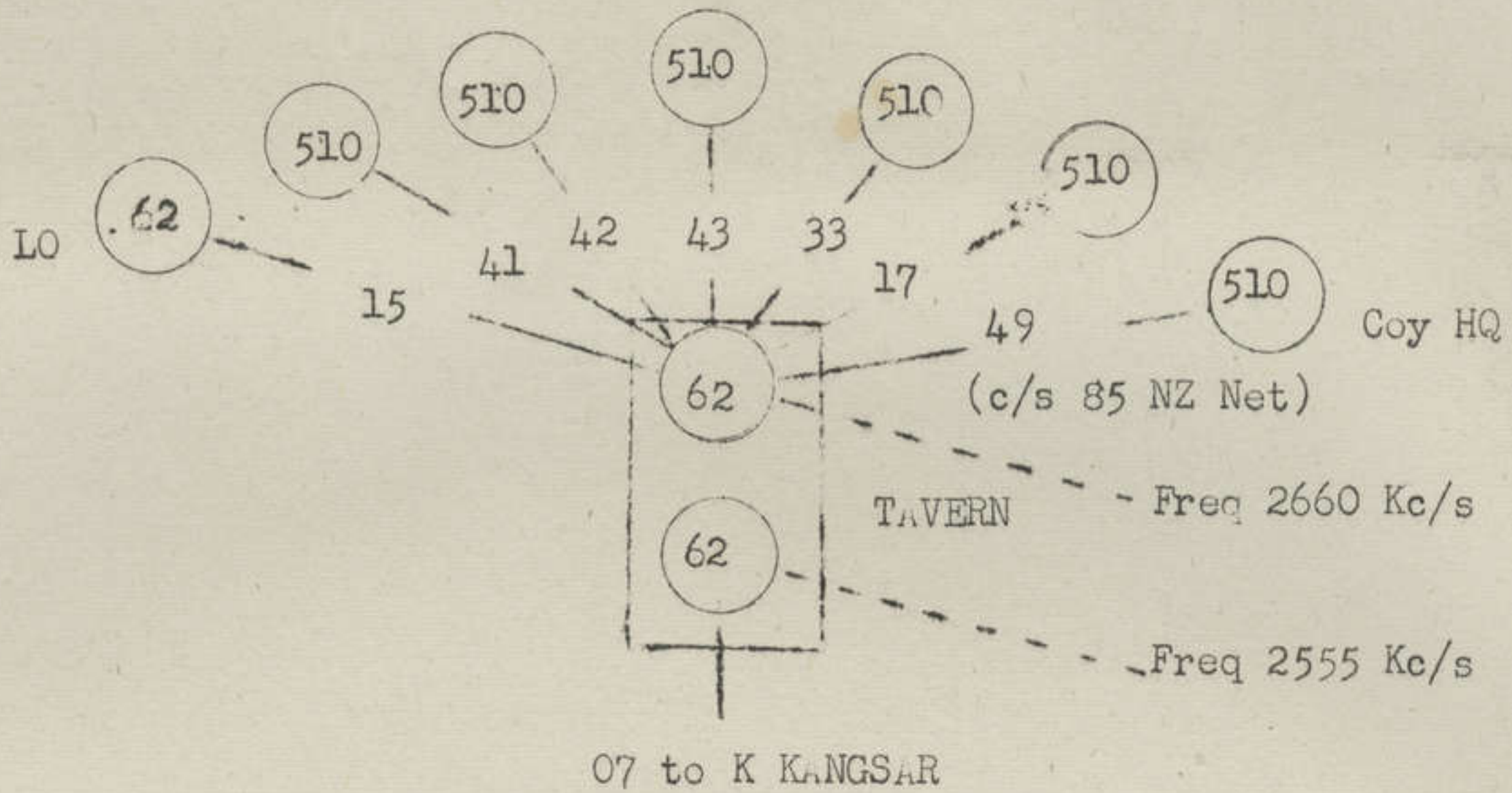

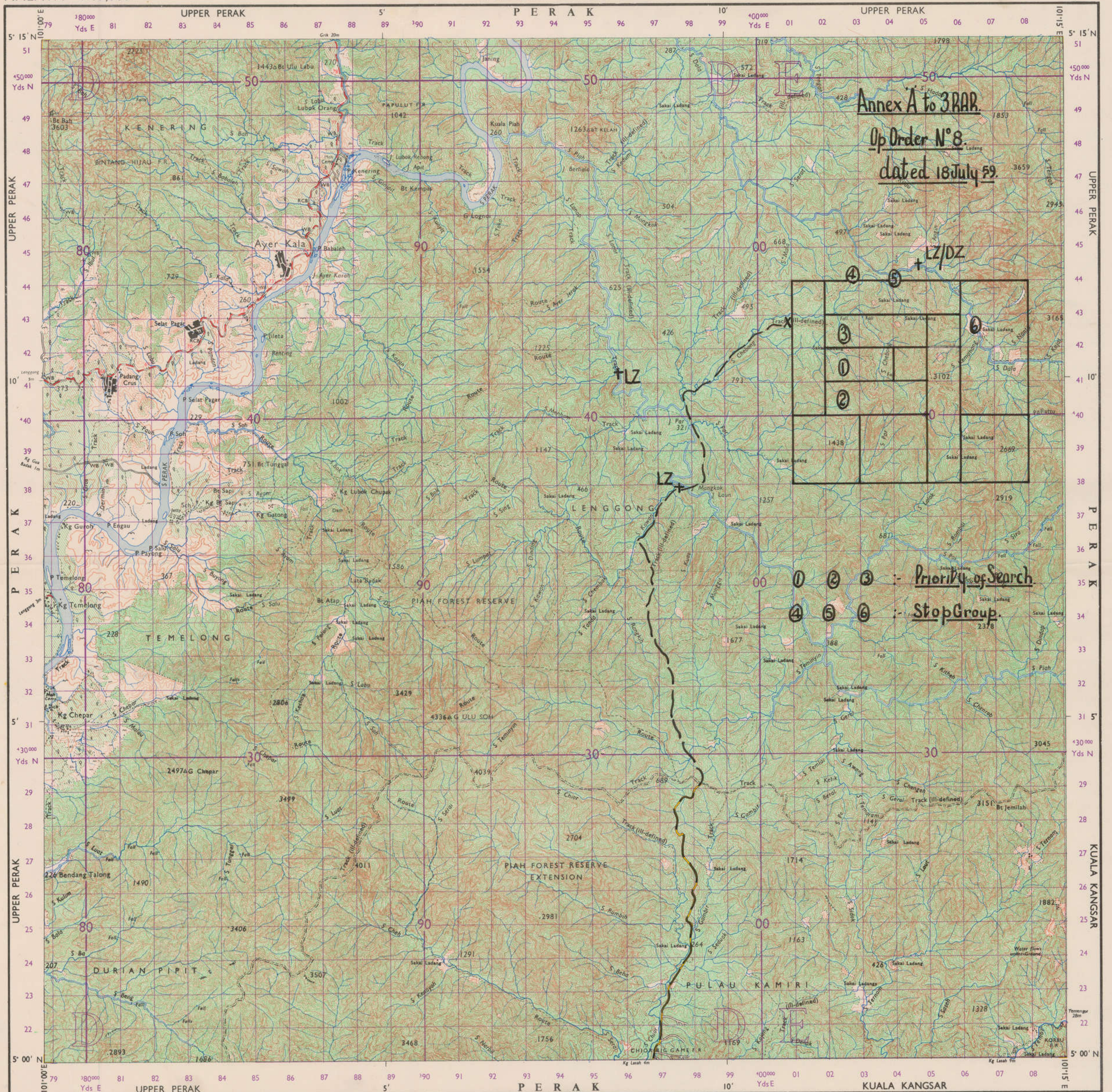

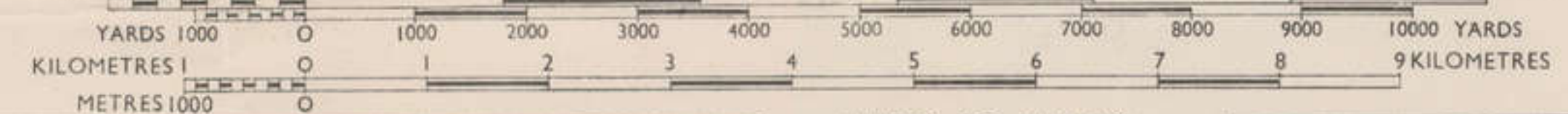
