

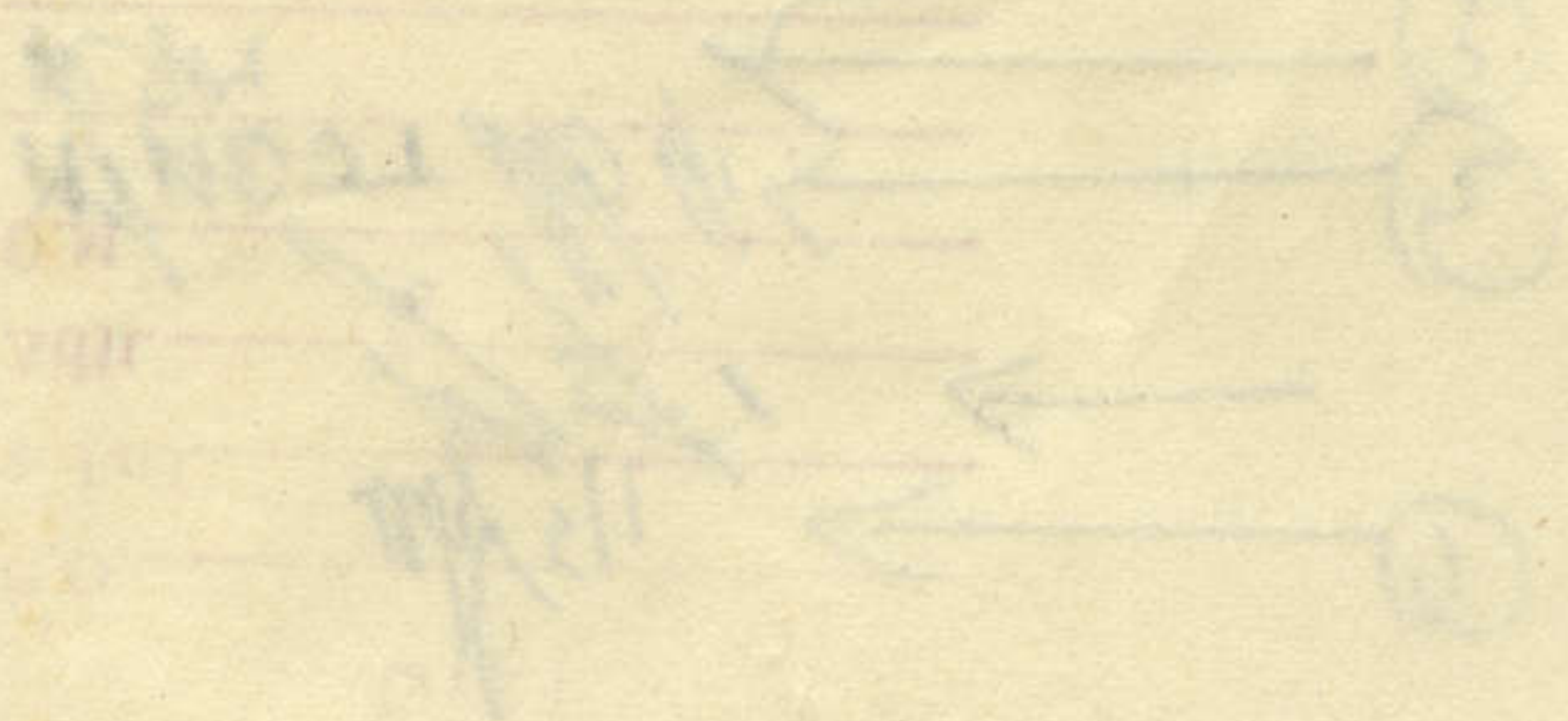

15. EXTRACTS OF 3 RAR STANDING ORDERS FOR MALAYA

SECURITY OF ARMS AND AMMUNITION - PARAS 10, 12, 42 and 46

INDIVIDUAL RESPONSIBILITY FOR SAFE CUSTODY OF ARMS AND AMMUNITION

10. Arms and ammunition, once withdrawn from unit or sub-unit central custody (e.g. arms kote, armoury or Q Store) become the personal responsibility of the individual to whom they are issued from such central custody, until properly returned.

12. Whilst in individual custody (VIDE PARA 10) weapons and ammunition will never be left unattended at any time, i.e. they will either be carried by the individual or otherwise left continuously in his sight at a range of NOT more than 6 feet. Immediate and severe disciplinary action will be taken for breaches of this order, and officers and NCOs will constantly be alert to detect offenders.

Particular attention will be given during daily barrack room inspection to ensure that the arms and ammunition are not left lying about.

LOSSES OF ARMS AND AMMUNITION

INDIVIDUAL ACTION

42. Any member of 3 RAR discovering the loss of arms and/or ammunition on issue to him or to any other member of such unit, will immediately report the loss by the quickest means to his Company Headquarters.

DISCIPLINARY ACTION

46. An individual who is responsible for the loss, through negligence, of arms will normally be tried by court martial. Loss of ammunition is a lesser offence, provided an immediate report is made. The most stringent action will be taken where unreported losses are subsequently discovered.

16. MISBEHAVIOUR AT LEAVE CENTRES

1. Reports of misbehaviour by members of 3 RAR whilst resident at or visiting leave centres and hostels are becoming far too prevalent.

2. All members are warned that if such behaviour persists the facilities of these centres may become considerably restricted.

17. OP "GINGER"-RESTRICTIONS ON TRAVEL AT NIGHT

1. With the introduction of Op "GINGER" a curfew has been placed on the main trunk road commencing at the ISKANDAR Bridge and SOUTH to IPOH. The period of curfew is from 1900 hours each night to 0600 hours next morning.

2. Members of the SF wearing uniform and travelling in either a civilian or army vehicle will be allowed to proceed on production of their ID cards.

3. Members of the SF wearing plain clothes and travelling in a civilian vehicle will be treated as civilians. NO travel permit is required but the car is liable to be searched. In particular, food may NOT be carried and the car may NOT stop whilst travelling between towns.

- (ii) personal clothing, eqpt necessaries, under arrangements coy conds (to be checked against scales laid down in Scale ust 231/4 part 2 & PARMIF Clothing Scale No 4 and Appx "D" to MCRG 2/57)
- (iii) unit arms and eqpt, under arrangements of sub units and depts by whom held on charge.
- (iv) vchs and unit hy wps under arrangements OC Sp Coy and Bn TO.

All clothing, necessaries and other items surplus to the scale laid down in the mob order will be withdrawn under arrangements made by II and returned to Ord. Surplus clothing will not be withdrawn until as late as possible (if mobilizing for emb elsewhere, clothing should not be withdrawn until emb orders are received).

MED ARRANGEMENTS

- 9. (a) Med Insps - immediately orders to mobilize are received, all ranks will be medically examined and their existing med classification will be confirmed. The MIO will report immediately to the Adj't any cases where anyone is regr-aded other than cl 1. Such personnel will be administratively prepared for reposting, while rfts will be demanded (see para 2)

- (b) In this connection, it is intended that the med insp of pers will be of a routine nature. The RMO, will however, be responsible for reviewing, and, where nec, reclassifying doubtful cases, incl any rfts joining the unit on mob.
- (c) Vaccination and Inoculation - coys will review vaccination and inoculation entries in MAF 83s; in cases of doubt the RMO will be consulted. Arrangements will then be made to have all pers requiring immunisation processed as early as practicable; details being arranged between the coy comds, unit Adjnt and the RMO.
- (d) Dent - all outstanding dent treatment cases will be completed as far as possible.

REAR DETAILS

- 10. (a) Definition - dependant upon the circumstances when the unit is mobilized, a rear details elem may be estb. It will be composed of pers serving with the unit who will no longer be required on mob e.g. pers not in med cl 1. The composition of rear details will be decided by the CO.
- (b) Duties and Composition - details concerning fmn, adm, duties and disposal of Rear details are contained in Appx M.

INTERIOR ECONOMY

- 11. (a) During the period of mob, a constant svy will be maint of all items on personal and unit issue; damage will be reported and repairs or replacement effected where nec.
- (b) During the period of mob, if temp issue camp stores in the form of pers and office furniture, cooking and/or san eqpt are issued, such items will be distinctly marked and not confused with Scale Aust 284/1 Part 2 and FARELF Clothing, Scale No 4 and Appx to MCRO 2/57.

TRG

- 12. (a) Irrespective of the unit mob sta, trg areas if not already allotted will be given to the sub units and trg syllabi covering the period of the mob, issued.
- (b) All weapons will be zeroed and testin and adjusting sights on unit hy wps effected.
- (c) Op Ammo will NOT be used for trg; trg ammo will be provided as nec.

PAY DOCUMENTATION

- 13. An examination of all paybooks will be carried out by the Pay Sgt and his staff and any discrepancies corrected.

PAD SCHEME

- 14. Shelter trenches will be dug and tps practised in the unit PAD Scheme for mob sta.

SECURITY

- 15. (a) All tps will receive instr on the necessity for strict security during mob, especially in outwards mail.
- (b) A svy of unit security measures will be made by the USO and any nec amdts issued.

POST

16. (a) Official and personal correspondence will cont to be addressed to the units designation and civ post address until orders are received for the substitution of the Army post address.

DIARY/TIME TABLE

17. Detail is contained overleaf. The obj is to provide a workable programme chronologically arranged, in the form of an aide memoire, which can be accelerated or expanded to meet the actual sit when mob is ordered.

DISPOSAL OF PERS

INTRODUCTION

1. Ref para 4 (a) - This appx deals with pers serving with the Bn on mob or who join it subsequent to mob, and who are not eligible to remain with the Bn. This appx and appx C give details of the machinery by which ineligible pers are disposed of, and deficiencies reported.

MED UNFIT PERS WITH BN ON MOB

2. (a) The mob order will state to the lowest med category permissible - at present the policy is cl 1 only.
- (b) Names of pers who do not reach the standard permitted when the mob med insp is held will be reported by the MIO to the Adjt.
- (c) During mob and in default of any specific orders, pers of categories lower than the min allowed will be posted to Rear Details, to await subsequent reposting.

PERS MEDICALLY UNFIT

3. After med insp by the MIO, any member below the min standard permitted, will be processed as in para. 2 above.

PERS IN HOSP ON DATE MOB COMPLETES OR WHO ARE ADMITTED TO HOSP AFTER THAT DATE

4. Pers in hosp on date mob is ordered to be completed, or who subsequently are admitted to hosp, will be posted to Rear Details. This, of course, applies only to pers who have been in hosp for a period of less than 21 days. Pers who exceed 21 days in hosp are automatically struck off str to X list.

CLOSING OF ACCOUNTS, LEDGERS

CLOTHING, EQPT AND MT STORES ACCOUNTS

1. (a) During mob offrs operating these accounts will ensure by frequent checks that stores and ledgers agree. Any item which will accompany the Bn when it moves subsequent to mob, will be struck off ledger charge by cert issue vouchers. The OIC Rear Details will be acquainted by offrs operating accounts of the nature of the account, the method of op, and his responsibilities regarding it.
- (b) After departure of Bn, action by OC Rear Details will be as follows:
 - (i) dispose of all stores left behind (normally through Ord channels). Vouchers must be completed in quadruplicate (one copy for temp receipt, one for formal receipt later, and two copies for Ord).
 - (ii) balance the ledgers which should show NIL if action is taken correctly in sub para (a) above. The vouchers may be received after the departure of the Bn for items taken with them. Such items must be taken on ledger charge, and if not supported by cert issue voucher, must be certified "Taken on Active Service".
 - (iii) closed ledgers will be despatched for audit to Comd HQ when ordered. In the event of ledgers not balancing correctly, an explanation must accompany the ledgers.

ACCN STORES ON BN CHARGE

2. If not handed over to an incoming unit or its adv party by the CM or OIC Rear Details, accn stores will be handed over to OIC Bk Stores or his rep.. AB 165 will be balanced and fwd to Comd HQ for audit.

POL ACCOUNT

3. On the day before the Bn is due to move from its mob sta, the POL account (AFG 3512) will be handed over by the Bn to OIC Rear Details, with all receipt and issue vouchers (AFG825 and 827), and all tpt work tickets. OIC Rear Details will transfer remaining stocks to unit designated to receive them. He will then close the account and fwd same to Comd HQ for audit, together with all supporting vouchers and work tickets.

MESSING

4. (a) All messing bills will be settled before the Bn leaves its mob sta.

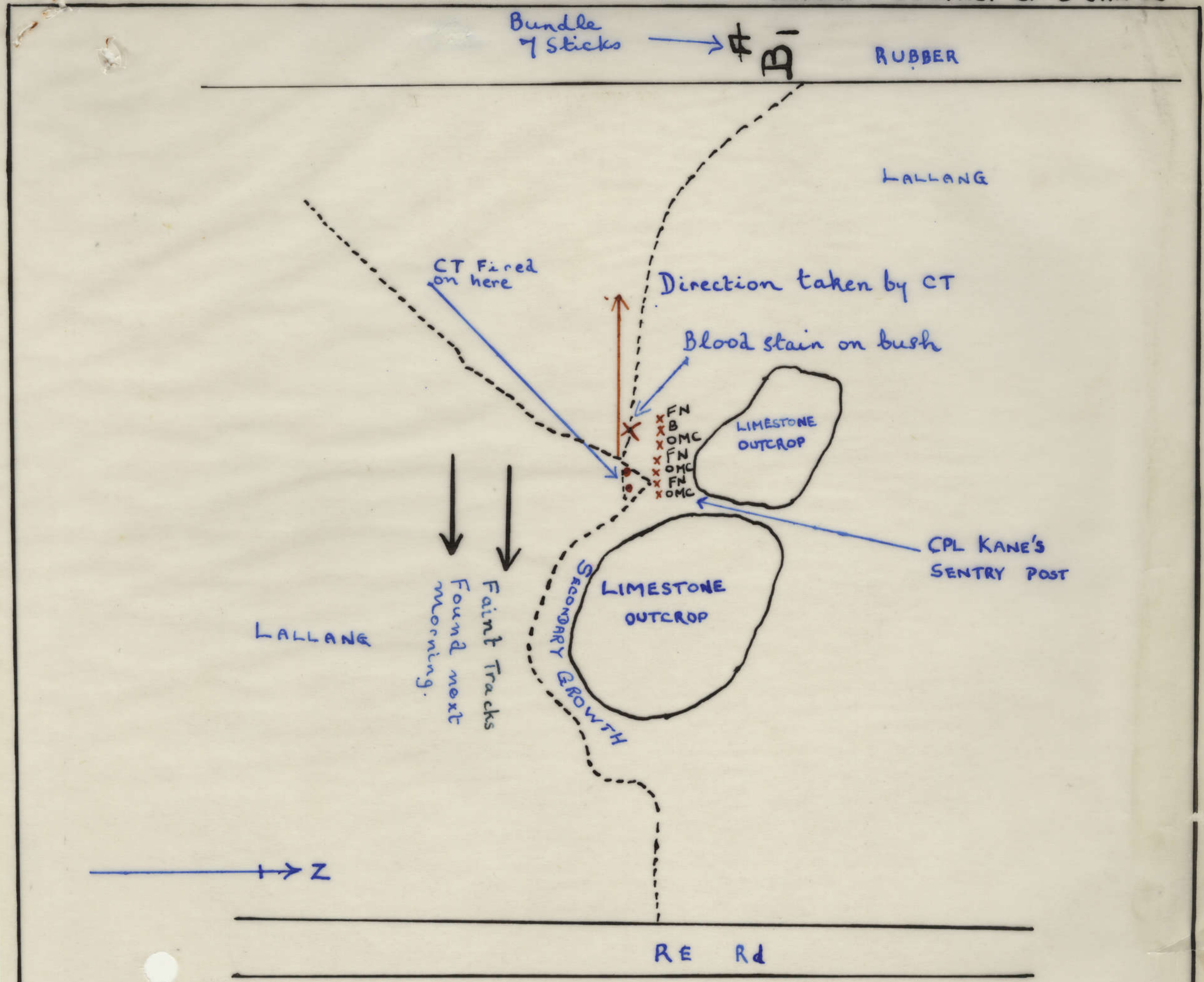

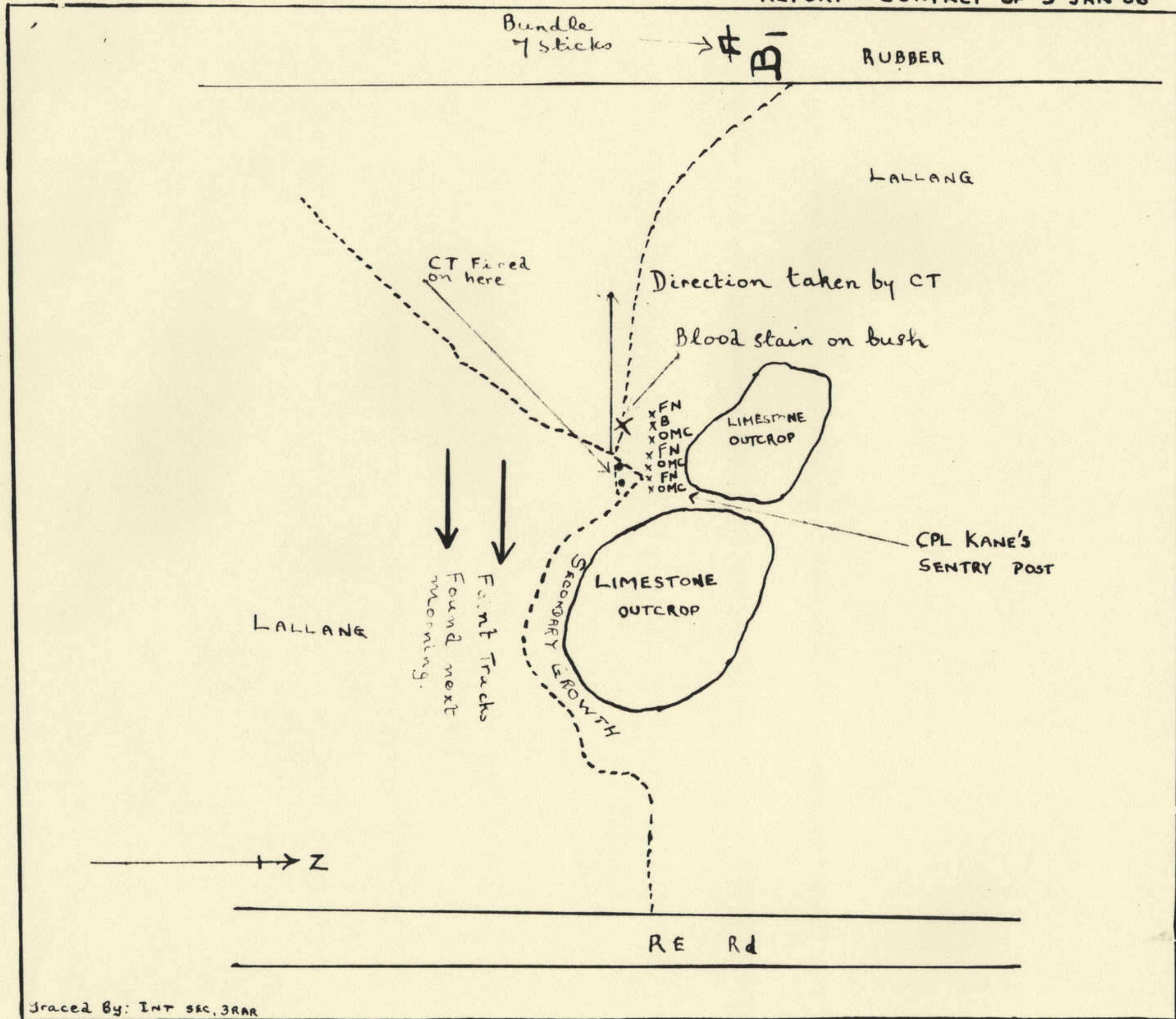

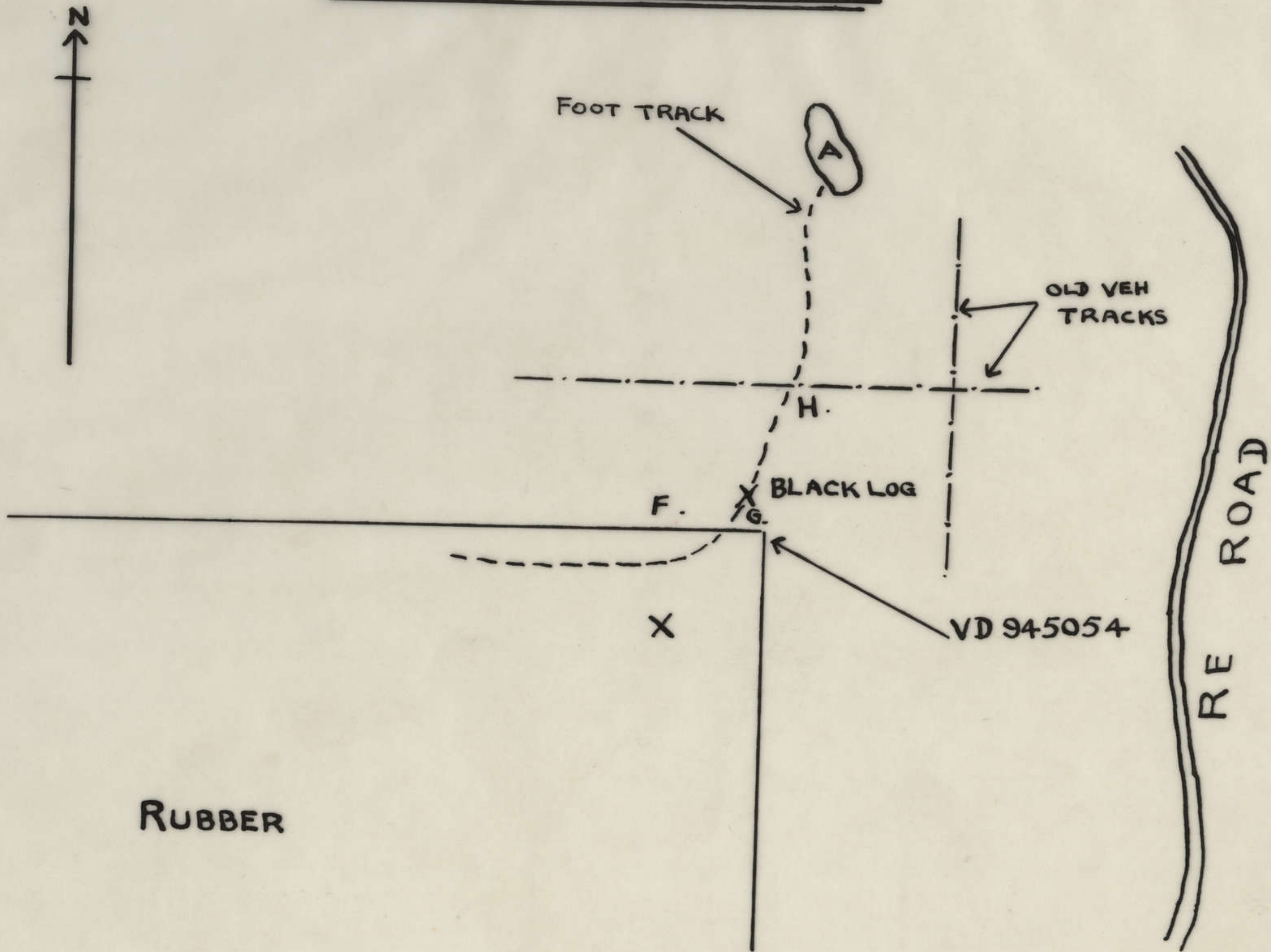

Loc track at VD 970062 for 1 CT and followed to VD 975060 where track lost. On 11 Jan 58 2 pl returned to base.

GEN AREA AND EVENTS



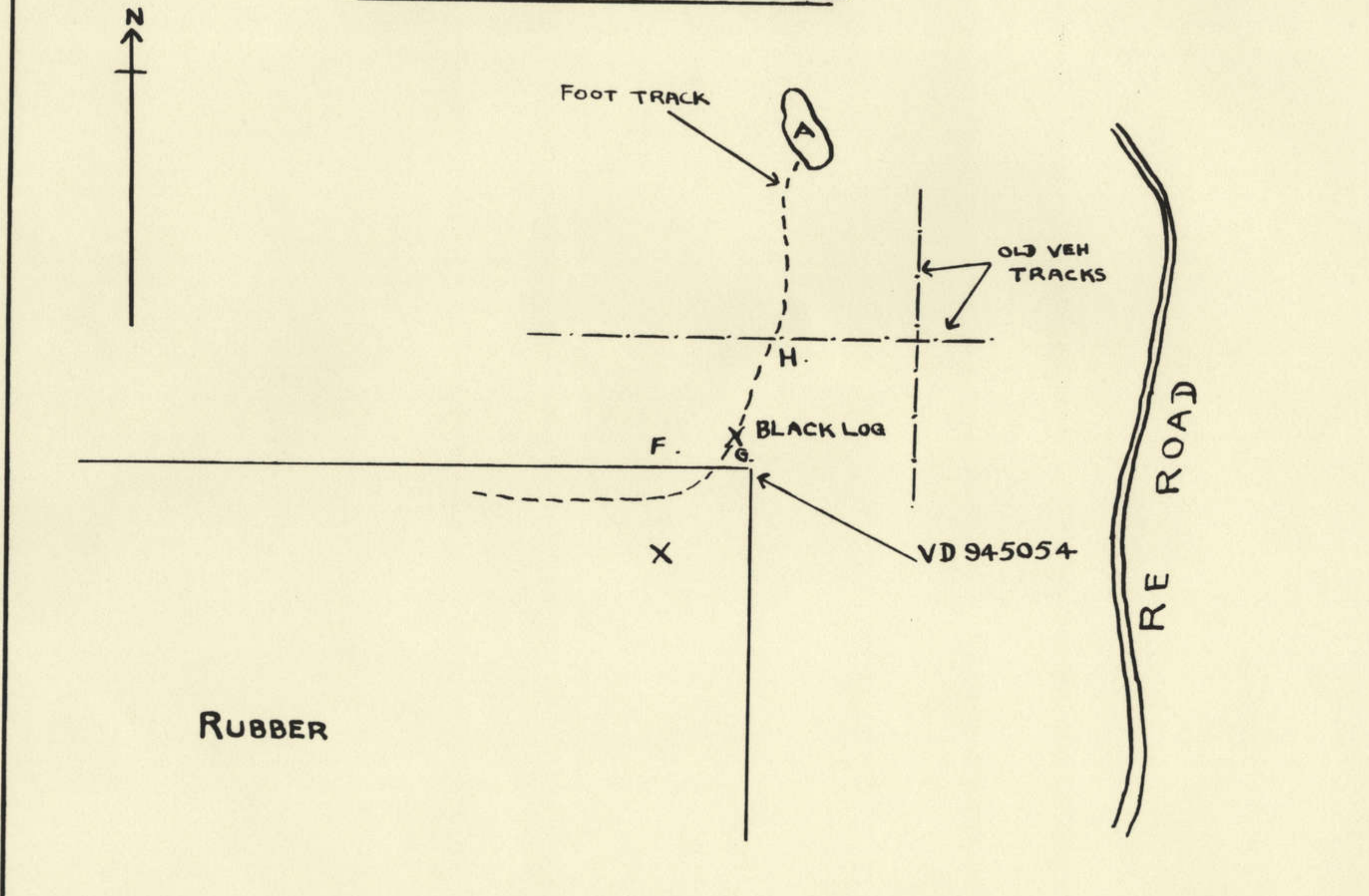

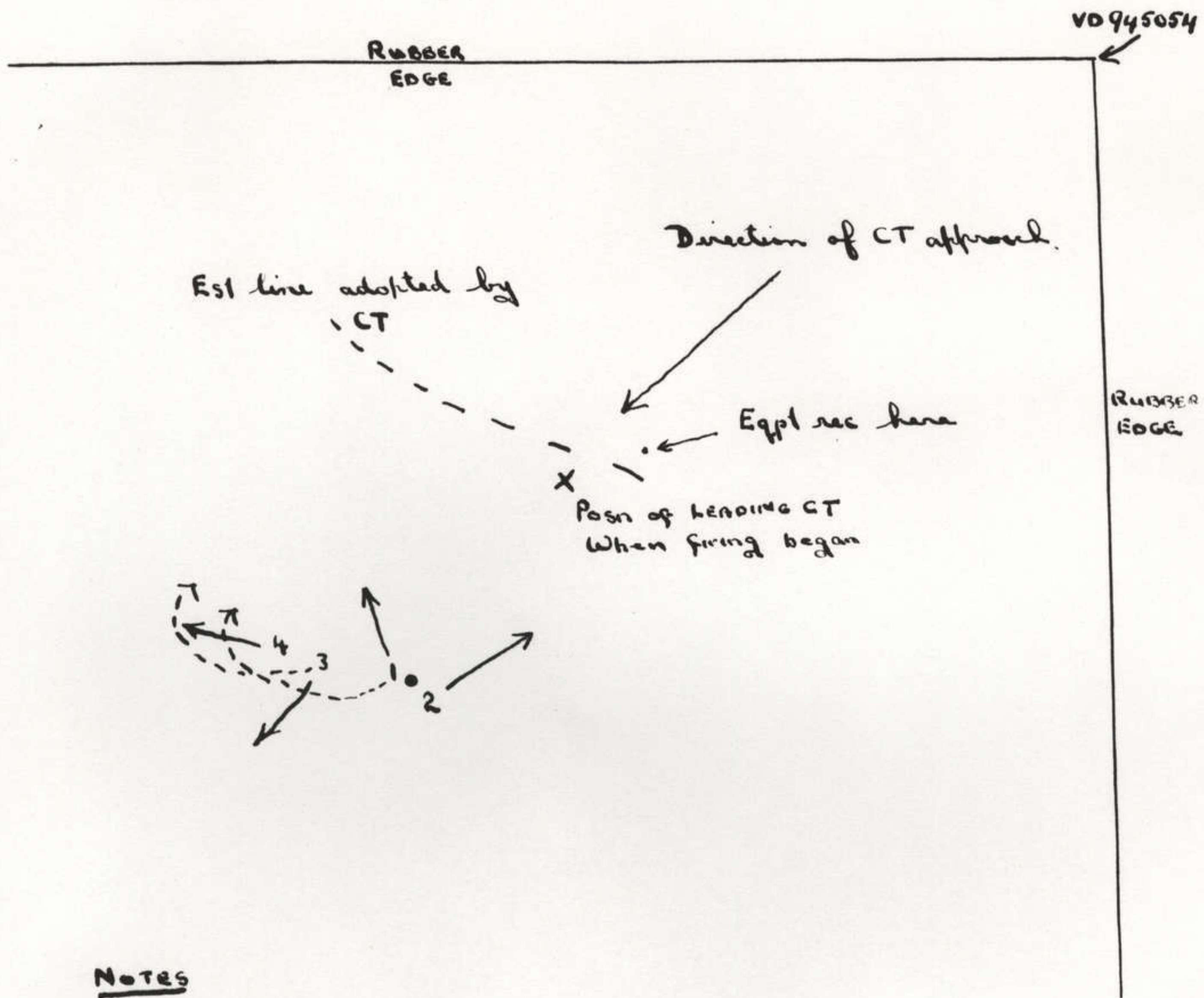

By Cpl K SMITH 7 Jan 58



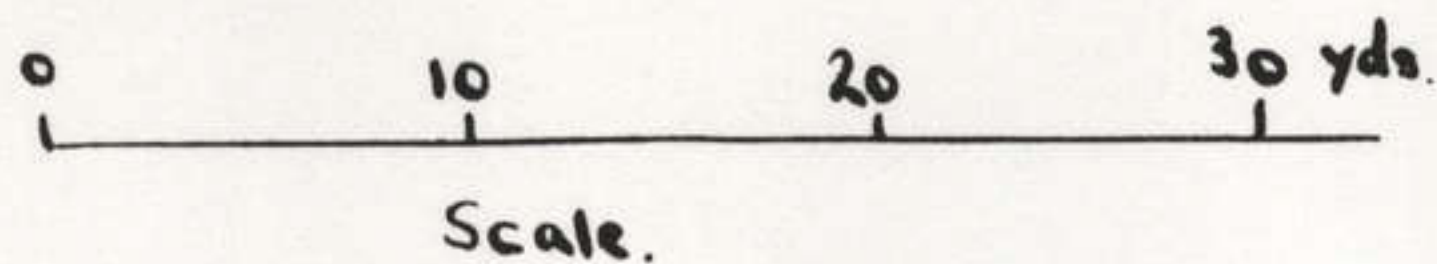

OPERATION "GINGER"

This leaflet is written to explain to the general public the Regulations affecting the supply and movement of foodstuffs, restricted articles, curfews, danger belts and cultivations etcetera, in the Operation "Ginger" area, and they come into force on the 15th day of January, 1958.

If you are in any doubt about these Regulations, do not hesitate to ask for advice. The Chinese Affairs Officers, the Penghulus, the Assistant Resettlement Officers, the Information Field Officers and the Police in the area will be glad to help you.

2. THE AREA IN WHICH THESE REGULATIONS APPLY: The Regulations mentioned in this statement apply to:—

- (a) The Mukims of Senggang Saiong east of the Perak River, but excluding the Malay Kampongs from Kampong Batang Kulim to Kampong Mandak.
- (b) The whole of the Mukim of Kota Lama Kanan.
- (c) The Mukim of Chegar Galah east of the Perak River.
- (d) The whole of the Mukim of Pulau Kamiri.
- (e) The whole of the Mukim of Sungei Siput.
- (f) All towns and villages within the boundaries of the Mukims of Kota Lama Kanan and Sungei Siput.
- (g) That part of the district of Kuala Kangsar excluding the sub-district of Parit lying east of the Perak River.
- (h) That part of the district of Kinta lying North of the Mukims of Sungei Raya, Sungei Trap and Blanja, EXCEPT Ipoh, Falim, Menglembu, Guntong New Village, Pasir Puteh, Pasir Pinji New Village, Kampong Simee New Village, Pengkalan Tin Ltd., Pinji Estate, Sengat Estate, Dusun Bertam Estate, Kampong Pari Hilir, Kampong Pengkalan Pegoh, Kampong Changkat Larang, Kampong Pengkalan Bharu, Kampong Pengkalan Gate Station, Kampong Pinji, Kampong Kepayang, Kampong Kurnia, Kampong Kramat Pulau and Kampong Sengat.

3. THE FOLLOWING ARE RESTRICTED ARTICLES:—

- (a) Padi, padi products, rice, rice products, flour, flour products, all forms of oats and barley, edible oil sugar, salt, concentrated foods, tinned foods, cooked food, dried fish, dried beans and dried peas;
- (b) Paper suitable for use in typewriting, printing or duplication, wax stencils and printing ink;
- (c) Drugs, medicines and other medical supplies;
- (d) Electric torches other than one loaded electric torch for bona fide personal use, and any type of dry cell electric battery;
- (e) Canvas or any article made wholly or partly from canvas;
- (f) Green or khaki cloth, pliable plastic material and rubberised or waterproof material and
- (g) Any article of clothing made wholly or partly from any of the materials specified in (f).

4. FOOD RESTRICTED AREAS are the areas where the consumption and movement of food are restricted and where people are permitted to live. Food may only be taken out of a Food Restricted Area under the conditions described in paragraphs 12 and 13 below.

5. FOOD PROHIBITED AREAS are areas within Operation Ginger Area, except the Residential Areas, metalled roads, access roads, and bridle paths leading to the Residential Areas.

6. SHOPKEEPERS dealing in restricted articles and foodstuffs must have a Licence issued by the respective District Officers, and must carry on their business in accordance with the conditions of that Licence.

7. RATIONING AND STOCKS

(a) The rice ration over the operational rice ration area will be:—

Men	—	3	katties	per	week.
Women	—	2½	"	"	"
Children	—	2	"	"	"

under 12 years of age.

- (b) The rice ration on the Central Cooking Area will be as follows:—
 (i) For those living in New Villages etc. where central cooking is applied:—

Any amount of cooked rice per week per head at the price laid down by the Chief Food Denial Officer from time to time.

- (c) Restricted Articles will be rationed as follows in the Operation Rice Ration Area and Central Cooking Area:—

	<i>Adults</i>	<i>Children under 12 years of age</i>
Flour	2 katties per week	2 katties per week
Salt	2 tahils	2 tahils
Cooking Oil	8 "	8 "
Sugar	12 "	12 "
Dried or Salt Fish	8 "	4 "
Tinned Milk	12 ozs	24 ozs
Dried Mee or Meehoon	1 katty	1 katty

- (d) Extra rice for feasts will be allowed on application to the respective District Officers.

- (e) Ration for eating shops and other users:— on permits issued by the Chief Food Denial Officer.

- (i) Edible Oil including solidified fats but excluding butter and margarine — 5 katties per week maximum.

- (ii) Salt — 12 tahils for each head of cattle. Nil for other animals. One pound for 10 pounds of ice or 15 katties for 200 pound of ice for ice factories. 2 katties per 10 gal. container of an icecream seller. $\frac{1}{2}$ katty for 500 one pound loaves for bakeries. 1 pickul for 5 pickuls of sauce for sauce makers.

- (f) Customers will only buy rationed article from the dealer with whom they are registered; they may change their dealer every month.

- (g) In the Ipoh exempted area, the Ipoh and Kuala Kangsar Police Districts Normal Restricted Areas, the normal rice ration will apply.

- (h) Retailers stocks of rationed articles are limited to two week's ration in respect of their registered customers.

- (i) Wholesalers stocks of rationed articles are limited to four week's supply of their normal sales.

- (j) Individual's stocks of rationed articles are limited to one week's ration.

- (k) At the end of every week Retailers will send in a return to the Chief Food Denial Officer, IPOH, copies of all invoices covering all restricted articles for which records are kept and which have been brought into stock during the week.

- (l) Padi producers in the Operational Area will be allowed to keep their stocks but will not be allowed to keep more than two week's ration of milled rice.

8. PROHIBITION OF SALES. In the Central Cooking and Operation Rice Ration Areas:—

- (a) Prepared Tapioca may not be sold unless the seller is in possession of a Licence permitting him to do so, issued by the District Officer.

- (b) Dried mee and meehoon may not be bought by eating houses or stalls for sale to customers uncooked.

- (c) Pliable plastic materials including tables cloths may not be bought, sold or moved.

- (d) Prepared oats may not be bought, sold or moved.

- (e) Padi; no non-producer will be licensed to sell padi. No producer may sell padi other than to a licensed mill or dealer.

- (f) Rice may NOT be sold in any form by eating houses or stalls.

9. **RECORDING OF SALES THROUGHOUT THE OPERATION GINGER AREA.** Each sale of the following articles in addition to those rationed in para 7(c) above will be recorded by the dealer recording the identity card number of the buyer and the amounts bought:—

- (a) Dried milk and bottled concentrated edibles other than condiments.
- (b) Canvas, green or khaki cloth, waterproofed or rubberised materials or articles of clothing made from these materials.
- (c) Canvas footwear over size thirty-two.
- (d) All forms of electric batteries.

10. **PUNCTURING OF TINS.** In the Operation Rice Ration and Central Cooking Areas all tins, with the exception of tinned milk and sales between licensed traders, will be punctured before sale with a hole not less than the size of a 20-cent piece.

11. **DEALERS.** Certain reductions will be made in the number of dealers in restricted articles where deemed necessary. Any infringement of the conditions of the licence or food denial regulations will result in the licence being cancelled.

12. **HAWKERS.** Throughout the Operation Ginger Area, hawkers will NOT be licensed to carry any restricted articles or foodstuffs except bread out of Food Restricted Areas and will NOT be allowed to stop and sell between Food Restricted Areas. Bread Hawkers must carry a stock book showing details of stock and daily transactions and may NOT stop and sell bread anywhere other than inside a Food Restricted Area.

13. **MOVEMENT OF RESTRICTED ARTICLES.** Throughout the Operation Rice Ration Areas and Central Cooking Areas:—

- (a) Movement of restricted articles by vehicle to estates, mines, and new villages off the main trunk road will only be permitted on MONDAYS and THURSDAYS with a permit specifying the restricted articles, subject to conditions in sub-paragraph (d) below.
- (b) In the Sungei Siput Police District and that part of the Ipoh Police District NORTH of a line between and all inclusive of Jelapang and Tanjong Rambutan, all such movements will be controlled by convoy.
- (c) Movement of restricted articles by food and bicycle to Kampongs will be allowed only on MONDAYS and THURSDAYS under a movement permit and subject to escort by Kampong Home Guard from points where access tracks leave the main roads to destination in each case.
- (d) Movements of restricted articles within the trade. These may be transported on main roads on any day by goods vehicle covered by tarpaulins or in motor vans. In each case the restricted articles to be securely fastened down and covered by a manifest from the owner.
- (e) Movement permits issued for restricted articles other than rationed ones previously mentioned will in all cases be impounded by the gate food check at the point of destination and returned to the office of origin every Saturday.
- (f) The usual exemptions referring to food for babies, invalids, train journeys, and fresh foods will continue to apply.
- (g) Movement of restricted articles for any purpose on days other than shown above will only be allowed by the District Officers or Food Denial Officer acting in conjunction with local OCPDs. Such permits to be issued only under the most exceptional circumstances.

14. **MONEY.** Normally it will be presumed that people taking money into rubber, cultivations or mines are taking it to the Communist Terrorists, and guards at gates will be told to advise people found carrying money to rubber, cultivations or mines, to return it to their homes unless they can explain satisfactorily what it is going to be used for.

15. **CURFEWS.**

- (a) All primary and secondary jungles in the Operation Area are subject to a 24-hour curfew. Permits for loggers and pipeline parties will include the stipulation that they must be clear of the jungle and on a recognised road or vehicle track by 4 p.m. each day.
- (b) All rubber estates, tapioca and vegetable cultivations in the Operation Area are curfewed from 4 p.m. to 6 a.m. as at present.

(c) The main trunk and certain secondary roads throughout the Operation Area are curfewed from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. Only persons with permits in motor vehicles can pass through. Other secondary roads are curfewed 24 hours as at present. Those roads affected will be marked by notice boards.

(d) Other non-residential parts of the Operation Area are curfewed from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. as at present excepting the Ipoh Non-Restricted area.

(e) All new villages in the Operation Area except Guntong, Menglembu, Pasir Pinji, and Kampong Simee are under perimeter curfew from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. and house curfew from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.

16. **DANGER BELT.** A danger belt between cultivations and the jungle edge has been declared and demarcated by signboards. No person is allowed to enter the danger area without prior written approval of the District Officer, and trespassers will be shot on sight.

All illegal cultivations in the Danger Belt will be destroyed without compensation.

A prohibited area has also been declared. Without written authority, entry into this area will result in arrest. This area is clearly demarcated by signboards.

17. **CULTIVATIONS.** All cultivations and small holdings must be signposted by the cultivators showing their names in English and the relevant vernacular language. All plots not signposted are liable to be destroyed.

18. **CATTLE GRAZING.** No grazing is allowed in the following areas:—

(a) East of a line from Tanjong Rambutan — Tanah Hitam — Royal Engineer Road — Sungei Kuang to Lasah.

(b) West of the Sungai Pari from where it crosses the Jelapang-Chemor road at the 10th mile stone to where it crosses the main railway line at 96 $\frac{3}{4}$ mile stone and thence following the railway line to the south gate of Sungei Siput.

19. **PROHIBITION OF THE USE OF ROADS.** Except with the written permission of the O.C.P.D. Sungei Siput North or the O.C.P.D. Ipoh, no vehicle, whether driven, ridden or otherwise, shall be permitted to be used on any road within the following areas except the main public highways between Chemor and Jelapang, Sungei Siput and Chemor. No person shall use or travel on any vehicle on any road within the areas mentioned below:

(i) The area bounded on the south by the District boundary, on the west by the jungle edge, on the north by the edge of Heawood Estate and Sungei Siput town perimeter fence and on the east by the main trunk Sungei Siput-Chemor road.

(ii) The area bounded by a line commencing at the point where the Mukim boundary of Ulu Kinta intersects the Sungei Siput North-Chemor Road; thence in a southerly direction along the said road to the junction of the Chemor-Jelapang Road; thence in a south-westerly direction along the said road to where it intersects the boundary of the Kledang Forest Reserve and thence along the said boundary in a northerly direction to where it crosses the boundary of the Mukim of Ulu Kinta.
