95. CUSTODY OF ARMS AND AMMUNITION - SAFE HANDLING WHEN TRAVELLING BY ROAD AND RAIL IN MALAYA

(a) Once arms and amm are issued they become the personal responsibility of the individual; losses are normally Court Martial offences.

(b) Pers sleeping with their arms will ensure that weapons are securely att to their persons by the sling, lanyard, etc.

(c) All pers travelling by rd or rail from PENANG will be issued with 10 rounds of amm.

(d) WEAPONS OR AMN WILL NOT BE LEFT UNATTENDED AT ANY TIME.

(e) LOADING OF WEAPONS

(i) Travelling by rd - on leaving the Town Board limits vehs will be halted and mags charged under supervision. On no account will a round be placed in the breach. Weapons will be unloaded under supervision on entering the Town Board limits of any maj town or immediately on arrival at a unit.

(ii) Travelling by rail - before entraining mags will be charged under supervision. On no account will a round be placed in the breach. Weapons will be unloaded under supervision immediately on detraining.

(f) LOADING OF WEAPONS

(i) Travelling by rail - weapons will only be fired on the orders of an Oftr or NCO.

(ii) Travelling by rd - each veh will have a veh cmd appointed. Each veh cmd will appoint two sentries who will be alert at all times. If the veh is ambushed the dvr will attempt to drive through the ambush and sentries will open fire. When clear of the ambush or as soon as practical the remainder of the tps will debus under the covering fire of the snetries. When all other tps are clear of the veh the sentries will debus. The veh cmd will then counter attack the CT ambush posn from flank and rear.

96. SANDYCROFT LEAVE CENTRE PENANG

- (a) Sandycroft Leave Centre PENANG will NOT be used by troops stationed on PENANG or in the BUTTERWORTH area other than those on leave at the centre.
- (b) This RO cancels 2 RAR RO 69 of 2 Mar 56.

76. DISCIPLINE - DRESS

The attention of all members is directed to the provisions of 2 BAR RO 28/56 para 2.

CT ANTI-PERSONNEL MINE

Introduction

This mine was recovered from a CT Camp by Security Forces operating in the Bongsu Area.

2. GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The CT Mine is of concrete construction of the anti-personnel type which may be operated by either of the following methods:-

- (a) Pull on static line attached to safety pin by person in ambush position
- or (b) Pull on trip wire attached to safety pin.

When actuated, the mine disintegrates scattering concrete and metal fragments over an area of 30/40 feet.

The mine is cylindrical in shape 7" in diam, and 7-1/2" in height. At the top is a metal support plate to which the striker way is soldered and from which the striker head protrudes being held in the armed position by a safety pin.

3. MAKE-UP

Tin plate container filled concrete and metal fragments to central filling cavity and striker way.

Actuating mechanism consist of two sections with an overall length of 8" as follows:-

- (a) Support Plate and Striker channel. The support plate is retained in position by two nuts screwed to bolts embedded in top of mine body at either side. The striker channel is soldered to the plate support and houses the striker and spring and fitted.
- (b) Cut down Ctge SA. 32 into which has been inserted a No 6 Commercial Detenator which is used as the intermediary.

4. EXPLOSIVE FILLING

Examination of the main Filling indicated that it was an explosive of the NG Group probably Nobels 62% blasting Gelignite.

5. TO NEUTRALIZE

- (a) Check for presence of Safety-Pin - if not in position destroy mine in situ.
- (b) Search for and neutralize any anti-handling devices.
- (c) Cut trip-wire if present.

6. TO DISARM

- (a) Check Safety Pin.
- (b) Remove nuts retaining Plate supporting.
- (c) Pull out plate with striker housing assembly attached.
- (d) Remove igniter assembly by inversion of mine and shaking gently.

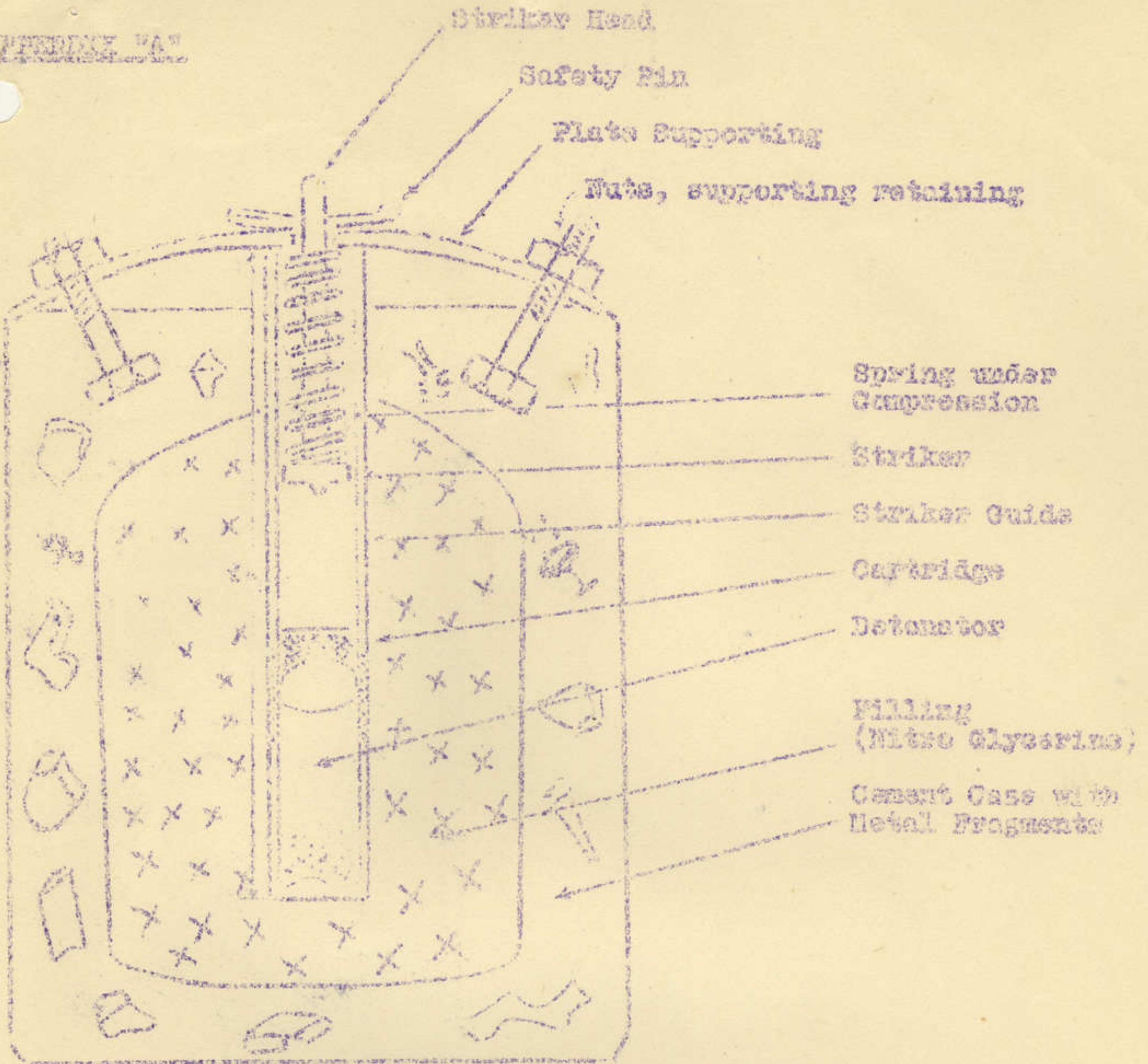
7. GENERAL

One mine was tested and it function normally leaving a crater approx 3 feet in diameter. The mine described was very well made and the standard of finish of the components indicated skilled workmanship in manufacture.

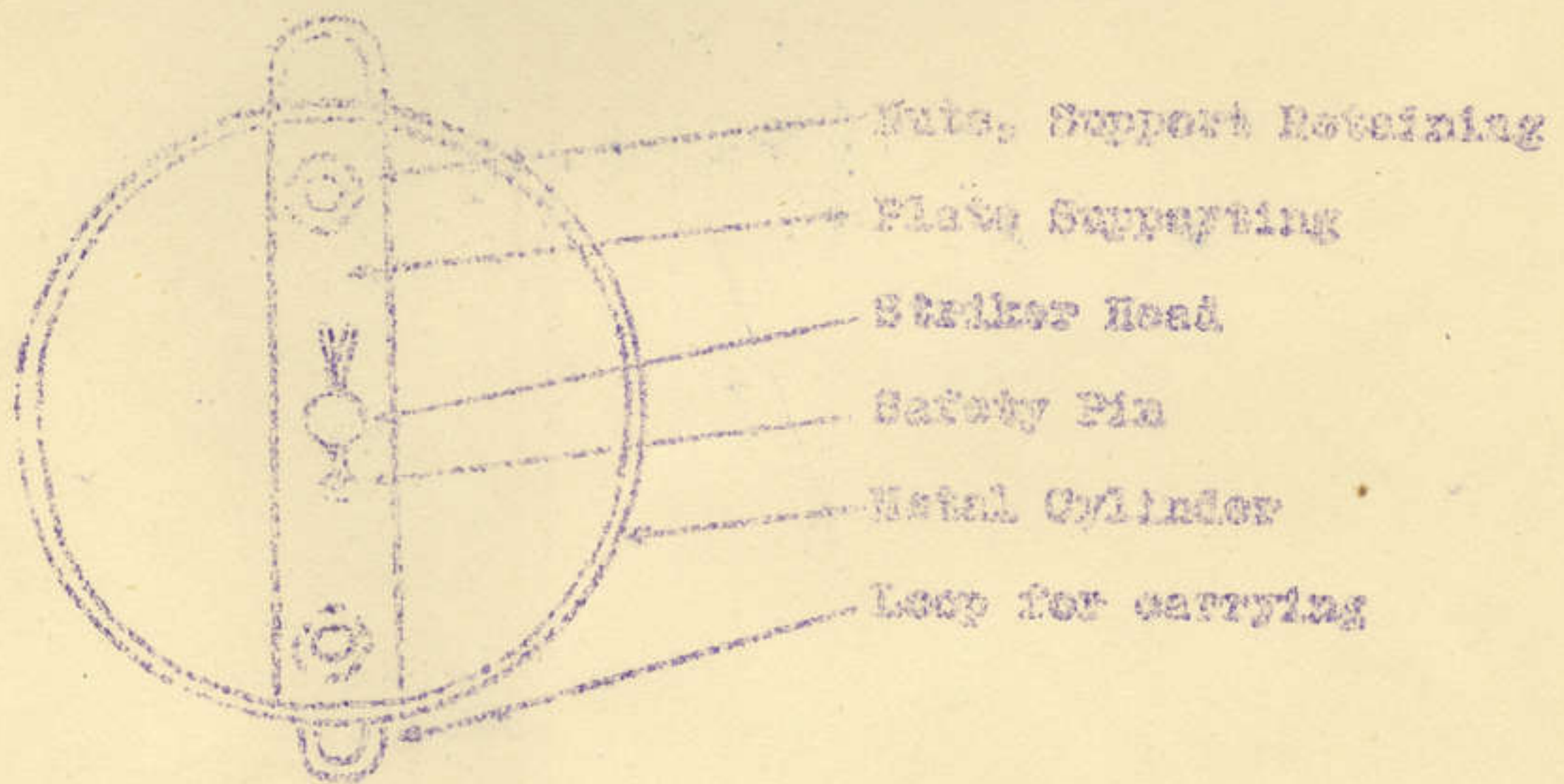
