NON ACCEPTANCE WHEN ALLOTTED 6.

Individuals unable to avail themselves of an Indulgence passage, when offered, will be placed at the bottom of the priority list. If a cancellation is made for operational reasons, then the member may be allotted a place at the top of the list at the discretion of the GOC 17 GUR DIV.

Passengers are liable to be landed at intermediate parts of call, if their berthsare required for individuals entitled to proceed at public expense; and must sign a statement that the conditions under which they embark are understood and accepted.

8. DISCIPLINE

All passengers travelling in troopships are subject to ship's standing orders.

9. DRESS

Correct uniforms must be worn when embarking or disembarking and during the voyage except during such periods as are approved by OC TROOPS. Voyage regulations do NOT give dispensation for WO's and other ranks to wear civilian clothes at any time on troopships, when moving as indulgence passengers.

10. BAGGAGE

Indulgence passengers are entitled only to normal cabin baggage and are NOT entitled to free portage.

11. EMBARKATION AND DISEMBARKATION

Indulgence passengers will comply with the normal regulations. Once embarked they will NOT go ashore again before sailing, as this interferes with normal embarkation.

12. DOCUMENTS

Applications will be submitted at least 21 days prior to the date of departure and will include: -

- (b) All rubber estates, tapioca and vegetable cultivations in the Operation Area are curfewed from 4 p.m. to 6 a.m. as at present.
- (c) The main trunk and certain secondary roads throughout the Operation Area are curfewed from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. Only persons passing through in motor vehicles can move. Other secondary roads are curfewed 24 hours as at present. Those roads affected will be marked by notice boards.
- (d) Other non-residential parts of the Operation Area, are curfewed from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. as at present, except Ipoh, Falim, Menglembu, Guntong New Village, Pasir Puteh, Pasir Pinji New Village and Kampong Simee New Village, non-restricted areas.
- (e) All new villages in the Operation Area except Guntong, Menglembu, Pasir Pinji and Kampong Simee are under perimeter curfew from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. and house curfew from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- 16. DANGER BELT. A danger belt between cultivations and the jungle edge has been declared and demarcated by signboards. No person is allowed to enter the danger area, and trespassers will be shot on sight.

All illegal cultivations in the Danger Belt will be destroyed without compensation.

The Danger Belt has extended in some areas into rubber. Entry into these areas may be made only with a permit issued by the respective OCPD.

17. CULTIVATIONS:

- (a) All cultivations and small holdings must be signposted by the cultivators showing their names in English and the relevant vernacular language. All plots not sign-posted are liable to be destroyed.
- (b) In certain areas of Sungei Siput and the Sungei Pari of Chemor, the raising of foodcrops is prohibited. This prohibition may be extended to other areas as operational necessity requires. The prohibited areas will be made known to the public by Gazette Notifications and other means of publicity.
- 18. CATTLE GRAZING. No grazing is allowed in the following areas:-
 - (a) East of a line from Tanjong Rambutan Tanah Hitam Royal Engineer Road Sungei Kuang to Lasah.
 - (b) West of the Sungei Pari from where it crosses the Jelapang Chemor road at the 10th mile stone to where it crosses the main railway line at 963 mile stone and thence following the railway line to the south gate of Sungei Siput.
- 19. PROHIBITION OF THE USE OF ROADS. Except with the written permission of the OCPD Sungei Siput North or the OCPD Ipoh, no vehicle, whether driven, ridden or otherwise, shall be permitted to be used on any road within the following areas, except the main public highways between Chemor and Jelapang, Sungei Siput and Chemor. No person shall use or travel on any vehicle on any road within the areas mentioned below:—
 - (i) The area bounded on the south by the District boundary on the west by the jungle edge, on the north by the edge of Heawood Estate and Sungei Siput town perimeter fence and on the east by the main trunk Sungei Siput—Chemor Road.
 - (ii) The area bounded by a line commencing at the point where the Mukim boundary of Ulu Kinta intersects the Sungei Siput North Chemor Road; thence in a southerly direction along the said road to the junction of the Chemor Jelapang Road; thence in a south-westerly direction along the said road to where it intersects the boundary of the Kledang Forest Reserve and thence along the said boundary in a northerly direction to where it crosses the boundary of the Mukim of Ulu Kinta.

OPERATION "GINGER"

Operation "Ginger" has now been in force for more than four months and experience gained during this period has disclosed certain weaknesses in the framework of the operation. The Central Perak War Executive Committee have therefore decided that amendments are necessary to ensure that supplies are completely denied to the Communist Terrorists. One point in particular has caused concern. Paragraph 7(d) of the pamphlet issued by the Chairman on the 8th January, 1958, stated that extra rice would be issued on application for festivals. From the number of applications received it has become clear that approval of such applications could produce a surplus of rice in areas where C.T. forces exert pressure. Both Perak State War Executive Committee and Central Perak War Executive Committee have decided that this privilege must be withdrawn and the operation conducted as a rigid food denial operation. From now on, therefore, the regulations affecting the movement of food-stuffs restricted articles, curfews danger belts and cultivations etc., in the Operation "Ginger" Area are as follows:—

(If you are in any doubt about these Regulations, do not hesitate to ask for advice. The Chinese Affairs Officers, the Penghulus, the Assistant Resettlement Officers, the Information Field Officers, the Police and the Food Denial Officers in the area will be glad to help you).

2. THE AREA IN WHICH THESE REGULATIONS APPLY:

- (a) The Mukims of Senggang, Kota Lama Kanan and Saiong east of the Perak River, but excluding the Malay Kampongs from Kampong Batang Kulim to Kg. Mandah.
- (b) The Mukim of Chegar Galah east of the Perak River.
- (c) The whole of the Mukim of Pulau Kamiri.
- (d) The whole of the Mukim of Sungei Siput.
- (e) That part of the district of Kinta lying North of the Mukims of Sungei Raya, Sungei Trap and Blanja, EXCEPT Ipoh, Falim, Menglembu, Guntong New Village, Pasir Puteh, Pasir Pinji New Village and Kampong Simee New Village.

3. THE FOLLOWING ARE RESTRICTED ARTICLES:

- (a) Padi, padi products, rice, rice products, flour, flour products, all forms of oats and barley, edible oil, sugar, salt, concentrated foods, tinned foods, cooked food, dried fish, dried beans, dried peas, tapioca products, tapioca flour and sago;
- (b) paper suitable for use in typewriting or printing or other process for duplicating words, figures or pictorial or other representations, wax stencils and printing ink;
- (c) drugs, medicines and other medical supplies;
- (d) electric torches other than one loaded electric torch for bona fide personal use, the onus of proving which shall be upon the accused and any type of dry cell electric battery;
- (e) canvas or any articles made wholly or partly from canvas;
- (f) green or khaki cloth, pliable plastic material and rubberised or waterproof material, and
- (g) any article of clothing made wholly or partly from any of the materials specified in (f), except when worn on or carried by the owner for personal use.
- 4. FOOD RESTRICTED AREA is an area where consumption and movement of food is restricted. Food may be taken into and out of a Food Restricted Area only under the conditions described in paragraphs 12 and 13 below.
- 5. FOOD PROHIBITED AREA is an area where, except in Residential areas, metalled roads, access roads, and bridle paths leading to a Residential Area, no food cooked or raw is allowed at any time.
- 6. SHOPKEEPERS dealing in restricted articles and foodstuffs must have a Licence issued by the respective District Officer, and must carry on their business in accordance with the conditions of that Licence.

7. RATIONING AND STOCKS:

(a) The rice ration over the operation rice ration area will be:-

Men 3 katties per week. Women $\frac{1}{2}$ katties per week. Children under 12 years of age ... 2 katties per week.

- (b) The rice ration in areas where Central Cooking is in operation will be as follows:Any amount of cooked rice per week per head at the price laid down by the
 Mentri Besar from time to time.
- (c) Restricted Articles will be rationed as follows in the Operation Rice Ration Area and Central Cooking Area:-

- (d) Extra rice allocations will be made to the Chinese Community only for Chinese New Year, the Malay Community only for Hari Raya Haji and Hari Raya Puasa, and to the Indian Community only for Thaipusam and Deepavali. No other extra allocations of rice or rationed foodstuffs will be made during the Operation.
- (e) Ration for eating shops and other users (on permits issued by the Chief Food Denial Officer).
 - (i) Edible Oil including solidified fats but excluding butter and margarine

10 katties per week maximum for a business.

- (ii) Salt 12 tahils for each head of cattle. Nil for other animals. One pound for 10 pounds of ice or 15 kattles for 200 pounds of ice for ice factories. 2 kattles per 10 gal. container of an ice cream seller. ½ katty for 500 one pound loaves for bakeries. 1 pikul for 5 pikuls of sauce for sauce makers.
- (f) Customers may buy rationed articles only from the dealer with whom they are registered.
- (g) In the Ipoh exempted area, and Kuala Kangsar Police District Normal Restricted Area, the normal rice ration will apply.
- (h) Retailers' stocks of rationed articles are limited to two weeks' ration in respect of their registered customers.
- (i) Wholesalers' stocks of rationed articles are limited to four weeks' supply to those retailers linked to them.
- (j) Individuals' stocks of rationed articles are limited to one weeks' ration.
- (k) Padi producers in the Operational Area will be allowed to keep their stocks but will not be allowed to keep more than two weeks' ration of milled rice.

8. PROHIBITION OF SALES in the Operation Area:

(a) Prepared Tapioca may not be sold unless the seller is in possession of a Licence permitting him to do so, issued by the District Officer.

- (b) Meals prepared from dried mee and meehoon may not be served by eating houses or stalls.
- (c) Pliable plastic materials including table cloths may not be bought, sold or moved.
- (d) Prepared Oats may not be bought, sold or moved except under a special permit.
- (e) Padi. No non-producer will be licensed to sell padi. No producer may sell padi other than to a licensed mill or dealer.
- (f) Rice may NOT be sold in any form by eating houses or stalls.
- 9. RECORDING OF SALES THROUGHOUT THE OPERATION GINGER AREA. Each sale of rationed articles mentioned in para 7 (c) above, and those mentioned on the Licence issued by the District Officer in para 1(a) of the Licence, must be recorded by the dealer, recording the identity card number of the buyer and the amounts bought.
- 10. PUNCTURING OF TINS. In the Operation Area all tins, with the exception of those containing tinned milk, sales between licensed dealers, and those held by persons in possession of a permit issued by the District Officer permitting them to hold stocks of unpunctured tins, will be punctured before sale with a hole not less than the size of a 20 cent piece.
- 11. DEALERS. Certain reductions will continue to be made in the number of dealers in restricted articles where deemed necessary. Any infringement of the conditions of the Licence or food denial regulations, will result in the cancellation of the Licence.
- 12. HAWKERS. Throughout the Operation Ginger Area, hawkers will NOT be licensed to carry any restricted articles or foodstuffs except bread out of Food Restricted Areas and will NOT be allowed to stop and sell between Food Restricted Areas. Bread Hawkers must carry a stock book showing details of stock and daily transactions and may NOT stop and sell bread anywhere other than inside a Food Restricted Area.

13. MOVEMENT OF RESTRICTED ARTICLES throughout the Operation Area.

- (a) Movement of restricted articles by vehicle to estates, mines and villages will only be permitted on MONDAYS and THURSDAYS by convoy. One convoy for movement to wholesalers in Chemor and Sungei Siput town will run on WEDNESDAYS in addition to the above.
- (b) Movement of restricted articles by foot or bicycle to Kampongs will be allowed only on MONDAYS and THURSDAYS under ration cards stamped with a letter "K" and subject to escort by Kampong Home Guards from points where access tracks leave the main roads to destination in each case.
- (c) Movement of restricted articles within the trade through the Operation Area may be made on any day by goods vehicle covered by tarpaulins or in motor vans. In each case the restricted articles must be securely fastened down and covered by a manifest from the owner.
- (d) Movement permits issued for restricted articles other than rationed ones previously mentioned will in all cases be impounded by the gate food check at the point of destination and returned to the office of origin every Saturday.
- (e) The usual exemptions referring to food for babies, invalids, train journeys, and fresh foods will continue to apply.
- (f) Movement of restricted articles for any purpose on days other than those shown above will be allowed only by the District Officers or Food Denial Officers acting in conjunction with local OCPDs. Such permits will be issued only under the most exceptional circumstances.
- 14. MONEY. Normally it will be assumed that people taking money into rubber, cultivations or mines are taking it to the Communist Terrorists. Guards at gates have, therefore, been told to advise people found carrying money to rubber, cultivations or mines, to return it to their homes unless they can explain satisfactorily the purpose for which it is to be used.

15. CURFEWS:

(a) All primary and secondary jungle in the Operation Area is subject to a 24-hour curfew. Permits for loggers and pipeline parties includes the stipulation that they must be clear of the jungle and on a recognised road or vehicle track by 4 p.m. each day.
