1. The aim of a Commanders Diary is to provide data on which to base future improvements in Army training, equipment, organization and administration, and to furnish historians with a record of the activities of units and formations in operational and non-operational periods in peace and in war.

GENERAL

- 2. Entries are to be made daily on AF C 2118 (Adapted) each entry being initialled by the officer detailed to keep it.
- 3. Commanders Diaries will conform with the rules for drafting orders given in "Staff Duties (Australia)", Chapter 2, Section 12.

RESPONSIBILITY

During Non-operational Periods

4. A Commanders Diary is to be compiled by commanders of all formations.

During Operational Periods (1)

- 5. A Commanders Diary is to be compiled in duplicate by:
 - a. Commanders of all formations.
 - b. Each branch of the staff at formation headquarters commanded by a brigadier or above.
 - c. Heads of services not below the rank of lieutenant colonel.
 - d. Personal staffs and officers holding special appointments.
 - e. Unit commanders.
 - f. Commanders of a detachment of a unit when so ordered.

COMPILATION

- 6. Both original and duplicate copies are to consist of:
 - a. Cover (AF C 2119) (Adapted).
 - b. Index as printed on cover.
 - c. Narrative (AF C 2118) (Adapted).
 - d. Annexes as shown in the Index.
- 7. All details of the unit or formation (if a detachment is concerned, the name of the parent unit), period covered and enclosure numbers of the annexes are to be shown on the cover. If there has been a change of command since the last report, the date of assumption by the new commanding officer is to be included.
- 8. The annexes are to be assembled in the groups shown on the cover. If there are no enclosures for an annex NIL will be entered on the cover. If additional annexes are convenient for a particular headquarters. the relevant papers should be assembled in the groups shown on the cover. If additional annexes are convenient for a particular headquarters.

- 13. Original Commander's Diary. This is to be forwarded monthly, unless otherwise ordered, by the seventh day of the succeeding month direct to AHQ.
- 14. Duplicate Commander's Diary. This must be clearly marked as a duplicate. It is to be sent separately from the original to AHQ one month after the original has been despatched but not before the former has been acknowledged.
- 15. When overseas, both copies of diaries are to be sent through the Army Records organization in the overseas theatre but at different times.
- 16. TOP SECRET Supplementary Diaries.
 - a. The documents referred to in Paragraph 9 together with a list of them made out on AF C 2118 (Adapted) must be placed in separate cover (AF C 2119) (Adapted). CHANNELS OF COMMUNICATION - FARELF/AUSTRALIA

LOVERIDGE RAA discussed in general terms the problems arising in regard to "channels of communication" FARELF/AUSTRALIA.

As a result of these discussions, it was decided that this HQ should submit further details regarding adr problems.

- 2. The following aspects require consideration:
 - a. Communications HQ FARELF/AHQ staff and service aspects.
 - b. Communications HQ AAF FARELF/AHQ.
 - c. Communications within FARELF; not further dealt with in this paper as the responsibilities and procedures are clearly and satisfactorily defined in paras 12 and 13, Part 1, AHQ Administrative Instruction No 6/64.
- Para 11, Part 1, AHQ Administrative Instruction 6/64 states:

"Communications concerning the administration of the Australian Army FARELF as a whole, or of its units and sub-units will be conducted, in the main, between HQ FARELF and AHQ with copies for information to HQ Aust Army Force FARELF. HQ Aust Army Force FARELF will deal with AHQ on matters of personnel administration which are peculiar to the Australian Force and on such other matters as AHQ may direct from time to time."

4. Staff aspects. The principal observation here is that "in the main" the Staff Directorates of both HQ FARELF and AHQ seldom observe the above procedure. Over a period of time, it has become customary for both agencies to use HQ AAF FARELF as an intermediary in their dealings with each other. This reluctance for direct negotiation has added to the workload of this HQ and has inevitably lead to past staff increases. In his 1964 review of the establishment of HQ AAF FARELF, the AHQ Inspector of Administration dealt with this aspect in some detail. Whilst the staff of this HQ will continue to encourage FARELF Staff Directorates to deal directly with AHQ, a reciprocal approach is desirable.

2/

Service Aspects. On the other hand, Service (and Arms) Directorates at both HQ FARELF and AHQ have adopted the principle of direct negotiation with some enthusiasm even to the extent that there is a considerable flow of DO correspondence. This mutual liaison between British and Australian counterparts has its encouraging facets, but often results in negotiations taking place on matters of which not only the staff of this HQ but also the staff of both HQ FARELF and AHQ are not aware. Further these dealings often have financial implications over which this HQ is expected to exercise control. It is considered essential that at least this HQ receive information copies of official correspondence between the Service Directorates of HQ FARELF and AHQ. In addition, the practice of some Service Directorates at AHQ dealing direct with Australian units in FARELF should cease.

AHQ/HQ AAF FARELF. Except for the reservation stated in para 4 above, there is little to add in regard to the direct dealings between AHQ and HQ AAF FARELF. It is obvious, however, that some AHQ Directorates do not appreciate the that this HQ does not directly command all Australian units in the theatre.

Summary

7. The problem in regard to channels of communication FARELF-AUSTRALIA arises from the fact that whereas the respective Staff Directorates appear reluctant to use the principle of direct negotiation, the Service Directorates are not; the latter often fail to keep this HQ informed of the detail of their negotiations. It is desirable that AHQ Directorates be informed of their responsibilities in these matters. For consideration, a draft instruction, based on a paper prepared by Lt Col LOVERIDGE, is attached.

CHANNELS OF COMMUNICATION - FARELF/AUSTRALIA (DRAFT)

Reference: A. AHQ Administrative Instruction 6/64.

Composition of Force

- 1. AAF FARELF consists of the Headquarters and:
 - a. Australian units of the Strategic Reserve;
 - b. Other Australian units located in SINGAPORE/MALAYA;
 - c. Other Australian units, detachments, etc., located in SOUTH EAST ASIA (less SOUTH VIETNAM).

Relationship of HQ AAF FARELF to Australian Units

- 2. Units of the Strategic Reserve. These units are listed in Annex A (Appx 1) to Ref. A. Unless otherwise specified, these units are under the operational command and administrative control of the C-in-C FAR EAST, or as delegated by him, except that matters of purely Australian administration are dealt with by HQ AAF FARELF.
- 3. Other Australian Units Located in SINGAPORE/MALAYSIA. These units are listed in Annex A (Appx 2) of Ref. A. They are not part of the Strategic Reserve and are under command of HQ AAF FARELF.
- (less SOUTH VIETNAM). These units are listed in Annex A (Appx 3) of Ref. A. They are not part of the Strategic Reserve and are under command of HQ AAF FARELF for certain aspects of Australian administration (see also Parts 6 and 8 of Ref. A.).

Administration

Ref. A contains the detailed instructions for the administration of AAF FARELF. From time to time, separate instructions are issued to cover specific elements of the Force.

Channels of Communication - Correspondence

- of communication for correspondence, signals etc., is between HQ FARELF and AHQ. For matters of domestic (Australian) administration concerning the personnel of AAF FARELF, the channel is normally direct from HQ AAF FARELF and not HQ FARELF.
- 7. Comd AAF FARELF is responsible for the safety and well being of AAF located in SINGAPORE/MALAYSIA and for matters of Australian administration of the Force as a whole. To enable the Comd AAF FARELF to fulfil these functions, it is essential that HQ AAF FARELF be kept fully informed of all negotiations taking place between the Staff, Arms, and Service Directorates of AHQ and HQ FARELF. In these cases, HQ AAF FARELF is to be an information addressee on all official correspondence.

Discussions with FARELF staff indicate that approval from MOD (Army) will be sought to finance the supply of spare parts and ammunition for the armalite over a seven year period at which stage it is anticipated that a replacement weapon will be available. This may be the SPIW System referred to in the enclosed paper.
- 3. The following are comments on the FARELF paper:-

a. Armalite Rifles.

- (1) The scale of issue to the Australian battalion is 313 rifles. FARELF propose that 9mm weapons be withdrawn eventually from infantry battalions. The SMC will be retained by units of other arms/services. However, ammunition stocks, scalings, etc will be adjusted accordingly.
- (2) The FARELF proposal will affect the AHQ proposal to issue the 9mm Fl weapon to 4 RAR. (See also our letter 205/12/5 of 1 Sep 66).
- b. 7.62mm IMGs/GPMGs. In regard to 4 RAR, the effect of the FARELF proposal is summarised as follows:-

 - b. Determination of costs, etc., involved in the issue of the Armalites and IMGs/GPMGs. (Note it is not yet known if the weapons are to be issued on repayment or on hire-loans, etc).

REDISTRIBUTION OF ARMALITES AND 7.62MM IMGS/GPMGS IN FARELF

Reference: A - HQ AAF R1005-60-1(G) of 6 Dec 66. B - HQ AAF R1005-60-1(G) of 7 Dec 66.

- 1. In Ref A, you were informed of the FARELF proposal to:
 - a. Replace 9mm SMGs in infantry battalions with Armalites.
 - b. Adjust the scale of issue of the IMG (7.62mm L4A4) to five per company plus five as battalion reserve.
 - c. Retain the full entitlement of GPMGs (7.62mm L7Al).
- 2. In Ref B (copy to AHQ), we requested FARELF to clarify the financial aspects of their proposal. In reply (FARELF FE 2111 Q (AE)1 of 13 Dec 66) they have stated:-
 - "1. Armalites could be issued to 4 RAR on the scales proposed in Reference A provided that you agreed either to purchase them outright or to pay the appropriate hire loan charges. However, as they are to be a permanent issue, it is preferable that they should be purchased outright.
 - 2. As the 9 mm weapons held by 4 RAR are not among the 'Common User' items, it would be necessary for you to arrange for their withdrawal and disposal. We regret that no credit can be allowed for these weapons when arriving at the cost of the Armalites.
 - 3. The present position as regards IMGs/GPMGs held by 4 RAR is as follows:
 - a. They hold 58 IMGs (L4A2), complete with ancilliaries, on hire loan.
 - b. They hold 53 GPMGs. These are at present on free issue pending completion of a financial settlement between UK and AUSTRALIA. MOD (Army) have recently confirmed that payment has not yet been received for these weapons.
 - 4. The effects of the proposal in para 8a of Reference A are that 4 RAR would:

/a.

- a. Retain 25 IMGs complete with ancilliaries on hire loan unless, of course, you decided to purchase them.
- b. Return 33 IMGs, complete with ancilliaries, to 3 BOD. Hire loan charges would cease from the date of return.
- c. Retain 53 GPMGs on free issue pending a financial settlement between UK and AUSTRALIA."
- 3. Actual costs (in sterling) are as follows:
 - a. Armalite.

Purchase - £62.10. 0.

Hire/loan - 17/4d per month.

b. 7.62 mm L4A4 (IMG).

Purchase - £187.10. 0.

Hire/loan - £2.12.1. per month.

- 4. The purchase price of the above weapons includes 25% for charges such as departmental expenses. As the UK has agreed to accept the return of all common items on reimbursement, it is considered generally that cutright purchase of weapons is preferable to hire/loan.
- 5. However, it would appear that in regard to the weapons of the infantry battalion, FARELF and AHQ differ in policy. Consequently your advice on the following matters is requested:
 - a. Armalites/9 mm SMG.
 - (1) Are you agreeable to the outright purchase of 313 Armalites for 4 RAR; or hire/loan?
 - (2) Policy in regard to the issue of SMG equipment 9 mm Fl.
 - b. 7.62 mm L4A4 (LMG). Retention by 4 RAR of 25 LMG complete with ancillaries; it is recommended that the present arrangement for hire/loan be converted to outright lean butchese.
 - c. 7.62 mm L7Al (GPMG). Action being taken to finalise the financial aspects of the issue of 53 GPMGs to 4 RAR.
- 6. It would be appreciated if an early decision were given.


