COMMANDERS DIARIES INSTRUCTIONS

AIM

1. The aim of a Commanders Diary is to provide data on which to base future improvements in Army training, equipment, organization and administration, and to furnish historians with a record of the activities of units and formations in operational and non-operational periods in peace and in war.

GENERAL

2. *Entries are to be made daily on AF C 2118 (Adapted) each entry being initialled by the officer detailed to keep it.*

3. Commanders Diaries will conform with the rules for drafting orders given in "Staff Duties (Australia)", Chapter 2, Section 12.

RESPONSIBILITY

During Non-operational Periods

4. A Commanders Diary is to be compiled by commanders of all formations.

During Operational Periods (1)

5. A Commanders Diary is to be compiled in duplicate by:
- a. Commanders of all formations.
 - b. Each branch of the staff at formation headquarters commanded by a brigadier or above.
 - c. Heads of services not below the rank of lieutenant colonel.
 - d. Personal staffs and officers holding special appointments.
 - e. Unit commanders.
 - f. Commanders of a detachment of a unit when so ordered.

COMPILATION

6. Both original and duplicate copies are to consist of:

- a. Cover (AF C 2119) (Adapted).
- b. Index as printed on cover.
- c. Narrative (AF C 2118) (Adapted).
- d. Annexes as shown in the Index.

7. All details of the unit or formation (if a detachment is concerned, the name of the parent unit), period covered and enclosure numbers of the annexes are to be shown on the cover. If there has been a change of command since the last report, the date of assumption by the new commanding officer is to be included.

8. The annexes are to be assembled in the groups shown on the cover. If there are no enclosures for an annex NIL will be entered on the cover. If additional annexes are convenient for a particular headquarters, starting at B.

DISPOSAL

13. **Original Commander's Diary.** This is to be forwarded monthly, unless otherwise ordered, by the seventh day of the succeeding month direct to AHQ.

14. **Duplicate Commander's Diary.** This must be clearly marked as a duplicate. It is to be sent separately from the original to AHQ one month after the original has been despatched but not before the former has been acknowledged.

15. When overseas, both copies of diaries are to be sent through the Army Records organization in the overseas theatre but at different times.

16. **TOP SECRET Supplementary Diaries.**

a. The documents referred to in Paragraph 9 together with a list of them made out on AF C 2118 (Adapted) must be placed in separate cover (AF C 2119) (Adapted). All details must be filled in and the cover clearly marked in red: "ANNEX Z — OFFICER ONLY". It may be convenient to group the papers by appendices.

b. Supplementary diaries must be forwarded under the normal rules for TOP SECRET correspondence, to AHQ. The inner envelope must be plainly marked:

COMMANDERS DIARY NARRATIVE

8 - 31 JAN 71

Maj T.F.H. WALKER assumed command of A Sqn 3 Cav Regt on 8 Jan 71. He found the Squadron professionally competent, with a high standard of discipline and high morale. The unit also enjoyed the confidence of other units in 1 ATF. All these factors were largely attributable to Maj H.J. COATES who preceded Maj Walker.

One of the first major tasks undertaken was to regroup the squadron vehicles. This was necessitated by the deployment of the squadron, which was working mainly in section sized groups, either opcon to, or in Direct Support of other units. The shuffle achieved four "independent" sections which are available for deployment on section-sized tasks, thereby releasing a full troop (in the ideal situation). Should this eventuate, the full troop might be beneficially used as a complete sub-unit. Or alternatively a troop complete can be released for R & C.

Tasking of sections is handled by the 2IC in his capacity as Ops Offr. This situation tends to by pass the troop HQ level. Troop commanders (and the Sqn commander) are not being given sufficient chance to exercise their command function.

The OC believes this is wrong. He attributes this situation to the past successes of the Sqn in understaking a wide variety of jobs. Hence the unit is now over-tasked.

Whilst frustrating for the OC and commanders at troop level, the present Sqn deployment is realistic in view of the enemy threat. It also allows section commanders to exercise initiative and their tactical ability - a job they are doing well, with obvious benefits for themselves, the Sqn, and eventually the Corps.

The M113 family of veh are proving their worth in this theatre. However the Sqn and LAD continue to experiment and modify certain aspects of the vehicle. At the moment, with the T50 turret fitted, the most successful (and most popular) gun configuration appears to be a .50 MG mounted in the turret, and a pintle mounted .30 MG on the front of the turret.

The 2ICs veh is being used to try a pintle mounted .50 MG. Because of the larger mounting bracket required, the weight distribution is spread over a greater area, and there has been no sign of damage to the turret as was first expected.

It is also interesting to note that the M28C sight is not used. A quicker means of directing fire onto a target is by sense of direction and observation of fall of shot.

Approximately 60% of the veh now has fuel cells in place of the old tanks, which were an integral part of the hull. This older type tended to crack along the welds because of constant vibration.

Servicing is generally kept up to date. Almost without exception services fall due on a mileage basis rather than a time basis. The LAD assistance is adequate. They can complete 3 or 4 'D' services in a day, thus enabling a section to be in from operational tasks for only 2 days. The second day is used to complete a 'C' service and a nontechnical inspection.

The administrative aspects of the unit function well. The reinforcement system is such that occasionally the squadron is short of manpower. Although there is an allowance for a handover period when key appointments change, this does not always occur. The problem is being considered at the moment and should soon be resolved. Proof of the benefit of this handover concept is the recent overlap of the tours of duty of the two adjutants, and of the two 2ICs.

Although the trickle replacement system is working at present, it is not recommended as a precedent in the event of future commitments to a theatre of war. Sub-unit replacement would be more advantageous.

As noted above, the Sqn is largely split into section sized groups, working with the other arms. The most common tasks are the defence of PSBs and NDPs, bushing, troop lifts and protection of other arms on specified tasks eg Engrs on land clearing or road construction.

A composite troop has twice ventured to the NE outside the former 1 ATF TACR into the MAY TAO - NUI BE region during this time. On both occasions the group being commanded by Capt R.K. HILL, MC. The first mission was an SAS insertion, the second an independent cavalry operation to destroy bunker systems and recce the area. During the move into the area an APC (c/s 33A) detonated an estimated 30 lb CHICOM mine. The crew commander and driver were wounded and the track extensively damaged. Although the belly armour was blown off, the incident proved the worth of uparmouring the M113. An engineer was also wounded when the mine detonated, and approx 1 hour later a Bushman Scout trod on a second mine which killed him and wounded 7 other Australians, most of whom were sitting on top of the tracks. One of these seven was a trooper, the remainder were soldiers from 1 ARU.

There were two other mining incidents during the month, both fortunately much less damaging.

The threat of mining is greater than that of SA or RPG fire to the APC at this time. This has resulted in many of the "line" troops wearing flack jackets (and sitting on them) and discarding the traditional beret and earphones for helmets.

In the latter part of the month the 1 ATF TACR was extended to the geographical borders of PHUOC TUY province, and at the same time AOs allotted to the Territorial Forces of RVN were extended. The Vietnamese now have responsibility for the western strip of the Province astride Route 15, and the Southern portion of the Province below HOA LONG and EAST to a line between the HORSESHOE and LANG PHUOC HAI.

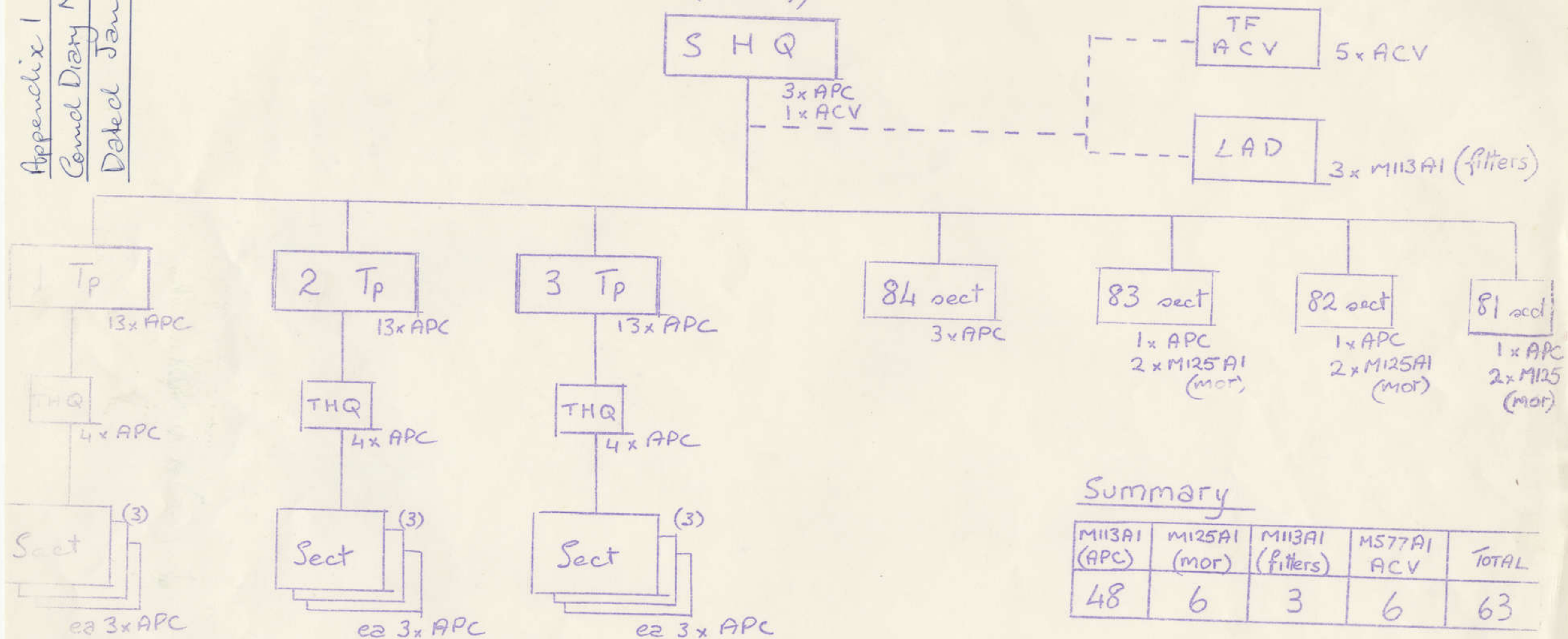
