AIM

1. The aim of a Commanders Diary is to provide data on which to base future improvements in Army training, equipment, organization and administration, and to furnish historians with a record of the activities of units and formations in operational and non-operational periods in peace and in war.

2. Entries are to be made daily on AF C 2118 (Adapted) each entry being initialled by the officer detailed to keep it.
3. Commanders Diaries will conform with the rules for drafting orders given in "Staff Duties (Australia)" Chapter 2, Section 12.

RESPONSIBILITY

During Non-operational Periods

4. A Commanders Diary is to be compiled by commanders of all formations.

During Operational Periods (1)

5. A Commanders Diary is to be compiled in duplicate by:
 - a. Commanders of all formations.
 - b. Each branch of the staff at formation headquarters commanded by a brigadier or above.
 - c. Heads of services not below the rank of lieutenant colonel.
 - d. Personal staffs and officers holding special appointments.
 - e. Unit commanders.
 - f. Commanders of a detachment of a unit when so ordered.

COMPILATION

6. Both original and duplicate copies are to consist of:
 - a. Cover (AF C 2119) (Adapted).
 - b. Index as printed on cover.
 - c. Narrative (AF C 2118) (Adapted).
 - d. Annexes as shown in the Index.
7. All details of the unit or formation (if a detachment is concerned, the name of the parent unit), period covered and enclosure numbers of the annexes are to be shown on the cover. If there has been a change of command since the last report, the date of assumption by the new commanding officer is to be included.
8. The annexes are to be assembled in the groups shown on the cover. If there are no enclosures for an annex NIL will be entered on the cover. If additional annexes are convenient for a particular headquarters, starting at B.

DISPOSAL

b. Supplementary diaries must be forwarded under the normal rules for TOP SECRET correspondence, to AHQ. The inner envelope must be plainly marked:

1 OCT 69	<p>OPS KINGSTON, JACK and CHIEFTAN continued. Plant Tp continued road construction on Route 23 between AN NHUT and LONG DIEN. A mini team and a splinter team from 1 Tp deployed on OP TAWA with W/Coy 6RAR and 17 Const Sqn in the THAI THIEN area. The recce officer (Capt J. BURROUGH) continued minefield recces along Route 15 between BARIA AND PHU MY. 3 mini teams supported B Sqn 3 Cav on escort duties. The 3 Tp Officer (Lt D. GEORGE) commenced recce of the SONG CA to locate a crossing point for the US LCT. The mini team with TANGO force in AO SABOT (OP CHIEFTAN) reported that a tank hit a mine and was damaged., but there were no casualties.</p>	
2 OCT 69	<p>2 mini teams were required to support B Sqn 3 Cav Regt on escorts tasks. Minefield recces were continued along Route 23 East of DAT DO to XUYEN MOC. A splinter team from 3 Tp deployed with C Coy 9RAR into AO STUART. The 1 Tp Ready Reaction CET reacted with the force to DAT DO/Route 23 to clear the area prior to the visit of the Australian Ambassador. The 1 Tp standby mini team reacted with a Cav force to HOA LONG to investigate reported VC activity. 21 Engr Sp Tp provided a TAOR patrol during the evening.</p>	
3 OCT 69	<p>2 CET's from 3 Tp were despatched to assist in construction of the bridge over the SONG CA for mov of the US LCT. 3 mini teams were provided to B Sqn 3 Cav Regt. A senior NCO visited the Aust LO in DAT DO to advise on the reconstruction of bunkers destroyed by the VC last month. The Ready Reaction CET was reacted with the force to reported enemy activity in DAT DO. Two pre-fabricated arc mesh pads were flown into 3 Tp at the bridge site for use on the approaches.</p>	
4 OCT 69	<p>A quiet day. 3 mini teams were provided to B Sqn 3 Cav Regt. An LZ const kit was flown into the splinter team with B Coy 9RAR. A US bridging eqpt was airlifted into the crossing on the SONG CA, was completed by 3 Tp by 1800hrs. Plant Tp supplied a TAOR patrol during the evening.</p>	
5 OCT 69	<p>A CET from 2 Tp was flown into c/s 61 of 5RAR on a bunker demolition task. 32 bunkers were demolished and the team extracted late in the afternoon. 2 mini teams were provided to B Sqn 3 Cav Regt. Road construction on Route 23 continued satisfactorily. HQ Tp supplied a TAOR patrol during the evening.</p>

6 OCT 69	<p>Elements of 5RAR redeployed south into AO JOHN. FSPB BRUISER was estb by a dozer and backhoe from Plant Tp. The 2 Tp Officer (Lt J. HOPMAN) moved to BRUISER while the 2 Tp Comd (Capt J. ATRENS) remained at FSPB BEN. 1 Tp deployed a mini team and a splinter team with A Coy 6RAR and the 17 Const LCT on OP BIRCH in the SW of the LONG HAI peninsula. 2 other mini teams supported B Sqn 3 Cav Regt on escort duties. One of the 3 Tp CET's at the bridge site in AO STUART was extracted for an anticipated redeployment tomorrow.</p>	
7 OCT 69	<p>A splinter team and 2 mini teams from 1 Tp deployed into AO SABOT on a combined Inf/Armd/Cav op. (OP ARAWA). A further mini team supported B Sqn 3 Cav Regt on an escort task.</p>	
8 OCT 69	<p>4 mini teams supported B Sqn 3 Cav Regt on escort duties. A CET from 3 Tp deployed into the LONG GREEN. to clear a suspected mined bunker system. 3 Tp completed recce of the next river crossing for mov of the US LCT. 21 Engr Sp Tp supplied a TAOR patrol during the evening.</p>	
9 OCT 69	<p>2 Tp HQ's, which had been split between FSPB's BEN and BRUISER, concentrated in BRUISER with the move of 5RAR almost wholly into AO JOHN. Only C Coy 5RAR remained in AO MAX. 3 mini teams were provided to B Sqn 3 Cav Regt.</p>	
10 OCT 69	<p>One mini team deployed on OP CHIEFTAN II in AO SABOT as OP ARAWA concluded. 4 mini teams supported B Sqn 3 Cav Regt on escort duties. Two CET's from 3 Tp were flown into AO STUART to prepare the crossing over the SOUI QUIT for the mov out of the US LCT.</p>	
11 OCT 69	<p>The 1 Tp Officer (Lt B. KOWALD) conducted a recce of a bridge crossing site at YS629654 on Route 328. 3 mini teams supported B Sqn 3 Cav Regt. Other Ops continued without incident. Plant Tp supplied a TAOR patrol during the evening.</p>	
12 OCT 69	<p>A CET from 2 Tp deployed to C Coy 9RAR on a bunker demolition task at 1555hrs. 3 mini teams supported B Sqn 3 Cav Regt on escort duties.. A quiet day.</p>

13 OCT 69	<p>An element of 1 Tp HQ's and 2 CET's deployed by road to construct the bridge crossing on Route 328 near XUYEN MOC, prior to the move of 6RAR on their next major Op. One CET from 2 Tp reacted at 0824hrs on a bunker demolition task into C Coy 5RAR. An element of 3 Tp HQ's and 2 CET's from 3 Tp deployed to AO STUART to construct the final bridge, crossing for the mov out of the US LCT. 3 mini teams deployed with B Sqn 3 Cav Regt on escort duties. The pre-fabricated steel girder bridge was airlifted into 1 Tp starting at 1400hrs. By evening the bridge and ramps were in position and the decking was 75% complete. The CET with C Coy 5RAR completed their task, having demolished 37 bunkers, and returned to base. One of the CET's with 3 Tp on their bridging task was withdrawn for a possible redeployment on 14 Oct.</p>	
14 OCT 69	<p>By 0850hrs, 1 Tp completed the bridge on Route 328 and the convoy deploying 6RAR to FSPB DISCOVERY crossed the bridge at 0940hrs. A CET(-) from 1 Tp deployed with an element of D Coy 6RAR on mine clearance of an area in PHUOC LOI. HMAPC's FLINT and STEELE deployed to FSPB BRUISER under the OC (MAJ R. ROWE) for mine clearance activities on 15 Oct 69. Elements of Plant Tp deployed with the road convoy to open up FSPB DISCOVERY and close down FSPB BRUISER. The mov out of the US LCT in AO STUART continued at a slow pace. Mini teams remained in support of Armd/Cav elements in AO's SABOT and SEABREEZE. Plant Tp continued road construction on Route 23 between AN NHUT and LONG DIEN. HQ Tp deployed one T AOR patrol.</p>	
15 OCT 69	<p>Additional bridging stores were flown into the 3 Tp team working on the bridge over the SOUI QUIT. The 6RAR insertion into AO LINTON completed. It is noteworthy that no Engrs teams deployed with the 6RAR rifle Coys. It remains to be seen whether this system will work satisfactorily. Early in the morning HMAPC's FLINT and STEELE cleared the XUYEN MOC airfield prior to the 5RAR fly out by Caribou aircraft. The mov out of the US LCT continued more slowly than expected and a 5 hrs delay on tomorrows fly out of the Bn eqpt was requested. The D4 dozer returned after assisting to close down FSPB BRUISER. 2 Tp elements returned to base. 3 mini teams supported B Sqn 3 Cav Regt.</p>	
16 OCT 69	<p>The TD15B dozer and Case backhoe returned after opening up FSPB DISCOVERY for 6RAR. The fly out of the Bn eqpt in AO STUART was delayed until 17 Oct after one section of the Bn had been lifted out by Skycrane. The 3 Tp Comd (Capt P. KNIGHT) and CET remained in location. 2 mini teams supported B Sqn 3 Cav Regt.</p>

17 OCT 69	<p>2 mini teams from 3 Tp replaced 1 and 2 Tp mini teams with TANGO force in AO SABOT. A mine incident at LO GOM RF Post caused the reaction of 2 mini teams to clear the area. The teams later cleared the surrounds of 4 bunkers in DAT DO which were destroyed last night by the VC. 4 mini teams were despatched in support of B Sqn 3 Cav Regt, one from 3 Tp to remain with the Op Com sect in AO STUART. At 1545hrs a CET from 3 Tp was airlifted into B Coy 9RAR to demolish a number of bunkers. 1 FD SQN WKSP supplied a TAOR patrol for the evening. The fly put of the Bn across the SOUI QUIT was completed, the US LCT having crossed and regrouped West of the river.</p>	
18 OCT 69	<p>A CET from 1 Tp moved to PHUOC LOI to assist D Coy 6RAR elements by clearing an area to prove it free of mines. The team was released at 1515hrs. The OC (MAJ R. ROWE) travelled to SAIGON to attend a conference on a new type of mine dog. The Deputy Comd 1 ATF inspected the unit and in general commented that the results were satisfactory. 1 Tp deployed three splinter teams (equiped as mini teams) to assist elements of D Coy 6RAR attached to PF Posts in the Route 44 area (PHUOC LOI to PHUOC HAI). A splinter team from the Ready Reaction CET (2 Tp) moved into an area south of the NUI DINHS with A Coy 5RAR. 2 mini teams supported B Sqn 3 Cav Regt on escort duties. The CET from 3 Tp completed a bunker demolition task commenced yesterday in support of B Coy 9RAR, and was extracted to NUI DAT at 1115hrs. A further mini team was reacted with an element of B Sqn 3 Cav Regt at 1900hrs on a task along Route 15 the team returning at 2130hrs. Ops in AO's STUART, SABOT, LINTON and SEA BREEZE continued, as did the Route 23 roadworks near AN NHUT.</p>	
19 OCT 69	<p>The 1 TP Officer (Lt B. KOWALD, acting as Tp Comd in the absence of Capt B. REID, who is being MEDEVAC to Australia on 20 Oct) returned to FSPB DISCOVERY, taking pentaprime and sprayer to seal LZ's at the FSPB. 3 mini teams from 3 Tp deployed into AO STUART with Cav and Armd elements who were to come under Op Comd 9RAR. 2 further mini teams were supplied to B Sqn 3 Cav Regt to assist in escort tasks. A quiet day operationally. 21 Sp Tp supplied a TAOR during the evening.</p>	
20 OCT 69	<p>A splinter team from 2 Tp reacted with an elm of 1 ARU to HOA LONG to check on areported cache. Negative results. In the afternoon the OC (MAJ R. ROWE) conducted a recce of parts of the Barrier Minefield near DAT DO in preparation for the re-commencement of final clearing ops in the field. HMAD8 (Her Majesties Armoured D8) POWER is being fully armoured in preparation for these activities. 2 mini teams supported B Sqn 3 Cav Regt on escort duties.</p>

21 OCT 69	<p>A splinter team from 2 Tp deployed with C Coy 5RAR into AO SABOT on OP WRIDGWAY. 2 further mini teams supported B Sqn 3 Cav Regt on daily escort duties. The OC MAJ R. ROWE conducted a further recce of the barrier minefield near DAT DO. At 1310hrs a mini team leader (L/Cpl B HANSEN) working with a B Sqn 1 Armd Regt element on Route 326 was KIA when a mine or booby trap was detonated. The other member of the team was WIA (slightly). The OC and a replacement mini team moved to the site of the incident. The OC visited the 1 Tp Officer (Lt B. KOWALD) at FSPB DISCOVERY late in the day. During the evening a requirement for deployment of an assault boat and a crew into 6 RAR's AO LINTON was passed and processed. Other ops continued without incident.</p>	
22 OCT 69	<p>A 1 Tp CET (-) plus asslt boat were lifted to the mouth of the SONG RAI and conducting boating ops with V Coy 6RAR during the day returning late afternoon. 2 members of a 1 Tp mini team with elements of B Sqn 3 Cav Regt in the LIGHT GREEN were WIA when 2RPG's hit the APC in which they were travelling. 3 mini teams supported B Sqn 3 Cav Regt on escort duties. Plant Tp deployed a TAOR patrol during the evening.</p>	
23 OCT 69	<p>1 Tp deployed a CET (-) to FSPB DISCOVERY for a task on 24 OCT and a splinter team to join V Coy 6RAR in an area where mines could be expected. Plant Tp commenced roadworks on Route 52 near the XA LONG TAN corner. Roadworks on Route 23 between DAT DO and LONG DIEN continued. During the day three mine incidents occurred involving armd/cav elements: 2 in AO SABOT and 1 in AO STUART. The mini team involved in the latter incident were badly shaken and were replaced. Four mini teams deployed on escort tasks with B Sqn 3 Cav Regt. A Euclid scraper became U/S on Route 52 and after considerable to extract the machine, attempts were abandoned late at night and a security element from Plant Tp remained overnight with the machine. (The whole machine was recovered early on 24 OCT).</p>	
24 OCT 69	<p>A 2 Tp splinter team and a 3 Tp mini team with A Coy 5RAR on Op SWITCH west of the NUI DINHS. 3 mini teams deployed with B Sqn 3 Cav Regt on escort duties. The 1 Tp CET moved out from DISCOVERY to a bunker system, cleared the area for mines (none found) and blew the bunker system. 1 Tp elements provided security for the Plant Tp works on Route 52.</p>

25 OCT 69	<p>A CET from 3 Tp was flown into A Coy 9RAR at 0905 hrs on a bunker dmln task. At 1220 hrs a DUST OFF request being passed by D Coy 6RAR at the horseshoe was monitored on the 1 ATF Comd Net. A request for a mini team was mentioned. 3 Tp were immediately tasked to stand by a team at short notice. At 1250 hrs the mini team was picked up by Albatross at WOMBAT pad and flown into IO GOM. At 1308 hrs advice was received from D Coy that Spr A.L. Duncuff had been KIA in the incident.</p> <p>It later eventuated that the No 1 of the team, Spr D.F. MC Kenzie, had been very lightly WIA and had remained on duty. 2 Aust soldiers were KIA and 6 WIA in the incident. The OC (Maj R. Rowe) travelled to the scene of the incident and spoke with Spr McKenzie, who was shaken and was later brought back to base as a routine MEDEVAC. The 3 Tp mini team returned from the bunker dmln task at about 1745hrs, 3 mini teams sp B Sqn 3 Cav during the day on escort tasks.</p>	
26 OCT 69	<p>The mine clearing group (APCs FLINT & STEEL, a RAEME repair team, and a mini team from 3 Tp) under comd of the 3 Tp Offr (Lt D. GEORGE) conducted a warm-up for the major mine clearing to come by clearing and area of rifle ranges near Long Hoi on the peninsula. No mines were detonated, however the day was a good trial of comms and techniques with the APCs. During the day 3 mini teams sp B Sqn 3 Cav on escort duties. The 3 mini teams from 1 Tp which had been working with elms of D Coy 6RAR and PF Coys along Route 44, re-grouped in the Horseshoe. During the day one of the teams neutralised an M 16 mine found on top of the ground at Hoi My. Other ops continued with little incident.</p>	
27 OCT 69	<p>1 Fd Sqn deployed elms on Op FRANGIMUS 111, the third phase of the barrier minefield clearing. The group comd was the 3 Tp Offr (Lt D. George), with the op of course comd by the OC (Maj R. Rowe). A CET from 3 Tp, 4 plant ops from plant tp (for HMA D8 POWER and the 2 TD15B dozers), a fwd repair team from the Wksp and drivers from Tpt for the APCs and B vehs. The group left NUI DAT at 0700 hrs. By mid day the night defensive posn (NDP) was still under construction and the first access cuts were being made in the minefield fence. 21 Engr Sp Tp sup an ambush ptl (AP) to assist in the night def of the area. This ptl discovered booby traps in the perimeter bunkers const some months ago by this unit which had obviously been evacuated by the PF who were supposed to man them. During the day 15 M16 mines were detonated by the APCs. 2 Tp sup a 3 man trg team under Ssgt Jones to instr a PF Coy in Dat Do in minewarfare.</p>	
28 OCT 69	<p>A sect from 2 Tp deployed to Phu My mil post on Route 15 to commence bldg a community centre as part of the pacification programme. The Comd 1 ATF (Brig Weir) visited the mine clearing activities at DAT DO. At 1100hrs the mine clearing group was fired on by two groups to the North and East of their posn. Late in the day the Comd 1 ATF arranged for an ACV and one tank to be placed under comd of the group and these welcome additions (for comms and security) arrived at 1920 hrs. During the day 34 mines were exploded.</p>

28 OCT 69	Four mini teams sp B Sqn 3 Cav Regt on escort duties.	
29 OCT 69	At 0855 hrs a shot was fired at HMAD8' POWER, without result. 3 USMC visitors , (Lt G. Goslin and two cpls), deployed from FSPB DISCOVERY with the acting 1Tp Comd(Lt B. Kowald) and elms of 1 Tp on a small bunker dmln task. During the afternoon HMAPC STEELE was damaged by an M16 mine. The Wksp Comd (Capt J. Power) went to the NDP for the night to assess the extent of the damage. 21 Engr Sp Tp again sup an AP for area security during the evening. One mini team sp B Sqn 3 Cav Regt during the day.	
30 OCT 69	The team for 2 tp shifted their mine training activities from Dat Do to the PF Coy at Hoi My. Plant Tp elms working on Route 52 near the old Long Tan were sp by security elms from 1 Tp . Heavy rain at Dat Do (about 7") during the night saturated the mine clearing group, who spent most of the day baling out and drying out.HMAPC FLINT left the group for the day for a task at Phy My 5 airfield (Route 15). The airfield was to be checked for mines prior to its use on the subsequent days for Caribou aircraft movement. A D8 dozer working in the HORSESHOE quarry was brought back to Nui Dat to be armoured-up to assist POWER and increase the earth moving output of the team at the mine - clearing. 1 Tp sup the AP for mine-clearing during the night . The fitters APC was involved in a minor rd accident in Baria on its return journey from Phu My with FLINT, and the night was spent at a camp compound in Baria. 21 Engr Sp Tp sup a TAOR ptl during the evening. 2 mini teams sp B Sqn 3 Cav Regt.	
31 OCT 69	2 Tp commenced their deployment with 5RAR on Op KINGS CROSS in the Hat Dich area. An elm of Tp HQs under the Tp Offr (Lt J. Hopman), 2 splinter teams with rifle coys and four mini teams with the cav and armd sp. Plant Tp supplied 3 ops for the 2 backhoes and one case dozer airlifted in to FSPB CAPE. Elms of 3 Tp commenced to return to Nui Dat with 9RAR. 2 further mini teams sp B Sqn 3 Cav Regt on escort duties. Op FRANGIMUS continued steadily. Plant Tp sup the ambush ptl during the night. 


RADIO NETS
