**COMMANDERS DIARIES  
INSTRUCTIONS**

**AIM**

1. The aim of a Commanders Diary is to provide data on which to base future improvements in Army training, equipment, organization and administration, and to furnish historians with a record of the activities of units and formations in operational and non-operational periods in peace and in war.

**GENERAL**

2. Entries are to be made daily on AF C 2118 (Adapted) each entry being initialled by the officer detailed to keep it.
3. Commanders Diaries will conform with the rules for drafting orders given in "Staff Duties (Australia)" Chapter 2, Section 12.

**RESPONSIBILITY**

**During Non-operational Periods**

4. A Commanders Diary is to be compiled by commanders of all formations.

**During Operational Periods (1)**

5. A Commanders Diary is to be compiled in duplicate by:
  - a. Commanders of all formations.
  - b. Each branch of the staff at formation headquarters commanded by a brigadier or above.
  - c. Heads of services not below the rank of lieutenant colonel.
  - d. Personal staffs and officers holding special appointments.
  - e. Unit commanders.
  - f. Commanders of a detachment of a unit when so ordered.

**COMPILATION**

6. Both original and duplicate copies are to consist of:
  - a. Cover (AF C 2119) (Adapted).
  - b. Index as printed on cover.
  - c. Narrative (AF C 2118) (Adapted).
  - d. Annexes as shown in the Index.
7. All details of the unit or formation (if a detachment is concerned, the name of the parent unit), period covered and enclosure numbers of the annexes are to be shown on the cover. If there has been a change of command since the last report, the date of assumption by the new commanding officer is to be included.
8. The annexes are to be assembled in the groups shown on the cover. If there are no enclosures for an annex NIL will be entered on the cover. If additional annexes are convenient for a particular headquarters, starting at B.

COMMA DISPOSAL DIARIES

13. **Original Commander's Diary.** This is to be forwarded monthly, unless otherwise ordered, by the seventh day of the succeeding month direct to AHQ.

14. **Duplicate Commander's Diary.** This must be clearly marked as a duplicate. It is to be sent separately from the original to AHQ one month after the original has been despatched but not before the former has been acknowledged.

15. When overseas, both copies of diaries are to be sent through the Army Records organization in the overseas theatre but at different times.

16. **TOP SECRET Supplementary Diaries.**

a. The documents referred to in Paragraph 9 together with a list of them made out on AF C 2118 (Adapted) must be placed in separate cover (AF C 2119) (Adapted). All details must be filled in and the cover clearly marked in red: "ANNEX Z — OFFICER ONLY". It may be convenient to group the papers by appendices.

b. Supplementary diaries must be forwarded under the normal rules for TOP SECRET correspondence, to AHQ. The inner envelope must be plainly marked:

In both camps Ptl Comd noticed that a portion of crawl trench had been exposed to view for ac this area was subject to A/S but the rest of both camps had NOT been touched and they could be used at any time.

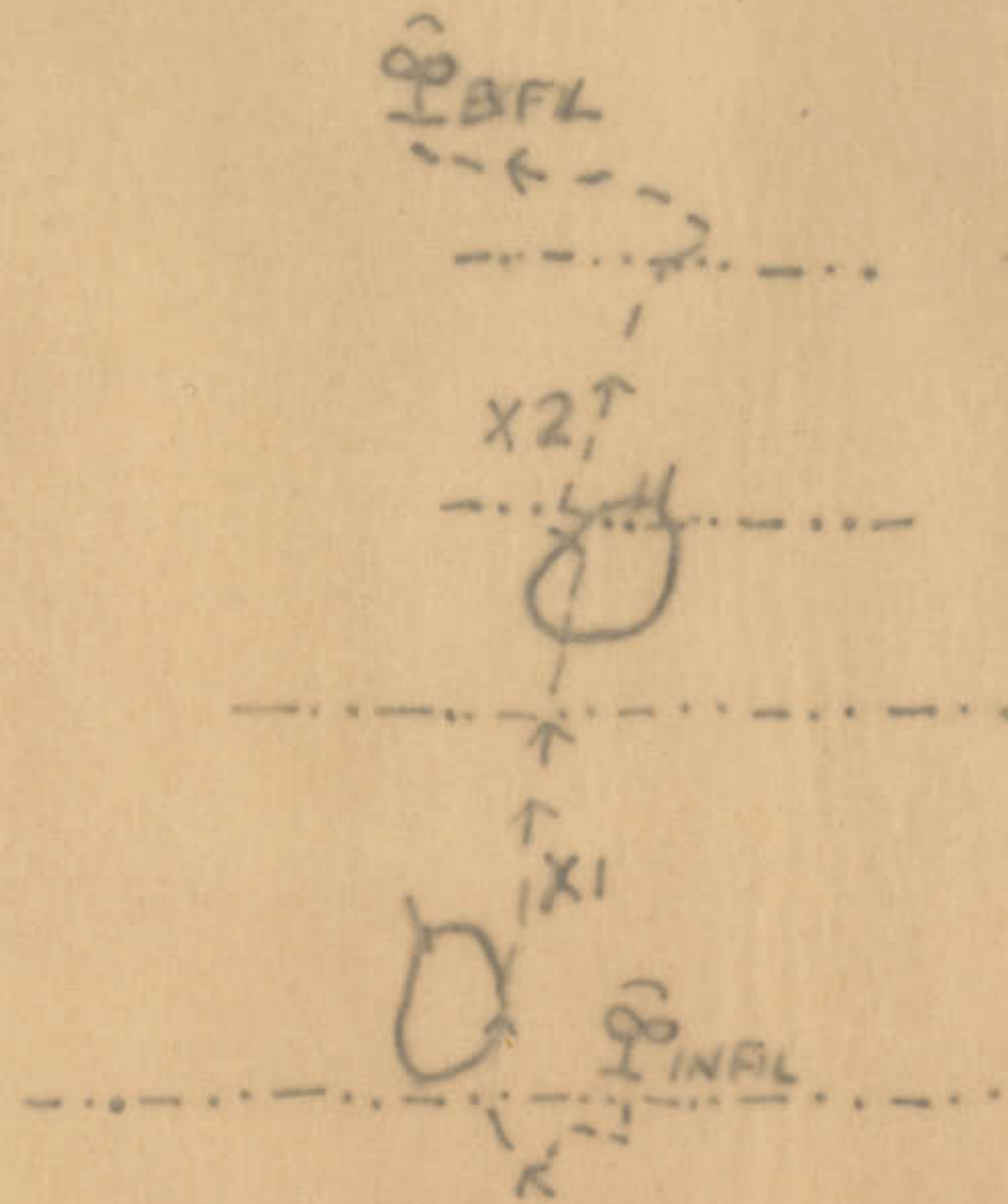

251700H 3 VC walked into FSPB DYKE, 1 VC observed the area, the other 2 VC were behind looking around the general area. They moved WEST into the scrub. 5 VC then came back into the area and moved out of clearing.  
Dress:- 1 VC was dressed in camouflaged gear and had a carbine.  
1 VC had a blue checked shirt and black trousers NO weapon.  
1 VC had NO shirt or weapon and black trousers. The other 2 VC were too far away to ascertain their clothing or equipment.  
260615H 1 single shot heard 150m N.  
260630H 1 single shot heard 200m N possibly on Firestone.  
260915H 1 VC was sighted 150m N looking around general area. Dress: Dark bush hat green shirt and black trousers carrying a carbine. He moved off WEST.  
260920H 3 VC were sighted 200m W behind mounds all were armed 2 carrying sand bags. They disappeared behind mounds and commenced digging.  
260940H 5 pers were dispatched to engage these three VC from another direction.

The patrol headed SW along a track left by the Bn. After moving approx 120m 4 VC were sighted at a distance of 15 - 20 ft. Ptl Comd engaged the first 2 VC with AR15 and M79, they fell to the ground dead. The third VC was engaged with 30 rounds from a heavy barrel FN, he fell backwards and was engaged with a further 30 rounds and did NOT move.

The 4th VC was engaged by 2 members of the ptl with AR16 he was seen to drop to the ground after being hit in the chest with approx 20 rounds plus 1 M79. The area of the contact was then engaged with further SA and M79 rounds.

The patrol withdrew to the ambush position. At the same time the 3 VC which were in dead ground to the ambush position were engaged with innumerable M79 and AW fire. One black hat was seen lying on the parapet of the refuse pit.

The ambush party then withdrew to their extraction LZ.

On extraction 1 VC was seen dressed in a brown shirt, he was engaged with M79 and AW fire with unknown results.

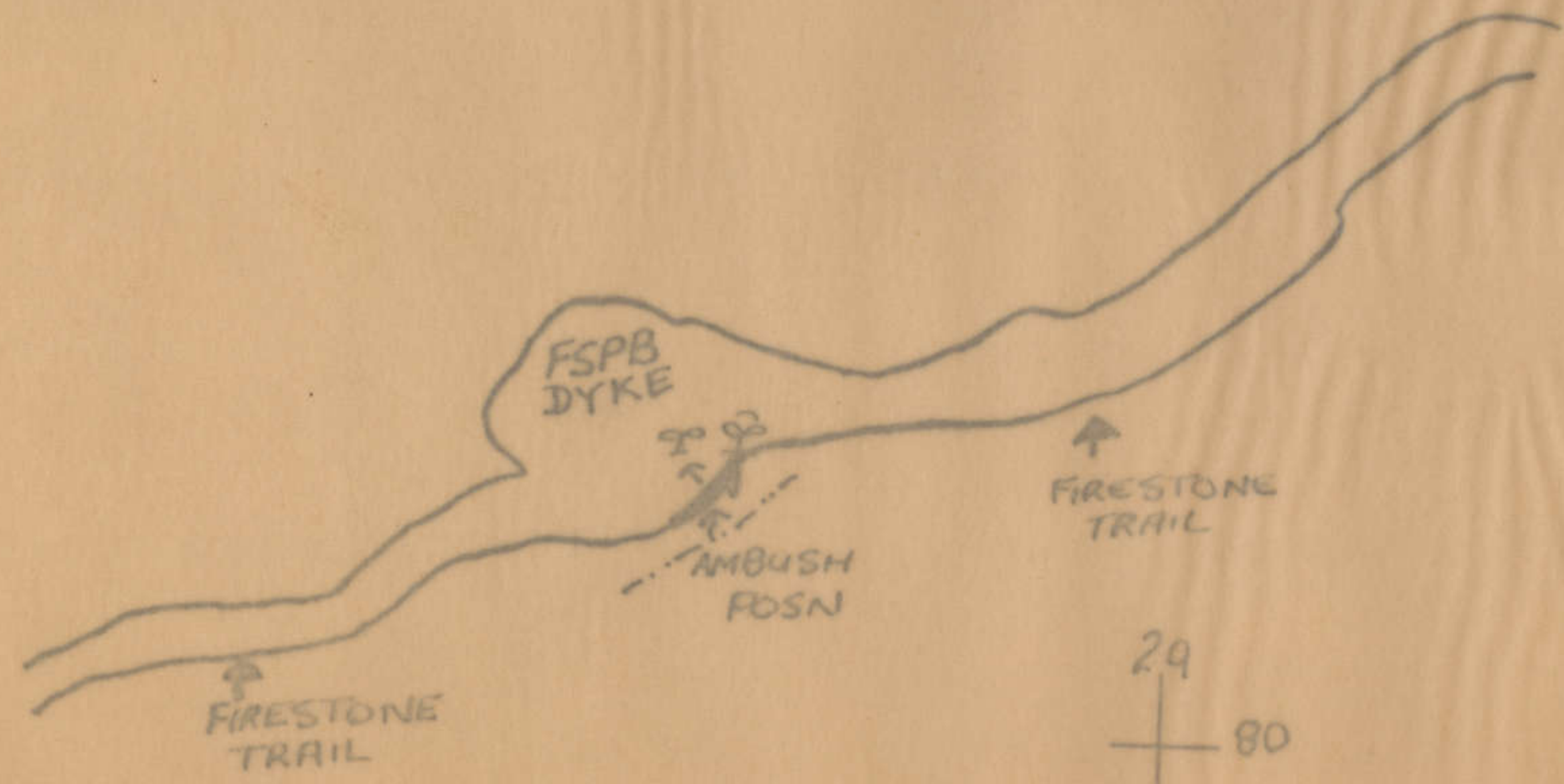




Ptl moved 10 - 15m when forward scout saw 1 VC 20m to his left front dressed in greens, NO weapon visible. The second member of the ptl saw a further VC 45m to his right dressed in greens carrying an unidentified weapon.

A further VC was sighted to the left of the ptl, walking towards ptl, he emerged from a clump of bamboo. He was dressed in black and was carrying a KAR 98B. The VC saw the patrol and was engaged with SA fire. The VC was hit through the chest and stomach and was thrown back into the bamboo.

Ptl then withdrew using fire and movement back to their LZ. Fire appeared to be coming from the WEST. Ptl took up fire positions around the LZ and movement was seen in the undergrowth around the LZ.

LFT was called in and laid suppressive fire in on area 25-100m WEST of patrol. One ptl member received shrapnel in the right arm due to the close proximity of the suppressive fire.


