PART I-G MATTERS

- 1. Location. A Sec I Topo Svy Tp remains in present location at YS43456671.
- 2. Enemy Contact. Nil.
- 3. <u>Tasks.</u> All elements, except for screen printing were fully employed during the reporting period. A Summary of major tasks undertaken is given in Annex A.
- 4. <u>Survey Control</u>. During the reporting period a third order station AASO16 (PIG) was established at:

E 752 159.72

N 1171 532.95

by tellurometer distance and bearing from AASOO1 (NUI DAT).

- 5. Polaris observations on line AASOO1 (NU! DAT) VUNG TAU Lighthouse gave a 5.0" variation to the computed azimuth carried through from original base. Due to the relative agreement of the two results, and the work required to amend existing results it has been decided to accept the present provisional co-ordinates of all points until such time as the I Topo Svy Tp work can be connected to National network via NUI THI VAI.
- AASOO1 has been renovated so that observations can now be made from over the ground mark instead of at the eccentric. AASOO1 has an RO for night work at VUNG TAU Lighthouse and a daylight RO at BA RIA Radio mast connected to the main chain stations.
- 7. Survey control for NUI DAT Special 1;5000 was completed during the reporting period and extra control required for the master planning map at scale 1;2500 is at present proceding.
- 8. Fieldwork for XUYEN MOC 1:10,000 was completed during the reporting period and this sheet is at present being compiled.
- 9. Compilation and field checking of the following sheets was completed during June 1967.

- 10. 1:25000 Mapping. Annotation and repromat for all sheets, except 6430-11-NE, has now been despatched to AHQ Survey Regt. This unit was unable to locate photography or compilation for outstanding sheet and photography has been ordered. At time of reporting this had not been received.
- 11. Second edition sheets Nos 6430-111-NE and 6429-Iv-NE were placed in stock during June.

- 12. This continues to be the hardest worked section of the unit but with the arrival of two draughtsmen during the reporting period the work load has been lightened on individual members.
- 13. Two members of 131 Div Loe Bty, with draughting experience, have been working for this unit during June and have been of great assistance.

Soreen Printing

- 14. A record 6080 impressions were made during the reporting period. As this was done in 20 days by one man it is an accurate indication of the skill and enthusiasm shown by Cpl SLATER.
- 15. Difficulties with drying of ink in screens (Sea Report No 13 Part 5) was alleviated by the loan of a Trucks, Van, Expansible, M292. This vehicle is air conditioned and the screen printer has been worked to capacity since being transferred into it. Unfortunately this truck will be removed from this locality on 5 Jul 67, for Op PADDINGTON and further experimentation with slow drying reducer, so far abortive, will have to be carried out.
