#### OPERATION REPORT No 15 Covering Period 1 Jul - 31 Jul 67

#### PART 1 - G MATTERS

- 1. Location. A Sec 1 Topo Svy Tp remains in present loc at YS4335 6671.
- 2. Enemy Contact. Nil.
- 3. Tasks. All elements of unit were fully employed during the reporting period. A summary of major tasks undertaken is given in Annex A.
- 4. Survey Control. Two third order stations, AAS 017 and AAS018, were established during the reporting period. These replace AAS013 and HORSESHOE EAST respectively. Both these stations were destroyed during extensive earthworks on the HORSESHOE feature. Stations were established by telluremeter distance and azimuth from AAS001 NUI DAT. Coordinates for stations are:

AAS 017 : E 749051.26 N1162117.98

AAS 018 : E 749564.71 N1162022.43

- 5. Attempts were made during July to relocate BINH BA GRAVEYARD from AASOO4 NULLON. Taking advantage of Op SOUTHPORT a new station AASO19 BINH BA GRAVEYARD was ground marked and the distance to AASOO4 measured. Due to cloud cover an azimuth could not be measured but it is hoped that the complete re-establishment will be effected in the near future. A tacheometric traverse from AASO19 to a marked traverse station on Route 23 immediately NORTH of BINH BA villiage was also observed. This traverse station had been established by tacheometric traverse from AASO12 DUC THANH in February 1967.
- Extensive earthworks, erection of permanent buildings and relocation of weapon pits, bunkers and gun emplacements has made HORSESHOE SPECIAL 1:1250 obsolete. During reporting period the feature was completely resurveyed for edition 2 of this map.
- 7. A series of level traverses within 1 ATF area has been commenced with a two fold purpose.
  - a. To satisfy an RAE requirement for drainage planning.
  - b. 2nd edition NUI DAT (SPECIAL) compilation by stereoscope.
- Photo identification of existing control and establishment of height control in preparation for compliation of ALSG 1:1200 Special map was effected during reporting period.

CONFIDENTIAL

9. 1 ATF AREA. During July ten (10) permanent traverse stations within this area were permanently marked with star picketts set in concrete to a depth of two feet. To prevent destruction of stations substantial notices of mild steel plates (15in x 9 in) marked

and welded to 8 ft star pickets have been placed next to the marks.

10 3rd Order Stations. Due to lack of RA Svy Marks, gunmetal, and ease with which these marks can be removed, a new ground mark has been devised. It consists of a 105mm cartridge stamped RA Svy Corp 1967 and the station number. This cartridge has a number of steel rods through it parallel to the ground and the whole is enclosed in a substantial concrete block poured in situ.

#### CARTOGRAPHIC SECTION

11. With five unit draughtsmen and two members of 131 Div Loc Bty working in this section the draughtsmen are able to keep abreast of compilation and printing for the first time.

#### SCREEN PRINTING

12. This section continues to use the Trucks, Van, expansible, M292 as a printing room. The removal of this van for Op PADDINGTON (See Op Report 14 para 14) did not eventuate.
