COMMANDERS DIARIES
INSTRUCTIONS

AIM

1. The aim of a Commanders Diary is to provide data on which to base future improvements in Army training, equipment, organization and administration, and to furnish historians with a record of the activities of units and formations in operational and non-operational periods in peace and in war.

GENERAL

2. Entries are to be made daily on AF C2118 (Adapted) each entry being initialled by the officer detailed to keep it.
3. Commanders Diaries will conform with the rules for drafting orders given in "Staff Duties (Australia)" Chapter 2, Section 12.

RESPONSIBILITY

During Non-operational Periods

4. A Commanders Diary is to be compiled by commanders of all formations.

During Operational Periods (1)

5. A Commanders Diary is to be compiled in duplicate by:
 - a. Commanders of all formations.
 - b. Each branch of the staff at formation headquarters commanded by a brigadier or above.
 - c. Heads of services not below the rank of lieutenant colonel.
 - d. Personal staffs and officers holding special appointments.
 - e. Unit commanders.
 - f. Commanders of a detachment of a unit when so ordered.

COMPILATION

6. Both original and duplicate copies are to consist of:
 - a. Cover (AF C 2119) (Adapted).
 - b. Index as printed on cover.
 - c. Narrative (AF C 2118) (Adapted).
 - d. Annexes as shown in the Index.
7. All details of the unit or formation (if a detachment is concerned, the name of the parent unit), period covered and enclosure numbers of the annexes are to be shown on the cover. If there has been a change of command since the last report, the date of assumption by the new commanding officer is to be included.
8. The annexes are to be assembled in the groups shown on the cover. If there are no enclosures for an annex NIL will be entered on the cover. If additional annexes are convenient for a particular headquarters, they are to be included starting at B.

DISPOSAL

13. **Original Commander's Diary.** This is to be forwarded monthly, unless otherwise ordered, by the seventh day of the succeeding month direct to AHQ.

14. **Duplicate Commander's Diary.** This must be clearly marked as a duplicate. It is to be sent separately from the original to AHQ one month after the original has been despatched but not before the former has been acknowledged.

15. When overseas, both copies of diaries are to be sent through the Army Records organization in the overseas theatre but at different times.

16. **TOP SECRET Supplementary Diaries.**

a. The documents referred to in Paragraph 9 together with a list of them made out on AF C 2118 (Adapted) must be placed in separate cover (AF C 2119) (Adapted). All details must be filled in and the cover clearly marked in red: "ANNEX Z — OFFICER ONLY". It may be convenient to group the papers by appendices.

b. Supplementary diaries must be forwarded under the normal rules for TOP SECRET correspondence, to AHQ. The inner envelope must be plainly marked:



124. CUSTOMS REGULATIONS

1. Australian servicemen on special service are allowed certain customs concessions in relation to goods sent or taken into Australia. These concessions are described in the Department of Customs and Excise leaflet "Customs Concessions to members of the Australian Defence Force on special service overseas".
2. These Customs concessions are divided into two categories:-
 - a. Goods sent to Australia.
 - b. Goods brought in by servicemen returning to Australia.
3. The concessions relating to each category are described in the leaflet mentioned in para one. In addition to the items listed in the leaflet, members returning to Australia (as distinct from those proceeding on R and R) may bring in free of duty one half gallon (previously three reputed quarts) of spiritous liquor.
4. Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph 5 below, personnel returning to Australia (as distinct from R and R) may import certain privately owned firearms and ammunition provided the conditions of Force (Army Component) RO 136/67 are fulfilled.
5. R and R Customs Restrictions. The following customs restrictions apply to all R and R personnel proceeding to Australia and is agreed inter-governmental policy. Importation of any of these items is prohibited:-

a. Narcotics	g. Firearms
b. Marihuana	h. Vietnamese currency in excess of 500 p.
c. Explosives	j. Gold or silver bullion
d. Ammunition	k. Articles produced in Communist China
e. Fireworks	l. More than one bottle of unopened alcoholic beverage.
f. Knives	m. More than one carton of cigarettes.

125. TEMPORARY ACCOMMODATION SAIGON/CHOLON AREA

1. Temporary accommodation in SAIGON/CHOLON area has reached a critical state for all ranks. Visits requiring overnight stays are to be kept to a minimum.

126. LOSS OF ID CARDS

1. The loss of ID cards is declared a prevalent offence.

127. FIRES - BURNING OFF

1. A number of fires have been caused by sparks, from burning off fires, drifting into tentage.

2. In future, whenever a burning off operation is to be conducted, all tentage within 100 metres of the fire is to be picqueted by a fire party equipped with suitable fire fighting equipment.

3. The fire party is to remain in the vicinity of the tents until the person responsible for the supervision of the task is satisfied that there is no further possibility of fire.

128. R AND R - R AND C

1. No member of 1 ATF is to take R and R or R and C during the first three months after arriving in theatre, or during the month preceding his return to Australia.

129. LEAVE - PERSONNEL ARRIVING/DEPARTING THEATRE

1. No officer or soldier is to be granted leave outside 1 ATF base area during the first three weeks following his arrival in South Vietnam or during the last four weeks preceding his RTA.

130. OUT OF BOUNDS - HOA LONG

1. The establishment known as Kangaroo Corner, Route 2, on the northern end of HOA LONG is out of bounds at all times to all members of 1 ATF, and the US units under administrative command of 1 ATF.

131. RESPONSIBILITY OF CONVOY COMMANDERS AND INDIVIDUAL DRIVERS

1. Convoy Commanders and individual drivers in control of vehicles are reminded of their responsibilities with regard to obeying local traffic rules and also the instructions of local Police Traffic Controllers.

2. In many cases the poor driving and non compliance with these rules has had the effect of destroying some of the good will that has been built up by the allies from other activities.

132. FIRE RESTRICTIONS

1. The following fire restrictions are to apply immediately:-
- a. Open fires are to be lit only between 0700 and 0900 hours.
 - b. Fires are not to be lit upwind of nearby tentage.
 - c. No fire is to be lit within 50 ft of tentage.
 - d. Rubbish is to be burnt in approved incinerators.

- e. Leaves are not to be burnt indiscriminately throughout the Sqn area. They are to be collected and burnt either in safe areas or incinerators/
- f. All fires are to be closely supervised.
- g. Fire fighting equipment is to be serviceable and readily available at all times.
- h. Fires may be lit in approved incinerators at any time.

2. 1 SAS Sqn RO 117/67 is cancelled.

133. NON-MILITARY ISSUE WEAPONS

- 1. No member is to be in possession of firearms unless such are on issue to him as part of his authorised Army equipment.
- 2. Any member presently in possession of non-military issue firearms is to deliver them to the Q store for safe custody within twenty four hours of this routine order being published.
- 3. Failure to comply with the provisions of this routine order will constitute an offence against Army Act section 11.

- 1. The attention of all ranks is directed to the notices appearing at the end of these orders.

For patrol route see ANNEX PF. Terrain Primary jungle with some secondary caused by bombing.
Patches of bamboo and scrub. Rocky outcrops, many tracks. Little water.
Good movement.G. Enemy YS 648613 at 0221725 Ptl sighted 20 VC moving NE on a track
in groups. The first group consisted of 7 females and 3 armed males,
five minutes later another group of 5 males passed, then about 3 minutes
later a further group of 4 males passed; the patrol was about to move
back from the track to observe further movement when another VC on the
track saw the patrol and ran up the track before the patrol could take
any action. The patrol withdrew NW passing 3 well constructed bunkers
approx 14 x 14ft, around which was strewn much garbage and hanging
nearby were 2 sets of black pyjamas on a clothesline. There was a bed,
some benches and cooking utensils indicating that the bunkers were lived
in.
During the night there were shots single and bursts to the N, E, S and W.
Primary and secondary explosions of mortars were heard to the NW. Time
of flight 12 seconds.
The VC were in mixed dress, one wore a light coloured camouflaged suit,
another had a red and white scarf. Basic webbing was not discernable. All
the males carried weapons but the patrol was unable to identify them.
One weapon with a large butt appeared to be an MG. The females all carried
small sacks on their shoulders apparently containing rice.H. Map corrections NilI. Misc info YS649619 an oxcart track running NW-SE had been camouflaged
from air.
In the area NORTH of where the Ptl sighted the VC there had been many
trees cut down for OHC. These had been cut between 2 - 7 days ago. There
were numerous zig-zag trenches 6ft deep in this area also.



